QB's- In '09 Sr Matt Nichols was the Big Sky OPOY, throwing for 3,830 (65%, 33-6) and left as the Big Sky's all-time career leader with 12,616 pass yds and 13,308 ttl yds (#6 FCS). His backups Jeff Minnerly and Scott Burgett comb to hit just 6-10 for 25 vds in '09. EW added SMU transfer Bo Levi Mitchell, who started 19 gms at SMU (4590, 57%, 36-33). They also signed JC Greg Panelli, who threw for 5,000 yds and 56 td in 2 yrs at JC but he RS. Mitchell threw for 3,496 (59.4%) with a 37-15 ratio and was the FCS Championship game MVP. His bkps threw for a comb 119 yds (1-1) and now everyone returns.

RB's - EW had to replace its top 3 rushers in '09 with Tyler Hart (84, 8.4) being their top returnee. They moved in CB Taiwan Jones and he led the way with 1,213 yds (1st tm BSC) while adding 561 yds rec (14.0). Hart was #2 (194, 3.5) while Darriell Beaumonte was #3 (135, 3.3). All 3 ret'd LY but Hart moved to WR. Despite missing 3 gms Jones rushed for 1,742 (7.9, 14 td) earning BSC co-OPOY and AA honors. He had a career high 230 vs NDSU in the playoffs but fractured his foot and missed L/2. Jones left

(917, 14.6) and #2 Brynsen Brown (733, 14.7). Boyce was lost to they lost Wilkins and WLB Makai Borden (#3 tkl'r). Johnson was inj vs UM, but still finished #2 with 634 (16.3, 2nd Tm BSC). Brown back along with AA Sherritt, Washburn

had just 4 rec as he was moved to the DL. Tony Davis (2nd tm BSC) led with 948 (12.3) while 1st tm BSCTE Nathan Overbay was #3 with 588 (11.5) setting an EWTE rec'd for rec (51). They again ret'd 3 st'rs LY but those players comb for just 35 car sts. With Jones over 1,500 rush yd (7.9) their ypg rush moved to 156 (4.8) and they trimmed their sks all'd to 24 (4.6%). TY they lose RG Nikola Myers (14st) and 2 bkps (3st). They ret 4 who started 13+ incl 1st tm AA C Chris Powers and 2nd tm BSC LT Gabriel Jackson and have 81 ret 9/17 career sts which makes them more experienced.

D-Line - In '09 the DL losses were heavy as gone were Buck Buchanan Award winner Greg Peach (EW #1 car sk) and two 2nd tm BSC players. They ret'd Renard Williams and Tyler Jolley (comb 54 tkl, 8 tfl, 11st at NT) and moved in WR Brown during the ssn but, as you would expect, their numbers regressed to 140 rush ypg (3.9) with 29 sks. LY they welcomed back 1st tm BSC DT Williams (7st, 35 tkl, 16 tfl), DE Evan Cook (10st, 30 tkl) and NT Jolley (11st, 44 tkl). They improved slightly to 3.5 ypc th) at thi soliey (11st, 44 ki). They improved signify to 3.3 ypc but the sk ttl only rose to 33 despite playing 3 more gms.
