This week a lot of news on players occurred with several going down with injuries and one dismissed.

NORFOLK STATE RB SUFFERS SHOULDER INJURY

NSU senior RB #3 **DEANGELO BRANCHE** (5103, 200) suffered a sprained AJ joint in his shoulder (could not confirm which one) in the first quarter against Bethune-Cookman and did not play much of the second half. The injury is not expected to be serious. They have a bye week this week and so is expected to play in two weeks.

CENTRAL ARKANSAS QB HURT AGAINST TULSA

Central Arkansas QB #14 **NATHAN DICK** (6030, 214) hurt his non throwing shoulder against Tulsa but his status for this week is unknown. An update is hopeful next week.

HUBEL TO REDSHIRT DUE TO SHOULDER SURGERY

Portland State senior QB #13 **DREW HUBEL** (6044, 202) will redshirt the 2010 season after having surgery on his right shoulder last week. Hubel had minor repairs to clean out and tighten the shoulder capsule last Thursday. He had suffered a dislocated right shoulder in the tenth game of last season that ended his year. The surgery came after he experienced shoulder discomfort early in the 2010 season. In the off-season, Hubel also had knee surgery to repair a subluxation of the knee cap that occurred in game six of last year. Hubel has a redshirt season available to him and will be able to return in 2011.

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS SAFETY OUT FOR THE YEAR

Senior SS #26 MIKE MCELROY (6000, 205) will miss the remainder of the season with an ankle injury that was sustained in a loss at Illinois on Sept. 11. McElroy will undergo surgery on his ankle. Southern Illinois will apply for a medical redshirt season for McElroy, who has not taken a redshirt year. In order to obtain a medical redshirt under NCAA rules, a player must have played in less than 30 percent of the teams' games and that 30 percent must have come in the first half of the season. He qualifies under both specifications.

MONTANA QB SUFFERS CAREER-ENDING INJURY

Montana senior QB #12 ANDREW SELLE (6007, 211) suffered a career-ending injury to his throwing arm in their 28-25 win over Sacramento State on Saturday.

ILLINOIS STATE DISMISSES DEFENSIVE TACKLE PROSPECT

Illinois State senior DT #53 **XZAVIER STEWART** (6010, 315) was dismissed from the Illinois State football team Monday, as announced by head coach Brock Spack. "We have dismissed Xzavier Stewart from our program for conduct detrimental to the team, effective immediately," Spack said. Spack will have no further comments on the dismissal of Stewart. Stewart transferred to Illinois State prior to the 2009 season from Kansas State. The 6-foot-2, 315-pound defensive tackle played in all 11 games for the Redbirds and recorded 19 tackles, 3.5 tackles-for-loss and two sacks on the season. In 2010, Stewart played in four games for ISU, with a pair starting assignments, and tallied 14 tackles and 1.5 tackles-for-loss.

VILLANOVA ALL-PURPOSE STAR INJURES ANKLE

Senior WR #4 MATT SZCZUR (5107, 203) sprained his left ankle on the first play of scrimmage and did not return to the game against Penn on Saturday. He is listed as questionable with head coach Andy Talley saying they would treat him this week and see where he is on Saturday.
