POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2011

QUARTERBACKS - Due to injuries, rFr Martevius Young got a start vs Rice in '07 but broke his leg on the 3rd play. Young, who had a powerful arm and is very mobile, had the 3 career snaps for SM QB's heading into '08 and he battled rFr Austin Davis. Davis started and broke numerous school single season records (like Brett Favre's 16 td passes by a frosh) throwing for 3,128 (58%, 23-8) and he was the #2 rusher (508, 3.3). He set school records with 461 vs Rice and 5 rush td's vs UAB. Davis was also the Bowl MVP. Young played in just 3 (2 att). Davis improved his arm strength in '09. He opened with 159 passes without an int but was lost in Wk 5 (foot). He threw for 1,165 (69%, 10-2). Young (8 sts), played well throwing for 1,861 (57%) with an outstanding 16-3 ratio (#3 rusher 294). Davis took almost all of the snaps LY and came close to his '08 numbers throwing for 3,103 (62.9%, 20-6) setting a schl rec with 278 comp's and was the #3 rusher. Young ply'd in 6 (12-23-132). TY they return Davis but lack depth as Young departs. Battling for the backup spot is Chris Campbell (PS#90) and Arsenio Favor (PS#163). Davis (#2 car passer, 299 yds away from #1) has already topped Favre and Lee Roberts as the career td pass leader (53) and should have his best season yet.

RUNNING BACKS - In '09 Damion Fletcher became the 9th RB in NCAA history to top 1,000 yds rushing for 4 straight yrs including '07 when he set a school rec with 1,586 (Sam DeJannette 1,545 '82). Naturally LY they had to replace Fletcher as well as their #2 rusher Tory Harrison (647, 6.2). The leading returning RB was Tracy Lampley (PS#86), who had 122 (5.8), although they did also return Sr VJ Floyd who had 398 (4.0) in 3 yrs. I projected rFr Kendrick Hardy (PS#16) as the starter. Hardy did not get a rush att in the first 3 vs FBS foes (86 yds vs FCS Prairie View) and only had 4 vs Marshall and EC. Finally, with Floyd and Desmond Johnson banged up, Hardy got 101 (9.2) vs Memphis and 147 (8.6) vs UAB. He later exploded for 205 (7.9) vs Houston and 91 (5.7) vs Tulsa and led with 903 (6.5). Soph Johnson (PS#141) ply'd in just 10 (inj) and had 611 (5.3). Lampley started 6 but was never really 100% (384, 5.9) and he now moves to WR for 2011 (#6 rec LY, 203, 7.8). This year they lose Floyd (8 st, 228, 3.3) but add explosive frosh Jamal Woodyard (PS#162). Jeremy Hester (5'6" 172 So, PS#139) and Darrell Sanders (5'8" 182 rFr) add depth. This unit is much deeper and more experienced than '10 and I look for Hardy to top the 1,000 yd barrier.

RECEIVERS - In '08 SM had their top 2 rec back in TE Shawn Nelson and WR Torris Magee while adding the tremendous addition of 6'6" DeAndre Brown (PS#7). While Nelson had his best season (557, 10.5), Brown lived up to his VHT billing (1st Tm CUSA) with 1,117 (16.7) before a gruesome broken tibia in the bowl. He was not 100% to open '09 and never regained his speed but still led with 785 (16.7). LY they had to replace 3 of their top 4 rec's and Brown never rebounded playing in just 6 (305, 15.2). Taking Brown out of the equation, the top returnee was Quentin Pierce (PS#158) who had 247 (9.9) in '09. LY Pierce battled injuries over the first 7 (120 yds) but finished #3 (454, 11.9). Johndrick Morris (6'3") was #2 with 684 (13.7) while Kelvin "Peanut" Bolden (PS#29JC) led with 722 (15.7). William Spight added 219 (8.8). TY they lose Morris (11 st), Brown (1 st, left early for the NFL, undrafted), Deon Hodges (1 st, 151, 11.6) and TE Jonathan Massey (1 st, 5 sec). Adding depth is Justin Sims (5'7" 166 So, 10.4 100m on SM track tm). This unit still has more exp than '10 and will hopefully remain healthier.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '09 SM had 3 st's back but slipped to 181 ypg rush (4.6) although they trimmed their sack total to 16 (4.1%). LY they had to replace 4 st's with just 26 career sts back. RT Jason Weaver was lost after 2 sts to injury. Surprisingly the lightly experienced unit improved to 201 ypg (4.7) with 17 sks. This year they lose 1st Tm CUSA C Cameron Zipp (13 st, 3Y st) and RG Alex Michael (13 st). Not in the PSL is Chase Moore (6'2" 256 rFr). They have 3 st's back (39 career starts) making this unit more experienced.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In HC Bower's final season, SM had 6 seniors in the 2 deep incl all 4 st's and yielded 134 ypg (3.8). Naturally the losses were heavy in Fedora's first year and 9 different DL's started including 1 true, 2 rFr, 3 soph and a JC. It surprised me that they only allowed 140 ypg rush although their 4.2 ypc was the worst since '04 and the D had just 20 sks (lowest S'/97). In '09 the top 7 DL tkl's were all back and they improved to 131 ypg (3.6) with 34 sks. LY SM only had to replace 2 DL's (comb 7 st, 56 tkl, 7 sk) and were clearly bigger, stronger and more exp'd. They trimmed their ypg allowed to 113 (3.6) which was their best since 2001 but the sacks dropped to 27. This year they lose 2nd Tm CUSA NT Anthony Gray (11 st, 44 tkl, 6 tfl), DT John Henderson (9 st, 33 tkl, 5 tfl), DE Roshad Byrd (11 tkl, 2.5 sk) and DE David Boyce (8 tkl, 1.5 sk). SM returns 2nd Tm CUSA DE Cordarro Law (#6 tkl'r, 6 sk) and move Jamie Collins (PS#31), who was #2 tkl'r, to the Bandit DE spot so they are equal to '10 in experience and could improve.

LINEBACKERS - SMLB's were named CUSA DPOY 4 out of 5 yrs from '03-'07. In '09 they had to replace 1st Tm CUSA Gerald McRath (#1 tkl'r, #4DC) and their #2 tkl'r. Fedora was impressed with how quickly true frosh Jamie Collins picked up the D (48 tkl's as DB) and moved him to LB. Last year they returned their #1 tkl'r in Corey Williams (121 tkl, 7.5 sk) and #2 tkl'r Ronnie Thornton (114 tkl, 10.5 tfl). Martez Smith, who was the #3 tackler, was lost after 5 sts to injury and was later tragically paralyzed in an off field incident. SM surprisingly yielded 29.5 ppg which was their worst since 1969 (30.7)! This year they lose Smith (27 tkl, 3 tfl), Hendrick Leverette (4 tkl) and move Collins to BAN. Williams (#1) and Thornton (#4) are both back and the Spur S is like a LB and they'll need to find a starter. The Golden Eagles are a little less experienced than '10 but still one of CUSA's best.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - From 1995-'08 SM had just 1 finish lower than #51 in my PDR and that was with an injury plagued group in '05 (#70). They had all 4 st's back in '09 and it was very surprising they dropped to #72. LY they had to replace 2 st's including a 1st Tm CUSA FS. DC Todd Bradford then mentioned that CB was the one position that was the biggest? coming into '10. With 2 st's back, SM improved to #59 (57.4%,

28-17). This year they lose 2nd Tm CUSA FS Justin Wilson (13 st, 41 tkl, 4 int), 4Y st'r CB CJ Bailey (11 st, 26 tkl, 3 pbu) and HM CUSA NB Chico Hunter (6 st, 54 tkl, 2 int). They do return 2nd Tm CUSA CB Deron Wilson, solid SS Kendrick Presley (PS#63) and add 2 JUCO's (IFS). Not listed in the PSL is Laurice Lawrence (5'7" 175 So). SM is on par with '10 in terms of experience and should improve again in my PDR.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Larry Fedora inherited a group that finished #87 in my ST rankings and had to replace their P/K. In '09 Danny Hrapmann (PS#32) was inj'd early but took over at the end to hit 4-7 FG and had 6 TB on 80 KO. True frosh P Peter Boehme avg'd 38.5 (36.4 net) while fellow true Tracy Lampley was the top PR (14.5, 1 td) while also having 17 KR (27.6, 1 td). The unit finished #18 despite missing 10 xp's. Hrapmann improved dramatically and hit 26-31 (L54) including 2-3 from 50+. He hit a 59 yd'r vs Houston which was called back after a time-out and the ensuing 59 yd att was blk'd. Hrapmann had 8 TB on 93 KO. He made my AA Tm and became one of the 3 finalists for the Groza Award setting a school rec for pts for a K in a season. Boehme avg 39.2 (tm net 36.3). Lampley saw his PR numbers drop to 6.3. Despite the presence of Hrapmann the team dropped to #62. TY they return everyone except FG LS Ben Schoenberger (13 gm) and should actually have one of the most improved ST units in the country.

COACHES - Larry Fedora is in his 4th yr here and was the OC at Okla St ('05-'07) and Flor ('04). Blake Anderson is in his 2nd yr as OC and 4th as QB coach. He was OC/QB cch at Louisiana ('07) and co-OC at MTenn ('02-'04). Dan Disch is the new co-DC after spending the L7Y under Ron Zook (co-DC Illinois '07-'09). LB cch David Duggan was also promoted to co-DC in his 4th yr here and was previously an NFL Europe HC (Cologne '06-'07).

PHIL'S FORECAST

Jeff Bower had a very successful 17 years as a HC here (29 yrs overall). In Larry Fedora's first year ('08) it appeared they were headed for their first losing season in 15 yrs (1993). They opened up 2-6 but swept their final 4 and overcame a 10 pt bowl deficit to finish 7-6. Despite their 4-4 CUSA record, SM was +99.3 ypg (best East) and had a much more veteran team in '09. QB Austin Davis was injured midseason but SM got their first perfect home record (6-0) since 1999 as they beat Tulsa 44-34 in the FHG for 19 seniors. In the game to decide the CUSA East Title, SM got the apparent go-ahead td but their xp was blk'd and ret'd for 2. They trailed by 2 instead of leading by 1 and lost by 5. They then had a disappointing bowl loss to MT by 10 to finish 7-6 again. LY they did draw the top 2 teams out of the West in UH and Tulsa and played UCF on the road. After a loss to SC in the opener, SM won their next 4 and jumped out to a 20-0 lead vs EC but despite a 404-338 yd edge, suffered a 1 pt loss. After routing Memphis on the road, SM was stunned again, this time by UAB. SM actually trailed 35-21 in the 4Q and managed to tie it but lost in 2OT. After dispatching Tulane, they went into UCF and won 31-21 keeping alive hopes for the CUSA East Title but after blowing out UH by 18, they gave up 634 yds to Tulsa and lost by 6 on the road. They opened up a 14-0 lead vs L'ville in the bowl but lost by 3 for an 8-5 finish. After a surprising +2.5 ypg avg in conf play in '09, SM was back to +94.1 in '10 which was best in CUSA. SM was 8 pts away from a perfect 8-0 CUSA rec and an 11-1 reg ssn mark. They also had 3 net close losses which gives them an 81% chance at improving their record. They have now had 17 consecutive winning seasons (last losing in '93 at 3-7-1) tying the previous team mark set from '51-'67 which is the 4th longest active streak among FBS schools. None of my 9 sets of power ratings call them #1 in the CUSA but almost all have them #2 and they have a schedule that sets up perfect with winnable road games and all the toughest games are at "The Rock." Four of my 9 sets of power ratings call for a 12-0 record!

SM is 6-1 S'83 vs LT but LY was the 1st meeting S'92. SM led 13-3 into the 4Q but needed an int at their 25 w/2:31 left to seal the 1 pt win. Golden Eagles have won 12 str home openers by 28 ppg.

SM is 3-0 in Huntington with each gm decided by single digits. In '09 the gm was tied 20-20 before a SM 63/7pt TD drive w/6:54 left. SM int'd MU at their 2 & 7 on their L2 drives to preserve the win.

SM is 18-3 vs SEL but have met just once S'69. SM won 45-0 in '06. Lions went 2-9 LY incl losses to Tulane & ULM. SEL is 0-11 the L5Y vs FBS teams (incl 2011 they have played at least two in 5 of the L6Y).

Only meeting was in '09 as this is SMiss' 1st trip to Charlottesville. Including bowls, the Golden Eagles are 3-11 vs BCS conf schools L6Y w/last road win in '04 (beat Nebraska 21-17).

Just the 3rd overall meeting. In the L/gm SM lost 45-40 ('08) but both tms had 25+ FD's & 570+ yds. SM actually never led & in the 4Q trailed by 19 w/6:48 left before 2 late TD drives.

First meeting. Larry Fedora was the QB/WR ocb at AF from 1997-'98 & during that period beat Navy twice (30 ppg avg). SM won both of their non-conf-incon-BCS AG's the L3Y (won LY at LT & in '08 at Ark St).

UCF: SM has gone 5-1 vs UCF (1st gm in '05) & this series has quickly developed into a rivalry.

UAB: SM is 5-1 vs UAB in Birmingham but only 1 of those wins was by DD ('05 37-7).

SM has won both meetings. In the L/gm ('08) SM came in 5-6 needing a win to reach bowl eligibility. Golden Eagles only led 7-6 at HT but in an 8 min span in the 2H scored 21 unanswered pts.

This series is tied 2-2. 1st meeting was at the Sun Bowl after the '53 ssn. SM was last here in '07 hammering UTEP 56-30 w/a 568-414 yd edge. The gm was close at HT but SM dropped 42 2H pts.
