## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

B's - In '09 UMass lost its all-time leading passer in 2x 2nd tm CAA Liam Coen. They ret'd bkp Scott Woodward (9-19-97) and added JC Kyle Havens (IFS). Havens started the 1st 10 throwing for 1,908 (55%, 9-15) and ret'd LY. Woodward started the finale (his final gm) and in 11 gms threw for 613 (54%, 2-7). Havens had every pass att here LY throwing for 2,692 (63.5%) with a much improved 20-7 ratio but departs. They ret rFr Brandon Hill (PS#126) and Ian Shultis (2 gm) plus add BG transfer Kellen Pagel (2-3-20 at BG LY) and true Fr Mike Wegzyn (PS#99) but it will be tough to top LY's numbers.

RB's-UMass ret'd its top 7 rushers in '09 led by 1st tm CAATB Tony Nelson (1325, 5.5, 12 td). LY 1st tm CAAFB Chris Zardos (164, 3.8) and 2nd tm CAA RB Nelson (#1 with 741, 4.9) both departed as they lost 5 of their top 7. They added N'eastern trans John Griffin (1009, 4.9 at NE in '09) and ret'd 2 of their top 4 in Jonathan Hernandez (4st, 577, 4.8) and Cedric Gonnet (129, 5.2). TY they lose Griffin (2st, 843, 5.0) and FB Scott Duggan (2st,1 yd). They ret 2nd tm CAA Hernandez (10st, 938, 4.3, #4 rec) and FB Jamar Smith (50, 4.5) and add Pitt trans Chris Burns (PS#56). They could match LY's outstanding numbers.

Rec's - UM ret'd its top 6 rec in '09 led by 1st tm CAA Victor Cruz (1064, 15.0) and Jeremy Horne (895, 17.9). LY they lost 2 of their top 3 rec incl Horne (297,13.5) and 1st tm CAA Cruz (868,14.7) who had 5 of the tm's 11 rectd. Their top returnees were Julian Talley (350, 12.5) and TE Emil Igwenagu (288, 12.0). They added Hofstra trans Anthony Nelson, who was the Pride's #2 rec

TY they lose 2 of their top 3 in 1st tm CAA Nelson (830,13.6) and Dan Sheeran (3st, 473, 12.8) along with TE Andrew Krevis (5st, 5 rec). They ret 2nd tm CAA Talley (747, 13.3) along with TE's Rob Blanchflower (4st, 179, 8.5) and Igwenagu (7st, 142, 11.8). **D-Lime** - The OL lost 2 strs in '09 incl C Sean Calicchio but ret'd 5 who comb for 39 st incl AA LT Vladimir Ducasse. Their ypg

increased slightly but their ypc fell from 4.4 to 4.0 and the sks allowed rose from 6 (1.7%) to 17 (4.8%). LY they lost 2 st'rs incl 1st tm CAA Ducasse who was a #2DC NYJ. They ret'd 5 who comb eff D with a poor 18-8 ratio. TY they lose CB Ke'Mon Bailey (5st, for 33 st and added N'eastern trans Greg Niland and Syracuse trans Nick Speller. Their 168 ypg was the highest S/'06 but their 37 st incl FS Darren Thellen (#3 tkl'r, 6 pbu), SS Shame Viveiros ypc stayed at 4.0 with 15 sk (4.3%). TY they lose 1st tm CAA LG (#4), CB Mike Lee (#7) and CB Antonie Tharpe (#9). Niland (11st) and C John Ihne (6st). They ret LT Speller (11st), RT Stephane Milhim (10st), RG Josh Samuda (9st), C Quniton

tkl'r, 2.5 sk) and DT Brandon Collier (3.5 tfl). They all'd 120 rush P Caleb Violette (39.0 avg, 1-2 FG). Violette's P avg dropped to

COACHES - HC Kevin Morris is in his 3rd as HC after being the OC here for 5 yrs prior. Former OL cch (5 yrs) Brian Picucci starts his 3rd yr as OC. They lose 7 yr DC Keith Dudzinski (MD LB). Their new DC is Frank Forcucci, a former asst cch here who was the Cent Conn LB coach last year after being the DC at Northeastern and Fordham.

FORECAST - UMass had to replace its all-time leading passer and had a new OC in '09. Their numbers dipped slightly but they still finished #4 in scoring and #2 in ttl off. LY they lost all 4 All-CAA players incl their #1 rusher, #1 receiver and a #2DC OL. UM added 3 transfers, ret'd an exp'd QB and led the CAA in ttl off (#3 scoring). TY the off ret 6 strs and adds 2 FBS trans. In '09 the D lost 5 of its top 7 tkl'rs but surprisingly improved. LY they again lost 5 of their top 7 tkl'rs incl 3 of their 4 All-CAA players but added an FBS trans. They remained #7 in ttl D but fell to #9 in scoring. TY they ret 9 st'rs incl AA LB Tyler Holmes. They began LY 4-1 with their only loss to Mich (by 5) but then went 2-4 the rest of the way. TY the big news is that they are moving up to the FBS and will join the MAC in 2012. While they are not eligible for the CAA crown or the playoffs they still count in the CAA standings. They are playing in a nationally televised gm at Holy Cross to begin the ssn. With 6 more ret st'rs than LY and 2 FBŚ trans, the Minutemen should have their 9th winning ssn in 10 yrs and will have a big impact on the CAA race.
