## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

**QB's** - In 2008 the Dolphins went to frosh Josh McGregor and he threw for 2,444 (56%) with a 24-11 ratio while being named the PFL FPOY. McGregor was named 2nd tm PFL in '09 after throwing for 2,693 (57%, 31-7). Last year he followed it up with another 2nd tm PFL performance throwing for 3,049 (62.9, 32-7). This year McGregor returns for his final season and is primed for another big year. His backup will be Rafael Echemendia who has no game experience.

**RB's** - Rudell Small repeated as 1st tm PFL in '09 when he rushed for 1,074 (5.5, 9 td). He ret'd for his final ssn LY and again was 1st tm PFL after rushing for 1,145 (6.1, 12 td). Small departs as the school's career record holder and leaves a huge hole to fill. They do return #2 rusher JJ Laster (810, 8.5) who also earned 1st tm PFL honors LY but the other backs have 0 career carries. While Laster is among the best in the PFL, losing a 3x 1st tm performer has this unit down a couple notches.

**Rec's** - In '09 JU ret'd #2 rec Josh Philpart (444, 12.3) who would lead with 912 (16.9, 13 td) while being named 1st tm PFL LY the top 4 rec's were back and Philpart led again with 800 (16.7, 12 td) and was 1st tm PFL again. This year Philpart returns again as one of the top players in the FCS. They will have to replace #2 rec Elliott Finkley (531, 19.0) who was one of the fastest players in school history but do return #3 Larry Thompson (477, 14.9) and '09 starter Tommie Harris (inj'd LY). At TE they must replace 2nd tm PFL Chris Kuck (163, 13.6) and will look to Andrew Davis (47, 9.4) to take over. With an AA cand leading the way, this is among the PFL's best units.

**O-Line** - JU ret'd just 2 starters in '09 and the numbers slipped from 152 rush ypg (4.1) to 127 (3.9). LY all 5 starters ret'd and as expected the numbers improved dramatically to 193 ypg and an incredible 5.5 ypc. They return 3 starters TY from a group who dominated the PFL with all 5 earning All-PFL honors. They must replace 2 1st tm PFL performers in LT Leonard Payton (4Y str) and LG Dustin Robinson (2Y str). The line will be led by a trio of 2nd tm PFL players anchored by RG Ian Osking (3Y str), C Kevin Halverson (2Y str) and RT Chad Cypher (2Y str). Stepping in to fill out the starting lineup will be LG Mike Arndt and LT Wisly Desire. This unit is less experienced and it will be tough to match last year's incredible numbers.

**D-Line** - All 4 starters were back in '09 and they improved from allg 159 rush ypg (4.3) to just 119 (3.2) and the sks increased to 34. LY they lost 2 str's but improved again to 106

(3.1) and had 32 sk. They return 3 str's TY but have to replace 2nd tm PFL DE Bradley Burns (27 tkl, 8 sk). They return two HM PFL performers in NG Mike Mayoral (#9 tkl'r, 6 tfl) and DT Rolando Fines (#5 tkl'r, 5 sk). DE Montague Mack may move to LB leaving the DE spots to Chance Smith (10 tkl) and possibly Daniel Delguidice (11 tkl, 2 tfl). This unit has improved in each of the L/3 yrs but it will be tough to match LY's numbers.

**LB's** - JU ret'd all 3 starters for a 2nd straight year in '09 but the ppg all'd slipped from 19.4 to 21.2. They ret'd 2 starters LY and the ppg improved to 20.5. TY the group must replace 1st tm PFL OLB Joseph Fennell (#2 tkl'r, 4.5 tfl) and 2nd tm PFL OLB Will Perry (#4 tkl'r, 6.5 tfl). Their only returning starter is MLB Layne McCombs (#6 tkl'r, 2.5 sk, 5.5 tfl) who suffered a knee injury LY and missed half the year. OLB Mike Klein (#7 tkl'r, 2.5 sk) has some exp (4st) and will step into the lineup. They will also see Taylor Marsh (-#10 tkl'r) promoted to a starter at OLB. With the loss of their top 2, the ppg allowed could slip.

**DB's** - The Dolphins ret'd just 2 str's in '09 and they all'd 221 ypg pass (54.6%). LY all 4 str's departed and the ypg fell to 222 while comp % improved to 50.9%. TY they return 3 str's led by SS Leonard Smith (#1 tkl'r, 2 int, 5 pbu) and CB's Colby Walden (23 tkl, 2 int, 12 pbu) and Darren Johnson (#8 tkl'r, 5 pbu). 1st tm PFL FS Jordan Dewhirst (#3 tkl'r, 4 int, 4 pbu) was susp indef in the spg and is ? for '11. Looking to fill in are Lacy McDougald (13 tkl), Ed Foley (22 tkl) and Alexander Bradley. This unit is much more exp'd than LY and should post their best numbers S'08.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - JU ret'd both RM LY and P Logan Chipperfield but had to find a new PK. Chipperfield avg'd 37.4 while K Josh Hostetler took over kicking duties and hit 7-12

(L/42). PR Elliott Finkley (9.1) and KR Colby Walden (25.1, 1 td) handled most of the return duties. This year both Chipperfield and Hostetler depart as well as Finkley.

**COACHES** - HC Kerwin Bell was a QB at Florida and later played QB in the NFL and CFL. He returns for his 5th year and is also the OC. DC Jerry Odom returns for his 2nd year.

**FORECAST** - Kerwin Bell has done a great job here after taking over a program that had 5 straight non-winning seasons. Last year they had their best year ever going 10-1 with their only loss coming at the hands of FCS power Appalachian St. After the loss to App St in week 2 they beat their next two opponents by a combined 83-15 then led San Diego 35-7 before allowing 3 late td's. They also led Drake 39-21 before allowing 2 late td's. They set several school records in the 86-7 win over Valparaiso (66-7 at the half) and after two more blowout wins closed the season with a 4Q comeback win at Butler then scored a td with 1:43 left to beat Campbell and clinch the conference title. They were clearly the best team in the Pioneer League as they outgained opponents by 220.1 ypg and they had the best offense in the FCS avg 42.2 ppg and 486 ypg. They did benefit from 3 net close wins and have to replace their all-time leading rusher but have two of the best players in the FCS in QB Josh McGregor and WR Josh Philpart. They open the season with 4 of their first 5 on the road but do get Dayton at home and should be one of the favorites in the Pioneer League again.
