POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - RJ Toman took over in '08 replacing NH's #1 car passer. He threw for 3,110 (65%, 28-15) which was #4 on NH single-ssn record. Toman was 2nd tm CAA and ret'd in '09 but his numbers declined (2181, 54%, 15-11) although he was the #3 rusher (251, 2.3). Kevin Decker (PS#102) threw for 380 (55%, 5-1) and both ret'd LY. Toman threw for 2,414 (62%, 15-11, 2nd tm CAA) but departs. Decker started 1 and threw for 447 (68.7%, 5-1) on the yr. He returns along with Georgetown trans James Brady, who threw for 880 (52%,

4-2) in 2 yrs at GT before sitting out here LY. While less experienced the talent is there and they could actually improve.

RB's - In '09 UNH ret'd 3 of its top 4 rushers led by RB Chad Kackert (630, 6.4). He earned 2nd tm CAA, leading with 780 (4.6, 10 td) but departed. LY they ret'd 5 of their top 6 led by Sean Jellison (424, 4.4, 7 td). Jellison started 10 but had just 375 (3.4) and departs. They ret 2 of their top 4 in Dontra Peters who led with 707 (5.0) and Chris Setian who had 184 (5.1). While they lose their str they ret their leading rusher and are on par with LY's unit.

Rec's - In '09 UNH had to replace a 1,000 yd rec then #3 rec Terrance Fox (490, 13.6) was susp. The Wildcats still ret'd 4 of their top 6 led by AA TE Scott Sicko. LY they lost 3 of their top 6 incl their #1 rec, Sicko (1st tm CAA, 725, 12.7) and #2 JT Wright (437, 10.9). They ret'd their #3, #4 and #5 rec's and got Fox back. Fox (10st) led with 821 (10.3) but departs along with #3 Kevon Mason (13st, 442, 13.0). Mickey Mangieri (#5 rec '09) missed the ssn (brk leg). They ret 4 of their top 7 incl #2 Joey Orlando (12st, 585, 11.7) along with TE's Sean Cullen (250, 12.5) and Chris Jeannot (4st, 205, 8.5). Despite losing 2 str's this unit could take a step up TY.

OL-Line - In '09 the OL had to replace 3 str's incl 2nd tm CAA LT Josh Drosch but ret'd 2 who started 10+ gms. The less

exp group only paved the way for 138 ypg (3.8) while all'g 31 sks (8.0%). They lost 2 str's LY incl 2nd tm CAA RT/C Tom Neill. They ret'd 4 OL who had sts (3 with 9+) but their numbers fell again to 128 ypg (3.5, worst S/O4) while all'g 38 sk (8.7%). TY the only loss is 2nd tm CAA LT Seth Price (12st, 2 yr str). They ret 6 who comb for 49 sts led by 2 yr str's LG George Pecoraro (12st) and C Chris Zarkoskie (13st). With a bit more depth, UNH should improve in 2011.

D-Line - In '09 UNH ret'd all 4 str's incl CAA DROY Brian McNally (55 tkl, 8.5 tfl) but he started just 3. They all'd 3.4 ypc for a 2nd str ssn and the D's sk tkl rose from 13 to 32. LY they lost 3 DL who comb for 28 sts but did ret both starting DT's incl Steve Young (6 tfl) and DE's James Jenkins and McNally. Again they all'd just 3.4 ypc and tied for a CAA lead with 37 sks. They lose 2 str's in DT Young (13st, 6 tfl) and DT Lance Mailloux (5st, 19 tkl, 4 sk). They ret DE's Jenkins (13st, 4sk) and 1st tm CAA McNally (13st), who led the CAA with 13.5 sks, along with DT Jared Smith (5st, 38 tkl, 4 tfl). This is once again a very solid unit.

LB's - The LB unit ret'd 2 str's in '09 but had to replace a 2nd tm CAA LB (#2 tkl'r). They improved from all'g 23.5 to 21.1 ppg. LY they ret'd 2 str's (#1 & #6 tkl'r's) but had to replace Sean Ware (#2 tkl'r). They all'd just 16.5 ppg (#5 FCS). TY they lose Ryan McNally (#5 tkl'r) and Devon Jackson (2st, inj'd). They ret Alan Buzbee (#3 tkl'r, 8 tfl) and AA Matt Evans (10.5 tfl), who led the CAA with 156 tkl and the unit could be just as strong.

DB's - The secondary ret'd 3 str's in '09 incl a 2nd tm CAA CB (#1 tkl'r) but lost a 2nd tm CAA FS (#4 tkl'r). They were #2 in pass D with a solid 16-21 ratio (#4 FCS in int). LY they lost 2 str's (#3 & #7 tkl'r's) but ret'd FS Hugo Souza (#4 tkl'r, 11 pd) and 2nd tm CAA CB Dino Vasso (#5 tkl'r, 5 int). They were #3 CAA in pass eff D with an even better 14-23 ratio (#2 FCS int). TY they lose 1st tm CAA CB Vasso (#4 tkl'r, 6 int), FS Souza (#2 tkl'r) and SS John Greer (#6 tkl'r, 3 int). The unit ret CB Kyle Flemings (13st, 30 tkl, 4 int) but the best of the ret secondary had a comb 1 int LY. This unit will likely take a step back TY.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '09 the ST unit lost its top PR and a 2nd tm CAA P. They ret'd their top KR and K Tom Manning (4-7 FG). Manning improved to 18-24 FG (L/54) including 2-3 from 50+ earning 1st tm CAA. He and the top KR (20.4) were the only losses LY. P Ryan Glasgow (34.7 avg in '09) only had 3 punts as TE/P Kyle Auffray (9st TE in '10) assumed the duties. TY they lose Auffray (37.7) and their top PR's but do return both K's in Mike MacArthur (10-13) and AJ DeLago (4-4).

COACHES - Sean McDonnell enters his 13th yr and has had 7 str winning ssns. Tim Cramsey enters his 2nd ssn as OC (9th overall) while former Dartmouth HC John Lyons takes over as DC.

FORECAST - In '09 UNH ret'd 5 off str's incl an exp'd QB and while they slipped in tfl off they went from #2 to #1 in scoring. LY they again ret'd 5 str's incl an exp'd QB but lost their top rusher and their top 2 rec. UNH improved to #4 in tfl off but fell to #4 in scoring. TY they ret 5 off str's and while they lose their starting QB they ret their top rusher and 4 of their top 6 rec and should again be toward the top of the CAA in off. The Wildcats ret'd 9 def str's in '09 and improved in scoring and tfl D. LY they ret'd 6 def str's (lost 4 of their top 8 tkl'r's) and moved up to #3 in scoring and tfl D. TY they ret 5 str's and lose 5 of their top 7 tkl'r's and their DC. With an inexperienced secondary and a new DC they may take a step back. LY UNH had their 5 gm win streak over FBS tms end but made their 7th str playoffs. UNH opened CAA play 0-2 with surprising losses to RI and rival Maine (snapped 7 gm series win streak). They won 5 of their last 6 CAA gms incl defeating Villanova, who had knocked them out of LY's playoffs. They beat MEAC co-Champ BC in the 1st rd but for the 2nd time in 2 yrs were knocked out by a CAA tm (UD). Despite replacing their starting QB, UNH could improve their off which will be needed as their D may take a step back. How well UN does in their 1st 4 CAA gms (3 away) will determine if they make their 8th straight playoffs.
