## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

**QB's** - In '09 Jeremy Moses led the FCS in passing with 4,124 (68%, 40-21) and was the SLC Co-POY. He returned for his final season LY and passed for 3,998 (61.1%, 34-7). He was again named the SLC POY and won the Walter Payton Award (FCS Heisman) setting a new NCAA record for career comp with 1,184! Dalton Williams returns for his 3rd season after RS LY. In '09 as the backup he threw for 344 (74%, 4-1). Also returning is LY's backup Brady Attaway, who threw for 313 (56.4%, 1-2). Williams was #1 coming out of the spring but no matter who starts it will be tough to replace an all-time NCAA record holder.

**RB's** - Vincent Pervis (#2 rusher) and Tyrone Ross (#3) returned in '09. Pervis led with 919 (6.0) and was 2nd tm SLC while Ross had 388 (4.9). LY both Pervis and Ross both departed. Their top returnee was #3 Romonte Hampton (324, 4.6) and he led with 399 (3.8, 6 td) while earning HM SLC honors. Jeremy Barnes switched from DB to RB after spg and was #2 with 337 (3.2, 3 td) while Keith Lawson was #3 with 311 (5.5, 4 td). This year Hampton departs but Barnes and Lawson both return and they bring in true frosh Gus Johnson (PS#147).

**Bo's** - Three of their top 5 rec ret'd in '09 including Duane Brooks, who was the SLC NCOY with 863 yds in 10 gms in '08. They lost 3 of their top 4 rec LY incl 1st tm SLC Brooks (1076, 9.1, 6 td), 2nd tm SLC HB Contrevious Parks (464, 10.3, 5 td) and Aaron Rhea (809, 13.7), who led with 11 rec td's. The top returnees were #3 Gralyn Crawford (785, 15.4, 7 td) and #5 Cordell Roberson (398, 19.0, 4 td). Roberson led with 1,011 yds (16.6, 16 td) and was named a 2nd tm AA. Crawford was #2 with 981 (13.3, 5 td) and was 1st tm AA while Kris Lott (616, 14.3, 5 td) and Anthony Foster (528, 10.2, 4 td) were #3 and #4. This year everyone returns and while more experienced they will have an inexperienced QB throwing to them.

**O-Line** - In '09 SFA ret'd 4 OL str's led by LSU transfer C Maxwell Holmes (PS#85) and improved their ypc from 3.4 to 4.3 ypc while allowing just 14 sk (3.8%). LY they had to replace a 1st tm SLC LT and 2nd tm SLC C Holmes. They ret'd 3 str's including RT George Bias and RG John Steel. Steel st'd the first 3 at RG before moving to C while earning 2nd tm SLC honors. LT Bias (12st) was named 1st tm SLC and RT Corey Dickerson (11st) was 2nd tm SLC. Their ypc plummeted to 3.2 but the sk went down to just 13 (7 year low). This year everyone returns except Fitseula Partsch (9st) and the unit returns 93 career starts making it one of the FCS's more exp'd OL.

**D-Line** - In '09 the DL ret'd 3 str's led by 1st tm SLC Tim Knicky (#6 tklr), who led with 12 sk (20.5 tfl). The Lumberjacks improved, allowing just 3.3 ypc (from 4.0) and the D led the SLC in sk with 42 (32 in '09). LY they lost both starting DE's including SLC Co-DPOY Knicky (12.5 sk). They ret'd 2 str's in DT Kenneth Charles (#8 tklr, 9 sk), who moved to DE and DT Sean Warren (#11 tklr). They again led the SLC in sacks with 37 and their ypc improved to 3.2. Charles (#6 tklr, 11.5 sk, 7.5 tfl) earned AA honors while Warren (#9 tklr, 7.5 sk) was 1st tm SLC. TY the top 3 depart but 5 players return with starting exp including DT Corey Hill (2.5 sk), DE Darren Robinson (#13 tklr, 6.5 tfl) and DT Gordon Booker (#12 tklr, 4.5 tfl).

**LB's** - Two years ago SFA only had to replace one starter and ret'd AA Jabar Williams (#1 tklr, 6 tfl) and LB Derrick Choice (#2, 10.5 tfl) and moved in '07 starting FS Devin Ducote (#2 tklr in '07) who RS in '08. Their ppg improved dramatically from 39.6 to 22.8. LY they ret'd all 3 str's in AA Williams (#2 tklr, 9.5 tfl), Choice (#4, 6.5 tfl) and Ducote (#1, 12.5 tfl) who led the SLC with 137 tkl. The ppg dropped to a 7 year low of 19.5 ppg and Ducote led again with 114 tkl (10 tfl). Williams was #2 with 108 tkl and was named the SLC DPOY while Choice was #3. TY Ducote and Choice both return and they bring in TCU transfer Justin Isadore (PS#140) but lose Williams, who was a #7DC (STL).

**DB's** - In '09 the secondary ret'd 5 who comb for 43 st in '08 incl their #3 and #4 tklr's. They improved from #5 SLC to #4 in pass D allowing a 19-11 ratio. LY they had to replace a 1st tm SLC S but they ret'd 3 str's incl CB Andre Banks (#6 tklr, 2 int, 6 pbu) and CB Josh Aubrey (#7 tklr, 2 int, 6 pbu). They moved to #2 in pass D with an 18-10 ratio. This year 2nd tm SLC Banks (#10 tklr) departs but 1st tm SLC CB Aubrey (#4 tklr, 12 pd), Texas transfer Ben Wells (PS#25), SS Caleb Nelson (#5 tklr) and FS David Cato (#8 tklr) all return.

## SOUTHLAND

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - In '09 the ST unit ret'd P Drew Nelson (40.6) along with their top KR and PR but lost their K. LY they lost a 2nd tm SLC K (20-28 FG) and their top KR and PR. They ret'd 2nd tm SLC P Nelson (41.5) and added in UTEP transfer K Logan Barrett (PS#74). Barrett only hit 3-7 FG's and was replaced by Thomas Henshaw who hit 7-9. This year Henshaw returns along with Nelson (41.6) and their top RM in Gralyn Crawford who avg'd 28.1 on KR's (3 td) and 8.0 on PR's (1 td).

**COACHES** - HC JC Harper returns for his 5th season as HC. DC David Gibbs returns for his 4th season while the new OC is Mike Nesbitt, who was the WR cch at W Texas A&M last year.

**FORECAST** - The Lumberjacks have had one of the most prolific offenses in the FCS the last 3 years. Led by QB Jeremy Moses, they led the FCS again in pass off LY. The 2010 season started with an expected loss to Texas A&M. After crushing Albany, they got a huge road win at perennial power Northern Iowa and rolled off four more wins. The Lumberjacks were shocked at home by Texas St before beating their next 3 opp's by a comb 135-40. In the playoffs they led defending champ Villanova 21-7 before imploding with 6 TO's. This year they return 10 starters on offense but lose their leader in QB Moses. On defense they return 6 str's but lose many of their key players including an NFL DC from a unit which posted its best numbers in recent memory. While SFA is still very talented, whether or not they make it a 3rd straight playoff berth will hinge on the how the new QB settles in.
