Best Bet: *New Mexico St 34 (+) New Mexico 37

The Owls are 9-2 in the series and last year led 34-3 at half in their 44-24 home win. The home team is 7-1 SU and ATS in this series. Both teams were pounded in their openers. Rice was out gained 656-241 by Stanford in Australia. UTEP was outgained 676-167 by Oklahoma. I expected more out of each last week but these teams are close experience wise and Rice was the much stronger team last year and grabs the road win with their special teams edge being the difference.

Texas St is 3-2 in road games including upsetting Houston in 2012 and last year they stunned Ohio their only win vs an FBS team all year. Colorado has just 12 ret starters from a 10 win team that played in the P12 title game and are just #88 on my Exp Chart. Texas St has 13 ret starters but is #117 on my Exp Chart. Texas St lost 5 road games last year by an avg of 26 ppg. Colorado needs to get their young team up to speed and get the coaching staff to get the team to play so they can show good effort. Last week Colorado benefited from 3 pass interference penalties on Colo St which basically wiped out 21 Colo St points. Texas St starts a 260 lb true free NT and Colorado is 10-2 vs the Vegas number when favored at home.

UAB has lost 11 straight road openers by 20 ppg. The Blazers have dropped 23 str non-conference away games (last win in '05 at Troy). BSU has won 7 str home openers by 16 ppg, last loss in '09 vs NT 10-10. In Clarks only year at UAB (2014) they upset both WKU and Florida Atlantic on the road and Ball St is a poor 2-9 as a HF. UAB is off a huge home win in their first game back in front of 40,000+. A season ago the visiting Atlanta A&M 45-15 and they went 1-7 with a 424-183 yard edge. Ball St is much improved and had a 375-216 yard edge at Illinois but gave up a late td and missed a tying fg at the end. 1st team MAC RB Gilbert was injured 3Q last week.

First mtg. Middle Tennessee is just 3-19 in road openers incl dropping 4 str the L/4 yrs vs Power 5 schools by 20 ppg. Syracuse is in Dino Babers 2nd season after drastic changes on both offense and defense last year and now has 19 ret starters and are #24 on my Exp Chart. Middle has weapons on offense to turn this into a shootout with QB Stockstill and WR James but they only possess my #90 defense. I'd expect a FCS foe with only Cental Michigan on deck. My computer had Syracuse beating Cent Conn St 58-6 so don't overreact to their 50-7 win. Middle was hyped for their home game vs Vandy but lost by 2 and were outplayed 367-215.

UVA is 17-12 host/non-conference games. Indiana is off a loss to powerful Ohio St but has 15 rest starters and is #47 on my Exp Chart. Virginia beat a FCS foe and has 13 rest starters and is #77 on my Exp Chart. Indy was a slight favorite at a similar AAC team in 2015 and won at Wake by 7. Virginia lost to FCS Richmond last year 37-20 but this year beat William & Mary 28-10 with a 369-240 yard edge rush. Virginia is a 2015 All-American in the backfield and has a 4th down after a bad miss on a 42 yd fg. Kurt Benkert hit 27-39-26.2 vs a W&M team that was 5-6 last year. Indy has the edge on offense, defense and special teams and grabs the road win despite WR Westbrook being lost for the year.
