POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - In '09, RJ Archer was 2nd tm CAA, throwing for 2,778 (60%, 16-9) in his only yr as the str. LY W&M ret'd Terrance Schmand (7 att '09) and added N Car trans Michael Paulus (PS#6, IFS). However, Sr Mike Callahan (PS#108), who had not seen the field in his 4 yrs here, started the 1st 4. Paulus came in and led the 4Q comeback vs Maine, throwing the GW TD with :20 left. He started the next 3 and QB'd most of the gm vs UNC (did not start) before being inj'd (OFY). He threw for 883 (62%, 4-2) in 6 gms. Callahan started 4 of the L/5 and threw for 1,659 (61.7%, 10-3). RFR Brent Caprio started vs NH (5-10 pass) but was inj'd. W&M moved in WR DJ Mangas (PS#295QB) in the spg. Paulus (OFS) should be ready for the fall so despite losing an 8 gm str the Tribe is more experienced at QB this ssn.

RB's - In '09 W&M ret'd 4 of its top 5 incl 1st tm CAA OF ROY Jonathan Grimes (929, 5.7) and he led the CAA in rushing with 1,294 (4.7). LY they ret'd their top 3 incl 1st tm CAA Grimes, Courtland Marriner (458, 4.9) and Terrence Riggins (290, 5.1). Grimes was banged up and led with just 887 (4.3) but still earned 1st tm CAA. Marriner had 355 (3.8) and Riggins had 211 (4.7) and both depart along with 1st tm CAA FB Jimmy Hobson (6 st, 49 tl yds). Grimes who is already W&M's car leader (5445 tl yd) should have a fine Sr ssn and they add Navy transfer Keith McBride (PS#168).

Rec's - In '09 W&M ret'd 4 of its top 5 incl 1st tm CAA TE. LY they lost 2nd tm CAA WR McAulay (620, 10.9) and 2nd tm CAA TE Rob Varno (467, 9.3). They did ret 4 of the top 6 who caught passes led by Cameron Dohse (566, 18.9) and Chase Hill (469, 13.8). Dohse ply'd in just 4 (205, 18.6) while 3rd tm CAA Hill had 490 (14.8) but both depart. They ret 5 of the top 6 who had rec's led by 2nd tm CAA WR Ryan Moody (731, 15.6) and 3rd tm CAA TE Alex Gottlieb (350, 10.3) but WR Mangas saw time at QB and Moody is ? (inj knee in spg).

O-Line - In '09 they ret'd 3 OL who each started 10+ gms in '08. They improved their ypg but their ypc fell (4.9 to 4.1). LY they lost two 14 gm str's incl a 2nd tm CAA C. They looked to ret 3 str's who all started 13+ but LT Jake Marcey missed the ssn. Their ypg fell to 129 (3.5) and they all'd 24 sk (6.6%). TY they lose 1st tm CAA LT Keith Hill (11st, 3 yr str) and RG Derek Toon (7st, 2 yr str). They ret 5 who comb for 41 st incl 3rd tm CAA C James Pagliaro plus Marcey (25 car sts) and they should put up much better numbers this season.

D-Line - The DL ret'd all 4 str's in '09 led by a 1st tm CAA DE and W&M was #1 in the FCS all'g just 61 ypg rush (2.0) while

the D led the CAA with 49 sk. LY the DL lost 3 str's incl two 1st tm CAA who were both DC's (#3 and #4 tk'l's). They ret'd 3 DL who comb for 17 st and 9.5 sk led by DT Michael Stover (#8 tk'l'r, 12.5 tfl). They all'd 147 ypg rush (4.0) while the sks plummeted to 19. TY they lose 2 str's incl 2nd tm CAA DT Stover (12 tfl). They do ret 2 str's incl 2nd tm CAA DE Marcus Hyde (12.5 tfl) and I look for improvement TY.

LB's - The LB unit ret'd #2 tk'l'r Jake Trantin in '09 but lost 2

str's who were their #4 and #5 tk'l's. They still cut their ppg all'd by almost half from 24.0 to 12.1 (#2 FCS). LY they looked to ret 4 LB's who comb for all 42 st incl their #1, #2 and #7 tk'l's but Trantin (2nd tm CAA) missed the ssn (personal). TY they lose Evan Francis (#2 tk'l'r, 11st) and Steinman (#5 tk'l'r, 12st) but ret 2nd tm CAA OLB Dante Cook (#1 tk'l'r, 10st) and Jabrel Mines (#4 tk'l'r, 3st) along with Trantin making them more experienced.

DB's - The secondary ret'd 3 str's in '09 incl its #1 tk'l'r but lost a #3DC (2nd tm CAA). They were #11 in the FCS in pass eff D (12-16 ratio). LY they lost 2 str's in 1st tm CAA SS David Caldwell (#5 tk'l'r) and FS Robert Livingston (#6). They ret'd their top 3 CB's incl CAA Def ROY BW Webb (2nd tm CAA) who led the conf with 8 int. They moved up to #10 FCS in pass eff D (6-13 ratio). TY they ret 3 starters in 1st tm CAA CB Webb, SS Brian Thompson (#3 tk'l'r) and FS Terrell Wells (#6 tk'l'r) who moves to CB to replace Ben Cottingham (9 pbu).

SPECIAL TEAMS - W&M usually fields a solid ST unit. Since the inception of the conf ('07) they've placed 10 on the All-CAA tm. LY they lost 2nd tm CAA K Brian Pate (23-35 FG) but ret'd 3 All-CAA players in P David Miller (1st), PR Webb (3rd) and KR Grimes (3rd). Webb (#2 CAA PR) and Grimes (#3 CAA KR) were both 2nd tm CAA

LY and ret along with K Drake Kuhn (13-18 FG). They do lose AA Miller (43.0) but P Tyler Bailey hit an 82 yd P in the spg.

COACHES - HC Jimmye Laycock enters his 32nd yr as HC and is off his 21st winning ssn. Zbig Kepa enters his 20th yr as OC (28th overall). Scott Boone enters his 8th ssn here and after 4 yrs as the LB cch adds the title of DC this ssn. He replaces 4 yr DC Bob Shoop who left for a position at Vanderbilt.

FORECAST - Despite losing a 32 gm starting QB, W&M still finished #5 in scoring and #3 in tfl off in the conf in '09. LY they ret'd just 5 off str's and were #5 in both categories. TY marks the 3rd str yr they're replacing their str at QB but have 6 ret str's incl 4 All-CAA plus get back an '09 OL str. The D ret'd 8 str's in '09 and led the FCS in rush D (#2 FCS scoring and tfl D). LY they ret'd just 5 str's and lost 5 of their top 6 tk'l's incl 2DC's. They all'd almost 100 ypg more finishing #4 in both scoring and tfl D in the CAA. TY they ret 6 str's incl 3 All-CAA and 5 of their top 7 tk'l's plus get back their #1 tk'l'r from '09. W&M, coming off an 11 win ssn, led UMass 23-14 in the 4Q of but lost. They then won 6 str incl wins over #2 Villanova and #2 Delaware and led NC 17-7 at half but lost both the gm and QB Paulus. They won 2 of their L/3 and were co-CAA Champs getting the #2 seed for the playoffs but lost to a surging GS tm. For the 2nd ssn in a row they were +DD TO's but did fall from 11 to 8 wins. TY they host both JMU and UNH but face UD on the road. The Tribe has the talent and if they can stay healthy should be able to capture their 2nd straight CAA Title.
