POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - In '09 ISU ret'd Ryan Roberts (L4 st) but he moved to WR in spg. WY transfer Chris Stutzriem (PS#103) started the 1st 2 but in 7 gms he threw for just 158 (49%, 1-3). Travis Johnson started the next 2 but pl'd in just 5 throwing for 152 (46%, 0-3). Roberts started 2 of the 1st 4 at WR (5 rec) then started the L6 at QB throwing for 561 (48%, 1-5) and was the #2 rusher (347, 3.9, 5 td). Stutzriem departed LY and Roberts moved to LB in the spg. They added Washington tran Ronnie Fouch (PS#55) and Hofstra transfer Coy Glass. Fouch started all 11 throwing for 2,252 (58.1%) with a 20-5 ratio, leading ISU to its 1st winning ssn S/'96. Fouch went over 200 yd passing in 7 str gms (inj'd on 1st series in finale) and his 20 td passes were an ISU rec'd. Glass hit 11-25 for 116 and both return this season.

RB's - ISU ret'd 5 of its top 6 rushers in '09 led by Darrius Gates (566, 5.0) and former Kentucky tran Antoine Brown (PS#81, 253, 3.5) along with starting FB Brock Lough. Brown led with 475 (3.0) but departed. Gates had 266 (3.6) while Lough had 55 tli yds and both ret'd LY. Gates became the 1st 1,000 yd rusher here S/'99 with 1,057 (5.6) and his 19 tli td set an ISU rec'd. He was #2 FCS in scoring and earned 1st tm MVFC but departs. They ret 5 of their top 6 led by Shakir Bell (649, 6.8) and 1st tm MVFC FB Lough (243, 4.9) but will be down a few notches TY.

Rec's - ISU lost its #1 and #6 rec's in '09. Their top returning WR was Jeramie Gray (#3, 105, 8.8). LY ISU ret'd 7 of its top 8 led by Bryant Kent (326, 16.3) and added JC's Justin Hilton, Ednut Egberongbe and John Goodlett. Hilton led with 684 (17.1), Kent was #2 (572, 13.3) while 2nd tm MVFC TE Alex Jones was #3 (545, 18.2). TY ISU ret's 7 of its top 9 plus adds Mich St tran Donald Spencer (PS#63) and should improve.

O-Line - In '09 ISU looked to ret 4 str's but RG Pat Burke RS'd (inj). Their numbers dropped to just 98 ypg (2.8) and they all'd 22 sks (9.4%). LY they ret'd all 55 sts and got Burke back. They lost LT Mike Smith (10st '09) after 2 sts but still almost

doubled their rushing to 193 ypg (5.1) with just 16 sks (5.0%). TY they lose 2nd tm MVFC RG Burke and LT Josh Jellison (5 st, 2.5 yr str). They look to ret 5 who comb for 85 career sts but Evan Borchers (6 st) was acad inelig in spg.

D-Line - The DL ret'd all 4 str's in '09 led by DT Rod Hardy (#6 tkl'r) who tied for the tm lead with 4 tli. ISU improved to 197 rush ypg (4.7) which was their best in the L6Y and the D almost doubled its total sacks to 15. LY they lost DE Dan Millington (#9 tkl'r, 3 sk) but ret'd 5 DL who comb for 33 sts and 9 sk led by DT Hardy (#7, 11 tli), DT Nate Brown (#8, 8 tli) and DE Ben Obaseki (#10, 11st as true). They added UTEP tran Josh Scott and moved in SLB Jacobly Washington (9 st, #4 tkl'r). Washington started the first 8 at DE then the L3 at LB. While they dipped to 203 ypg, their ypc improved to 4.4 and the D had 22 sks. TY they lose DT Brown (#10 tkl'r), but are switching to a 3-4 and 2nd tm MVFC Washington (#1 tkl'r, 10 tli) and Scott (L3 st DE, 9 tkl) were listed as LB's in the spg. They do ret 1st tm MVFC DE Obaseki (#2, 16 tli) who was #2 in the MVFC with 9 sk and could improve.

LB's - The unit lost both starting LB's in '09 (#1 and #2 tkl'r) but ret'd CJ Cook (#5) and went to a 4-3 D. The unit improved the ppg to 35.5 but that was still 6th worst in the FCS. LY they ret'd a comb 33 sts led by 2nd tm MVFC MLB Aaron Archie (#1 tkl'r, 10 tli), WLB Cook (#5, 6 pd) and SLB Jacobly Washington (#4, 7 tli) but he moved to DE for the 1st 8. They also moved in QB Ryan Roberts. They allowed 29.8 ppg, their fewest S/'03 (29.7) despite Archie being lost after 8 gms (inj). TY they ret MLB Archie (#5 tkl'r), MLB Cook (#12) and WLB Santino Davis (#6) who also worked at P (38.4 LY) while SLB Roberts (#7, 8.5 tli) moved to S in spg. They add another spot and move in Washington and DE Scott. I expect the ppg to continue to go down.

DB's - The secondary lost the #7 tkl'r in '09 but ret'd 4 str's led by WS Alex Sewall (#4, 4 pbu) and FS Donye McCleskey (#3), who had BOTH of the ISU's int (24-2 ratio in '08). The '09 unit all'd 191 ypg (64%) but with a respectable 14-10 ratio. LY they lost McCleskey (#2 tkl'r, 2 int) and 4 others (12 st, 76 tkl, 3 int). They added Hofstra tran Calvin Burnett who quickly turned heads. ISU all'd 185 ypg (54%) with a 15-13 ratio. TY they move in SLB Roberts and everyone ret's incl 1st tm MVFC SS Sewall (#2 tkl'r) and CB Burnett (#9, 6 int, 8 pbu), who led the MVFC in pd per gm (1.27) as a rfr.

SPECIAL TEAMS - LY ISU lost its #2 KR and P (36.1). LB Davis stepped in at P and avg 38.4 but was inj'd in gm 8. Cory Little won the K job but only hit 5-7 (0-1 40+). He battled '09's str Braulio Martinez (5-12, L/40) in spg. The PR unit avg'd 11.1 ypr (1 td) while the KR unit avg'd just 15.1. Everyone ret's TY.

COACHES - In his 3rd season, HC Trent Miles was named the MVFC COY. He took a team that was picked 9th in the MVFC and on a 2-60 slump to a 6-5 year as ISU tied for 3rd place with 4 MVFC wins (most conf wins S/'88). ISU's off had a rec'd setting year behind OC Steve Eleghart but he left for a HC job in mid-June. The new OC is OL ch Harold Etheridge, who is in his 2nd yr here. TY Shannon Jackson (4th yr) will split DC duties with Jesse Minter (3rd yr) whose dad, Rick (former Cincy HC), was the LB ch here LY before leaving for Kentucky in Dec.

FORECAST - In '09 the Sycamores offense set a program-low with just 99 pts for the entire ssn. LY, with 10 ret str's, they set a program-high with 351 pts on the ssn incl a rec'd 48 td. Fouch was the 1st QB to go over 200 yds pass and throw for 4 td's in a single gm here S/'06 and he led the Sycamores to their 1st winning ssn S/'96. With 8 ret str's, the D improved to 29.8 ppg and vs YSU forced 2 inc on the final drive to grab ISU's 1st MVFC road win S/'02 (broke an overall streak of 36 road losses). LY ISU won its 1st ssn opener S/'96 and that win equaled its wtl for the previous 3 ssns comb! They only trailed Cincy 12-7 at HT before losing by 33 then, vs Missouri St, rallied from a 14 pt 4Q deficit to win on a 32 yd FG in OT. ISU led N Dakota St 12-0 in the 1H but lost by 12 then, vs UNI (down 3), couldn't conv on 4th down and lost by 10. TY they ret 18 str's but face 2 FBS tms in their 1st 3 gms. They have the potential for a 2nd straight winning ssn but will need more than one conf road win to accomplish it.
