3 - In 2009 GSU returned Greg Dillon who split snaps in '08 but had a solid 15-7 ratio. He led GSU to the #1 scoring offense (33.5), #4 total offense (354) and was #5 in pass efficiency in '09. Dillon threw for 1,747 (57%, 13-11) and was the #3 rusher. LY he was replaced by Anthony Carrothers who came in and showed ability with his arm and legs. Carrothers threw for 1,443 (54.7%, 7-8) and was the #3 rusher (247, 2.7). TY he will be backed up by the coach's son DJ Williams with Justin Higgins (PS#122) and Antoine Temple providing depth.

This was their biggest strength over the last 3 yrs so there will be some rebuilding heading into '11 with the loss of their top 2 rushers from LY after returning both in '10. SWAC OPOY and 1st tm SWAC Frank Warren (1537, 6.6) departs as does his 18 tds. His backup Cornelius Walker rushed for 421 (4.5) and departs leaving Rodale Pippen (#3 RB, 75, 8.3) as the top returnee. Pippen will battle Kenneth Batiste (5, 5.0) and Dawrence Roberts who was #1 coming out of Hein (3.5 til) takes over at NT spring.FB Oshae Hamilton returns after 11 st LY while Edward and providing depth will be DE Martinez had the top spot in spring.

BGG - In 2009 GSU returned 4 of their top 5 and last year ret'd mostly intact led by #1 rec Kiare Thompson (761, 22.4) and Mario Louis (284, 17.8). The ground game was the feature of the offense so the unit didn't have much pressure on them. With so many new faces in the backfield this group will have to step up but must do so without LY's top guy. The leader will be Louis while competition for the open 2 spots incl Bakari Maxwell (196, 21.8), Van Phillips (18, 6.0), Kameron Thurmond, Dezmond Spivey and Cory Robinson. They must replace TE Larry Donnell (37, 7.4) and will look to Johnny Hedgeman to fill the void.

D=UTDG - This unit improved from 4.4 to 5.1 ypc and imreturn but they must replace LG Charvo Lampton (10st). GSU returns 8 players with starting experience led by 1st tm SWAC duo RT Sanford Banks and LT Bennie Peoples. The unit will (7st).
