QB BJ Coleman

QB's - In '09 the Mocs set 3 exp QB's in Jare Gault (10th, 961, 52%, 7-6), Tony Pastore (2nd, 456, 46%, 4-4) and Sloan Allison (331, 40%, 0-9) and they added Tenn tran BJ Coleman (PS#65). They had a new OC and switched to more of a passing game. Gault and Allison moved to WR and Coleman started all 11, throwing for 2,348 (57%, 17-9). LY they ret'd Coleman but lost Pastore (1-1-4) and Gault (3-7-23). Coleman threw for 2,996 (56.3%, 26-13) and was 2nd tm SoCon. He ret's along with backup Graham Nichols (4-8-44).

RB's - UTC ret'd 6 of its top 7 rushers in '09 incl #1 Erroll Wynn (636, 3.2) and #2 Shaun Kermah (253, 3.9) and got back Bryan Fitzgerald (798, 6.8 in '07) who missed '08 (inj). They switched their off but still saw their rush ypg increase slightly. Wynn RS (inj) and true frosh Chris Awuah started 7 and led with 459 (3.0). Fitzgerald was the #2 (342, 5.3) but departed along with Kermah (19, 2.7). Bo Dyer was #3 (103, 3.2) but moved to LB in the spg of LY. They ret'd Awuah and JJ Jackson (46, 4.2) plus got Wynn back. Wynn led with 653 (5.3) but departs TY and Keon Williams (500, 4.9) was susp'd for the '11 ssn. They only ret 2 of their top 5 in Jackson (223, 3.5) and Awuah (113, 4.3) but had a similar amount of experience back last year.

Rec's - UTC ret'd its top 3 rec in '09 in Clint Woods (512, 10.4), Blue Cooper (364, 16.5) and Chris Pitchford (245, 10.7) and added Miami, Oh transfer Brian Sutherland. The Mocs switched the off and improved their rec yds by 69 ypg. LY they lost 3 of their top 5 in 2nd tm SoCon Cooper (824, 9.8), Woods (250, 8.6) and Terrance Davis (186, 13.3). They ret'd Pitchford (528, 12.0) and starting TE Garrett Hughes (244, 14.4). They also add rF Marlon Anthony (PS#142) and moved in DB Joel Bradford (24 tk, 2 int).

They improved again by 60 ypg. TY they lose Hughes (346, 13.8), Sutherland (729, 14.6) and Pitchford (230, 12.8). They ret 6 of their top 9 led by AA Bradford (1284, 15.9) and Anthony (195, 11.5).

O-Line - In '09 the OL ret'd 5 who comb for 44 st incl three 12 gms st's in C Justin Galyon, LT Chris Harr and OG TJ Hurless but switched the off. They improved their ypc from 2.3 to 2.8 and cut their sks all'd from a conf-worst 42 (12.5%) to a conf-best (#3 FCS) 9 (2.2%) despite not having a mobile QB. The OL ret'd all 5 st's LY in 2nd tm SoCon Harr, RG Hurless, C Galyon, LG Omre Harris and RT Adam Miller. They improved to 153 ypg rush (4.2) although they all'd 15 sk (3.8%). TY they lose three 3 yr st's in 1st tm SoCon LT Harr, RG Hurless and C Galyon. They ret 44 car st incl 4 who started LY in RT Miller (9), LG Austin Wilson (8), LG Harris (3) and RT Dustin Tate (2) and add Tenn tran Kevin Revis (PS#99).

D-Line - The DL lost 2 st's in '09 but ret'd DT BJ Taylor (34 tkl, 8.5 tfl) and DE Jaron Norfleet (25 tkl, 3.5 tfl). They trimmed the rush ypg to 149 (3.8) and increased their sk tfl to 30. LY they lost 2 st's in Taylor (#11 tkl'r, 6.5 tfl) and 1st tm SoCon Josh Beard (#4) who led the FCS in sk per gm (12 overall). They ret'd DE Joshua Williams (t-#9 tkl'r, 7 sk), DT Nick Craig (t-#9, 2.5 sk) and DE Norfleet (#14). They also added UAB tran Nick Davison (PS#421, 5st in 2Y) and Tenn tran Chris Donald (PS#5). They took a step back all g 163 ypg (4.0) with 20 sk. TY they lose 2nd tm SoCon DE Donald (#4 tkl'r, 7.5 sk) and 2 DL who comb for 5 st (44 tkl). They ret NT Davison (t-#5, 8 tfl), DT Craig (#8) and DE Williams (5 sk).

LB's - This unit ret'd 2 st's in '09 in SLB Joseph Thornton (#1 tkl'r) and MLB Doug Faatila (PS#112JC, #8) and moved in SS Tony Swafford (#2) but he moved back at midssn due to inj's. They allowed just 25.7 ppg, their fewest S/'00. LY they lost Thornton (#1 tkl'r), Steven Smigelsky (#3) and Faatila (#7). They ret'd Ryan Consiglio (#2 tkl'r, 9 tfl) and moved in SS JD Dohard (25 tkl, out 5 gm inj). The ppg rose to 31.2. TY the unit ret's intact led by SLB Consiglio (#1 tkl'r, 9.5 tfl), MLB Shane Heatherly (t-#6), WLB Gunner Miller (35 tkl, 4.5 tfl) and Wes Dohard (32 tkl).

DB's - In '09 the Mocs ret'd 3 who comb for 26 st in FS JD Dohard (#3 tkl'r), CB Buster Skrine (#7) and CB Chris Lewis-Harris (#10). They improved to 159 ypg pass despite losing Dohard (inj, out 5) and were #5 SoCon pass eff D (12-11 ratio). LY they lost Swafford (16 tkl) and Dohard moved to LB. They ret'd 1st tm SoCon CB Skrine (#6 tkl'r), CB Lewis-Harris (#8) and FS Jordan Tippit (#5, 5 int) and added rF Kadeem Wise. Surprisingly they allowed a 4 yr high of 207 ypg pass and were #9 in pass eff D (19-13 ratio). TY they lose 1st tm SoCon CB Skrine (#7 tkl'r, 9 pd, #5DC CLE) but ret 6 who comb for 37 st

incl FS DJ Key (#2 tkl'r), SS Lewis-Harris (#3), SoCon FOY CB Wise (6 pbu, 6 int) and FS Tippit (3 int).

SPECIAL TEAMS - LY the ST unit ret'd P Mike Hammons (40.1), PR Joel Bradford (13.1) and their top 3 KR's but they lost 1st tm SoCon K Craig Camay (16-19 FG, L/52). They signed K Nick Pollard (PS#67) but he RS (inj). TY all of the top ply's ret incl P Hammons (38.4), K Jeff Veres (3-9, L/37) and Pollard.

COACHES - Russ Huesman was previously the DC at Richmond. His 2 winning ssns are equal to the L/4 HC's comb. OC Marcus Satterfield and DC Adam Fuller both ret for their 3rd ssns.

FORECAST - The Mocs ret'd 9 off st's LY, got '08's #1 rusher Wynn (MedRS) back and were in the 2nd yr of the system. They scored their most pts S/'79 and improved from #6 to #3 SoCon in scoring and from #7 to #3 in tfl off. TY they ret just 4 st's and lose three 3 yr starting OL but ret their QB and top WR. UTC ret'd 7 def st's LY and had 9 of their top 14 tkl's back in the 2nd year of the system. After allowing their fewest pts S/'00 in '09, they fell from #4 to #8 in scoring and from #3 to #6 in tfl D. TY they ret 9 def st's and 11 of their top 13 tkl's but lose a rare NFL DC CB and their sack leader. Huesman has breathed new life into this program with back-to-back winning ssns for the first time since 1990-'91. Their 4 conf wins in '09 were their most S/'98 and their 5 conf wins LY were their most S/'85. While the Mocs have the potential to make their 1st ever FCS playoffs TY, their conf road schedule is much tougher and they will not match LY's 5 conf wins.
