

MONTANA STATE BOBCATS

POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011



QB DeNarius McGhee

QB's - In '09 MSU ret'd 3 QB's who had starting exp in Oreg tran Cody Kempt (PS#78, 9st, 1316, 51%, 9-12, #4 rusher), Mark Iddins (PS#179JC, 1st, 334, 49%, 4-3) and Mark Desin (2st, 264, 46%, 1-4) but Desin went back to WR. Iddins started the 1st 5 and threw for 1,217 (58%, 5-6). Kempt started the L/6 and threw for 1,108 (58%, 9.4). LY Iddins departed and Kempt lost the job to rFr DeNarius McGhee (PS#246) as new OC Brian Wright's off had them taking snaps from under center. McGhee threw for 3,163 (62.7%) with an impressive 23-6 ratio earning BSC co-OPOY. Kempt threw for just 151

(61.9%, 3-1) and departs TY while McGhee is in his 2nd year of the system along with JC Grayson Galloway who RS here LY.

RB's - In '09 MSU had to replace Demetrius Crawford who led with 1,314 (5.2). They did ret CJ Palmer (312, 5.0) and Aaron Mason (226, 4.0). That year Mason led with 618 (4.8, 2nd tm BSC), while Palmer added 510 (4.4) and Blayde Becksted was #3 with 215 (5.0). Palmer and Becksted ret'd LY and they added JC transfer Orenzo Davis. Davis led with 1,126 (5.5) earning 2nd tm BSC while Palmer was #2 (447, 5.9). TY they lose Becksted (52, 5.8). They looked to ret their top 6 but #1 Davis was ruled ineligible in June. They do add Nebraska transfer Tray Robinson (PS#82, 266 tll yds 2Y).

Rec's - In '09 MSU had to replace 5 of its top 7 rec. They ret'd DeSean Thomas (#1, 407, 17.0) and TE Joe Schreiber (#6) and added Oreg tran Elvis Akpla. Schreiber moved up to #4 but Thomas had just 107 (13.4). They were led by true frosh Everett Gilbert (556, 12.1), JC Julius Lloyd (442, 12.3) and Akpla (380, 14.1). LY they ret'd their top 3 and Kyle Begger (1st, 123, 7.2) replaced Schreiber at TE. Lloyd led with 711 (19.8, 7 td) but departs TY along with 2nd tm BSC TE Begger (253, 9.7). They ret 3 HM BSC WR's in Akpla (682, 15.9), Gilbert (574, 12.0) and Tanner Bleskin (502, 15.2) along with TE Shane Robison (102, 14.6).

O-Line - The OL had to replace 2 str's in '09 incl a 1st tm BSC LT but ret'd 4 OL who comb for 40 sts incl 2nd tm BSC

RG Jeff Hansen. After MSU led the conf in rushing in '08 (for 1st time S/89), the rush numbers dropped a little to 147 ypg (3.9, #2 BSC) and they allowed just 18 sks (4.8%). LY they lost 1st tm BSC RG Hansen (11st) but ret'd 5 who comb for 44 sts led by 1st tm BSC RT Mike Person (11st). They finished #3 BSC paving the way for 176 rush ypg (4.5) and gave up just 18 sk (4.7%). TY they lose 1st tm BSC LT Person (#7DC SF) and 1 bkp. They ret 7 who comb for 48 sts incl 2nd tm BSC RG Alex Terrien and add Oreg St transfer Tyler Thomas and JC Stephen Memory.

D-Line - In '09 MSU had to replace 3 DL (comb 22 st) but ret'd 5 who comb for 26 st incl 2nd tm BSC DE Dane Fletcher who led MSU in tfl in '07 and '08. They allowed just 82 ypg (#1 BSC, #7 FCS) despite losing DE Brad Smith (7st '08) after 2 but the D's sk tll did drop to 30. LY they lost 1st tm BSC Fletcher (#3 tkl'r, 17 tfl) but ret'd 6 who comb for 35 sts led by 1st tm BSC DT Dan Ogden (#6 tkl'r, 5.5 sk) and DE John Laidet (#9 tkl'r, 3.5 sk) but Smith (inj) missed the ssn. Their numbers plummeted as they allowed 153 ypg (4 gms 248+ rush yds) and the D had 24 sks. TY they lose 1st tm BSC Ogden (#5 tkl'r, 6.5 sk), NT Jason D'Alba (11st, 31 tkl) and BAN Dustin O'Connell (6st, 13 tkl). They ret DE Laidet (11st, 28 tkl) and DT Zach Minter (28 tkl, 10 tfl) and add JC Eric Homece.

LB's - In '09 the LB unit had to replace their #1 tkl'r but ret'd WLB Jeff Price (#2) and SLB Chase Gazzerro (#3). Despite Gazzerro and Price only combining for 7 sts, 72 tkl the Bobcats ppg all'd dropped from 27.7 to 22.2. Both departed LY along with WLB Matt Harris (5st, #7 tkl'r). They ret'd 2nd tm BSC MLB Clay Bignell (#1 tkl'r) and SLB Jody Owens (#4 tkl'r) and added JC Roger Trammell but the ppg swelled to 25.8. TY they ret 4 LB who comb for 33 sts including WLB Owens (#2, 8.5 tfl) and MLB Bignell (#7). SLB Aleksei Grosulak (#1 tkl'r, 8 tfl) tore his ACL in April and his replacement to begin the season will be Trammell (29 tkl).

DB's - In '09 the secondary lost CB Arnold Briggs (11st) to an ACL inj in Aug but ret'd 3 who comb for 27 st (#4, #5 & #6 tkl'r's). They fell to #5 BSC in pass eff D with a 27-13 ratio. LY they lost 2nd tm BSC CB Kevin Retoriano (#8 tkl'r) but ret'd 6 who comb for 33 st led by FS Michael Rider (#1 tkl'r, 4 int) and SS Jordan Craney (#5). They were #4 in pass eff D with a 19-8 ratio. TY they lose FS Rider (#3 tkl'r) and SS Craney (#4). They ret 3 who comb for 19 st in S Joel Fuller (#9 tkl'r), CB Darius Jones (11 pbu) and S Sean Gords.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '09 the ST unit lost its top RM but ret'd K Jason Cunningham (13-19, L/52) and P Eric Fisher (41.8). They avg just 5.6 on PR and 18.3 on KR. Cunningham hit 14-18 FG (L/47). Fisher and Mackey Nolan split time at P (32.8 tm net). LY they ret'd their top PR, KR & K. P Rory Perez had a

COACHES - HC Rob Ash enters his 5th ssn here after 18 yrs as HC at Drake and he was the BSC COY in 2010. DC Jamie Marshall came with him from Drake. OC Brian Wright, who was the OC at Youngstown St ('05-'09) ret's for his 2nd ssn after his off led the BSC in scoring and tll off and finished #4 FCS in tll off.

FORECAST - The Bobcats won the 1984 IAA Championship going 12-2. MSU has had just 13 winning ssns since then but has now had 9 straight, their longest streak ever. They have made the playoffs just 4 times S/84, but all have come in the last 9 yrs. In '09 they ret'd just 5 off str's but added an FBS transfer and while they improved in tll off (#9 BSC to #5), they dropped from #5 to #6 in scoring. LY they ret'd 8 off str's and added a new OC and led BSC in scoring and tll off (#4 FCS). TY the off ret's 8 str's incl the BSC co-OPOY and they add 1 FBS and 2 JC trans. In '09 the D ret'd 6 str's and 8 of their top 10 tkl'r's. They remained #1 in tll def and #6 in scoring. LY they ret'd 8 str's incl 5 of their top 6 tkl'r's but fell to #5 tll D and were #5 in scoring. TY the D ret's 5 str's but gets back 4 of their top 7 tkl'r's. The Bobcats shared the BSC title LY and were the #4 seed in the playoffs but were run over by NDSU in their first game losing by 25. TY the off should be even more potent in its 2nd yr under OC Wright and the D should improve after a down year. MSU will again be in the hunt for BSC crown.
