2023 ACC Football Championship Game

No. 4 Florida State 16, No. 14 Louisville 6

Florida State won its 16th ACC title and its first since 2014. FSU's 16 titles are second to Clemson's 21. The Seminoles won their fifth ACC Football Championship Game (2005, 2012, 2013, 2014).

FSU is one of only four undefeated teams remaining in all of FBS, joining Michigan, Liberty and Washington.

The Seminoles are on a 19-game winning streak dating back to last year, the longest active streak in the ACC and the second-longest active streak in the country. The winning streak is also the second-longest in program history and third-longest in ACC history.

FSU's defense racked up season highs in tackles for loss (13), sacks (7) and PBUs (10).

FSU's Braden Fiske had a huge night, recording career highs in tackles (9), tackles for loss (4.5) and sacks (3.0). He doubled his season totals in TFLs and sacks today.

FSU held Louisville to six points, its fewest since a 27-3 loss to Virginia on Sept. 22, 2018. That also marked the last time UofL did not score a touchdown.

The Cardinals came into the game averaging 33.0 points per game. FSU also held Louisville to 188 yards of total offense, 250 yards below its season average of 438.6.

The Cardinals' previous season low in total yardage was 306 against NC State. FSU held Louisville to minus-14 yards over its final four possessions of the game.

FSU's Lawrance Toafili rushed for 118 yards, which is eighth most in championship game history. He is the 14th player to rush for at least 100 yards in the ACC Football Championship Game.

Toafili's third-quarter run of 73 yards was the longest non-scoring rush in championship game history and the second longest-run (Travis Etienne, Clemson, 75 yards, vs. Pitt, 2018).

The teams combined for 18 punts, which is a championship game record. Both teams punted nine times, which ties the championship game record for a team.

After making its first trip to the ACC Football Championship game, Louisville will take a 10-3 record into its bowl game.

With Louisville making its first appearance in the championship game this year, 13 different ACC teams

TEAM NOTES

Louisville falls to 6-18 in the all-time series vs. Florida State, meeting for the first time on a neutral field.

Louisville falls to 10-3 overall, achieving that record for the first time in program history.

Louisville drops to 17-16-1 in neutral site games, ending a three-game winning streak on neutral fields which matched the longest streak in program history.

Louisville moves on to its bowl game, playing 14 games in a season for the first time.

Florida State was penalty-free in the first half, marking three straight halves without an opponent penalty for the first time since records are available (1962).

Louisville extends its streak of holding opponents scoreless on their first possession to 17 games.

Louisville holds its 11th opponent in 13 games this season scoreless in the first quarter, the most first-quarter shutouts in program history.

Louisville extends its scoring streak to 300 games, the ninth longest active streak in FBS.

Each team punts nine times for the first time in a Louisville game since Drake and Louisville punted 10 and 11 times, respectively, on Sept. 25, 1971.

Louisville limits Florida State to 219 yards of total offense, the second lowest output by the Seminoles in the all-time series, surpassing only a 212-yard outing vs. the Cards in 1970.

The Cards hold Florida State to its lowest offensive yardage total since Miami held the Seminoles to 203 yards on Nov. 2, 2019.

PLAYER NOTES

QB Jack Plummer was 14-of-36 passing for a season-low 111 yards, no touchdowns, and one interception. He rushed 13 times for a loss of 32 yards including seven sacks for 59 yards.

RB Jawhar Jordan led Louisville's rushers with 52 yards on 14 carries, reaching 2,037 career rushing yards to become the Cards' 18th 2,000-yard career rusher.

WR Jamari Thrash led Louisville's receivers with seven receptions for 57 yards.

LB TJ Quinn led the Louisville defense with 11 tackles.

CB Storm Duck had the first sack and first solo tackle for loss in his Louisville career to go with two tackles.

DT Ramon Puryear had his fourth sack and sixth tackle for loss of the season to go with two tackles.

CB Quincy Riley had a pass breakup to push his team-leading total to nine and added a solo tackle.

LB Jaylin Alderman had six tackles and matched his career high with 1.5 tackles for loss along with an assisted sack and a pass breakup.

DE Stephen Herron had two quarterback hurries to take the team lead with eight on the season. He added four tackles and an assisted sack and assisted tackle for loss.

K Brock Travelstead made both of his field goal attempts from 36 and 33 yards to push his season total to 17 made field goals, tied for fourth most in a season at Louisville.

P Brady Hodges punted nine times for 371 yards, the most punts by a Louisville kicker since Mason King punted nine times at Boston College in 2018 and the most punting yards since King punted for 404 yards vs. LSU in the 2016 Citrus Bowl.

- » No. 4 Florida State won its 16th ACC championship and improved to 5-1 in the ACC Championship Game with a 16-6 win over No. 14 Louisville Saturday at Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte, North Carolina. Florida State leads the all-time series with Louisville 18-6.
- » The 16 ACC championships are the most among all ACC programs since Florida State joined the league in 1992.
- » The Seminoles improved to 13-0 overall with eight wins over bowl-eligible Power 5 teams, the most in the nation. FSU has won 13 games for the third time in program history (14-0 in 2013, 13-1 in 2014).
- » Saturday was the first time since Nov. 28, 2015, vs. Florida (W, 27-2) that Florida State has held a ranked opponent to under 10 points.
- » FSU is now 27-6 all-time when ranked No. 4 in the AP poll, including 9-0 this year. FSU is 157-29 when ranked in the top 5 with a 12-0 mark in 2023.
- » Florida State's 19-game win streak is the 2nd-longest active streak nationally, the 2nd-longest in FSU history and 3rd-longest in ACC history. During its current win streak, Florida State has outscored its opponents 734-316.
- » Florida State is now 2-0 in neutral site games in 2023 and has won four straight over the past two years (2023 vs. LSU in Orlando, 2022 vs. Oklahoma in Orlando and vs. LSU in New Orleans).
- » FSU is 42-13 in NFL stadiums over the past 40 seasons with four straight wins (2023 at Pitt, 2022 at Miami and vs. LSU in New Orleans).
- » Louisville came into Saturday's game averaging 33.0 points per game and had scored 30 or more points in their last four games and 8 of 12 this season. The Cardinals were averaging 438.6 yards per game (188 in ACCCG) and 6.57 yards per play (2.7 in ACCCG).
- » Florida State's 7.0 sacks, 14.0 TFLs and 10 PBUs were all season highs.
- » For the second consecutive game, FSU held its opponent to negative yardage in the fourth quarter (-15 at Florida, -23 vs. Louisville).
- » Defensive tackle **Braden Fiske** had a career night with 9 total tackles, 3.0 sacks and 4.5 tackles for loss, all career highs. His sacks and TFLs are season-highs for any Nole, and his tackles are the second-most for a Nole.
- » Running back and game MVP **Lawrance Toafili** took snaps as the wildcat quarterback Saturday and ran for a career-high 118 yards including a 73-yard run in the third quarter that was his longest of the season. It was the second-longest run in ACC Championship Game history.
- » Toafili's 73-yard run tied his career high from his freshman season and came on the Noles' first play after the Cardinals tied the game. It was Toafili's third career 100-yard game.
- » Florida State held Louisville to 69 total yards, 4-for-14 passing, 1-for-8 on third down and had 6.0 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks and 3 PBU in the first half. FSU's last first-half shutout was a 44-14 win vs. Boston College last season.
- » Louisville's six points were tied for the second-fewest points scored in ACC Championship Game history. The only other first-half shutouts in the ACC Championship were Clemson vs. Miami in 2017 and FSU vs. Duke in 2013.
- » Defensive end **Jared Verse** finished the game with 2.0 sacks and 3.0 TFL's. He leads FSU with 9.0 sacks and 12.5 TFLs this year. Verse also surpassed 30 career sacks and 50 career TFLs during Saturday's game.
- » With a PBU in the fourth quarter, **Patrick Payton** joins Christian Wilkins (Clemson, 2016) as the only two ACC defensive linemen to record 10 or more pass breakups in a single season.
- » Payton tied his career high with seven total tackles. Payton ended the night with seven total tackles, 1.0 sack, 2.0 TFLs and one PBU.
- » Linebacker **DJ Lundy** picked up his sixth TFL on Saturday which is his most in a single season.
- » Linebacker **Kalen DeLoach** deflected a pass on 4th down, his second PBU of the year. Louisville was 0-for-5 on third down in the first quarter and 0-for-1 on 4th down.
- » Kicker **Ryan Fitzgerald** scored 10 points, including a career-high 3 made field goals. He ranks 9th in FSU history with 296 career points, passing Dalvin Cook (288, 2014-16) and Warrick Dunn (294, 1993-96). His 112 points are tied for 11th in a season at FSU.
- » Fitzgerald is 4th in FSU history with 58 made PAT this year.
- » **Azareye'h Thomas** forced his first career fumble. The play resulted in a four-yard loss, giving him 4.5 TFL on the season.
- » Every member of FSU's starting offensive line has at least 36 career starts and the five have combined for 212 in their careers.
- » Linebacker **Tatum Bethune** intercepted his first pass as a Seminole and third of his career. FSU has a takeaway in 12 of 13 games this season.
- » Florida State's 16 points tonight moved them to 6th all-time for total points in a single season with 481.
- » Defensive back **Renardo Green** tied his career high with three PBUs.
- » **Keon Coleman** surpassed 1,500 receiving yards in his career with four catches for 19 yards.
- » FSU's defense has not allowed 30 points in a game this season. The 13-game streak is the longest active in the ACC and 3rd-longest in the country. The last time Florida State held at least 13 consecutive opponents below 30 points was a 22-game streak from 2003-05.

JEFF BROHM: Credit them. Their players, their coaches. They played hard and they found a way to win the game.

For us, it was disappointing. I'll take the blame for the loss. I would have liked to have played a whole lot better than that on offense. I thought our defense played really, really well the entire game, gave us a chance without question. Our special teams played really well, and we were not up to par on offense, so that's my fault.

Once we had to kind of rely on the passing game a little too much, we couldn't execute very well, so that was disappointing.

We'll have to figure out ways to fix that moving forward. I'm sure we'll have another tough game in the bowl game coming up, but disappointed today, but I do think we had a lot of guys that played hard and quite a few guys that played really well, especially on defense and special teams.

Unfortunately offense was not good, and that's my fault.

Q. You guys had an incompleteness in the end zone there in the fourth quarter and I was curious did you consider challenging that call, the incompleteness on the drop?

JEFF BROHM: Well, I would hope that they reviewed it. We had some time there. I was told it was an incomplete pass. That's all I know on that one.

Q. When they went to the wildcat and Toafili had success on the back-to-back plays with the touchdown, why did that happen? You guys had obviously been very good against the run against

them. Why did that allow them to have some success?

JEFF BROHM: Well, quite honestly, our adjustment to wildcat the first couple times was not good, so that part I did not like. That's on us as coaches. After that we adjusted it to something more aggressive, and we stopped it every time, so that was not the best coaching on our end, and then of course we didn't execute it, but we switched that plan up after that, and unfortunately it cost us.

Q. Jeff, when you talk about the offense just having a rough night, does that come down to just like keeping Jack upright? He was getting tons of pressure. When you look at the game, what do you think was the biggest failure for the offense?

JEFF BROHM: Well, these guys pressed us across the board on the slot, on the outside. They challenged routes, and we had to earn our completions. We got a few. We missed a couple plays early we could have hit.

We kind of dropped one in the end zone right before the end of the fourth quarter that we need to catch. We let the one kind of slip out of our tight end in the end zone, as well, that we need to catch, and after that we didn't execute.

Once it turned into a heavy pass-oriented game in the fourth quarter when we were down, we were really dismal with that. So just goes to show that if we don't have balance, we have a long ways to go in the passing game.

Q. How would you evaluate how Jack played tonight? What do you think he struggled with?

JEFF BROHM: Well, it wasn't his best game. I think early on, he did some pretty good things. Missed a few throws here and there. Didn't pull the trigger a few times. But not until the interception in the end zone, that's when the wheels started to come off a little bit.

You've got to go back and look and figure out ways to not allow that to happen again, but like I said, he played hard. He hung in there.

Like I said, once we got to where we were pass oriented trying to come back, they were good pass rushers. We got pressure on the quarterback. Could he have stood in there a little longer, made a couple of those? Probably.

But, you know, the balance left us, and really all year when we've had to throw it a whole lot, we have not been as efficient as we need to be. We've got work to do.

Q. How much do you attribute just the offensive mistakes and miscues to being self-inflicted as opposed to what Florida State was doing defensively?

JEFF BROHM: Well, I'll give Florida State a whole lot of credit. We knew they were going to press us on the outside, press us on the slots, challenge routes, play downhill. They were very active, and we needed to run the ball.

We had a hard time getting some yards with the run early on. Finally broke a few on a couple drives early in the second half that helped us. Got us in position to take a lead, to get some points, and we stalled in the red zone.

We had some chances. Like I said, we probably had -- they weren't two easy catches, but we had two balls that we can easily catch to score a touchdown.

I think once we threw the interception on 3rd down when we're in scoring territory and right in the game, that's when the wheels started to come off, and we were extremely inefficient after that.

Like I said, that's on me. I need to do a better job.

Q. How much, when you look back on this game in terms of the building of this program, how you want it, how much will you point to some of those plays that you feel like you could have made in terms of a championship game, you're not going to get a lot of opportunities and you have to seize those opportunities?

JEFF BROHM: Well, like I said, the way I saw the game on the field, I haven't watched the film, but our defense really played well, and we needed them to. The team was playing their third quarterback.

But we played pretty well overall other than the wildcat couple plays that really cost us. They played to the end, so I'm proud of their effort. They kept us in the game. Our

special teams -- okay, we maybe had one punt that we shanked, but other than that, got us the advantage, got us the ball in scoring territory.

Then we couldn't convert. Like I said, we had chances to convert, and we have to make those plays.

Sometimes guys got to understand you've got to make contested plays. You've got to make contested plays with people kind of holding on to you, grabbing on to you, hitting you as you catch the ball, hitting you as you throw the ball.

Against good football teams that's how real football works, and we were not able to make those. And like I said, after that then we really started to stink it up on offense in the fourth quarter.

Q. Jeff, just big picture, what was this experience like being here, playing for an ACC Championship, and what did you say to the guys in the locker room after this?

JEFF BROHM: Well, you know, I was very optimistic with our team after the game because I was very proud of their performance. I thought they played very hard. I thought there were a lot of guys that prepared hard, wanted to win, quite a few guys that gave really good performances.

Unfortunately we had a handful not play up to par, and like I said, I think you've got to play better on offense.

So that starts with me as the head coach. We've got to figure out ways to create a few more big plays. We've got to figure out a way when we have to throw the ball a lot to be more efficient.

That was what was disappointing. That's what cost us. But I do think our guys wanted to win. They were up for the challenge as far as facing an undefeated team in a championship game.

We had some moments. We score a couple of those touchdowns late in the third quarter, early in the fourth quarter, it's a different ballgame, but we didn't. When that didn't happen, they took advantage of it, and things went south.

Q. You touched on it a little bit just now, but overall how do you feel like this team handled the moment being it was the first time the program has gotten to the ACC Championship game?

JEFF BROHM: I thought they handled the moment well as far as they were jacked up, ready to play. They had a good week of practice. It was not fun losing our last game,

as well, but we knew this was going to be very challenging.
We were going to have to play well in order to win.

I think we were right there in the game with numerous chances. Stalled in the red zone for field goals early on, which you can't do against good teams. Didn't convert when we had a chance to score, and I don't know, maybe take the lead or tie the game. I can't remember what the score was. And really get some momentum going. Didn't happen.

Then once we had to try to make plays in the fourth quarter, we didn't make any.

Q. Mike, I asked you yesterday about trying to lobby for Florida State, and there's a lot of people questioning whether you deserve a playoff spot because you don't have your starting quarterback, and that has increased since this game ended. What do you have to say about why this team belongs in the playoff?

MIKE NORVELL: Because this is a real team. It's one that finds a way to win games. Whatever it needs to look like.

There's plenty of teams that have talent. There's plenty of teams that you could sit there and point to a moment here or a moment there, but it's about getting the win. It's about making sure that you show up and you do the things necessary to achieve in each situation, and we've done that on the road. We've done it at home. We've done it with a backup quarterback, and now we've done it with a true freshman quarterback. This team continues to find ways to make it happen.

You sit back and you look, since the BCS was created and the history of this, there's never been an undefeated Power 5 team that was denied an opportunity to play for a national championship over a one-loss team.

There's a reason. Because you have to earn it on the field. I don't care how much talent you have. I don't care what it looks like on a game or in a moment. You've got to get it done, and if you have all that ability, well, go finish. That's what this team has done. This team has showed up week in and week out and they've worked for it.

We've had some one-play games. We've had some challenging moments that they had to respond, and that's what makes a champion. These guys are champions.

You know what, if we get our opportunity, which I fully expect to get, this is going to be a team that's going to continue to do all things necessary to put themselves in a position to go take the next step.

I believe in this football team. It's funny there's people that can count us out. Jordan Travis went down. That was a special player. He means everything to our program.

MIKE NORVELL: First off, just so proud of our football team. The work they put in, the journey we've been on, the ups, the downs, the adversity that we've faced, tonight starting a true freshman quarterback in the ACC Championship game, not necessarily how we envisioned it, as we've been going through these last 13 games, but it was a football team that responded together, and that's what we have. We have a real team, no matter how you've got to do it, no matter what it needs to look like, we find ways to win games.

We've got the most Power Five wins over bowl eligible teams in the country. This is a team that has been resilient in the way that they have had to overcome, and it shows up in how they play.

Defense had to show up big tonight, and they did. That was a really good Louisville offense that's been playing -- I think they scored 30 points in the last five or six games that they played, and to hold them to 6 points was awesome.

We made the plays necessary, and that's what this team is all about. There's times that you face challenges and you've got to get yourself up, and we've been through that. We've been through that the last four years. I'm grateful for all those challenges, for this team to go up and show up in times just like this.

I knew it was going to take everybody, and it absolutely did. And to be able to finish up 13-0, conference champions, the schedule which we played and how we've had to work through it, it's a special group, and I'm just honored for the opportunity to coach them.



When he went down, we still went on the road, and big rival, found adversity and responded to it and found a way to get a win.

Tonight, same thing. Adversity shows up, challenges set in, this team is built for it. I believe in them. I don't care where, who, when. I've had 13 straight games this season, and the final six last season, and you know, we beat a lot of teams from all these different conferences that presumed are at this other -- we show up and play and find a way to win, and that's what this team has done.

Q. To follow up on that, do you feel like you could compete with the other three teams if you make it to the College Football Playoff?

MIKE NORVELL: I believe in this team 100 percent. I don't care who, where, when we play. This team is going to show up and they're going to battle. You can take any stat line. And we told our guys, tonight whatever it takes, if it's offense, if it's defense, we've got to help and we've got to respond and we've got to have each other's back in situations.

We scored 16 points tonight. If somebody said you score 16 points, what's it going to look like? Tonight it looked like a win. Something that will be remembered. It's something that obviously our football team did what was necessary, right, to be able to achieve success.

Because that's what it comes down to. You can have all the talent in the world, but it comes down to doing the things necessary to win games, and that's what this team just consistently does.

Q. Can you talk about going to LT in the wildcat, getting a spark defensively, and just the decision to do that with UL's defense being very good?

MIKE NORVELL: We talked about it all week. It's a defense that doesn't give up much in the run game. We felt we if we could gain a little bit of an advantage if we were able to implement a little bit of wildcat into it. We really put it in late in the week, and it was something that these guys, they did a wonderful job of being able to adapt to it.

LT had an unbelievable game. The big run, the touchdown, it was a spark we needed, and our offensive line, we knew there was going to be some challenges. That was a really good defense that we played against, but they rose up in the moment and were able to get it accomplished.

Q. How scary is the defense now after tonight?

Because I feel like going into this College Football Playoff, some of these three teams you got to look out for our defense.

MIKE NORVELL: Yeah, I think our defense has played at an extremely high level. We have gotten better throughout the season. You look at the way they played in the second half of games. They can adapt, they can adjust, they can go out there and execute.

They got put in challenging situations tonight. To be able to get the interception there, with Tatum in the end zone, that was such a huge play.

These guys have such heart. They're such competitors. Whoever lines up across from us, we know we've got to embrace the challenge. We're built for challenge. That's the way that we work, the way that we push the standard of what's necessary here at Florida State. It's how we've gotten the program back to where it is, because of guys like this.

It's just a great group, and I thought our defense was lights out tonight and helped carry us to the championship tonight.

Q. Brock Glenn showed some poise at different times; made throws when you guys needed to; he obviously did enough, like you mentioned, to win the game. Talk about his performance.

MIKE NORVELL: You know, it was remarkable. To be able to go in there -- that's the thing, he's a true freshman, but he missed the better part of the middle of the season due to injury.

He's got great confidence. He's going to be a special player. I've got a lot of confidence in where his career is going.

But he does have poise, and he's able to go out there and execute. We put a lot on our quarterbacks, and he embraces that, as well.

For a few freshman just to get his first start in the ACC Championship game, I don't think that's happened in, what was it, 20-something years for a first-time starting quarterback? Two times in the last 20 years that that's had to show up, and we got it done.

LAWRANCE TOAFILI: We're extremely proud of him. He comes to work every day, and he just has the mindset that if anybody goes down, he's got to be ready. I'm very proud of him and showing the moments and just being ready for his moments. I'm definitely proud of him for that.

Q. We were watching on Instagram waiting to see Braden and Jared break the rock. Talk about the defense; it seems like everyone in that unit played at a level to contribute tonight?

MIKE NORVELL: It was a talented offensive line group, too, from Louisville, too, but those guys knew it was going to take all of them.

You could go down the line like you mentioned. Pat; Fabien had a couple big plays; Josh Farmer; Jared; Braden. I don't want to leave anybody out because all of those guys were impactful. I thought our linebacking corps really flew around the ball. Our secondary embraced the challenge in huge plays and in one-on-one situations where guys just -- they got the job done. We wanted to be aggressive. We wanted to attack.

I've got all the respect in the world for Coach Brohm and the offensive mind that he is and the players that they have on that team, but our guys were special tonight.

Q. LT, what was your reaction during the week as it became clear the wildcat was going to be a bigger part of the package and what did you see on the 73-yard run?

LAWRANCE TOAFILI: I was just trying to be ready for my moment, trying to make it happen if it needed to be done.

On that play, it actually just opened up. It was a perfect block by the lineman and running back in the backfield. He blocked for me, too, so it was really just me running, so definitely grateful for them.

MIKE NORVELL: You did it fast, and I liked it.

Q. Mike, are you surprised it's even a conversation? Going undefeated in a Power Five conference, the whole point is to win the games and other teams haven't. Are you surprised it's even a conversation?

MIKE NORVELL: Yeah, it's entertainment in some things to be able to have the conversation, but I don't think there is a conversation. We're at Florida State. We open up a season with LSU on the road, maybe a Heisman Trophy candidate, maybe winner in their quarterback that -- you know, we showed what we were about then defensively, special teams-wise, offense, the talent that we have.

The way that we've won games. To go on the road at Clemson. Nobody else was able to accomplish that. Some ranked teams went in there, but we were the only team that was able to beat them on the road, and it was

tough.

We've been down in games. We've been down 10 points I think in three or four different games, and we responded. It's not just like we came back -- we came back and finished games. We came back and were able to do the things necessary to achieve victory.

I don't think there is a conversation. This is a team that is well deserving. This is a team that has earned it. This is a team that has showed up consistently and proven that they have what it takes to win, and we've done it against more Power Five bowl eligible teams than anybody else out there.

So I don't want to hear about the schedule. Actually we schedule a tough non-conference. We put ourselves out there, and then you embrace it in how you go about your business. This team, they've earned it.

Like I said, each week it changes what's the hot team or the most talented team, but then when they lose a game, there's a reason. This team has all the ability, and they just get it done.

Q. Coach, playing with a third string quarterback in the ACC Championship game and winning it is an amazing and phenomenal feat, so just talk about the adversity your team has had to overcome along with the grit and determination that the team has portrayed during this game and throughout the whole season.

MIKE NORVELL: They're built for it. Like I said in my opening statement, I thank God for the challenges we've had over the last four years, because like I said, through that journey sometimes you have to go through what you need to prove you can get through.

Well, we can get through a lot of things. We can get through a lot of challenges. We can get through a lot of adversity that's thrown at us. I believe in these players. That's what gives me such great confidence, because I watch them every single day.

It's not just on the field. Everybody can get excited about 13 wins or whatever, 19 straight wins that these guys have been able to take those steps. I also watch them in the classroom. We've got a football team that has over 3.0 team GPA. That is best ever in program history.

There are challenges that they embrace and a lot of things that they don't necessarily like to do, but they're willing to do it because they want to uphold the standard of what Florida State deserves. They love and care about each other, and I think you see that in how they play.

We push them, and I'm not going to stop pushing them because I believe in where they can go and I believe all that they can accomplish.

Q. LT, why do you feel like you guys should make the playoff? Does it anger you that people are talking about you not making it?

LAWRANCE TOAFILI: Honestly, I feel like we go out there and work every day, you know what I'm saying? We play for each other. We are a close-knit team. I feel like we haven't lost a game yet, so we're proving our point and showing what we can do. That's how I feel, honestly.

Q. Your resume is incredible, obviously, but what would you say to the committee if they were saying, hey, that team that you had tonight is not the team that won all those games? How do you put that together with such a big part of your offense missing?

MIKE NORVELL: We just beat a top-15 team with a true freshman quarterback. Like that doesn't matter. I don't care perspective what people think. We win. We win. You know what, if we get the opportunity to go play in the national semifinal, it's going to be a challenge. I believe in this team. I believe in what they can do. I believe in who they are. You know what, they showed up every single week and done it.

So I don't really care about what everybody else's opinions are. I know who I coach, and I know we get the opportunity, they're going to go fight for everything they get because they've been doing it the last four years, and whatever the next opportunity is, I promise you they're going to show up.

Q. LT, Coach talks a lot about adversity, that the running back room has faced adversity throughout this entire year, an example being the Clemson game. How motivated has this team been, the running back room playing with a chip on its shoulder to just have that game, and you really had that game tonight.

LAWRANCE TOAFILI: Yes, sir. All of us together, we're just pushing each other. We feed off each other's energy. We're really just playing our part. Like Coach Atkins says, we're on fries, you know. We're doing our part. We had a big part today so we had a big role. We had to step up to the plate.

Q. LT, Coach is really amped right now. Was there any extra emphasis on physicality today for you guys? There's been a lot of talk about the injuries. Was there any extra motivation to come out and make a

statement?

LAWRANCE TOAFILI: That's every day. Early in the morning, 6:00 in the morning, you know what I'm saying? Ready.
