The Terriers run a Wingbone offense so the QB's do not have huge passing numbers but are a major factor in the rush attack. In '09 Wofford lost st'r Ben Widmyer (1284, 65% 10-2, 800 rush). They ret'd Mitch Allen (170, 59%, 0-2, 404 rush) who threw for just 605 (44%, 7-6) but was the #1 rusher with 633 (4.7). Allen returned LY along with Chris White who ply'd in 3 (16 ttl yd). Allen threw for 871 (53.6%, 8-3) and was the #2 rusher (681, 4.5). Brian Kass threw for 297 (52.9%, 4-0) with 156 rush (3.7). White was just 2-2-11 pass (-6 rush). All 3 return TY giving them good depth at the QB position.
