POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - In '09 Sr Matt Nichols was the Big Sky OPOY, throwing for 3,830 (65%, 33-6) and left as the Big Sky's all-time career leader with 12,616 pass yds and 13,308 tdl yds (#6 FCS). His backups Jeff Minnerly and Scott Burgett comb to hit just 6-10 for 25 yds in '09. EW added SMU transfer Bo Levi Mitchell, who started 19 gms at SMU (4590, 57%, 36-33). They also signed JC Greg Panelli, who threw for 5,000 yds and 56 tdl in 2 yrs at JC but he RS. Mitchell threw for 3,496 (59.4%) with a 37-15 ratio and was the FCS Championship game MVP. His bkps threw for a comb 119 yds (1-1) and now everyone returns.

RB's - EW had to replace its top 3 rushers in '09 with Tyler Hart (84, 8.4) being their top returnee. They moved in CB Taiwan Jones and he led the way with 1,213 yds (1st tm BSC) while adding 561 yds rec (14.0). Hart was #2 (194, 3.5) while Darriell Beaumonte was #3 (135, 3.3). All 3 ret'd LY but Hart moved to WR. Despite missing 3 gms Jones rushed for 1,742 (7.9, 14 td) earning BSC co-OPOY and AA honors. He had a career high 230 vs NDSU in the playoffs but fractured his foot and missed L/2. Jones left early for the NFL (#4DC OAK) but everyone else ret incl Mario Brown (341, 3.4) and Beaumonte (219, 2.7). They also incl in Wash transfer Demetrius Bronson (PS#69) but it will be tough to replace one of the FCS's most productive backs.

Rec's - EW ret'd 7 of its top 10 rec in '09 incl #1 Aaron Boyce (917, 14.6) and #2 Brynson Brown (733, 14.7). Boyce was lost to inj vs UM, but still finished #2 with 634 (16.3, 2nd Tm BSC). Brown had just 4 rec as he was moved to the DL. Tony Davis (2nd tm BSC) led with 948 (12.3) while 1st tm BSC TE Nathan Overbay was #3 with 588 (11.5) setting an EWTE rec'd for rec (51). LY they lost their top 3 and their top returning WR's were Nicholas Edwards (11st, 334, 12.8), Brandon Kaufman (5st, 294, 12.8) and ex-RB Hart (162, 9.5). Kaufman earned 1st tm BSC after leading the conf with 1,214 yd (16.0) while Edwards totaled 614 (10.8). TY they lose WR Ashton Gant (5st, 321, 8.9) and TE Matt Martin (15st, 116, 8.9) but ret their top 3 incl Kaufman and Edwards to what is a well stocked unit.

O-Line - The OL ret'd 3 str's in '09 and with the emergence of RB Jones the ypc improved to 141 rush ypg (4.5) but they all'd 31 sks (6.6%). They again ret'd 3 str's LY but those

players comb for just 35 car sts. With Jones over 1,500 rush yd (7.9) their ypg rush moved to 156 (4.8) and they trimmed their sks all'd to 24 (4.6%). TY they lose RG Nikola Myers (14st) and 2 bkps (3st). They ret 4 who started 13+ incl 1st tm AA C Chris Powers and 2nd tm BSC LT Gabriel Jackson and have 81 ret career sts which makes them more experienced.

D-Line - In '09 the DL losses were heavy as gone were Buck Buchanan Award winner Greg Peach (EW #1 car sk) and two 2nd tm BSC players. They ret'd Renard Williams and Tyler Jolley (comb 54 tkl, 8 tfl, 11st at NT) and moved in WR Brown during the ssn but, as you would expect, their numbers regressed to 140 rush ypg (3.9) with 29 sks. LY they welcomed back 1st tm BSC DT Williams (7st, 35 tkl, 16 tfl), DE Evan Cook (10st, 30 tkl) and NT Jolley (11st, 44 tkl). They improved slightly to 3.5 ypc but the sk tkl only rose to 33 despite playing 3 more gms. TY they only lose DT Jolley (10 tfl) as DT Williams (15st, 16 tfl), DE Paul Ena (11st, #8 tkl, 10 tfl) and DE David Gaylord (8st, 26 tkl) all ret plus they added Wash tran Andru Pulu (PS#94).

LB's - In '09 the LB unit ret'd the #1 tkl'r, SLB Zach Johnson (11st, 10.5 tfl) along with 3 LB (17 comb st) who were the #6, #8 and #9 tkl'r's. However, Johnson missed the ssn (medical), then they lost MLB Kyle Wilkins after 6 st and his replacement, Tyler Washburn, was also slowed by inj. They moved in DE Paul Ena, who started the L/2 at MLB and finished as the #5 tkl'r. SLB JC Sherritt led the FCS with 170 tkl and the D all'd 27.4 ppg. LY they lost Wilkins and WLB Makai Borden (#3 tkl'r). Johnson was back along with AA Sherritt. Washburn but Ena moved back to DE. EW allowed 24.9 ppg and AA Sherritt won the Buck Buchanan Award leading the FCS once again with 176 tkl. TY the unit ret's 2nd tm BSC WLB Johnson (#2 tkl'r, 17.5 tfl) and MLB Washburn (#4 tkl'r) although Sherritt now departs.

DB's - The secondary ret'd the #2 and #5 tkl'r's in '09 but finished last in the BSC in pass D allowing 289 ypg (63%) with a 21-17 ratio. LY they lost FS Kevin Hatch (12st, #4 tkl'r), CB Lonnie Hosley (11st) and CB Brett Iginobina (7st). They ret'd SS Matt Johnson (#2 tkl'r, 6 int) along with CB's Jesse Hoffman (2st, 32 tkl) and Dante Calcote (3st, 32 tkl). They improved to 239 ypg (57%) with a 16-26

ratio. TY they lose 2nd tm BSC CB Calcote (#7 tkl'r, 13 pd) and CB Hoffman (#5 tkl'r, 15 pd) but ret 1st tm BSC S Matt Johnson (#3 tkl'r, 5 int) and S Jeff Minnerly (#10 tkl'r, 3 int).

SPECIAL TEAMS - LY EW lost its top PR but ret'd Taiwan Jones (20.4), K Mike Jarrett (5-10 FG) and P Cameron Zuber (39.9 avg). Zuber improved to 40.3 ypg (34.4 net). The PR unit avg'd a paltry 5.3 ypr but did have 2 td while the KR unit totaled 3 td, all by Jesse Hoffman who departs TY along with Zuber.

COACHES - HC Beau Baldwin enters his 4th ssn. Both OC Aaron Best and DC John Graham also return for their 4th yrs.

FORECAST - Last season EW had just 5 off str's back and added SMU transfer Mitchell. While they finished just 3rd in tdl off and 4th in scoring that includes 4 playoff games. The D ret'd just 5 str's but was in the 3rd year of the system and improved to #4 in scoring and tdl D. The Eagles installed Red Turf LY (The Inferno) for their own unique home field adv and it paid off as they went 9-0. The Eagles got their 1st ever Nat'l Title in dramatic fashion. They won 6 gms where they trailed or were tied in the 4Q incl vs Delaware in the finale. In the 1st 2.5Q's, EW had just 98 yds tdl off and trailed 19-0. With RB Jones out, they relied on QB Mitchell who threw for 302 yds with a 3-1 ratio on the day. He found WR Kaufman for the go-ahead TD with 2:47 to go. Delaware drove 44/9pl but on 4&10 only got a 9 yd pass and EW totaled its school record 13th win and 1st ever National Championship. TY they ret 14 str's and look poised to make a 3rd straight playoff run.
