

NORTH CAROLINA TAR HEELS

POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - In '07 NC ret'd both players who started in '06 in Joe Dailey (7 st) and Cameron Sexton (5 st). I projected that rFr TJ Yates would win the starting job and he did, becoming the 4th straight 1st year starting QB for NC. Yates had just 13 practices as the #1 QB prior to the opener. After 3 games, he was completing 66% (9-3) and had 2 of the school's all-time top 10 passing performances (344 vs EC and 339 vs UVA). Surprisingly, Yates' numbers regressed over the final 9 (58%, 5-15 ratio). The coaches did notice a loss of velocity and he had shoulder surgery in the offseason and missed spring '08. Yates bulked up to 215 lbs and had the team poised for a big season as they led Virg Tech 10-3 but he broke his ankle and missed 6. Mike Paulus (PS#6) came in vs VT but Sexton started the next 6 until Yates ret'd. Yates threw for 1,168 (60%, 11-4). Last year Sexton transferred and Paulus lost the bkp job to rFr Braden Hanson (PS#11). Yates started all 13 and threw for 2,136 (60.3%) but with only a 14-15 ratio. He is already the school's #2 career passer. Hanson played in 3 (2-6 pass, 2 int). They also used RB AJ Blue (PS#81) in the Wildcat (1 pass). Despite returning a 3 year starter I expect rFr Bryn Renner (PS#20) to strongly contend for (and possibly win) the job. No matter who starts, they should have improved stats.

RUNNING BACKS - NC used to be called "Running Back U." They have had twenty-four 1,000 yard rushers (most in NCAA until USC passed them in '05). They had 12 straight 1,000 yard rushers from 1973-'84 but have had just one in the last 16 years ('97 Jonathan Linton). In 2007 true frosh Greg Little (PS#6) moved over from WR at the end of the year and started the last 2. He was the clear cut starter into '08 but lost his job to Shaun Draughn (PS#128), who was at SS as a rFr (5 tkl). Draughn (6 st) led with 866 (4.4). Little had 339 (4.3). Ryan Houston (PS#21) entered when NC was inside the 10 and rushed for 299 (3.9) and led with 8 TD's. Last year Draughn bulked up 10 lbs and had 199 (5.9) vs 2 FCS foes but vs 8 FBS foes had just 359 (4.0). He suffered a shoulder injury vs Duke (1 att, 9 yd) and missed the last 4. Houston, who does not have the breakaway speed (bruiser), rushed for 713 (3.7). Johnny White (PS#84) added 143 (7.5). AJ Blue (6'2" 225 So) had 33 (1.8) and FB Anthony Elzy (5'10" 215 Sr, PS#52) had 40 (3.6). This year they only lose FB Bobby Rome (PS#48QB, 3 st). Not listed below are Matt Kolojechick (5'10" 185 So), Hunter Furr (6'0" 205 So, PS#90), Steven Hatley (5'10" 210 Jr), Kenny Owens (6'0" 225 Jr) and FB Curtis Byrd (6'1" 230 Sr). The unit should maintain better health and have much improved numbers.

RECEIVERS - As a true frosh in 2006 Hakeem Nicks led with 660 (16.9). In '07 he set the school record for rec in a season (74). In '08 Nicks became NC's career rec leader as a Jr and was the first Tar Heel to top 1,000 rec (1222, 18.0). He holds 14 NC records (217 yds in bowl). Brandon Tate, who was leading the ACC in all-purp yd, had 376 (23.5) in the first 6 of '08 but was lost for the year. RB Greg Little moved back to WR and had 146 (13.3). Nicks became the Heels' 1st ever #1 DC WR in '09. They also had to replace Tate (#3DC), TE Richard Quinn (#2DC) and Brooks Foster (#5DC). The Nicks-Tate-Foster combo combined for 1,932 (16.9) while last year's inexp'd top 3 comb for 1,483 (11.2). Little led with 724 (11.7) and became only the 5th UNC player to top 60 rec's. True frosh Erik Highsmith (PS#166) surprisingly beat out a lot of VHT's and had 425 (11.5). Zack Pinalto (miss 4) had 334 (10.1) and is NC's all-time rec leader at TE (old record, Freddie Jones '96). True frosh Jheranie Boyd (PS#8) had 214 (17.8) and was also used on reverses (130, 6.5). Adding depth are Ryan Taylor (6'3" 240 Sr, PS#118), Christian Wilson (6'3" 235 Jr, PS#33, 3st 2Y), Lee Browne (5'10" 175 Jr), Quentin Plair (6'1" 185 Sr) and TE's Nelson Hurst (6'4" 245 So, PS#53, Miss St trans) and Alex Asher (6'3" 210 So, PS#284). This year the unit returns intact with good talent and a lot more experience.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In Davis' first year NC had 2.5 st's ret but their C missed 6 and they avg just 99 ypg rush (3.0), their

fewest since 1944 (49 ypg), while allowing 37 sks (10.1%). In '08 they had 4.5 st's back but only improved to 123 ypg (3.5) with 28 sks (8.8%). Last year they had to replace a pair of 3 year st's then 3 OL from the 2 deep were lost over the summer. They had 3 st's back (30 '08 sts) but C Lowell Dyer only started 4 (inj). They only improved to 133 ypg rush (3.6) with 26 sks. This year they lose LT Kyle Jolly (13 st, 3Y st'r) and Dyer (18 car st). Not listed below is Sam Ellis (6'5" 285 Sr). They have 4 st's ret (7 w/st exp) and add in PS#3 James Hurst (IFS). I will call it the best O-line that Davis has fielded here at NC.

DEFENSIVE LINE - The Tar Heels had one of the best D-lines in the country in both 2000 and '01 but then allowed 4.8, 4.9, 5.2, 3.5 (4 ret st'r) and 4.5 ypc the next five years. In Davis' first year they had to replace 2 st's but improved to 3.5 ypc. In '08 Davis had to replace 2 st's (1st and #7DC's) and they allowed 139 ypg (3.7). Last year in the magazine I said they had their best D-line since '01 as the entire 2 deep ret'd and they had 6 VHT's. They also had great bulk inside with 4 DT's at 300+ lbs. That forecast was spot on as the Heels allowed just 96 ypg rush (2.8) with 33 sks. DE Robert Quinn was #2 in the NCAA in negative yds (117). They lose DT Cam Thomas (13 st, 23 tkl, 2.5 tfl, #5DC SD), DE EJ Wilson (12 st, 49 tkl, 12 tfl, #4DC SEA) and DT Aleric Mullins (15 tkl). Four return with starting exp (6 VHT in 2 deep) incl 1st Tm ACC Quinn and 2nd Tm ACC DT Marvin Austin. While not as exp'd as '09, this unit is loaded with NFL prospects.



LINEBACKERS - When Davis took over he did bemoan a lack of depth at LB saying most teams that play a 4-3 have 10 to 13 LB's, and they were nowhere near that. They've gotten better depth in each of his years. Last year they lost their defensive MVP (#2 tkl'r) but had 2 of 3 st's returning. They moved WLB Quan Sturdivant to MLB but he moved back to WLB for the final 5 while "true" frosh Kevin Reddick (Hargrave), started the final 5 at MLB. NC allowed just 17.1 ppg, their best since 1997. This year they only lose SLB Kennedy Tinsley (#11 tkl'r, 0 st) and return their #1, #3, #8 and #9 tkl'r's. Sturdivant earned 1st Tm ACC and Bruce Carter was 2nd Tm and this figures to be one of the ACC's elite LB corps.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In 2007 NC had 3 frosh starting but their inexp'd unit (1 ret st) climbed from #103 in my PDR to #94. FS Deunta Williams (PS#30) was the ACC Rookie of the Year (1st Tm Frosh AA). A veteran unit in '08 only improved to #74 allowing a solid 15-20 ratio. Last year they had to replace a 1st Tm ACC SS but had 7 of the top 8 back. CB Kendrick Burney set an ACC record with 170 IR yds vs Mia then set a school record with his 3rd career IR TD vs BC. He did have another int result in a TD when he handed the ball off on an 89 yard IR. As expected, NC made big strides moving up to #17 (58.6%, 10-19). They only lose FS Melvin Williams (31 tkl) and CB Jordan Hemby (12 tkl). NC has all 4 who started all 13 back including two 1st Tm ACC (FS

& CB) and a 2nd Tm ACC SS. Adding depth are Peter Mangum (5'10" 175 Jr), Josh Hunter (6'2" 185 rFr, PS#80), Brian Gupton (6'3" 195 Jr) and Curtis Campbell (6'2" 205 rFr). This is the ACC's best secondary and is my #8 DB unit in the FBS.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '07 Davis inherited my #22 ST unit including K Connor Barth (10-10 FG's, long 54 '06) as well as their top returnman, Brandon Tate. Davis said for the team to have outstanding ST's coverage, they needed to have more than 10 LB's and be deeper in the secondary. NC dropped to #47 but did block 3 punts. In '08 they had to replace Connor Barth (NC all-time FG leader). His brother Casey hit 10-15 FG (L/42). Tate was on his way to becoming an AA returnman as he had 397 all-purp yards vs McNeese topping Derrick Fenner's 1986 school record (339). Tate set the school record for career ret TD's (6) topping Charlie "Choo-Choo" Justice's record (46-'49) before being lost vs ND (22.6 avg PR). LB Bruce Carter had 5 blk'd kicks in '08 incl 3 punts vs Conn. Overall they finished #22 but had to replace Tate and their P (34.0 net) in '09. Barth hit 21-25 FG (ties UNC single season record) but had a long of just 42 with 2 TB on 66 KO. New P Grant Schallock avg 40.3 (35.2 net). Johnny White was the top KR in '08 (25.3), but slipped to 20.5. The top PR was Da'Norris Searcy (14.6). NC slipped to #86 but with everyone back, should crack the Top 25.

COACHES - In 2007 the Tar Heels brought in Butch Davis, who helped assemble a Miami team that went on to a couple of undefeated reg seasons in 2001-02, guiding them out of probation. Davis was 51-20 in 6 years at Miami (4 bowl wins). He did not have much success in the NFL with Cleveland but is acknowledged as a solid college HC and a fantastic recruiter. His OC is John Shoop who was the OC for the OAK Raiders at the end of '06. In '08 he brought in DC Everett Withers who was the TEN Titans' DB coach from 2001-'06 and the DC at Minnesota (Big Ten) '07. In his first year here NC trimmed the ppg allowed from 24.5 to 21.2 (17.1 '09). In '07 Davis brought in assoc HC/DL coach John Blake from Neb who is one of the top recruiters in the nation and was Okla's HC from 1996-1998. For the first time S/'99 the staff returns intact.

PHIL'S FORECAST

In 2007 Butch Davis took over a team that had been to one bowl the previous five years and had not finished above .500 in that span. The 2006 squad finished 3-9 (-66.1 ypg ACC play, 3rd worst). In '07 he had just 9 ret st's (fewest in the ACC) and I thought Davis did a tremendous job. They could have easily had a much better record than 4-8 as they had 6 close losses. Davis was the first NC coach to win his first reg ssn game here since Dick Crum (1978). In '08 he had 18 ret st's and they were my #2 Most Improved Team. If not for two key injuries, NC could have been playing for the ACC Title, which they have not won since 1980. They did have only 11 seniors on the '08 roster. The first key injury was when QB TJ Yates was injured vs VTech. NC led at the time but lost thanks in part to 4 TO's. Yates started just 6. The second came when WR Brandon Tate was lost for the year (Tm MVP at that pt). They still managed to finish 8-4 and had a close loss in the bowl (WV QB Pat White's final gm). Despite their 8-5 overall record, they were actually outgained by a 365-321 avg. Last year while they had just 5 road games, they were all vs '08 bowl teams and NC was fortunate to match the previous year's 8 win total. Against Conn they trailed 10-0 but UC lost their starting QB and NC rallied for the win. At 3-0 they were destroyed by GTech (406-154 yd deficit) and then were upset by Virginia 16-3. The next Thur, in their first ever Thur night HG on ESPN, they led Fla St 24-6 in the 3Q but lost 30-27. They stunned VT on the road on another Thur night, where the Hokies are almost unbeatable and after beating Duke they got a couple of return TD's to get past Miami 33-24 despite being outgained 435-329. BC turned it over 6 times including 2 return TD's which put NC up 21-0 early and the Tar Heels won 31-13. They led NCSU 24-14 but lost by 1 and in the bowl, lost to a solid Pitt team, 19-17. This year they have 19 ret st's which is #1 in the ACC. They were 4-4 in the ACC (-9.4 ypg). The D has

an ACC high 233 career sts ret incl 6 who turned down a shot at the NFL. NC has one of the best D's in the country (best ACC) and 7 of my 9 sets of power ratings call for a double digit win season. They are a darkhorse National Title contender.

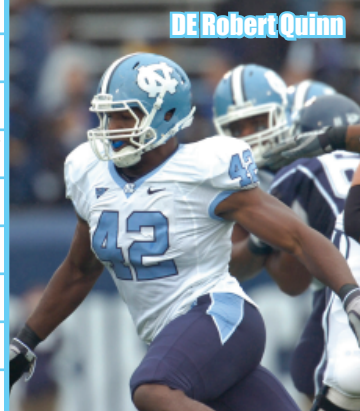
