POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QB's - In '09 ASU ret'd Walter Payton Award winner Armani Edwards (2902, 64%, 30-9, 941 rush) and DeAndre Presley (379, 67%, 1-2) and added Toledo transfer Travis Cadet (PS#39). Edwards was an AA for a 4th time and became the 1st ever 2-time winner of the Payton Award. He threw for an ASU rec'd 3,291 (68%, 12-7, 679 rush, 18 td). LY ASU lost Edwards (#3DC CAR) who was #2 FCS in career tll off (Steve McNair) and Cadet (20-36-241, 366 rush) who moved to RB. They ret'd Presley (7-15-89) to compete with rFr Jamal Jackson. Presley started all 13, throwing for 2,631 (61.2%, 21-7) and was the #1 rusher with 1,039 (6.4, 13 td), earning AA honors. Jackson was 7-14-144 with 100 rush yds and both return this year.

RB's - In '09 ASU looked to ret 7 of its top 8 rushers incl RB Devon Moore (123, 5.6) who had played in just 3 (inj) but top RB Robert Welton (544, 5.7) did not ret after surg. The top 4 RB's comb for 1,802 (5.1) led by 1st tm SoCon Moore (1374, 5.4, 19 td) and Cedric Baker (233, 5.2). All 4 ret'd LY but QB Presley was the #1 rusher. This year they lose Moore (403, 3.6, 10 td, 136 rec) and Devin Radford (161, 4.7). They return 2nd tm SoCon RB Cadet (671, 5.8, 6 td), who was the #5 rec (218, 11.5), along with Baker (261, 4.3, 5 td).

Rec's - ASU ret'd 4 of its top 5 rec in '09 led by CoCo Hillary (735, 13.1) and 1st tm SoCon TE Ben Jordan (506, 17.4). Hillary was leading until he was inj'd late in the ssn but was still 2nd tm SoCon (514, 13.9). Brian Quick led in yds with 982 (16.1) but Matt Cline (981, 11.5) led in rec (85). LY they ret'd their top 6 incl 1st tm SoCon TE Jordan (226, 14.1). After losing a 4 yr str

at QB they avg'd 46 fewer ypg passing. Quick led with 844 (18.0, 9 td) earning AA honors while 1st tm SoCon TE Jordan had 306 (11.3, 6 td) and both ret. TY ASU loses 5 of its top 8 incl Cline (415, 9.9), Hillary (318, 13.2) and Blake Elder (182, 11.4).

O-Line - In '09 the OL lost an AA RT and a 1st tm SoCon LT but ret'd 3 str's, however, 2nd tm SoCon RG Daniel Kilgore was inj'd and served as the utility backup. ASU dropped to 206 ypg rush (4.9) but the sks all'd fell to 20. LY they ret'd 4 str's in 2nd tm SoCon C Brett Irvin, LG Pat Mills, RG Matt Ruff and RT Orry Frye along with Kilgore. They improved to 217 ypg (5.2) with a conf best 9 sk all'd (2.5%). TY they lose three 1st tm SoCon OL in C Irvin, LG Mills and AA LT Kilgore (#5DC SF). They ret RG Ruff, RT Frye, LG Xan Thomas (1st) and rFr Kendall Lamm (PS#336).

D-Line - ASU ret'd all 4 str's in '09 incl 1st tm SoCon DE Jabari Fletcher and 2nd tm SoCon DT Anthony Williams. They trimmed the ypg rush to 136 (3.9) and the D had 30 sk. LY they lost DT's Williams (#9 tk/r) and Malcolm Bennett (#10). They ret'd 1st tm SoCon DE Fletcher (#6 tk/r, 10.5 tfl), DE Lanston Tanyi (#4, 7.5 sk) along with DT's Bobby Bozzo (#12) and Gordy Witte (10 tk). Tanyi missed the ssn (surgery) and they allowed 167 ypg (4.2) and the D had 31 sk. TY they lose AA Fletcher (t-#4 tk/r, 9 sk) and DT Bozzo (42 tk, 4 sk) but ret DE John Rizer (46 tk, 5.5 sk), NT Dan Wylie (39 tk, 5.5 tfl), DT Witte (5st, 15 tk), Tanyi and add NCSU transfer Zack Miller.

LB's - The LB unit ret'd 2 str's '09 in 2nd tm SoCon OLB DJ Smith (#2 tk/r) and SoCon DPOY MLB Jacque Roman (#1) and the ppg all'd slipped to 22.4. LY they lost Roman (#2 tk/r) but ret'd AA Smith (#1 w/137 tk, 14.5 tfl) and Justin Lloyd (#8) who lost his spot. ASU all'd 23.6 ppg. TY they lose AA Smith (#1 tk/r) who was #6DC GB and SLB Justin Wray (#2). The unit ret's WLB Brandon Grier (#3) and MLB Jeremy Kimbrough along with Lloyd.

DB's - The secondary ret'd 3 str's in '09 led by 1st tm SoCon CB Cortez Gilbert (#4 tk/r) and AA FS Mark LeGree (#1 FCS w/10 int). They finished #2 SoCon in pass eff D with a 16-18 ratio. LY they only lost AA CB Gilbert (#3 tk/r) but ret'd 3 str's in AA S LeGree (#5 tk/r, 7 int), 2nd tm SoCon CB Ed Gainey (#7) and CB Dominique McDuffie (#11). They dropped to #3 in pass eff D with an 18-14 ratio. TY they "only" lose AA S LeGree (5 int) who was #5DC SEA. They ret 3 str's in CB Troy Sanders (t-#4 tk/r), FS McDuffie (#6, 4 int) and CB Gainey (#8).

SPECIAL TEAMS - Last year the specs trms unit returned all of its top players including P Sam Martin (40.0), 2nd tm SoCon K Jason Vitaris (19-28) and 2nd tm KR CoCo Hillary (24.9). This year they lose K Vitaris (11-12, L/50) but ret P Martin (39.2) and 2nd tm SoCon KR Travis Cadet (22.9 KR, 6.0 PR).

COACHES - Legendary head coach Jerry Moore enters his 23rd season at Appalachian St. He has led the Mountaineers to 16 playoff appearances, 9 SoCon Crowns and 3 FCS Titles and is his own OC. Dale Jones, who has been with the program since 1996, begins his 2nd season as the DC.

FORECAST - The Mountaineers returned 9 off str's LY but had to replace 2x Walter Payton Award winner QB Armani Edwards. With very similar numbers they remained #1 SoCon in scoring and #2 in total off. TY they return just 5 off str's and while they have an AA QB, their top RB and top WR, they lose 5 of their top 8 receivers and three 1st tm SoCon OL including a #5DC. LY ASU ret'd 6 def str's and 5 of their top 8 tk/r's after unexpectedly losing their #4 tk/r (inj) prior to the ssn and had a new DC. While their numbers dipped slightly they remained #3 in scoring and #4 in tll D. TY they are in the 2nd ssn of the def, ret 7 str's and 16 of their top 21 tk/r's. They also get back their #4 tk/r from '09 but must replace 2 NFL DC's. LY App St just got by Chattanooga in the opener but started 8-0. Prior to the anticipated conf showdown with Wofford the Mountaineers were upset by GSU. ASU then bounced back to whip Wofford and share the SoCon Crown. With the playoffs on deck they lost to Florida. After defeating WIU they lost at home to '09 Champ Villanova. For the last 5 years App St has been able to reload but their 12 ret str's is their 12nd fewest in that period and depth became an issue LY especially along the DL. They will again be the favorite in the SoCon race and will make their 7th straight playoff appearance.
