POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - In '09 SB ret'd Dayne Hoffman (1636, 48%, 11-9) and Dan Sweeney (14-22-110) and they added Michael Coulter (PS#1413JC). Coulter won the job and threw for 2,060 (55%, 15-10). Sweeney departed LY and Hoffman (3-6-59, 1-1) missed the ssn (sng). Coulter ret'd and they added JC Kyle Essington. Coulter threw for 1,811 (60.5%, 17-10) while Essington was 3-4-34. Both ret TY and they add JC Lyle Negron (PS#355JC).

RB's - In '09 SB ret'd BSC FPOY Edwin Gowins (1310, 9.4, 11 td) and 2nd tm BSC Conte Cuttino (1195, 6.0). Both were 1st tm BSC as Gowins led with 890 (6.1, 9 td) and Cuttino had 800 (4.5). Cuttino departed LY along with both FB's. They ret'd Gowins and added two Hofstra tran in Miguel Maysonet, who led the Pride with 385 (4.9) and Brock Jackolski (76, 3.8), who was the Pride's top KR (598, 22.1). Gowins ply'd in just 2 (inj) and finished #3 with 155 (5.3). Maysonet led with 1,128 (6.4, 12 td) while Jackolski had 1,029 (6.9, 9 td) and both were 1st tm BSC. SB ret's its entire rush unit incl Gowins and is the only FCS tm with three 1,000 yd backs.

DE's - In '09 SB lost its top 3 rec (comb 1190 yd) with Donald Porter being the top returnee with just 137 (12.5). They added JC TE Brett Arce but he RS. They improved their pass numbers by 36 ypg. They ret'd 4 of their top 5 LY led by Donald Porter (476, 19.0), Jordan Gush (413, 15.9), Matt Brevi (344, 13.2) and former New Hampshire tran Michael Lepore (214, 13.4) but lost TE Chris Tyler (2 rec) and #3 Stephan Towns (398, 10.8) who led with 37 rec. Porter ply'd in just 1 gm (at CB) and with the FCS's #7 rush off their passing numbers fell by 27 ypg. TY their only losses are #3 Lepore (243, 15.2) and Cameron Hill (1 rec). The rest of the unit returns led by 2nd tm BSC Brevi (668, 17.1) and Gush (525, 13.5) along with TE Arce (10st, 73, 12.2) and Porter. They add Kevin Norrell (PS#359JC) who played at Wash St as a true in '08.

O-Line - The OL ret'd 3 st's in '09 but lost a 1st tm BSC LG and a 2nd tm BSC LT. They added 2 JC's incl Brian Crew (PS#384JC). Despite having 2 All-BSC RB's they rushed for 65 ypg less as the ypg fell from 6.0 to 4.5 despite allowing 2 fewer sks (15, 5.1%). LY they lost 3 st's but ret'd 1st tm BSC C Paul Fenaroli and LG

Crew (9st) along with LT Joe Faiella (4st) and added Hofstra tran Armand Poole. They improved to 218 ypg rush (5.6) but allowed 18 sk (8.0%). TY they lose 3 st's incl two 1st tm BSC in C Fenaroli (38 car st) and LG Crew (9st) along with RG Poole (10st). SB ret's LT Faiella (11st) and RT Michael Bamiro (10st) along with OG's Mario Dattilo (3st) and Phillip Vournazos (1st). They add in JC's Joe Danaker (PS#187JC) and Steven Watts.

D-Line - The DL lost all 3 st's in '09 incl its #6 tk'l'r and 1st tm BSC DE James Harris (#5 tk'l'r, 10 tfl) and moved to a 4-3 D. While they improved their rush ypg allowed (144), the ypc remained 4.1 and the D again had just 12 sk. LY they lost 2 st's in 2nd tm BSC DE Christopher Perri (#8 tk'l'r) and DE Ryan Sollazzo (#14 tk'l'r). They ret'd DT Ryan Haber (#7 tk'l'r) and NT Michael Marino (#14 tk'l'r) along with former JC Joseph Kirkpatrick (#13 tk'l'r). They added former Maine tran Jonas Rousseau, JC Roosevelt Kirk and Hofstra tran Andrew Nelson. They allowed just 127 rush ypg (best S'02) with a 3.7 ypc but the D had just 10 sk (T-5th fewest FCS). TY they lose DE's Kirkpatrick (6st, 22 tk) and Rousseau (5st, #12 tk'l'r, 4.5 sk). They add Maryland tran Masengo Kabongo (PS#72) and ret 5 who comb for 33 st in DT Haber (30 tk, 7 tfl), DL Nelson (27 tk), DE Alex Probasco (17 tk), DE Kirk (15 tk) and NT Marino (11 tk).

LB's - The LB unit lost the #8 and #9 tk'l'r's in '09 but ret'd 4 st's incl two 2nd tm BSC LB in Tyler Santucci (#1 tk'l'r, 7 tfl) and former Conn tran Carl Teague (#4 tk'l'r) along with Stephen Schwicke (#2 tk'l'r). LY the unit lost AA and BSC DPOY Santucci (#1 tk'l'r, 14 tfl), LB Chevar Rankins (#8 tk'l'r) and Teague (25 tk). They only ret'd WLB Schwicke (#3 tk'l'r, 68 tk, 7.5 tfl) who also ply'd FB (4st). TY they lose Schwicke (17 tk) and SLB Julian Glenn (10st, #7 tk'l'r). They ret 2nd tm BSC Craig Richardson (#2 tk'l'r, 6.5 tfl), Jawara Dudley (#4 tk'l'r) and Grant Nakwaasah (#6 tk'l'r).

DB's - In '09 the secondary ret'd 5 who comb for 34 st incl SS Arin West (#3 tk'l'r) and former Mich tran 2nd tm BSC CB Chris Richards (#7 tk'l'r, 3 int). They were #2 in pass eff D (11-12 ratio). LY they lost 3 st's in 2nd tm BSC CB Richards (#6 tk'l'r, 7 pbu), CB Benjamin Clements (#4 tk'l'r, 3 int) and SS Cory Giddings (#8 tk'l'r, 2 int). They ret'd 1st tm BSC FS Arin West (#2 tk'l'r, 3 int) and added Rutgers tran Al-Majid Hutchins (PS#120) and Utah St tran Sheldon Armstrong (PS#416, DNP). They were #3 in pass eff D (14-17 ratio). TY they lose 1st tm BSC SS West (#1 tk'l'r, 7 pd) but ret 3 st's in FS Dominick Reyes (#3 tk'l'r, 7 pd), CB Davonte Anderson (T-#7 tk'l'r, 4 int) and CB Hutchins (#9 tk'l'r) along with CB Cedrick Moore (#5 tk'l'r, 2st) and add BC tran Dan Mulrooney (PS#149) and 2 JC's.

SPECIAL TEAMS - The ST unit lost its K/P in '09 but ret'd its top RM. LY they lost their LS but ret'd K Wesley Skiffington (15-17, L/43), P Drew Evangelista (36.7) and their top RM. TY they lose Evangelista (33.9) but ret their top PR, 2nd tm BSC KR Jackolski (26.3, 1 td) and 2nd tm BSC K Skiffington (7-12, L/44).

COACHES - HC Chuck Priore enters his 6th year and was the BSC COY in '09. OC Jeff Behrman is back for his 6th ssn. DC Jim Gush left for Baylor after 2 yrs here and the new DC is Rob Neviasser, who was the DC at Rhode Island the L/2 yrs.

FORECAST - The Seawolves, with 6 off st's, improved from #4 to #2 in both scoring and tfl off LY. TY they ret 7 st's, have 3 former 1st tm BSC RB's and add several JC's. The D ret'd just 4 st's LY but had 2 of their top 3 tk'l'r's back but slipped from #2 to #3 in scoring and from #2 to #4 in tfl D. TY they add 2 BCS tran, ret 8 st's and 9 of their top 11 tk'l'r's. SB lost by 3 in OT to Brown and by 5 to UMass to start 1-3. They then won 5 of their next 6 (won all 5 BSC gm) and had their 6th winning ssn since moving up from Div II in '99. In the finale they faced Liberty, who was 4-1 in conf play. They ended in a 3-way tie for the conf crown (SB's 2nd straight shared title) with LU and Coastal Carolina. Each team was 1-1 against the others so the auto-bid came down to fewest pts allowed in BSC play. SB came into the finale with a 38 pt lead (all g 68 pt - 5 gm) but by allowing 54 vs LU, lost out to CCU. TY SB ret's 5 more st's than LY and hosts both LU and CCU. They should have a 3rd straight winning ssn and with the best conf schedule look to be the fav for the BSC crown and secure their 1st FCS playoff bid.
