

### POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2012

**QUARTERBACKS** - In '07 NC ret'd both players who started in '06 but I projected that rFr TJ Yates would win the job and he became the 4th straight 1st year starting QB for NC. Yates started 12 in '07 but was lost after 6 sts in '08 (inj). In '09 he started all 13 (2136, 60%, 14-15). In '10 it was widely speculated that rFr Bryn Renner (PS#20) would beat out Yates. Yates held on and had a year far better than I expected, throwing for a schl rec 3,418 (67%, 19-9), becoming the 1st QB here to top 3,000 yds in a ssn. Renner played in 3 (2 att). Yates, who served as the Texans' starting QB LY, left (#5DC) as NC's career leader. I projected Renner to start and he is more mobile and brings a fiery enthusiasm to the huddle. He threw for 3,086 (68.3%, 26-13) breaking NC's single ssn td record (Chris Keldorf, 23 '96) but surprisingly had -88 net yds rushing. Added to the mix this year are PS#13 Marguise Williams, Caleb Pressley and 2 true frosh. It will be tough to improve much upon LY's stats but Renner is much more experienced and new HC Larry Fedora's SM offense should have another fine year.

NC used to be called "Running" Back U." Their twenty-four 1,000 yd rushers were the most in the NCAA until USC passed them in '05. They had 12 straight 1,000 yd rushers from 1973-'84 but had just one over the next 17 yrs ('97 Jonathan Linton)! LY they had to replace their top 3 rushers. Ryan Houston (PS#21) was mostly a short ydg back and led in '09 with 713 (3.7) but RS in '10. He was used as a short ydg back again LY and finished #2 with 325 (3.8, 7 td). Giovani Bernard (PS#18) was impressive in Aug as a true frosh in '10 but suffered a torn ACL. In his first year back from inj he topped that 1,000 yd barrier with 1,253 (5.2, 13 td) and was also the #3 rec (362, 8.0). Converted QB AJ Blue was #3 with 138 (4.2). Not listed below are FB's Devon Ramsay (6'2" 250 Sr, PS#29, 1 st ACL LY), Matt Kolojejchick (5'10" 200 Sr) and Conner Gonet (6'0" 220 rFr). This year they lose Houston and FB Curtis Byrd (1 rush, 6 rec) but Bernard is another year removed from his injury and could put up even stronger numbers.

- The Top 3 in '08 comb for 1,932 (16.9) and in '09 NC had to replace #1, #2, #3 and #5DC's. The inexp'd top 3 of '09 comb for just 1,483 (11.2). True frosh Erik Highsmith (PS#166) surprisingly be at out many VHT's and had 425 (11.5). In '10 their top WR, Greg Little (#2DC), was ineligible while their top TE was OFY after 6 sts (#1 rec at time). Dwight Jones led with 946 (15.3). LY Jones set a schl record for rec's with 85 (Hakeem Nicks 74 '07) and had the 2nd best season all-time in yds with 1,196 (14.1, Nicks 1222 '08). Highsmith was #2 with 726

(14.2) and behind him with dynamic ypc's were PS#8 Jheranie Boyd (20.9) and true frosh TE PS#20 Eric Ebron (20.7). TY they lose Jones, TE Nelson Hurst (13 st, 1 rec) and HB Christian Wilson (11 st, 10 rec). They do have 4 VHT's in the group and could come close to '11's numbers.

After avg 99 ypg rush (3.0) in Davis' 1st season of '07, NC improved their ypc each year with 123 (3.5) '08, 133 (3.6) in '09 and 126 (3.7) in '10. That '10 unit did allow 37 sks (most s/'07, 8.7%) despite having 4 st'rs back. True frosh James Hurst (PS#3) started 12 and was 1st Tm Fr AA, LY they had to replace 2 strs (3Y and 2Y strs) but had 8 of their top 10 back (60 car st). Nobody in the projected 2 deep was under 305 lbs as the starting 5 avg 6'5" 319 but still had mobility. NC only had 2 sts lost to injury all year (4 started all 13). They put up their best rushing numbers in both ypg (139) and ypc (4.1) s/04 while trimming the sks to 27 (7.3%). TY they lose C Cam Holland (11 st, 3Y st'r) and bkp OT Carl Gaskins (10 gm). They again have 8 of the top 10 back but now have 93 car sts. NC returns their top guy in Hurst (2nd Tm ACC) and this should be one of the ACC's best O-lines.

E - In '09 I said that NC had its best D-line s/'01 as the entire 2 deep ret'd (6 VHT). They also had great bulk inside with 4 DT's at 300+ lbs. That forecast was on the spot as the Heels all'd just 96 ypg rush (2.8, 33 sk). In '10 they had to replace 2 st'rs (#4, #5 DC's). I still listed NC as the #1 D-line in the country as they had 2 of my preseason 1st Tm AA in DE Robert Quinn and DT Marvin Austin. By looking at the stats, you would think I was way off base as they all'd 126 ypg rush (3.7) which was a drop off from '09, but still better than any stats from '02 through '08. The reason being this was the area hit hardest by the NCAA as both Quinn and Austin DNP (0 st'rs back!). LY NC had to replace #1 and #2 DC's although neither played a single play and had all 4 st'rs back. The numbers improved but only to 124 ypg (3.6, 25 sk) TY they lose 2x 1st Tm ACC DE Quinton Coples (13 st, 55 tkl, 7.5 sk, #1DC NYJ), DT Tydreke Powell (13 st, 46 tkl, 1 sk), DE Donte Paige-Moss (29 tkl, 2 sk, left early NFL, undrafted) and DT Jordan Nix (19 tkl, 3 tfl). They will use a hybrid (DE) OLB) in their new 3-3-5 defense. While NC has 2 solid st'rs, they could put up similar numbers after underachieving LY but

they don't appear to have as many NFL prospects.

LINEBACKERS - In '09 NC had to replace its Def MVP (#2 tkl'r) but had 2 st'rs back. "True" frosh Kevin Reddick started the final 5 at MLB. NC allowed just 17.1 ppg (best s/'97). In '10 they ret'd their top 4 LB tkl'rs (#1, #3, #8, #9) incl Quan Sturdivant (1st Tm ACC) and Bruce Carter (2nd Tm ACC). Due to the massive susp's to the DL and DB's, this unit held the D together. NC only slipped to allowing 23.2 ppg. LY they had to replace those two (#2, #6 DC's) but did return the top 2 tkl'rs in Reddick and Zach Brown. Brown earned 1st Tm ACC but NC allowed 24.8 ppg. Reddick fought off inj's LY (11 st, 12 gm) but still finished #2. TY they lose Brown (12 st, #1 tkl'r, 5.5 sk, 8 tfl, #2DC TEN) and Ebele Okakpu (5 st, 14 tkl, 3 tfl) who was dismissed after 5 sts. They return their #2, #11 and #18 tkl'rs.

This unit is a little less exp'd after losing its top guy.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '09 NC had 7 of their top 8 back (lost 1st Tm ACC SS). CB Kendric Burney set an ACC record with 170 IR yds vs Miami then a schl rec 3rd career IR td. As expected, NC made big strides moving up to #17. In '10 all four 13 gm st'rs ret'd but all 4 were susp for at least the first 3 and NC dropped to #45. LY 3 of those 4 st'rs and a CB with 5 sts departed but they did return 4 who had 4+ sts in '10. SS Matt Merletti was lost after 8 sts. NC dropped even further to #67 (60.9%, 24-14). TY they lose CB Charles Brown (12 st, 53 tkl, 2 int, 7 pbu), SS Jonathan Smith (8 st, 45 tkl), FS Merletti (36 tkl,

2 int. 1 pbu) and SS Brian Gupton (8 tkl). New DC Dan Disch will run a 3-3-5 D using a 5th DB or RAM (S/LB) to emphasize speed. SS Gene Robinson (#7 tkl'r) will take on the new role. They have 3 back with 8+ car sts making them much more exp'd and I would expect a good-sized move up the PDR.

- In '08 NC finished #22 in my ST rankings but dropped to #86 in '09. Then, losing 13 players to susp, dropped to #111 in '10. The school's all-time FG leader Connor Barth's little bro Casey hit 19-22 in '10 (L49). Casey came into LY hitting 50-62 car FG (NC rec 82 cons xp) but battled a groin inj and RS after playing in just 3. Thomas Moore (6-10 FG, L46) and Trase Jones comb for just 1 TB on 64 KO but they had an above avg KR D (19.5). True frosh PS#26 TJ Thorpe had a 100 yd KR td vs Clemson (avg 26.7 on yr) but the PR were below avg (74 yd on yr, 4.1). True frosh Tommy Hibbard only avg 39.2 on punts (tm net 35.9). NC moved up slightly to #74. With Barth back, NC should have their best ST finish in 4 yrs.

S - Butch Davis took over a program which had achieved 8 wins just once in the previous 9 ssns and he led them to B2B2B 8-5 finishes. An NCAA investigation cost him his job in July '11 and DC Everett Withers was the interim. UNC got to a bowl (7-6) but bring in Larry Fedora who guided SM to a schl record 12 wins LY (4 str bowls). Fedora was also the OC at Okl St ('05-'07). The OC is Blake Anderson who spent 4 yrs at SM incl the last 2 as OC. The DC is Dan Disch who served in the same role at S Miss LY and previously at Illinois ('05-'10, co-DC 2Y).

# 'S FORECASI

In '07 Butch Davis took over a team that had not finished above .500 in 5 yrs. The '06 squad was 3-9 and he had just 9 st'rs back (fewest ACC). Davis did a tremendous job as NC had 6 close losses and could have easily finished better than their 4-8 record. In '08 they were my #2 MIT with 18 st'rs back and if not for a couple of key inj's could easily have been playing in the ACC Title game. They were -44 ttl ypg (-26.3 ypg in ACC). In '09 all 5 road games were vs '08 bowl tms and after they lost to Pitt in the bowl NC finished 8-5 again. In '10, 7 of my 9 sets of power ratings called for NC to have a DD win season and they figured to have perhaps the best defense in the NCAA as it was loaded with NFL talent. Unfortunately, after my magazine hit the newsstands, NC's D was wiped out by NCAA susp's. In the opener, they were w/o 13 players (8 proj st'rs). They finished with their 3rd straight 8-5 season. NC had an amazing 89 sts lost to inj's or susp, by far most in the NCAA. NC did benefit from 3 net close wins. LY I called for them to win at least 9 for the first time s/97. Once again, after my magazine was on the newsstands, NC shockingly lost their HC (fired a week before Aug camp). Naturally given that information, I would have projected them lower with an interim HC. NC opened 5-1 before a home loss to Miami where they had a 429-311 yd edge (did trail 27-10) They lost by 21 at Clemson but rebounded to beat WF 49-24 in dominating fashion. Withers then made some inflammatory statements prior to NCSt which got the Wolfpack riled up and they were shutout in the series for the first time s/60, 13-0. NC trailed VT 24-7 but got a td with 2:32 left to pull within 24-21 but did not recover the onside and lost by 3. In their FHG they beat Duke 37-21 but then were a no show for the bowl being outgained 513-353 with asst coaches all trying to find other jobs and Larry Fedora having already been named the HC. Fedora is in a good situation as NC returns 13 st'rs and LY was #5 in the ACC at +19.5 ypg despite a 3-5 record. NC is not eligible for the post season but has 4 winnable ACC road gms getting their toughest foes at home and 2 of my 9 sets of power ratings project a 12-0 season. I will call for the Tar Heels to have DD wins for the 1st time s/97 provided there are no more bombshells in the offseason.
