**Final Game Notes**

- Georgia defeated LSU 50-30 to win its 14th SEC Championship and fourth SEC Championship game title (4-6 overall record). The 14 SEC championships rank second all-time to Alabama's 29.
- Quarterback Stetson Bennett was named the SEC Championship MVP. He is the 17<sup>th</sup> quarterback to take home the honor. Bennett's 204.2 quarterback rating is the second highest in the championship game, trailing only Auburn's Cam Newton's 208.4. Other Georgia MVPs include QB David Greene (2002), QB D.J. Shockley (2005), LB Roquan Smith (2017).
- Winning head coach Kirby Smart improves to 2-3 in the championship game with his other title coming in 2017.
- Tonight's attendance of 74,810 is the fourth highest SEC Championship game in Mercedes-Benz Stadium. The record is 78,030 in 2021.
- Georgia is the fifth team to score 50+ points in the championship game. Auburn holds the record with 59 in 2013. The other fourth eventually appeared in the national championship game (Auburn 2010 & 2013; Alabama 2016 & 2020).
- The 80 combined points (UG 50, LSU 30) is the third most in the championship game. The record is 101 set in 2013 (Auburn 59, Missouri 42). No. 2 was 98 in 2020 (Alabama 52, Florida 46).
- LSU's 502 yards passing is a championship game record surpassing the previous mark of 421 set by Alabama in 2021.
- This is first time a team had two quarterbacks throw for more than 200 yards. LSU's Jayden Daniels had 208 and Garrett Nussmeier had 294 yards.
- The 52 passes attempted by LSU is a championship game record. The previous mark was 51 by Georgia vs. LSU 2011.
- The 31 passes completed by LSU is the second most in the championship game. The record is 33 by Alabama vs. Florida 2020.
- This combined 1,078 yards of total offense is the second most, trailing the 1,211 set in 2013 Auburn vs. Missouri.
- This is the fourth time a team has a pair of 100-yard receivers with LSU's Malik Nabers (128) and Kayshon Boutte (107). The last was Florida in 2020 with Kadarius Toney 153 and Kyle Pitts 129.
- Kendall Milton (113 yards) became the first Georgia back to run for 100 yards in the championship game since Todd Gurley tallied 122 yards in 2012. Milton is the third Bulldog to rush for 100+ yards as Musa Smith totaled 106 in 2002.



# GEORGIA FOOTBALL

*Postgame Notes: The SECCG vs. LSU, Dec. 3, 2022 in Atlanta, Ga.*

**Bulldogs Capture SEC Crown:** Top-ranked Georgia improves to 13-0 for the first time in school history after a 50-30 victory over No. 14 LSU in the SEC Championship Game to capture its 14th SEC title in school history. The 14 titles is the second most in the SEC.

\*The **2022 senior class** added to its **school record** for wins as it now stands at **47-5**.

\*The Bulldogs have won 15 straight going back to last season's CFP semifinal/Capital One Orange Bowl win over No. 2 Michigan.

\*This is the 2nd SEC title in the Kirby Smart era (the first since 2017) as the Bulldogs are now 79-15 in his seven seasons at the helm.

\*With today's win, Georgia improves to 9-2 all-time as the No. 1 ranked CFP team including 4-0 in 2022.

\*Senior QB **Stetson Bennett** becomes the 4th Bulldog to earn SEC Championship Game MVP honors (David Greene, QB-'02, D.J. Shockley, QB-'05, Roquan Smith, LB-'17). The Bulldogs are now 4-6 in the SEC Championship Game and 2-3 versus LSU.

**Bulldogs Tally 50 Points:** Georgia carried a 35-10 lead to halftime and won 50-30 with 529 yards of offense on 73 plays.

\*The 35 points tied the mark for most in an SEC Championship Game first half as Alabama led Florida 35-17 in 2020.

\*Georgia came in ranked 12th nationally in Scoring (38.2 ppg) and now outscored foes 279-67 in opening half and 115-23 in the 1st qtr.

\*After an LSU TD in the first quarter to tie it at 7-all, Georgia responded with a 75-yard TD drive on seven plays to take a 14-7 lead.

\*Senior QB **Stetson Bennett** (23-for-29 for 274 yards, 4 TDs) finished the 1st half 19-for-24 for 214 yards and 4 TDs to four different Bulldogs. (3-yarder to **Brock Bowers**, 22-yarder to **Ladd McConkey**, 14-yarder to **Darnell Washington**, 3-yarder to **Dillon Bell**).

\*Bennett now has 269 completions this season which ties the single season record, also by Eric Zeier in 1993.

\*Sophomore **Brock Bowers** posted a team-high six catches for 81 yards and a TD while RS-sophomore **Ladd McConkey** had five catches in the first half for 69 yards and a TD. McConkey (knee) did not return in the second half.

\*Following a Red Zone stop by the defense, Georgia put together a 95-yard drive on eight plays in 4:27 to make it 42-17. A key play in the drive was a 51-yard scamper by **Kendall Milton** while **Kenny McIntosh** capped the drive with a 2-yard score, his ninth of year.

\*Georgia converted a two-point play when **AD Mitchell** tossed one to **Darnell Washington** to make it 50-23 with 13:13 left in the game. It was the first successful two-point play since Bennett ran in for one against Arkansas in 2020.

**Defense Faces Aerial Attack:** Georgia came in ranked 1st nationally in Scoring Defense, allowing just 11.3 points a game. LSU managed to post 30 points, gaining a season-high 549 yards (502-passing; 47-rushing) on 72 plays. The passing yards was the second most ever by a Bulldog opponent, trailing only the 528 put up by Kentucky in the Wildcats 34-30 loss in Lexington in 2000.

\*Following LSU's TD to make it 7-all, the Tigers next four possessions resulted in Zero yards on 11 plays with three punts and an INT as Georgia built a 35-7 advantage. On their final possession of the first half, LSU notched a field goal, going 51 yards on seven plays.

\*The Tigers became only the second team to score a first quarter TD against Georgia as Ga. Tech did it last week. After Tech scored, Georgia outscored Tech 37-0 until allowing a TD with 2:55 left in the contest. Today for the rest of the half, Georgia outscored LSU 28-3.

\*The leading tacklers were sophomores **Javon Bullard** and **Smael Mondon** each with six. Also, the Bulldogs had four sacks by junior **Jalen Carter**, sophomore **Chaz Chambliss**, senior **Tramel Walthour** and senior **Robert Beal** with a forced fumble by Beal.

**Special Teams Summary:** Junior **Nazir Stackhouse** blocked a 32-yard field goal attempt and **Chris Smith** returned it 96 yards for a score and a 7-0 lead. It marked Georgia's first special teams TD of the year and first blocked FG return for a TD since the 2012 SEC Championship Game when Alec Ogletree returned one blocked by Cornelius Washington 55 yards for a score versus Alabama.

\*For Smith, it was his second career TD after having a pick-six for 74 yards in the '21 season opening 10-3 win over Clemson.

\*There have been five blocked field goals in SEC Championship Game history and four of them by Georgia. Before tonight, the last one here came in 2017 by DaQuan Hawkins-Muckle on Auburn's Daniel Carlson's 31-yard attempt.

\*Today marked the 27th defense or special teams score in the **Kirby Smart** era. Georgia has scored 41 points on special teams in the Smart era. Earlier this year, they had a blocked punt for a safety versus Kent State.

\*Senior PK **Jack Podlesny** registered 6 points, going 0-for-1 in FG (miss 43-yarder) with 6 PATs. He had made 11 straight field goals before tonight's miss going back to the Vanderbilt game. He is now 23-for-26. He has a team-high 130 points. He handled kickoffs too.

**Red Zone Review:** Georgia finished 5-for-5 in the Red Zone with 5 TDs while LSU finished 1-for-3 with one TD.

\*Georgia came in today ranked 1st nationally in the Red Zone at 97 percent. They have now scored 69-for-71 times including 48 TDs, 21 FGs and twice coming up empty. The Bulldogs came in No. 1 in Scoring Defense and now opponents are only 17-of-28. Today, Georgia blocked a field goal and returned it for a TD on the Tigers first trip. On 4th-and-1 at the UGA 5, the Tigers were stopped for no gain. The third trip resulted in a TD.

**Points Off Turnovers:** Georgia is now Even in Turnover Margin on the year after forcing three turnovers and having one today.

Georgia has scored 54 points off 16 turnovers while opponents have 50 points off 17 turnovers.

\*Georgia got an INT by **Smael Mondon** after a pass break up by **Chris Smith** and a tip by **Javon Bullard** to Mondon. It led to a TD and a 21-7 advantage. The Tigers recovered a fumble at the LSU 43 on the opening possession of the 2nd half. It led to a TD.

\*Smith added an INT in the 4th quarter, and it was his team-high third and 10th overall by the Bulldogs this year.

\***Warren Brinson** recovered a fumble caused on sack by **Robert Beal, Jr.** With 3:21 left, Georgia ran out the clock.

**Captains, Coin Toss and For Starters:** Senior **Chris Smith** (FS), junior **Warren McClendon** (RT), redshirt sophomore **Sedrick Van Pran** (C) and sophomore **Jamon Dumas-Johnson** (MLB) served as the captains. LSU won the toss elected to receive the ball.

\*Six Bulldogs started their second straight SEC Championship Game in **Stetson Bennett** (QB), **Sedrick Van Pran** (C), **Warren McClendon** (RT), **Darnell Washington** (TE), **Marcus Rosemy-Jacksaint** (WR) and **Kelee Ringo** (DB). **Kearis Jackson** (WR) started tonight after starting the 2019 SEC Championship Game too.

**Up Next:** No.1 Georgia (13-0) will tune in Sunday at noon (ESPN) for the CFP Selection Show to learn its seed and opponent.

\*The CFP semifinals will be played Dec. 31 on ESPN in Atlanta (Chick-fil-A Bowl) and Glendale, Ariz. (VRBO Fiesta Bowl). Game times are either 4 pm ET or 8 pm ET. Georgia is 4-2 all-time in the Chick-fil-A/Peach Bowl and has never played in the Fiesta Bowl.

\*Georgia will be making its third appearance in the CFP and extend the nation's longest active bowl streak to 26 straight years.

\*The Bulldogs are 35-21-3 all-time in bowls, and the appearances and victories rank second nationally.

THE MODERATOR: Coach, give us a recap of the game.

BRIAN KELLY: Congratulations to Kirby Smart and the University of Georgia of being the SEC champs. They were the better football team today. Proud of my team. Proud of the fight that they gave today. We were just a little short.

Some key plays obviously in the game were pivotal. Obviously the special teams play early. Inability to get off the field on third down. Fourth down, a couple opportunities that we had to convert.

In its totality, you're talking about five or six plays where, look, could have, would have, should have, right? The best team won today. I love the way our guys competed. They fought. That's who they are. That's the identity of this team all year.

Unfortunately we were not clean enough in some of those areas against the No. 1 team in the country. When you're playing the best team in the country for an SEC championship, those things are going to come back and affect the outcome.

But as I told them in the locker room, we've got a great foundation. It's a young football team that will take this lesson and build off of it.

So excited to have the opportunity to coach 'em.

THE MODERATOR: Questions for Coach Kelly or the



players.

**Q. Coach, on the blocked field goal early, do you feel like your guys weren't coached on that? They got confused?**

BRIAN KELLY: Obviously we did a poor job coaching. It's our responsibility to have our guys alert in that situation. They were not alert. That falls on coaching. That falls on my shoulders. I take full responsibility for that.

**Q. Mekhi, the fight that you guys showed in this game, obviously getting down early, the situation with the quarterback going out, Garrett stepping in, the ability to fight through that to show who you have been. What are you going to take away from this game?**

MEKHI WINGO: I would say I'm glad the team fought. That's what we've done all year. We've had multiple comebacks. Just different things. I'm proud of the team. I'm happy to go to war with these guys any day.

I will say we just fell back on our traits, who we were. We're a team that fight.

MALIK NABERS: Obviously how we looked at it didn't matter. Quarterback came in. There were just plays to be made on the field. I feel like Garrett gave us opportunities to make plays on the field and we did it in the second half.

I was very proud of the offense that we didn't give up, we kept striving and putting plays together.

**Q. Brian, Jayden, was he limited coming into the game or did something happen within the game that made his ankle injury seem to get more aggravated?**

BRIAN KELLY: No, I thought he started off really well. He was throwing the ball accurate. The early drive, obviously. He looked good, poised in the pocket.

It was second quarter, when he stepped up in the pocket, he got rolled up on. It was a reinjury, reinjured the ankle that had been injured.



But, no, I think he felt good, looked good. Our assessment was that he was moving the team in the manner that we wanted him to. It was just a matter of getting rolled up again.

**Q. Mekhi, what was it like going against that Georgia offensive line and that run game, how they kind of attacked y'all?**

MEKHI WINGO: I mean, it's a challenge every single week playing in the SEC going against good O-lines. We've played a great running back almost every week. It was just another bump in the road for us. Same preparation throughout the week. We got to fall back on our traits and do what we do, and everything will fall in line.

**Q. Coach, were you surprised they went for two to make it 50 in the fourth?**

BRIAN KELLY: Not really. I don't get too caught up in what other teams are doing. It's not my job. It's my job to stop 'em, not to figure out whether they should go for two or not.

No, I really didn't give it much thought.

**Q. Brian, you talk about not playing clean today. Was this also an illustration of how far this team needs to evolve? Do you see them being at a different level where you guys need to be?**

BRIAN KELLY: Not really. I mean, look, I'm not going to sit here and say would have, could have, should have, like I said in my opening comments.

If we just do a little bit better job on a field goal situation, take 7 off the board, it's 43 points, maybe we convert that, it's 37. You got a one-score game, you know what I mean? Now you got a one-score game going into the fourth quarter, we get stopped on fourth and inches, that's a pretty close game.

The divide is not huge, but we got work to do. As I told our guys. It's 24/7. It's not just on the field. It's how we do things away from the building. It's every day in the classroom, in the community, all the little things that are going to allow us to be more aware and to be better communicators and have an attention to detail in all those areas.

We got to continue to develop our football team. This foundation is really strong, and we'll be able to continue to build on it.

But I don't believe that the gap is something that we can't

continue to close and get back here again next year. That will be our goal, to get back here and to win it.

**Q. Malik, the pass game, with both quarterbacks was working, what specifically were y'all doing well in this game?**

MALIK NABERS: You know, it was just our guys just playing, being better than other people, just pushing the ball down the field, creating matchups with speed guys, other guys in the cornerback position.

I feel like Garrett gave us opportunities down the field, trusting us to make plays. We came out and made those plays.

**Q. Brian, about Garrett's play today, some good and some bad.**

BRIAN KELLY: Yeah, he did some really good things. He's called upon to come in and be aggressive, which he was. For a guy that's coming in off not playing a lot of football, really pleased.

Look, there's a learning experience out there. There's some throws that obviously he'd like to have back. Look, he's got a quarterback mentality that he wants to be aggressive. As Malik said, he's pushing the ball down the field, giving these guys a chance to make some plays down the field, and they did.

Sometimes there are plays where they're 50/50 balls, but he gives them a chance to make some plays. He did a nice job with that.

**Q. Coach, the next couple weeks, obviously you're focused on recruiting, but internally with this team, what are the goals that you have?**

BRIAN KELLY: Well, they got exams. They got to take care of their academics. So, first and foremost, academics. We'll give them a chance to rest up a little bit, get them in the training room, some weight training. We have our end-of-the-year banquet where we're going to celebrate our seniors on Sunday, thank them for what they've contributed to an SEC West championship.

We'll do exit meetings with our players, what they've done well, what we can do better as we look forwards another game, as well. We'll practice next week.

Again, there are other things that are as important as recruiting, and that is your team. We're not going to rush off and forget about our players and the development of our players at this very crucial time, as well.





**Q. Jayden playing through that in the second quarter, particularly the last drive, what did that tell you about him?**

MALIK NABERS: I feel like that tells me that he's passionate about playing the game of football for this team. He's a fighter. He came in here with a bump on his ankle, but he just never backed down through practice or anything. He just kept fighting.

To say that he fought through three quarters of play against the No. 1 team on a bum ankle shows that he's a pretty strong player.

**Q. Speaking for the team, the idea of looking forward towards a bowl game, the end of the season didn't finish the way you wanted it to, but you have one game left. What are your thoughts?**

MEKHI WINGO: I would say we just want to finish off the right way, get back to it, back to our process, going at it in the weight room, working hard, practicing, paying attention to the smaller details. Just end the season on a good note, send the seniors out right.

MALIK NABERS: Like Coach Kelly told us when we were talking, going out on a winning season, not a three-game losing streak. That's all I would say.

**Q. Coach, I think before the Texas A&M game, you won every November game for five seasons straight.**

BRIAN KELLY: That's correct.

**Q. What is the approach here across the next month, the off-season, to not let the final two games here take anything away from what you accomplished?**

BRIAN KELLY: Well, I don't think there's anything that can take away from what this team accomplished on the field relative to winning an SEC West championship. They won that on the field.

What I think it does is it brings into light clearly the progress that we've made and the things that we have to continue to work on.

I think for everybody, it clearly defines who we want to be and that we're not there yet. That's okay. You know, that's okay. We're not happy that we're not the SEC champs. That's not what we wanted today. We wanted to win this game. But we know where we're at.

We've clearly talked about what we need to do to be the

SEC champs. That's okay. We need to go to work and get better at the things necessary for us to be better collectively, individually and as a football program.

THE MODERATOR: We'll open things by asking Coach Smart to make some opening comments and then go to questions.

KIRBY SMART: We came here with a plan to have a connected assault. We talked about it all week. We wanted our team to stay connected, and they did that.

Our team kind of played this game like they played the whole season: unbelievably well in spurts and unbelievably poor in spurts, and answered the bell when they had to.

I'm proud of 'em. They've handled that all year. I want to give a lot of credit to Brian Kelly and the LSU team that never went away, never quit fighting. Had an injured quarterback. They did a really good job of fighting and pushing through.

But this has been a different group. You guys have tried to label them, tried to figure 'em out, tried to analyze 'em. They're not comprehensible. They do what they have to do, and they do it well. They care about each other and they really do it for each other.

No greater example of that than these two men sitting next to me who have been part of our program for a long time.

THE MODERATOR: Questions, please.



**Q. Chris, walk me through the blocked field goal? Kirby, was it a no, no, no, then all right?**

KIRBY SMART: I'll let Chris answer it. Chris knows we watch those in the team meeting about once every three weeks. I'll let him talk about it.

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: Like Coach said, that's a scenario we go over a lot. We know the ball past the line of scrimmage, we had an opportunity to be able to pick it up. I was waiting for the go to get it from the sideline.

KIRBY SMART: The rule is you're not allowed to pick it up unless you score with it (smiling).

**Q. Kirby, I don't know if you saw when Jalen picked up the LSU quarterback and almost held him there. Stetson is shaking his head. Do you see that sort of stuff from him in practice? Have you ever seen a player with that happen before?**

KIRBY SMART: Yeah, I've seen players do that. They usually didn't end well. They usually don't have the restraint. I told him, I said, You proved to a lot of people that there's a thought process and great restraint to keep from doing something dumb. It showed great discipline on his part to not do anything.

We had a penalty in this game early in the year, I think it was Kamari, on a -- I don't know if you call it a body-to-body suplex tackle. You don't do that. I just got a lot of respect for Jalen to not do that.

Unfortunately we don't let him do that to Stetson, otherwise Stetson would be in pieces.

**Q. Stetson, you seemed extremely confident in the first half. What was it about the game plan that made you feel so comfortable?**

STETSON BENNETT: Well, I mean, I was familiar with the plays. We repped them a lot during the week, during the season. We had executed them during the week. When it's the SEC Championship, you kind of got to play confident. If you don't, then they're going to beat you.





Yeah, I don't know. Got good players. I mean, I don't think I got touched tonight. Our O-line was incredible, so...

**Q. Everybody was talking before the season about all the guys you don't have coming back. What were people missing in their analysis of you guys coming into this season?**

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: I think what they were missing was the culture we were able to create around here, the next-man mentality. Start of the season we had a lot of guys that weren't able to play. But as the season went on, they gained experience, and I think that helped us out a lot.

STETSON BENNETT: For me and Chris, it took us a while to get here, right? Really no option but to play well now, right? When things start going bad, what are you going to do? Stop? Like no.

We knew how hard it was to play for the University of Georgia, right? So now we'll do almost anything to win. I think we have a lot of older guys like that.

**Q. Chris, what's the takeaway from this? Obviously you guys got more work, you've got great big huge games in front of you. 506 yard passing allowed in this game today. What is your takeaway on that? Do you flush that, or are there some lessons learned tonight?**

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: We got a lot of work to do. Definitely don't flush it. But we were able to come out on top with a great team win. We got to get back to the drawing board and continue to work.

**Q. Kirby, you mentioned some unbelievably poor spurts here in the course of the game. What concerned you coming out of tonight? What are you going to work on over the next four weeks?**

KIRBY SMART: Everything. Like, there's nothing that we can't work on during the next four weeks, right? We do camp-style practices. Our guys know everybody can get better. Conditioning level, tackling.

Football's a tough, hard sport. Our guys embrace challenges. So I think they'll embrace the challenge of getting better. You can't say you're going to go work on one thing because then you'll be giving up on some other things. We need to work on a lot of things.

Our guys understand as the year goes on, teams tackle poorly, teams cover poorly. Defense usually deteriorates. That's not the culture here. It won't be accepted or

tolerated, so we got to fix it.

**Q. (No microphone.)**

KIRBY SMART: I'll have to watch the tape to see. We played a different style the second half. That affected us some. Just got to play better. We got to affect the quarterback better.

**Q. Stetson, the coach spoke earlier this week about checking the box as far as this game is concerned. This may sound like a silly question, you won a national title last year, came up short in this one, was there any kind of void that you were determined to take care of today?**

STETSON BENNETT: What's the question? Sorry.

**Q. You won a national title last year, came up short in this game. How important was it to make up for that today?**

STETSON BENNETT: Yeah, winning the SEC is a big deal. This is the best conference in football. National championships is huge and great. That's our next goal. But SEC is the first goal, second goal after winning the East.

Winning the SEC championship, there's only one of those. It's a banner. It's the same thing as a national championship, just a little bit smaller scale.

So, yeah, it was important for us.

**Q. Kirby and Chris, did the example of the ball hitting the LSU player's helmet, the field goal, is that a perfect example of not playing till the whistle is blown?**

KIRBY SMART: Yeah, I think it's a trite expression to say play till the whistle is blown. Everybody plays till the whistle is blown. That's what you do.

I think it's more about his instincts. That's the same play and same exact route that he picked off on Clemson last year. He jumped it. He played it aggressive. He understood what the quarterback's check was. He understood his leverage.

How many times do you think you've run that stunt since you've been here?

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: A ton.

KIRBY SMART: A ton. He saw it, jumped it. By him jumping, it caused the ball to go in the air. And then it



bounced off him.

I think Smael's -- we talk about tips and overthrows, Mel Tucker had a saying here, what do we say, Chris, tips and overthrows?

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: Got to get those.

KIRBY SMART: We got 'em. That's a big deal. Smael did it, and then Chris picking it up.

That's football savvy and football awareness for him to pick that ball up. Because we tell them. We showed him video of guys touching the ball after the block and the other team gaining possession. But we also say if you can score, go do it. I don't know if you remember last year, we blocked one on Alabama in the national championship game, and Lewis or Quay about messed it up. They would have gotten the ball. We use that as an example of don't touch it.

Chris thought about that. You could see him thinking about that. Then he realized, There's nobody covering. So he went.

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: Same thing coach said, just savviness and instincts, understanding what we want to get done when we step out there.

**Q. Anything on the McConkey and McClendon front?**

KIRBY SMART: McClendon is light MCL. Don't know how long it will be. He wasn't able to go back in obviously. I don't know what grade it is. We'll get it looked at tomorrow.

Lads is continuation of what he has been having. His knees have been bothering him. He has some tendinitis in there. Didn't so much hurt him on the play, it just started aggravating him more. He didn't feel like he could go.

**Q. Stetson, you had a moment after your touchdown pass to Darnell, you kind of looked over to the sideline and shook your head. What was going through your mind?**

STETSON BENNETT: It's fun to throw to somebody that big and that fast. Thank you for bringing him here and thank you for calling that play.

No, I mean, I don't know. I felt like we were in a rhythm. Ladd was the one after. I guess that was the next drive. I can't remember, sorry.

But, yeah, we were in a zone. It felt like what we were calling we were executing. We were having fun playing

football there.

**Q. Kirby and Stetson, Kendall had another game with several big runs. How big has he been in the last few games back from the injury?**

KIRBY SMART: Man, his toughness. I thought tonight was the first time he really had his pad level and was running through contact. He's made some big runs, but tonight his pads were lower, he ran over people, kept his legs churning. He had the explosive ones. He's really fast when he's broken out of there. It'll almost like he's gaining steam at the end of the year as he's running the ball.

**Q. Chris, earlier in the week you said fourth time is a charm. How does it feel to finally get this one?**

CHRISTOPHER SMITH: It feels amazing. Just coming up short so many times, just to finally be able to get a win, it feels great for sure.

**Q. Kirby, did you call the two-point conversion so y'all could use that play? Stetson, your view on that play?**

KIRBY SMART: We went with it because it was by the book. We felt that differential made it right. I think it was 25 to go to 27, is that right? It was just by the book.

The book said if they were able to score, their analytics were to go for two. We might as well save that play. It's one we've worked on for a long time. In football you don't save plays. You run 'em when you need 'em. We didn't know what was going to happen the next three to four series, so we executed it.

STETSON BENNETT: I liked it. It was fun to just see it. I talked to A.D. in the huddle, because he hadn't played that much. I was like, All right, this is you, brother.

I sprinted left, tossed it to him. We actually threw a spiral I think. I don't think he's thrown one of those in practice. I don't think he's repped that play.

KIRBY SMART: No.

STETSON BENNETT: Somebody else did.

KIRBY SMART: Me and A.D. have something that you'll never have.

STETSON BENNETT: What?

KIRBY SMART: We're both career passing record at UGA is one for one. Two-point conversions, dropped the snap, one for one. You and Bubba are behind me. It's me and

A.D. (smiling).

**Q. Coach, they seemed like they were having some momentum. They scored a couple touchdowns. Y'all get the ball at the five. Eight plays, 95 yards. Took the momentum out of the game. Is that planned? Is there a message in the huddle?**

KIRBY SMART: Let me tell you what was planned. To come out in the second half and drive it down their throat. We were doing that, we had a little mishap, okay? So that was the plan. The plan was being executed, all right? We didn't play real good defense tonight. But there were some opportunities that they didn't just make plays, we just didn't make plays.

Malaki had a couple tough plays. He makes those plays every day in practice. I would bet money on Malaki playing a half safety a thousand times.

He misjudged the ball and the kid is crushed for it. But you know what, he's going to be a better football player for having experienced it. We gave up some plays that we probably shouldn't have.

You give them credit for that. We got to continue to grow. I thought the play of the game was the Marcus Rosemy screen, third-and-five backed up, third-and-six backed up. Stets hits him on a screen. Marcus sticks it in there. Two great blocks. That was the drive you're referencing. Without that conversion we're punting the ball back to them.

Great call by Monk, too.

**Q. Say you had an undefeated quarterback who might be up for an individual award, maybe like the Heisman, would you lobby for that for him?**

KIRBY SMART: Well, absolutely. I mean, I think it's one of those things, this guy's 23 of 29 in the second half, I mean, he didn't get to do a whole lot in the second half, so I don't know what he was in the first half. He's played really well.

I had several people come up to me and say they thought he played the best game of his career tonight. He played really good.

**Q. Coach, you mentioned the third down play, how physical you guys were, able to get that first down. How proud are you of your team on how physical they are, especially your receivers?**

KIRBY SMART: Yeah, the physicality at our place comes out every day in practice. The thing I'll never shy away

from or tell people is that physical wins in our league. You see, our league's different. Our league's tough. Our league's hard. Week in and week out, it's extremely physical.

There was more depth in our league this year than I ever remember. I mean, top to bottom. You look at what Vanderbilt was able to do, what South Carolina is able to do, Mississippi State is able to do. Everybody is really physical.

So you got to set yourself apart and you got to have a culture, build your culture around guys who think toughness matters. If toughness doesn't matter, you have no chance in this week. You win on the road with toughness. I thought we won tonight with some toughness.

**Q. Stetson, obviously the last two performances in here have been really strong for you. Can you talk about your comfort level playing here, the likelihood you'll be back here again in a few weeks.**

STETSON BENNETT: Well, I don't know what goes into all those decisions.

Yeah, I mean, we like this place. We play pretty good here (smiling). I don't know if it's the turf or humidity. Good Lord, it was hot in there today. I'm about to cramp up sitting here and I didn't barely run.

I mean, I don't know. I don't think it's anything about this place in particular. I think we just had a good game plan and went out and executed it.

**Q. Kirby, obviously tomorrow is the selection show. How much do you know about what awaits you guy, who the opponent might be? Did you see a little bit of the chaos that took place before your game got played?**

KIRBY SMART: I have not seen one thing. I tried not to pay attention to any of it. I didn't have any games on or anything. I haven't heard anything to even know what's going on.

It didn't matter. To me, that's so far away that, like, we don't control it. Number two, so far away you got time to prepare for it. My focus has been on this because I told those kids, I don't want one kid to walk out of our program without an SEC championship ring for their career. That was about to happen if we didn't get that one.

They said enough was enough tonight. They got 'em one.
