POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

OB's - In '09 UR ret'd Eric Ward who, in his 4th yr as the st'r, threw for 2,396 (62%, 16-10) and left as UR's career pass leader. LY they ret'd John Laub (9-18-122) and added USC tran Aaron Car (PS#9). Corp started the 1st 5 but was inj (OFY) on the 1st series vs NH. Laub was out with a wrist inj so P Nick Hicks (HS QB) came in but threw 5 int. He suffered a concussion vs NH so they took the RS off true Montel White. White started 3 (14-29-174, 2-1) and went 2-1 but was lost to an eye inj vs JMU. Laub was finally healthy and started the L/3 throwing for 506 (45.1%) but with a 2-9 ratio. On the year Hicks went 17-44-181 with an 0-6 ratio. Despite missing the L/6, Corp still led with 645 (54.5%, 3-4). All 4 ret and they should have better health.

1984-90 - In '09 UR had to replace 1st tm CAA Josh Vaughan (1884, 5.3, 20 td) and 2x 2nd tm CAA FB John Crone. Their top returning RB's were Garrett Wilkins (311, 4.9) and Justin Forte (120, 5.0). Forte led with 1,057 (4.6) but with just 6 td. LY they ret'd 5 of their top 7 but their top returnees were Wilkins (282, 4.6) and FB Kendall Gaskins (93 yd, 6 td). Tyler Kirchhoff led with 547 (4.5, 6 td) but departs. They do ret 3 of top 4 led by 1st tm CAA FB Gaskins (402, 4.1, 5 td, 133 rec), Jovan Smith (266, 4.6) and Wilkins (181, 4.5).

Reed's - UR ret'd its top 3 rec in '09 in 1st tm CAA Kevin Grayson (853, 14.0), TE Gray (723, 12.3) and Jordan Mitchell (440, 18.3). LY they again ret'd their top 3 in Gray (713, 14.0), 2nd tm CAA Grayson (545, 11.4) and Donte Boston (494, 15.0). With the new off and QB inj's their numbers dropped as Gray led with just 478 (12.6) but was still 1st tm CAA. They lose Grayson (190, 10.0) and Boston is ? after being susp in the spg. They ret Gray, TE Kevin Finney (157, 9.2) and Ben Edwards (135, 13.5) plus add Miami, FI tran TE Andrew Tallman (PS#43).

C-Line - In '09 the OL ret'd four 16 gm st's incl 2 AA's but the ypg dropped to 159 (4.0). They did cut their sks all'd from 26 to 18 (5.1%). LY they lost 4 st's incl two 1st tm CAA. They ret'd C Drew Lachenmayer and added Rutgers tran Richard Muldrow (PS#83). For the 3rd year in a row, the rush ypg fell and they finished #8 in the CAA in rush with 156 sk (5.2%). TY they only lose 2nd tm CAA C Lachenmayer. They return 6 who comb for 44 st and they should make solid improvement in the run gm.

B-Line - The DL held 12 of their 16 opp under 100 yds (incl Montana, 39) and all'd just 94 ypg (3.0) rush in '08. In '09 they had to replace 2x 1st tm CAA DE Lawrence Sidbury (#4DC, 11.5 sk) and DE Sherman Logan (6 sk) so a step back was expected. Surprisingly though, they were #5 in the FCS allowing 79 ypg rush (2.7) but their sk tk did fall from 36 to 21. LY they lost 3 str's incl NG Parker Miles (#6 tkrlr, 4 tfl) but ret'd AA NT Martin Parker (#4 tkrlr, 15.5 tfl). They still had their worst rush D S/O's allowing 168 ypg (4.1) while the D had 19 sk. TY they lose 3 DL (18 comb st) incl consensus AA DT Parker (2.2 tkrlr, 13.5 tfl) and DE Tyler Sullivan. They ret 5 who comb for 26 st but could struggle without their star.

LF's - After all'g 15.6 ppg (#6 FCS) in '08, UR ret'd all 3 str's in '09 incl its #1, #2 and 7th tk'lrs. The ppg did dip some to 16.3 but that was still 9th FCS. MLB Collin McConaghy was the #1 tk'l'r (5.5 ftl) earning 1st tm CAA and departed. LY they ret'd 1st tm CAA Eric McBride (#3 tk'l'r) and Weldon (#2 tk'l'r) but all'd 20.5 ppg (worst S/07). TY UR loses Weldon (#3 tk'l'r) and their #2 all-time tk'l'r, CAA co-DPOY McBride (CAA best 54 str st). They ret their #4 tk'l'r, but look down a notch or two with the loss of AA McBride.

BB's - In '09 UR ret'd all 4 str's int AA CB Justin Rogers (7 int). Opp could not run vs UR so they did allow 37 ypg more pass and had 13 less int (15-16 ratio). LY the losses were heavy losing 3 str's. They did ret 1st tm CAA CB Rogers (3 int, 8 pbu) and surprisingly improved to 197 ypg (61%) with a 12-14 ratio (although run D not as good as in yrs past). TY they lose SS Max Prokell (#5 tkf'r, 6 pbu) and 1st tm CAA Rogers (7 pd) who was a #7DC (BUF). They ret CB Tremayne Graham (#6 tkf'r, 8 pd) along with S's Darryl Hamilton and Colin Pehanick (5 pd). They also add Georgia Tech tran Cooper Taylor (PS#102).



SPECIAL TEAMS - All of the top ST players ret'd in '09 incl 2nd tm CAA PR Derek Hatcher (10.8), 2nd tm CAAK Andrew Howard (17-27, L/53) and P Brian Radford (37.2). Hatcher earned 2nd tm CAA but Howard's #3's dropped (13-22/L/44) and Radford lost his spot (15 punts, 36.5). LY Howard, Radford and P Brett Weigant (38.2) all departed. Will Kamin took over at PK and hit 11-12 (L/45) earning 1st tm CAA. P Nick Hicks avg 39.0 while Justin Rogers handled PR and KR. TY they lose 1st tm CAA PR Rogers but ret Kamin and Hicks.

COACHES - HC Latrell Scott was the youngest HC (34) in DI LY. He arrived after spending '09 as Virginia's WR cch and '08 at Tenn. He was an asst HC here in '07 (on staff 3Y). They ret 2nd yr DC Bob Trott, who was the 3rd DC here in 3 yrs LY and was Virg's LB cch in '09 and was a DC at ULM, Baylor, Duke, Clemson, Ark and also cch'd in the NFL. OC Wayne Lineburg returns for his 2nd ssn, after spending '07-'09 as an asst cch at Uva. He was the OC here from '04-'06.

Forecast - The Spiders ret'd 7 off str's in '09 and they were #3 in scoring and #6 in tfl off. LY they ret'd just 3 str's losing a 4 yr str at QB and were in a new off. They added a VHT FBS QB but he was lost after 5 st as all 4 QB's missed time with inj. They were #7-9 in scoring and last in tfl off. TY they ret 8 off str's, are in the 2nd yr of the system and add an FBS tran. In '09 UR ret'd 9 def str's and were #3 in both scoring and total D. LY they ret'd just 4 str's, lost 10 of their top 16 kl'r's and were under their 3rd DC in 3 yrs. They fell to #6 in scoring and #9 in tfl D. TY they add an HT FBS tran but ret just 5 str's and lose 5 of their top 7 kl'r's. UR won its 1st ever FCS Championship in '08 and made its 3rd straight playoffs in '09. LY they sold-out the 4,000 ssn tickets for their new on-campus stadium but lost their HC and had just 7 str's back. Despite an inj plagued sn at QB they had their 6th str winning ssn and went 5-1 at home. TY they ret 13 str's, should be healthier at QB, are in the 2nd yr of their systems and are an upset away from returning to the playoffs.
