## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

**QB's** - In '09 Liberty ret'd Spencer Landis and Mike Brown who comb to hit 13-21-113, while Brown was the #4 rusher (142, 9.5). They added S Carolina transfer Tommy Beecher (PS#72) in the fall. Beecher led with 1,700 (68%, 9-5, 193 rush) and was 2nd tm BSC but departed. LY they ret'd BSC OPOY WR/QB Brown, who threw for 427 (71%, 4-0) with 442 rush (5.7, 9 td) while also being the #1 rec. They also ret'd Tyler Brennan, who hit 9-15-101. Brown started all 11 and was again the BSC OPOY throwing for 2,956 (63.5%, 23-11) and was the #1 rusher (854, 5.3, 9 td). Brennan threw for 222 (74.3%, 3-1, 47 rush) and both ret TY.

**RB's** - In '09 the Flames lost former Pitt transfer Rashad Jennings (1500, 5.7, 17 td), who was a 2x BSC OPOY (#7DC JAX). They ret'd FB Derek Bishop and top returning rusher BJ Hayes (194, 10.8). Aldreakis Allen led with just 530 (4.5, 156 rec). LY Liberty lost FB Bishop (22 tl yds) but ret'd their top 3 RB's in Allen, SirChauncey Holloway (285, 5.3) and Hayes (247, 6.2) and added former UMass transfer Korrey Davis but Allen left school. TY they get Allen back and ret every rush yd from LY incl top RB's Holloway (524, 4.9, 10 td), Davis (201, 3.5) and Chase Barnett (140, 5.8).

**WR's** - Liberty lost 4 of its top 5 rec's in '09 incl 3 All-BSC players. Their top returnee was Wildcat QB Mike Brown (331, 17.4) who started 4 at WR and they added S Carolina transfer WR Freddie Brown (PS#91). Despite playing QB, Mike Brown led with 698 (11.6) and was 1st tm BSC at WR. LY they lost Freddie Brown (204, 9.7) and 2nd tm BSC TE Will Quarles (116, 12.9). LU ret'd 4 of its top 5 incl Brown, 2nd tm BSC Chris Summers (603, 13.1), Ervin Garner (124, 20.7) and added in Troy transfer Greg Pratt (PS#199) but Brown moved to QB full-time. TY they only lose Kyle DeArmon (239, 17.1) as 12 of the top 13 ret led by AA Summers (1081, 14.2, 15 td), Pat Kelly (635, 16.3), 2nd tm BSC BJ Hayes (546, 9.8) along with TE Tommy Shaver (104, 13.0).

**O-Line** - The OL lost 3 st's in '09 incl a 1st tm BSC C who started every gm in 4 yrs. They ret'd two 12 gm st's and former Alabama transfer RG Alex Stadler (PS#23, 5st). The yppg rush dropped

to 176 (5.0) and they allowed 15 sk (4.8%). LY they lost 3 All-BSC st's in LT Josh Weaver (1st tm), LG Bryan Mosier (1st tm) and C Mario Cosby (2nd tm). They ret'd 3 who comb for 27 st in 2nd tm BSC RG Stadler, RT Justin Vargas and OT Soeren Wendland. While the yppg dipped to 171 (4.7) they allowed just 7 sk (1.8%). TY the OL loses four 11 gm st's incl 3 All-BSC ply's in LT Vargas (1st tm), RG Stadler (1st tm) and RT Wendland (2nd tm). The only OL with starting experience are LG Malcolm Boyd (11st) and OT Stan Herring, who started 1 as a blocking TE LY.

**D-Line** - The DL lost two 2nd tm BSC DL (#5 & #1 tk'l's) in '09 but moved in starting WLB Patrick Bannon (28 tk'l). They allowed 25 yppg more and the ypc went up from 3.7 to 4.1 while the D's sk total fell to 15. LY they lost 1st tm BSC DE Trey Jacobs (#10 tk'l) but ret'd 2 st's in 2nd tm BSC NG Asa Chapman (#8 tk'l) and DE Daryl Robertson (#11) along with DE Bannon (16 tk'l) and DE Terry Adams (#7 tk'l, 7 fl). They allowed just 116 rush ypp (3.5) while the D had 24 sk. TY they lose 1st tm BSC DE Adams (T-#7 tk'l, 11 fl), 2nd tm BSC DE Bannon (#6 tk'l) and Robertson (11 tk'l). They ret AA NG Chapman (#3 tk'l) and DE Cory Freeman (12 tk'l) and move in LB Greg Schuster (7st, 23 tk'l).

**LB's** - The LB unit lost 2 st's in '09 incl 1st Tm BSC Nick Hursky (#1 tk'l) and moved WLB Bannon to DE so they had just 1 st'r back in ILB Chad Brown (#6 tk'l). LY they lost 2nd tm BSC WLB Wes Cheek (#1 tk'l) and SLB Ian Childress (#5 tk'l). They ret'd 2 st's in 2nd tm BSC MLB Doncel Bolt (#2 tk'l) and Brown (#4 tk'l). TY they lose 1st tm BSC Kyle O'Donnell (#1 tk'l, 12 fl) and 2nd tm BSC MLB Bolt (#2) and move DLB Schuster to DE. They ret DLB Connolly (19 tk'l), who started the 1st 6 until inj and move in WS Brent Vinson (10st, 25 tk'l, 6 pd).

**DB's** - The secondary lost 3 All-BSC DB's but finished #4 in pass eff D with an outstanding 10-17 ratio in '09. LY they lost 2nd tm BSC S Chris Rocco (#3 tk'l) and CB Tim Torrence (#6 tk'l). They ret'd 2 st's in S Larry Claiborne (#9 tk'l) and CB Donald Manns (18 tk'l) along with 1st tm BSC S KaJuan Lee (#11 tk'l, 5 int). Liberty remained #4 in pass eff D but with a 15-11 ratio. TY they lose CB Manns (#9 tk'l) and move WS Vinson to LB. They ret st's FS Claiborne (#5 tk'l) and CB Lee (17 tk'l) along with WS Chris Mayo (T-#7 tk'l) and former Pitt transfer Ron Hobby (PS#109, 11 tk'l).

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - The ST unit ret'd both P's (38.0) and both K's (17-22 FG) in '09 but lost 1st tm BSC LB Dan Pope and

Dominic Bolden (1st tm PR, 2nd tm KR). LY they ret'd AA K Matt Bevens (22-26 L/50), 2nd tm BSC P Mike Larsson (36.7) and their top PR but lost 2nd tm BSC KR Aaron Hewlett (30.6, 1 td). TY they lose their top KR but ret their top PR, 1st tm BSC P Larsson (41.7) and AA K Bevens (20-27, L/52) who is just 1 of 2 FCS K's with 20+ FG LY.

**COACHES** - HC Danny Rocco was the BSC COY in his first 3 sns and has had a winning season all 5 yrs. DC Tom Clark enters his 6th yr, while former pass gm coord Brandon Streeter enters his 3rd as OC and 6th overall.

**FORECAST** - The Flames ret'd 5 off st's LY with their top 4 rushers, 5 of their top 6 rec and the BSC OPOY all back. They remained #1 in both scoring (#3 FCS) and tfl off (#2 FCS). TY they ret 7 st's incl 2x BSC OPOY Brown. LU also ret's its top 10 rushers and 12 of its top rec but just 12 car sts on the OL. The D ret'd 6 st's LY and 9 of its top 14 tk'l's. They remained #1 in scoring but slipped from #2 in tfl D. TY they ret 6 st's and 13 of their top 20 tk'l's but lose 7 of their top 11. The Flames have won 4 str conf crowns but have shared the L/2 and again just missed the playoffs. LY they started 2-2 but won 5 straight. With a showdown vs SBU on deck, they were upset by CCU which cost them a trip to playoffs. They defeated SBU and finished ranked (#19) for a 3rd str ssn. How quickly the OL comes together will determine how far they go TY. They will again be in the BSC race but must face SBU on the road and the HT has won all 3 meetings.
