## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

**QUARTERBACKS** - In 2008 the Raiders looked to return their starting QB, however, he was injured in the 1Q of the opener and Greg Sullivan, who played just 1 series in '07, took over. Sullivan started the next 3 years and LY he earned 1st tm PL throwing for 1,349 (65%, 8-5) while rushing for 651 (5.2). Filling his big shoes TY will be Sr Steve Rizzo. Rizzo played in 4 gms in '09 (no att, 1 car) and in 10 gms LY, incl getting a start vs Lehigh, he threw for 89 yds (44%, 2-1) and rushed for 176 (4.9). Also in the mix are Jr Josh Hasenberg and rFr Gavin McCarney, who both RS'd LY.

**RUNNING BACKS** - The Raiders are building quite a RB lineage as 1st tm PL Jordan Scott had 1,875 w/ 20 td in '07 and 1,148 w/ 15 td in '08, while Nate Eachus had 932 (5.4) w/ 10 td as both were 1st tm PL in '08. In '09 2nd tm PL Jordan McCord led with 930 (4.8). Eachus played in only 8 games but finished with 919 (4.9) and 16 td earning 1st tm honors. McCord DNP LY and Eachus (1871, 5.9, 21 td) was a consensus 1st tm AA. TY both return as does Noah Jackson (358, 4.2) and the only loss is 1st tm PL FB Gigi Cadet (9st, 142 rec, 15.8). This unit can compare with any in the FCS.

**RECEIVERS** - In 2009 Pat Simonds led for a second straight ssn with 1,012 (15.3, 14 td) which was 52% of the team's total receiving yds. He earned 1st tm PL and an AA award while Doug Rosnick was #2 with 396 (13.7). Rosnick was the only one of the top 5 rec to return LY. He led with 646 (13.2) which was 50% of the team's rec yds and was 1st tm PL. Daniel Cason was #2 (2st, 185, 8.8) and Chris Looney was the #3 WR (#5 overall, 2st, 91, 11.4). TY they again lose their #1 but ret 5 of their top 7. Jonathan Mputu (77, 5.9) has the most exp with 8 sts LY. They'll need someone to step up to take the pressure off this powerful rush based offense.

**OFFENSIVE LINE** - The OL ret'd 4 starters and 7 with starting exp in '08 and they rushed for 268 ypg and 5.1 ypc. In '09 they lost 4 starters incl an AA and two 1st team PL but still rushed for 250 ypg and 4.5 ypc finishing #3 in the FCS! LY they lost 2.5 starters incl a 1st tm PL and did

it again avg 276 ypg, 5.2 ypc and finishing #2 in the FCS incl 230 rush yds (4.4) at Syracuse. This year they lose only 8 sts and return a pair of 1st tm PL in RG James Germano and RT Vittorio Ottanelli. To show how deep this unit is, Kevin Morgan is scheduled to be the #2 C after making 10 st in '09 and 1 st LY.

**DEFENSIVE LINE** - In '09 they lost 2 of the 4 st's and after allowing 172 ypg rush and 5.5 ypc in '08, they allowed 117 ypg and 3.9 ypc. LY they lost 2 st's incl a 1st and 2nd tm PL but moved in a starting LB and only slid to 128 ypg and 4.2 ypc. TY they lose 2 st's but they are PL DPOY Rush DE Zach Smith (#3 tkl'r, 10.5 sk, 4 tfl) and 1st tm PL DE Lamont Sonds (#5 tkl'r, 8 sk, 3.5 tfl). Both DT's ret in Tyler Danielson (11st, 27 tkl, 5 tfl) and Greg Kafaf (11st). The top 4 competing for the 2 DE spots have a comb 4 tkl's of exp. While they ret 2 st's for the 3rd straight ssn their losses will be tough to replace.

**LINEBACKERS** - In 2008 the LB unit ret'd 2 starters and the team allowed 29.1 ppg. In '09 they again returned 2 starters but they were the #1 and #2 tkl'r's and the D improved by allowing 22.4 ppg. LY they lost 2 starters who were the #1 and #3 tkl'r's and moved the #4 tkl'r, Zach Smith to rush DE. Behind the powerful DL the new unit improved to 21.8 and if not for their 1st game vs an FBS team s/'03 (all'd 42 at Syr) they would have avg a recent best 19.8 ppg. This unit now returns intact after 1st tm PL Chris DiMassa (#1 tkl'r, 4.5 sk, 4.5 tfl) received a med RS for the '08 ssn. Patrick Friel (#2 tkl'r) is on the inside while Adam Lock (#7 tkl'r, 7.5 tfl) is on the outside.

**DEFENSIVE BACKS** - In '09 the secondary had to replace a pair of starters incl a 1st tm PL. They allowed 191 ypg passing and an excellent 48.7% comp. LY the unit lost only one starter but he was the tm's #1 tkl'r and was 1st tm PL and despite dropping to a still respectable 56.1% they improved to all g 168 ypg. This year is quite unusual as they actually lose all 4 starters (32st) but return 5 that made a comb 12 starts LY. FS Vinnie Nicosia (1st) had 11 st in '09, while SS Chad Frey started 3 as a true. Kenny McKenzie (5st), Wendell Lewis (2st) and Nat Bellamy (1st) will battle for the 2 CB spots.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - Punter Evan Goldszak returns after having a 38.3 avg and an above avg 34.7 net. The team has attempted only 14 FG's in 2Y (made 10) and 3 will battle to be the K incl Goldszak. Noah Jackson returns
