

NEBRASKA CORNHUSKERS

POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - Joe Ganz started the last 3 of '07 throwing for 1,435 (59%, 16-7) including a school record 510 vs K-St with 7 TD's. HC Bo Pelini retained OC Shawn Watson in '08 making Ganz a good fit for the offense and he set a new school record throwing for 3,568 (68%, 25-11). Zac Lee (PS#13JC, 2 gm, 2 pass) was the only QB with exp in '09. He battled a couple of Pelini recruits in rFr Kody Spano (6'2" 210 So, PS#38) and true frosh Cody Green (PS#21). After Spano tore an ACL, they moved in LB Latravis Washington (6'3" 230 Sr, PS#48) to compete. Also on hand was true frosh Taylor Martinez (6'1" 195 rFr, PS#99, fastest QB). Lee hit 76% in 3 gms vs Sun Belt teams but in his first 2 road starts (VT's tough D, rain vs Missouri), he hit just 39.7%. Green saw his first significant action vs TT and started vs Baylor (1st true QB to start here since '92, Tommy Frazier), leading scoring drives on his first 3 poss. NU did not score after that and in his 2nd start vs Okla, Green had zero FD's (19 yds) in 5 poss and Lee reclaimed the job (Green 3 pass last 5). Lee threw for 2,143 (58.6%, 14-10) and Green for 317 (53.2%, 2-2). Lee was banged up all of '09 and missed spring after elbow surgery. Green and Martinez took all of the #1 snaps and it looks to be a 3-man race in August. I look for improved passing numbers from the Husker QB's.

RUNNING BACKS - In '07 Marlon Lucky (PS#3) led with 1,019 (4.9) and true frosh Roy Helu (PS#98) rushed for 209 (4.6). In '08 Lucky started 11 but was just #2 with 517 (4.1). Quentin Castille (235 lb) had 467 (4.4). Helu was bothered by a shoulder injury but still led with 803 (6.4). Last year they had to replace Lucky then Castille was dismissed in August. The top backup became true frosh Rex Burkhead (PS#39). Helu had a fine year rushing for 1,147 (5.2) despite another shoulder injury (24 yds, 2 fmb1 vs Iowa St). He was not 100% after and had just 3 carries in the bowl. Burkhead missed 5 (inj) but rushed for 346 (4.3) incl 89 (5.2) running the Wildcat in the bowl. True frosh Dontravey Robinson (PS#82) added 165 (4.2) and rFr Lester Ward (6'3" 225, PS#86) had 38 (3.8). This year the unit returns intact and not listed below are Collins Okafor (6'1" 225 So, PS#38) and FB's CJ Zimmerer (6'0" 230 rFr, PS#101) and Mike Hays (6'1" 235 Jr). This group is deeper and will have improved rushing numbers.

RECEIVERS - In '08 Nate Swift and Todd Peterson combined for 1,727 (13.8) but both had to be replaced in '09. The leading returnee was Mike McNeill who set the Husker school record for rec by a TE (32, 13.8) in '08. The top returning WR was Menelik Holt (355, 11.8). Heading into '09 their WR coach said he wanted to have 6 or 7 WR's in the rotation but the only one assured of a spot was Niles Paul (PS#7). Despite some inconsistent play, Paul was far and away #1 with 796 (19.9) while McNeill had just 259 (9.3). Curenski Gilleyle had 302 (17.8). Not in the PSL are Nick Failla (5'10" 185 rFr, PS#231), Ty Kidlow (5'7" 175 rFr, PS#156), Steven Osborne (6'4" 205 So, PS#170) and TE's Ryan Hill (6'3" 255 Jr, PS#56) and JT Kerr (6'4" 240 rFr, PS#59). This year they lose Holt (5 st, 15 rec) and Chris Brooks (179, 12.8). This is a much improved rec corps with good size (proj WR st's avg 6'3" 225) as TE McNeill moves to WR.

OFFENSIVE LINE - For years NU was famous for its "Pipeline" O-line but OL coach Milt Tenopir moved on after the 2002 season and the Huskers haven't had a 1st Tm B12 OL S/O1. In '08 they had to replace 2 st's but opened holes for 170 ypg rush (4.5). Last year they had to replace 2 NFL DC's but did have a back with 7+ career sts and Pelini noted that Ricky Henry (PS#67DL) was one of the most physical players on the team. VTech Coach Beamer said "We haven't played an OL this good in a while. Up front they are exceptional." Surprisingly the numbers dropped to 147 ypg (4.0) with 19 sks (5.2%). This year they lose C Jacob Hickman (14 st, 3Y st'r, HM B12) and backups Derek Meyer (3 sts) and Andy Christensen (9 car st). Adding depth are Cole Pensick (6'2" 270 rFr, PS#132) and Brian Thorson (6'3" 285 So, PS#197). This will be the best O-line that OL Coach Barney Cotton has fielded here (75 career sts).

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '07 NU had to replace 4 st's (#1 & #4 DC's). A drop off was expected but it's almost unheard of that a team allows 99% more ypg rush. The Huskers yielded 232 (5.2) which is their worst total in modern history (just 13 sks). In Pelini's 1st season in '08 almost everyone was back and PS#7 NT Ndamukong Suh was NU's first 1st Tm All Big 12 DL since 1999 (#1 tk1r). The Huskers cut their ypg rush allowed in half to 116 ypg (3.6) with 35 sks. Last year they had to replace 2 st's and 2 bkps but Suh turned down the NFL and DE Barry Turner (11 st '07, 2 st '08 inj) ret'd. The DT combo of Suh/Jared Crick was the best in the country (comb 158 tk1, 21.5 sks). The Huskers' D-line had not had an AA S/97! Suh remedied that situation by nearly winning the Heisman Trophy but instead had to "settle" for almost every major def award in the country. As you would expect, NU's rush D improved to 93 ypg (2.8) with 44 sks. This year they lose Suh (14 st, Outland, Lombardi, Nagurski, Bednarik winner, #1DC DET, #1 tk1r), Turner (14 st, 51 tk1, 16 tfl) and DE David Harvey (1 st, 1 tk1). They plug in Baker Steinkuhler (PS#10L) into Suh's spot. While this unit returns 2 st's just like LY, it will be tough to replace the #2 pick in the draft (1st Husker in Top 10 S/98) but it will still be a top-notch unit.

LINEBACKERS - NU was very inexp'd in '08 even opening with 5 DB's in the majority of their games. Last year they had to replace 2 LB's (comb 15 sts, 87 tkls, #5DC). They then lost starting LB Blake Lawrence to injury and the starting trio included 2 rFr and Phillip Dillard (PS#16, 5 sts, 38 tk1 '08). Having a D-line like they did helped and the Huskers allowed an NCAA best 10.4 ppg (fewest S/84). This year they lose 2nd Tm B12 Dillard (9 st, #2 tk1r, 11 tfl, #4DC NYG) and Lawrence (2 st, 10 tk1). Sean Fisher and Will Compton were only #11 and #12 in tackles (comb 14 sts) but should be improved as soph and they add in PS#6JC Lavonte David. The 3rd LB spot is now officially called Peso and is a S/LB hybrid which was used all but 50 plays LY. Not in the PSL are Graham Stoddard (6'2" 235 So), Jay Martin (6'2" 230 Jr), Thomas Grove (6'2" 225 Sr) and Alonzo Whaley (6'1" 225 So, PS#159). The staff is really impressed with Eric Hagg's play and I expect more big plays out of this unit.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '07 the Huskers had 3 st's back and were #58 in my PDR. In '08 they had to replace a pair of 3 yr st's and 4 bkps (comb 6 st, 101 tk1) yet NU moved up to #39. Last year they had to replace one starter (ret 7 w/ 55 sts '08). Thanks in part to a dominating D-line, the Huskers climbed all the way to #1 allowing just 47.8% (7-20 ratio). This year they lose 1st Tm B12 SS Larry Asante (#3 tk1r, 2 int, 7 pbu, #5DC CLE) and FS Matt O'Hanlon (14 st, 69 tk1, 6 int, 5 pbu). They do return 1st Tm All-Big 12 CB Prince Amukamara (5 int, 11 pbu) who headlines my #2 secondary (pg 15). Not listed below are Dijon Washington (6'0" 185 rFr, PS#96), Marcus Mendoza (5'10" 195 Jr, PS#41) and Courtney Osborne (6'3" 200 So, PS#297).

SPECIAL TEAMS - In the last 15 yrs, the Huskers have ranked in the top 10 of my ST rankings 5 times. In '08 they had their K and P back including fan favorite KO man Adi Kunalic (PS#23). Kunalic elicits chants from the crowd when he records a TB and is #1 over the past 3 years in the NCAA with 86 TB's. ALEX Henery hit 18 of 21 (NU record long 57, 2 miss 50+) in '08 as NU finished #41 in Pelini's first season. Last year they had to replace their P (32.1 net) and top PR, Henery also took over at P (net 34.7) while hitting a school record 24-28 FG's (long 52, 3 miss 50+). Niles Paul was the top KR (27.9) and PR (10.7). NU finished #16 and with everyone back, could contend for the top spot as long as Kunalic does not RS.

COACHES - Bo Pelini was the interim HC for NU's 2003 bowl win over Mich St (17-3). He was the DC here in '03 and the DC at LSU from 2005-'07. He ret'd as HC in '08. Last year Nebraska added a year to his contract (thru 2015) raising his annual base pay to \$2.1 mill. Defense was NU's problem in '07 as it allowed a school record 477 ypg which topped 1948's 380 ypg. Carl Pelini (Bo's brother) served 3 years under ex-NU HC Frank Solich at Ohio and became the DC here in '08. Shawn Watson is in his 5th year at OC as a holdover from the previous regime.



PHIL'S FORECAST

Nebraska was 11-0 and headed for the Big 12 Title game in 2001 when they were upset at Colo 62-36. From that point through the end of '04, the team had 9 losses by 22+ points. Frank Solich's last team earned an amazing 35th straight bowl bid in '03 but he was let go despite a record of 58-19! After interviewing DC Pelini among others, NU chose ex-OAK Raiders HC Bill Callahan. In 2004 they were making a dramatic switch going from the option to the West Coast offense. That year I called for Iowa St (2-10 in '03) to top NU in the Big 12 North. NU's loss to Colo in the finale gave them their first losing season since 1961. Callahan's teams improved to 8-4 in '05 and 9-5 in '06 with an appearance in the Big 12 Title game. I was one of the few NOT to pick NU to win the Big 12 North in '07. Callahan had been given an extension by then-AD Steve Pederson. Pederson was fired midway and Callahan was let go after a 5-7 season. The '07 Huskers D set school records for most pts (455) and yds (5,722) allowed. In '08 Nebraska made my Most Improved List despite having just 10 ret st's and a schedule which included 5 opponents who were in Jan bowls in '07. The Huskers did not disappoint me winning 6 of their last 7. NU did need a 57 yd FG to take the lead with 1:43 left vs Colo giving them a tie for the Big 12 North Title. Pelini was able to RS all but 3 frosh. They knocked off Clemson in the Gator Bowl. They were -11 in TO's in '08 and had 34 sts lost to inj. NU was +112 ypg (best North). Last year they had to replace 12 fifth year seniors (23 lett). I was in the minority calling for NU to win the Big 12 North in '09 (most had KU) and once again the Huskers did not disappoint me. They did suffer B2B home losses by 21 to TT and 9-7 to Iowa St a game in which they were an amazing -8 in TO's fumbling it into the EZ 2 times for TB's (362-239 NU yd edge). They also could have beaten VTech in Wk 3 (343-278 yd edge) but allowed a TD pass with :21 left. They got got that that back vs Okla when they were +4 in TO's and won (outgained 325-180). After knocking off Kansas they beat K-St for the Big 12 North Title 17-3. The next week, in a letdown spot vs Colo, they were outgained 403-217 but won. While NU had just 106 yds in the Big 12 Title game vs Texas, the Horns needed a 46 yd FG which barely snuck thru the uprights after the officials controversially put :01 back on the clock. The Huskers easily handled Ariz in the bowl 33-0. An interesting stat is that since Nov 2001, 63 out of 65 BCS teams have beaten a top 19 tm and the only 2 that have not are Duke and Neb. This year NU has 15 ret st's and had 2 net close losses but benefitted from great yps's (Off 12.8, Def 26.1). Despite a 6-2 rec sgn B12 record, NU was actually -12.3 ypg. Despite those factors they are the most talented team in the Big 12 North and 6 of my 9 sets of power ratings call for a 12-0 regular season.

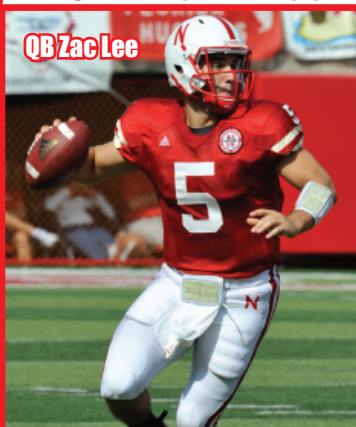
