## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

**QB's** - Into '08 it was a 2-man battle for the starting spot but in game 2, after not starting the opener, Greg Denham took over and started the next 2 yrs throwing for a comb 6,410 (64%, 46-24). He was All-GWC both yrs and was set to ret LY but in the spg decided to forgo his senior ssn. RFR Randy Wright stepped in and earned 2nd tm GWC and ROY throwing for 2,432 (58.9%, 17-8). UC Davis now has an exp'd All-Conf player returning and is far ahead of last year.

## FB Nick Aprile



**RB's** - Joe Trombetta departed having led the team in rushing from '07-'09. Josh Reese (375, 5.5) was #2 in '09 and finished #2 again LY (317, 3.9) adding 165 (5.6) rec. FB Nick Aprile only had 123 (4.2) in '09 but led LY with 389 (3.9) and also was used in the Wildcat package. Both return making this unit more experienced than LY's version.

**Rec's** - The Aggies have a solid lineage of WR's and in '09 Chris Carter (889, 10.5) departed after earning GWC OPOY while Bakari Grant (584, 13.0) moved on to the SF 49ers. LY the leading returnees were Sean Creadick (#3, 466, 11.9) who led with 928 (14.1) and earned 1st tm GWC, and TE Dean Rogers (326, 11.2) who was #2 with 404 (13.5) and earned 3rd tm AA. For a second straight season they lose their top 2. Anthony Soto (344, 11.9) will be the go-to guy while Tom Hemmingsen (140, 10.8) will also start. WR Stephen Dunstan (9st, 127, 15.9) also returns. Filling the TE spot will be Mike Cody (5 rec). It'll be tough to replace their top 2 again but they just keep churning out quality players.

**O-Line** - In '09 UCD lost a pair of All-GWC ply'rs and the numbers fell to 90 ypg (3.1) while all'g 22 sks (4.9%). LY they lost 1 str in 1st tm GWC C Tommy Hernandez who signed with MIN. The 4 returnees struggled and actually had a recent low of 80 ypg (2.7). TY they lose 1 str (B2B 1st tm GWC) and anchoring the unit is 1st tm GWC C Ray Wilburn. The left side is set with LG Sean Davies (21st L/2Y) and LT Robert Ayotte (26st L/3Y). While RG Al Doiron (8st) ret's, Tim Ketaly (L/3st) will battle him for the #1 spot. It wouldn't surprise me if RFR Jay Luchetti secures the #1 RT spot. I exp a dramatic increase in the numbers TY.

**D-Line** - In '09 UC Davis lost 1 starter but ret'd 4 with starting exp but the numbers slipped to 126 rush ypg (3.8). LY the Aggies again lost one starter but a second starter was banged up and only had 7 tkls making it like 2 lost. As with the OL, this unit had its worst recent performance allowing 168 ypg (4.3). TY they lose 1 starter in 1st tm GWC DE Eric Sobotka (34 tkl, 5 sk). Both DT's are back in Andrew Benjamin (2nd tm GWC, 32 tkl, 3.5 tfl) and Brock Galvin (39 tkl). Tommy Grillo (20 tkl, 2.5 tfl) returns as one DE while Bobby Erskine (2st, 35 tkl, 2.5 tfl) slides up. They have solid depth incl Jacob Mixon who was banged up LY after making 11 st at DT in '09. This unit should certainly be able to reach '09's level.

**LB's** - This unit lost 1 starter in '08 and again in '09 and lost 2 of the 3 starters LY. While the team allowed 37 ypg more, they actually trimmed the scoring to 26.8 ppg. This year they lose a 5 gm starter (#5 tkl'r) and Dozie Amajoyi (#1 tkl'r, 8 tfl) who was the GWC DPOY (media). Back at MLB will be Jordan Glass (9st, #3 tkl'r, 4.5 tfl), the WLB will be Byron Gruendl (7st, #4 tkl'r, 2.5 sk, 4.5 tfl) and the SLB is Neil Pierce (2st, 5 tkl). While they lose their star, this unit is equal or ahead of LY's starting experience.

**DB's** - The secondary replaced 2 starters '08 and again in '09 (209 ypg, 59%). They again lost a pair of starters LY (1st & 2nd tm GWC) and the numbers were level allowing 204 ypg and 59.1%. TY they lose just 1 starter in 2nd tm GWC SS Danny Hart (#2 tkl'r, 4 tfl). They ret 2nd tm GWC CB Jonathan Perkins (39 tkl, 2 int, 7 pbu) along with Jonathan Calhoun (4st, 13 tkl) and Dre Allen (5st, 39 tkl) who will split starts. The starting FS for a 3rd season is Kevyn Lewis (39 tkl, 5 tfl) while soph Earnest Sayles (5 tkl) was the #1 SS out of spring. This is the first time in 4 seasons the Aggies have more than 2 starters back and could have their best numbers in the L/7Y.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - Intact is the best way to describe the ST's. K Sean Kelley (13-17, L/43) was 1st tm GWC while P Colton Schmidt (38.8, 34.5 net) was 2nd tm. The top 3 KR's

are back and they combined for a 19.6 avg while PR Tom Hemmingsen (1.9) should certainly have better numbers.

**COACHES** - HC Bob Biggs is entering his 19th season here and is joined by longtime OC Mike Moroski who is in his 23rd season. Mark Johnson is in his 3rd season as DC (4th stint here). He was most recently the DC at Utah St.

**FORECAST** - The Aggies had a streak of 37 straight winning yrs snapped when they went 5-6 in '07. The had a 2nd straight 5 win season in '08 and S/'03 they have had 6 wins the other 6 yrs. They were shell shocked against Cal in the opener getting outFD'd 26-4 and outgained 517-81. That shellacking seemed to carry over in a loss to Portland St. They righted the ship with a win at San Diego but after a loss a Weber St they were 1-3 with another FBS foe on deck. They trailed San Jose St 13-0 at HT but came back and pulled out the upset giving them a 2nd FBS win in 6 yrs (beat Stanford 20-17 in '05). They won the next week vs SD but then dropped B2B home gms vs South Alabama and Southern Utah to fall to 3-5. They easily handled ND, 35-16. In the Battle for the Golden Horseshoe they trailed Cal Poly 21-0 and needed a 69/11pl drive and a 5 yd td pass with :35 left. With a winning season hanging in the balance vs Sac St they again trailed in the 4Q but got a 21 yd FG with 6:34 left for B2B 1 pt wins (3rd of the ssn) in a game that featured torrential downpours and a 47 min lightning delay. The 16 ret starters ties for the most in recent history and they should reach 7+ wins for the first time S/'02.
