Suh will give HC Jim Schwartz the Albert Haynesworth force on his DL \& in 1 offseason will have made this one of the most improved units in the NFL.

McCoy gives the Bucs the 2 gap penetrating DT that the unit has lacked in recent years which will improve all 3 levels of the defense.

The Redskins have a $3-5$ year franchise QB with McNabb on board \& now have to protect him. If they sign Flozell Adams prior to the draft then this spot is for sale for teams who want Eric Berry.

Matt Cassel was sacked once every 11.7 pass att's in 2009. Bulaga would improve the LT spot \& shift Brandon Albert to RT also improving their rush attack.

Pete Carroll needs to replace Hall of Fame LT Walter Jones \& gets great value with Williams here. Carroll is looking at the longterm picture here \& gets a foundation type player.

The Browns have lacked a big play defender in the secondary since Anthony Henry had 10 ints back in 2001. Berry is a high impact player who will challenge for Defensive Rookie of the Year.

Davis does have some character issues which were magnified at his Pro Day. However the game tape \& need match here.

Chan Gailey has stated that he's not overly enamored with Trent Edwards or Ryan Fitzpatrick. Clausen showed great strides in his last year at Notre Dame \& the Bills need a QB that isn't passive about leadership.

Rolando McClain will be a serious consideration for former LB Jack Del Rio but in a division where you face IND \& HOU twice a year the top CB here is a must.

McClain will pair with DJ Williams to give the Broncos a very impressive force vs the run (129 ypg 4.5 LY ) as Josh McDaniels has made rebuilding the front 7 a priority in 2010.
 Jason Ferguson is facing an 8 game suspension \& MIA isn't sold on the depth on the roster. Williams is the best $3-4$ NT in the draft \& will be an instant starter. MIA has also brought in Earl Thomas 3 times \& it wouldn't be a surprise to se him taken either.

Thomas had a very impressive Pro Day (4.37 40) \& will give Singletary's secondary a huge boost in youth \& depth. The \#2 Safety in the draft has more value at this point than the 5 OT .

Patrick Kerney has 1 more year at most left \& Carroll did the Seahawks a huge favor by retaining DC Gus Bradley ensuring continuity. Morgan will allow the Seahawks to keep the pressure with the front four but it won't be a surprise if $S$ Taylor Mays is taken here.

The Giants rush attack fizzled in 2009 as Brandon Jacobs ( 3.7 ypa ) wore down at the end of the year. Spiller is a huge boost in speed at the unit \& will also be a boost on KR's.


Pierre-Paul is a high risk/ high reward here with lots of physical upside. On other teams this would be a big question mark but Fisher has a lot of faith in DL coach Jim Washburn to develop him. The highest rated CB on the Titans draft board is also a strong possibility here.

lupati has seen his stock jump since the Senior Bowl \& has shown more than enough athleticism to make the transition to RT. He is the tough aggressive mauler the team needs for its run game.

Wilson could be the rare rookie to come in \& start for the Steelers. At worst he'll be the nickel CB at the beginning of the year for a unit that allowed a 22-14 TD/Int ratio in 2009.

The Falcons resolved their glaring need at CB with Dunta Robinson in FA. They could use another pass rusher but Witherspoon is a fantastic value especially with Mike Peterson turning 34 in June.

While the Texans have a big need at RB \& on the DL, they have a huge hole at CB. Jackson has been on the rise since the Combine \& is a walk on starter for the Texans here.

Bryant has top 10 talent but the questions about his life skills have driven his stock down. In a choice between the top WR \& top TE in the draft the Bengals go with Bryant here.


Graham is a little bit smaller than the protypical Belichick OLB but his work ethic \& motor are ideal. Adalius Thomas is on the way out \& Tully Banta-Cain led the team with 9.5 sacks which makes Grahams abilty to play DE/OLB that much more attractive.

While the Packers did resign Chad Clifton \& Mark Tauscher back in the offseason there is no guarantee they'll survive 16 games in 2010. Brown can start the year as the swing OT \& start as needed before taking a spot full time in 2011.

The Eagles have the ammo to move up \& down in the draft \& it wouldn't be a surprise to see them make a trade here. They are set on offense entering the draft \& make a move here to counter Romo \& the Dallas pass attack here.

Todd Heap's body has a lot of miles on it \& the Ravens were burned by a lack of depth here in 2009. They do have a big need at CB but won't reach as they stick to Ozzie Newsome's best player available strategy.

The Cardinals have lost the most in FA during the offseason. They move to try \& replace Karlos Dansby with Kindle who is a versatile option here.

It wouldn't be a surprise to see the Cowboys trade this pick to BAL for LT Jared Gaither or resign Flozell Adams after the draft. They have struggled to improve the FS spot for years \& Mays is an ideal fit for them here.
