In '09 Perrilloux threw for 2,350 (59%) with an outstanding 23-2 ratio while rushing for 443 (4.5, 8 td) earning OVC OPOY but departed. He finished throwing for 2,248 (58.6%, 18-9) with 193 (3.2) rush but fell short of conf honors. He has dropped 25 lbs this off-ssn. His backups are Soph QB/P Coty Blachard (PS#114, 296, 65.9%, 8-2, 360, 6.6 rush), who earned OVC FPOY as well as Alabama tran Thomas Darrah (PS#138).
