POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QUARTERBACKS - Jeff Ballard (PS#44) won 90.5% of his starts ('05-'06) while setting numerous school and MWC records. Marcus Jackson (PS#74) was his backup in '06 and threw for 386 (59%, 2-1). In '07 rFr Andy Dalton (PS#74) beat out Jackson. Dalton attempted 371 passes in '07, 307 in '08 and 323 in '09 when he set a new career high with 2,756 (62%, 23-8) and had 512 rush (4.4). At that point he had already become the school's career leader, the same school that's had QB's like Sammy Baugh and Davey O'Brien. Dalton had a fine senior season setting records for yds (2857, reset his own), comp (66.1%, passed Ballard's 61.9% in '06) and td passes in a single season. He had a 27-6 ratio and added 435 (5.1) rush. Casey Pachall played in 8 but had just 9 att's (94 rush, 6.3). This unit goes from a QB who set the standard with 42 wins (Baugh #2 at 29-7-2 from 1934-'36) and 10,314 yds (#2 DC CIN) to 78 career yds and 0 victories.

RUNNING BACKS - TCU's most famous alum is LaDainian Tomlinson, who rushed for over 4,000 yards in his last 2 yrs here and went on to NFL stardom. Joseph Turner (PS#163) led in '07 (597, 5.2), '08 (577, 4.0) and in '09 (754, 5.1). Both Matthew Tucker (PS#96, 676, 6.4) and Ed Wesley (PS#183, 638, 6.3) topped LT's rush numbers (538, 4.3). LY they lost Turner (12 st) but added UCLA transfer Aundre Dean (PS#6). First Tm MWC Wesley became TCU's first 1,000 yd rusher S/'03 with 1,078 (6.5) while Tucker was named 3rd Tm MWC with 709 (4.8). Waymon James (5'8" 203 So, PS#80) had 513 (5.9) and Dean added 223 (7.0). This year the only loss is FB Ryan Hightower (16 yds). Not listed below are Dwight Smith (5'10" 218 rFr, PS#168) and FB Luke Shivers (6'0" 220 Sr). This is the deepest group of RB's in the MWC!

RECEIVERS - In '08 the top WR by far was Jimmy Young who had 988 (16.7) earning my 2nd Tm MWC honors. Young set a school record with 226 vs WY. He was basically the entire WR corps as the #2 rec was a TB. In '09 they had 2 st's ret but 1st Tm MWC KR/PR Jeremy Kerley led with 532 (12.1). Young was #2 with 517 (15.7) and Antoine Hicks, who orig signed with Texas (PS#38), was #3 (478, 20.8). All 3 ret'd LY and showing the talent this unit has, Young only had 6 rec in the first 5 and finished #3 (486, 15.2). RFr Josh Boyce (PS#228) led with 646 (19.0) while Kerley was #2 (575, 10.3) and Hicks had 175 (13.5). Kerley tied Mike Renfro's 1977 school record of 10 td rec. This year they lose Kerley (11 st, #5DC NYJ), Young (10 st, HM MWC), TE Evan Frosch (6, 2 rec, 3rd Tm MWC), Bart Johnson, (6 st, 419, 13.5), Curtis Clay (1 st, 5 rec) and Alonzo Adams (1 rec). Not listed below are Garrett Winsett (5'9" 180 Sr) and TE's Robert Deck (6'4" 270 Sr) and Justin Rose (6'2" 230 Sr).

With 3 of the top 4 rec's gone, this unit is less exp'd in '11 and hopefully Hicks returns to '09 form. They also add a great class of true frosh WR's (2 VHT's and 3 HT's).

DEFENSIVE LINE - HC Gary Patterson usually does well here, even with inexp'd O-lines. As an example, in '09 he had to replace 3 st's but the unit actually improved to 240 ypg (5.2) while allowing just 12 sks. LY they had to replace a 1st Tm MWC LT (#5DC) but had 4 st's back incl 1st Tm MWC players C Jake Kirkpatrick and LT Marcus Cannon (0 sk all'd '09). As you would expect, the outstanding O-line opened holes for a Patterson-era best 247 ypg rush (5.4) while allowing just 9 sks (2.7%). This year the losses are heavy. Gone are 1st Tm AA and Rimington winner Kirkpatrick (13 st, 2Y st'r), 1st Tm MWC Cannon (12 st, 3Y st'r, #5DC NE), RT Zach Roth (10 st) and RG Josh Vernon (13 st, 2Y st'r). They have just 36 career sts returning. In '06 TCU had to replace 4 st's but actually improved to 4.5 ypc. This year's unit will test Patterson's magic and I do not see any way they could come near 2010's production as that was clearly his best O-line yet.

DEFENSIVE LINE - Patterson who is the DC here prior to being named HC, always fields a top-notch D-line as they have yielded 2.9 or less ypc rush in 10 of the last 12 yrs. The only 2 years they did not was LY (3.3) and in '04 when they had to replace all 4 st's (still only 3.2). After all g just 47 ypg (#1 NCAA) and 1.7 ypc in '08, TCU had only 1 st'r back in '09 but it was star DE Jerry Hughes. While the numbers dropped, they were still outstanding at 80 ypg (#2 NCAA), 2.6 and 33 sks. LY TCU had to replace Hughes (#1DC) but had 7 of its top 8 back. While I expected the sack numbers to drop (did slide to 27), it was surprising to me that they slipped to 100 ypg (3.3) which was #5 in the NCAA. NT Kelly Griffin was lost after Wk 8 and they were allowing just 89.2 ypg (3.1) prior to taking on Wisc's powerful rush attack in the bowl. This year the Frogs lose 1st Tm AA DE Wayne Daniels (13 st, 39 tkl, 6.5 sk, 7.5 tfl), 1st Tm MWC DT Cory Grant (13 st, 18 tkl, 3.5 sk) and Griffin (8 st, 5 tkl, 2.5 tfl). The breakout ply'r on the DL should be DE Stansly Maponga (2nd Tm MWC LY). This will be another solid group but with just 1 st'r back, TCU's rush D numbers could drop for a 4th straight yr.

LINEBACKERS - TCU runs a 4-2-5 and while all of their safeties are legitimate S's, I list the SS here as I limit the DB's to 4 positions. In '09 they had to replace their #1, #2 and #3 tkl's (all 3 NFL DC's!) and did slip some to all g 12.8 ppg. LY they had to replace 3rd Tm AA SLB Daryl Washington (#2DC) but had 5 of the top 6 back. SS Tyler Luttrell started the first game but lost his job and had just 10 tkl's (9 gm) so it was like having 1 st'r back. They did improve to 12.0 ppg LY. This year they lose 2nd Tm MWC SS Colin Jones (12 st, 2 tkl'r, 11.5 tfl, #6DC SF) and Luttrell. TCU does return Tanner Brock (#1 tkl'r, 3rd Tm AA) and 1st Tm AA & MWC DPOY Carder (#4 tkl'r, 9.5 tfl). Adding depth are Marcus Mallet (6'1" 216 rFr, PS#134), Christopher Cisi (5'9" 195 So) and David Stoltzman (6'0" 212 Jr). This group has more exp and two of the top LB's in the country and are my #6 rated LB corps.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - TCU has recorded 5 straight Top 10 finishes in my PDR (#4 in '06 w/1 ret st'r, #9, #2, #5 and #4 LY). LY the Frogs had to replace their CB combo of Rafael Priest and Nick Sanders who had combined to start 42 consecutive gms together. This year they lose 2nd Tm MWC CB Jason Teague (13 st, 37 tkl, 2 int, 7 pbu), 1st Tm AA FS Tejay Johnson (13 st, 66 tkl, 3 int, 4 pbu), WS Alex Biloye (7 st, 39 tkl, 4.5 tfl), SS Jurrell Thompson (22 tkl) and CB Malcolm Williams (12 tkl, #7DC NE). The Frogs had an interesting stretch from the end of '09 into early '10 where they had ret'd 5 of 8 int's for td's. Patterson will produce another solid secondary but this unit is clearly less exp'd and loses its star, Johnson who was a finalist for the Jim Thorpe Award.

SPECIAL TEAMS - TCU almost always produces a top-notch ST unit under Patterson. In the last 10 yrs they finished in the Top 35 eight times (#2 in '07). They have had a 1st Tm MWC returnman for 6 straight yrs (3 diff ply'rs). In '08 Ross Evans was the only frosh Lou Groza semifinalist hitting 12 straight FG's (16-20, L50) but he missed 6 xp's. TCU finished #18 in '08 and despite losing their top KR, moved up to #11 in '09. Jeremy Kerley led the MWC in KR avg (26.6) and PR avg (14.4) and his 563 PR yds were a school rec (MWC STPOY). LY the unit ret'd intact. Kerley avg 27.7 on KR's and 12.9 on PR's and was again MWC STPOY. Anson Kelton improved his punting avg from 37.5 to 41.6 (tm net 34.8 to 36.5). Ross Evans hit 15-18 (L48) in '09 and 11-13 (L43) LY as TCU finished #19 (5 of L6Y in Top 25). Evans set the TCU record for xp's made (Chris Kaylakie 1998-'00) and att'd (Chris Manfreddie '05-'07). This year they lose Kevin Sharples (14 TB, 97 KO) and Kerley. Patterson has shown he can produce a top-notch RM so the unit probably will not drop as much as expected.

COACHES - Gary Patterson replaced Dennis Franchione prior to the 2000 bowl and has never looked back. Patterson was named CUSA's COY in '02 and the MWC COY in '05 and in '09. He's led the Frogs to B2B 12-0 reg seasons and was the Walter Camp and FWAA Eddie Robinson COY in 2009 when he took home a total of ten COY honors. Jarrett Anderson (14Y here, WR cch '01-'08) and Justin Fuente (RB cch '07-'08, QB cch L2Y) are co-OC's for a 2nd season. Patterson had been an asst under DC Dick Bumpas at Navy and hired the solid DC away from WM. Bumpas (8th year) was a Broyles Award finalist the last 3 yrs (#1 D NCAA all 3 yrs!).

PHIL'S FORECAST

In the past TCU did not land the most highly touted HS recruits but built bigger, stronger and faster athletes with a great weight training program. Almost 75% of the roster can bench 400 lbs and each year many opposing HC's mention that TCU is the fastest team in the MWC, especially on defense. After being a member of the SWC, TCU has had some outstanding seasons incl 10-2 ('02 in CUSA) and even flirted with an '03 BCS bowl before losing a late game at SM. They have been to a bowl in 12 of the last 13 yrs. In '05 they moved into their 4th conf in 11 yrs and won the MWC Title finishing 11-1 (#11 AP). It was their 3rd diff conf title in 6 yrs. From '05-'07, they beat five B12 tms. In '08 TCU was arguably the best non-BCS team despite their 2 losses. Against eventual Nat'l Title participant Okla they were only outFD'd 17-16 and despite outgaining Utah on the road 416-275, they lost. They finished 11-2 (#7) beating an unbeaten Boise in the bowl. In '09 after being +211.4 ypg in MWC play in '08, they improved to +261.9. The Frogs were a missed FG in the Big 12 Title game away from the possibility of playing in the National Title game. In a rematch vs Boise, they played a "B" game effort and lost to the Broncos, 17-10 and finished #6. LY TCU ret'd 16 st's (incl 13 '09 All-MWC ply'rs), and was ranked in the preseason Top 10 (#6) for just the 4th time (#9 '52, #7 '56, #8 '58). Eight of my 9 sets of power ratings called for TCU to go 12-0 and mine was the ONLY magazine to have them ranked higher than Boise. TCU had the type of season I expected going a perfect 13-0. At the start of the year Patterson appeared reluctant to score late and that cost him a few spots in the polls but they rolled through the MWC (+313 ypg) beating the other MWC titans, BYU and Utah, by a comb'd score of 78-10! They beat Wisconsin in the Rose Bowl and finished #2 AP (three 1st place votes). The Frogs have finished #1 in the FBS in total D 5 of the last 11 years (just the 3rd team with 3 straight 1's!). After the Frogs accepted a bid to go to the Big East next year, a HG vs Boise was switched to the blue turf (4 MWC AG's). TCU is 16-3 vs AQ conf's since '02 and the 13-0 record was their first perfect season since 1938 (Nat'l Champs). While this looks like a rebuilding year with just 8 ret st's (ties for fewest Patterson era), 6 of my 9 sets of power ratings call for an 11 win season.

TCU is just 3-9 in Waco S'75 LTH ('06 ssn opener), TCU trailed 7-0 at HT but shutout the Bears the rest of the way. TCU is 12-2 S/05 vs BCS tms. Horned Frogs are 5-1 L6Y in road openers.

TCU is 7-1 S'89 vs AF LTH ('09), TCU dealt with freezing rain & icy conditions. Frogs had 3 TO's incl 2 inside the AF 10 & one late 4Q which AF turned into a TD. TCU had a 106 yd edge (+9 FD's) in the 3 pt win.

First meeting. TCU has won 9 str home openers by 27 ppg. Under Patterson, TCU is 17-1 hosting non-conf opp's (17 straight wins, only loss was in '01 to FCS NWST).

First meeting. Vikings went 2-9 LY incl losses to AZ St 54-9 & Oregon 69-0. TCU's avg score vs L/4 FCS opp's is 58-12. TCU is 3rd tm in NCAA to lead in tll D 3 yrs in a row (Tol '69-'71 & OK '85-'87).

TCU has won 10 of the L/11 meetings. In each of the L2Y, TCU has trailed. LY TCU was down 17-14 w/13:58 3Q. From that point on the Frogs went on a 27-7 run incl 83 yd KR & 19 yd IR TD's.

First meeting was in '05 & TCU is 6-0 vs Sdst. LTH the Horned Frogs scored TD's on 7 of their 1st 10 possessions in the 55-12 win. TCU's def forced 4 TO's and allowed just 3 FD's in the 1st 3Q's.

Boise St: This one time MWC matchup was moved from Fort Worth to Boise (MWC presidents decided).

Colorado St: TCU has won every MWC meeting by a 31-8 avg & has held CSU out of the EZ for 11 str Q's.
