POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - Collier Winters saw action in 6 games in '07 then missed '08 with an injury as Sr Chris Pizzotti threw for 2,490 (63%) and earned Ivy POY honors. Winters started all 10 in '09 throwing for 1,861 (57%) with a 15-7 ratio and was #3 rushing with 295 yds (2.4) earning 2nd mt Ivy. Winters was named the Ivy's preseason OPOY but tore his adductor muscle and DNP in the first 5. LSU transfer Andrew Hatch started the first 2 before being sidelined with a concussion in the loss to Brown. Third string QB Colton Chapple got the next 3 starts leading the Crimson to a 2-1 record including a loss to Lehigh in which an apparent TD pass with 1:14 left was ruled incomplete. Hatch started vs Princeton but Winters QB'd the 2H and played full-time the rest of the way despite being less than 100%. Those 3 combined to pass for 1,883 (56.6%) with just a 12-12 ratio. While Hatch (3st, 502, 58.0%, 4-4) now departs, Chapple and Winters return and I expect Winters to contend for All-Ivy honors.

RB's - In '08 Gino Gordon led with 578 (4.9) and earned 2nd tm lvy honors. Gordon (632, 5.5) led again in '09 while adding 23 rec's (8.5) and this time he earned 1st tm lvy status. Treavor Scales had quite a freshman season finishing #2 with 485 (4.5) earning 2nd tm lvy honors and was named the lvy's ROY in '09. Both returned LY and Gordon had a memorable Sr season finishing #2 in the lvy in rushing and shared the Bushnell Cup as the league's MVP. He had six 100 yd gms including 113 yd vs Penn to end the Quakers' 33 gm streak of not allowing a 100 yd rusher. Scales had two 100 yd gms to finish #2 with 520 (6.0). Gordon now moves on and Scales becomes the feature

back with #3 rusher Rich Zajetski (201, 4.9) the likely bkp. While Scales is a quality replacement, Gordon will be missed.

Rec's - In '09 this unit was one of the deepest in the country returning their top 6 rec's who combined for 3,405 (14.9) with 23 td's. Eight of their top 9 rec's returned LY with 7 having had 10+ rec's. Even with the QB injuries the numbers at this spot remained similar to '09. Just 2 of the top 7 pass catchers return TY with TE Nicolai Schwarzkopf (10st, 113, 12, 12.6), WR Leri Richards (5st, 235, 11.8), WR Mike Cook (6st, 108, 12.2) and WR Marco Iannuzzi (6st, 108, 12.2).

(4st, 119, 19.8) all departing. Even though #1 WR Adam Chrissis (10st, 481, 12.0) returns and WR Chris Lorditch (545, 18.2 in '09) is back after LY's inj. this unit loses a lot of experience.

O-Line - With 5 ret OL str's in '08 the rush numbers "only" improved to 143 ypg (3.8). In '09 2 str's ret but both were all-conf players and with a more mobile QB the rush numbers increased to 179 ypg (4.2) while allowing 21 sks. LY they lost 4 str's with the only returnee being Brent Osborne who moved from RG to RT. Surprisingly, the rush numbers were their best S/'04 avg 198 ypg (4.7) while allowing 16 sks (5.5%). The Crimson now loses 3 str's in 2nd mt lvy RT Osborne (10st, 2 yr str), 2nd mt lvy C Chris LeRoy (10st) and LG Matt Bush (10st). Three players return with starting exp and this unit has proven it can reload.

D-line - The DL ret'd 3 starters in '08 yet allowed 109 ypg rushing and 3.4 ypc which was the 1st time in 4 years they allowed 100+ ypg and over 2.7 ypc. In '09 they lost 2 st'rs but were able to get back to their high standards as they allowed 83 (2.8) to finish #6 in the FCS in rush D. LY 3 st'rs were back and Josue Ortiz blossomed in his 1st year as a st'r finishing 2nd in the league in sks as a Jr and earning AA honors. Surprisingly, the rush D slid to allowing 105 ypg (3.0) although they finished 2nd in the conf with 30 sks. While 2nd tm Ivy DL Chuks Obi (10st, 4 tfl), DE Victor Ojuwku (10st, 28 tkl) and DT David Sklar (4st, 3.5 tfl) now depart. HC Murphy said Ortiz may be the Ivy's best overall player. I look for improved numbers vs the run.

LB's - In '08 the Crimson had all 3 str's back and the team allowed 7.8 ppg. Despite having only 1 str return in '09 in Connor Murphy (#8 tkrlr), Harvard improved allowing 17.2 ppg. LY they lost their #2, #3 and #11 tkrlrs with just their #7 tkrlr returning. The D remained strong allowing 18.7 ppg (#2 lvy). TY they have their most exp'd LB corps S/'08 with just 2nd tm lvy SLB Nick Hasselberg (10st, T-1 tkrlr) graduating. Four players return with starting exp including their #4, #7, #9 and #11 tkrlrs and this a deep and talented unit.

DB's - With 1 starter back in '08 the secondary allowed 190 ypg pass and 53% completions. Despite having 3 s'trs back in '09 the numbers dipped to 214 ypg and 56%. LY they lost two s'trs but returned two 1st tm lvy players in S Collin Zych and CB Matthew Hanson. The ypg slipped to 204 although the % remained at 56. TY 1st tm FS Yych (1st, T-#1 tk'd) departs along with SS Anthony Spadafino (7st) and CB Nico Amaro (1st). While 2 s'trs return like last year, I think the numbers will improve with a stronger front seven.

SPECIAL TEAMS - If the Crimson wishes to end Penn's Ivy domination, one area it can upgrade is the ST. P Jacob Dombrowski avg'd just 36.4 LY. To put that into perspective, LB Alex Gedeon avg'd 36.8 vs Columbia when Dombrowski missed (illness). The team's net of 27.2 was #115 in the FCS. Top KR

IVY LEAGUE

Marco Iannuzzi (34.5, 2 td) played in just 4 gms due to inj and the other KR's avg'd just 18.5. K David Mothander hit 9-15 FG but was only 3-9 from 30+. Harvard did sign 2 K's this year and both could compete for jobs right away.

COACHES - HC Tim Murphy enters his 18th season here and is the only Ivy head man to lead his team to 7+ wins for 10 straight seasons. Joel Lamb is in his 5th season as OC and was a former Crimson QB. Fellow alum Scott Larkee was previously on the staff here in '01 and returned in '07 with this being his 3rd season as DC.

FORECAST - Harvard alums have been treated to 10 straight winning seasons including going undefeated in 2001 and 2004. The Crimson is #2 in the FCS and #7 in Div IA this decade in win %. After going 19-2 in Ivy League play from '07-'09, Harvard came into LY with just 10 ret str's (its fewest S/'04) and also suffered an untimely injury to the Ivy's Preseason OPOY in QB Winters. After an opening win over Holy Cross, the Crimson trailed Brown 23-0 in the 2Q, losing the league opener at Brown for the 2nd time in 3Y. After getting back on track vs Lafayette and Cornell, the Crimson blew a 17-0 lead vs Patriot League champ Lehigh to fall to 3-2. With Winters returning to QB the 2H vs Princeton, Harvard rolled to 3 straight wins to get back into the title chase. ST's mistakes doomed them vs Ivy champ Penn as they set up the Quakers' first 17 pts in a game in which Harvard had a 388-256 yd edge. The Crimson bounced back to beat rival Yale for the 9th time in 10 years denying the Bulldogs a share of the Ivy title in the process. Once again Harvard returns 10 str's but this time they get 3 of the other Ivy contenders at home making them one of the favorites.
