POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2012

QUARTERBACKS - In '08 UCF had to replace their QB. Due to in's true frosh Rob Calabrese (PS#78) got 8 st (664, 39%, 108 rush). In '09 they added Wake Forest transfer Brett Hodges (PS#125, 402, 66%, 3Y). Calabrese started the first 2 but Hodges started 10 of the last 11. After the team threw for just 1,395 in '08, Hodges threw for 2,438 (60%, 17-13) in '09 while Calabrese, who was booed as he entered in the 4Q vs Miami, threw for 260 (54%, 3-0) for the season. Calabrese began '10 as the starter but true frosh Jeff Godfrey, who directed 2 scoring drives in the opener, took over when UCF trailed NCST 28-7 and started the last 12. Godfrey threw for 2,159 (67%, 13-8, 566 rush, 10 td) and was CUSA FPOY. Calabrese threw for 316 (64%, 2-2) but tore his ACL vs Marshall (gm 6) on a td run. The bkp was rR Blake Bortles (PS#142). Godfrey was #1 in CUSA in pass eff in '10 but UCF seemed to tailor the offense to more pocket passing. Godfrey's production dropped to 1,898 (69%, 5-5, 405 rush). Bortles replaced Godfrey in the 1Q vs SM (gm 10) and on the final drive hit 9-10 (24-34-248 gm) leading them to the potential game winning td (2ptng). Bortles threw for 958 (68.2%, 6-3). Rafael Echemendia (6'2" 200 Jr) is an FCS transfer and ran the scout tm LY. They add in Colo St transfer Nicolas Ranieri (6'2" 206 PS#92, IFS) and VHT Missouri transfer Tyler Gabbert (PS#25) who arrives this fall. Calabrese RS last year, could continue to run the Wildcat like '10, and may be used as an HB/WR. Godfrey, who orig planned to trans has an opportunity to return and may also be used at WR. There's a lot of talent with many options and they should top last year's passing numbers (238 ypg, 68%, 11-8).

RUNNING BACKS - In '09 Latavius Murray (PS#43) tore his ACL and Brynn Harvey (6'1" 209, PS#166) had a fine year with 1,109 (4.2). Ronnie Weaver had 86 (4.5). In '10 Murray moved to HB and Harvey suffered a knee inj in the spring and RS. Weaver rushed for 890 (4.8) while Murray moved back to TB and rushed for 637 (5.7). LY the trio all ret'd so it looked like CUSA's best RB corps. Harvey led with 574 (4.6) and Weaver had 299 (3.9). Murray finished with 549 (5.6) incl 233 vs UTEP (4th best UCF hist) and was also the #5 rec (242, 14.2). Sr FB Billy Giovanetti (5'11" 230) has 13 sts in 3Y. Added in this year is Cedric Thompson (6'0" 218 rR, PS#141) and VHT Miami, Fla transfer Storm Johnson (PS#20). This year the only loss is Weaver (5 st) and I look for the Johnson, Murray and Harvey group to outproduce the numbers of LY's trio (1422, 4.7).

RECEIVERS - Last year UCF lost their top 3 rec's (comb 1753, 15.1) and the top returnees were AJ Guyton (PS#42) who had 353 (12.6) and Quincy McDuffie (144, 11.1). Three frosh who O'Leary were high on emerged. JJ Worton led with 531 (13.0). RfR Josh Reese (PS#99) was #3 (461, 15.4) and

Rannell Hall had 4 rec's. McDuffie finished #2 with 482 (11.2) and Guyton #4 with 404 (15.0). TY they lose Guyton (8 st) and TE Adam Nissley (11 st, 235, 11.2). They add in QB Calabrese, potentially QB Godfrey and WR Breshad Perriman who was a star in spring. This unit is more experienced (top 3 back) than it was heading into last year and looks stronger.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '10 UCF had their most exp'd OL (4 st's ret) s/07 (235 ypg rush, 4.9, 20 sks). The numbers improved to 188 (4.4) with 20 sks (6.8%). LY they lost a 1st Tm CUSA RT (3Y st'r, #3DC) and their LT (1.5 yr). They did return 4 who had 7+ career sts (87 car sts) but went from 4 ret sts to 3 and the numbers dropped to 169 ypg (4.3) with 25 sks (7.2%). TY they lose 2nd Tm CUSA RT Nick Pieschel (11 st, 4Y st'r), OG Cliff McCray (8 st, 3Y st'r) but once again have 3 st's back and add in GT transfer Phil Smith (3Y st'r) so their career sts climb to 89 and they ret 4 that have been full time st's.

DEFENSIVE LINE - UCF had a veteran D-line in '09 and allowed just 83 ypg (#4 FBS, 2.6) with 38 sacks. In '10 they had to replace 314 lb DT Torrell Troup (#2DC), a 1st Tm CUSA DE and another starting DT. They did return CUSA DPOY DE Bruce Miller (13 sk '09). Despite the losses, UCF still only allowed a solid 108 ypg rush (3.4) with 32 sks. LY UCF lost Miller (#7DC), a starting DE and DT but ret'd 2nd Tm CUSA Darius Nall who tied a team high with 8.5 sks despite not starting. After losing 3 st's for the 2nd straight year, the numbers were almost identical to '10 yielding 109 ypg rush (3.8) but with only 17 sks. TY they lose Nall (10 st, 24 tkl, 5 tfl) and bkp DT Barry Snider (6 tkl). It will be tough to top LY's numbers but I expect the sacks to rise with their most experienced D-line in 3 yrs and they are one of CUSA's best.

LINEBACKERS - In '10 UCF had to replace their #1 tkl'r (1st Tm CUSA) and 2 bkps (comb 5 st, 46 tkl). They did get back Chance Henderson (11 sts, #4 '08, inj '09) and ret'd their #2 and #3 tkl'rs. With a veteran unit, UCF allowed just 17.1 ppg, their best since 1989 (16.8 DI). LY they had to replace 2 st's and a bkp (#2, #4, #8 tkl'rs). They did bring in a pair of JUCO's who were IFS but neither made the 2-deep. They also moved in RB Jonathan Davis (PS#24), added Ray Shipman who hadn't played since his freshman yr of HS (Mr BB in Fla) and VHT Leilon Willingham (PS#38). Despite very few LB's returning, UCF still allowed just 18.3 ppg. TY they lose MLB Josh Linam (11 st, #3, 10 tfl) and Willingham (3 st, 19 tkl) but have 4 of the top 6 back (#5, #7, #8 tkl'r) and this may be CUSA's top LB corps with the 2 ret sts now in their 2nd year of playing the position.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '07 this unit returned intact and climbed all the way up to #14 in my PDR with 24 int's. In '08 they had the most exp'd secondary in the FBS and moved up to #8 (14-18 ratio). In '09 I called this unit BY FAR my biggest concern on the team. They had to replace 186 career sts (50 car int). O'Leary did say that Josh Robinson (PS#102), Kemal Ishmael, AJ Bouye and rR Jarrett Swaby were further ahead than any frosh he'd coached at UCF. Robinson was the #5 tkl'r and led all FBS frosh with 6 int's. UCF still plummeted to #83. In '10 they had 3 st's back and as expected, rose to #12. LY they had to replace 2 st's and 2 bkps (comb 2 st, 43 tkl). They did return two 1st Tm CUSA DB's in Ishmael (#1 tkl'r) and Robinson (conf high 15 pbu). They lost CB AJ Bouye after 7 sts (ACL) but UCF still finished #13 (54%, 12-9). This year they lose CB Robinson (12 st, 48 tkl, 17 pd, #3DC MIN) but have 4 of the top 5 back.

SPECIAL TEAMS - George O'Leary always fashions a fine ST unit as they were #8 in my ST rankings in '07, #24 in '08, #24 in '09 and #9 in '10. LY 3 fumbled punts resulted in 2 td's and a FG for their opp's incl crucial td's by BYU and FIU.

Rannell Hall was a dangerous KR (31.0). Nick Cattoi hit 10-15 (L48) while Shawn Moffitt hit 5-9 (0-3 40+). Cattoi had 7 TB on 53 KO. P David Bohner improved to 41.2 but with only a 33.0 net. UCF slipped but only to #22 and even with the loss of Cattoi and Bohner, they could find themselves in my Top 25 again.

COACHES - O'Leary led GT to a 52-33 record and five bowls in 7 years. In 8 yrs here he has 2 CUSA Titles in 3 trips to the championship and 4 bowl appearances (only bowls in UCF history). O'Leary was the CUSA COY in '05, '07 and '10. Charlie Taaffe is in his 4th season as OC and has 20 yrs as a HC in both the CFL and NCAA (Hamilton '07-'08, Montreal '99-'00, The Citadel '87-'96 and Army '81-'86). UCF is on their 4th DC in 3Y's as they hired Ted Roof in Dec but he left for Penn St a month later. Jim Fleming takes over after 1 season here as LB cch (Kent St LB '10, Akron DC '04-'09).

PHIL'S FORECAST

George O'Leary inherited a 3-9 team and there was a lot of attrition with the new HC (73 schlp players) and UCF finished 0-11. In '05 I picked the Knights higher than any other magazine (most had them last). Nine of their top 68 were walk-ons, but after UCF lost their first 2 (17th st loss) they became the 7th team in NCAA history to go from winless to bowl-eligible. They had the biggest turnaround in the NCAA in '05 (+8 wins) before dropping the CUSA Title game (51,978 crowd) and were in their first bowl in their 10 yr IA history. With an enrollment of 53,000+, they are the 3rd largest FBS university. In '05 they were only +2.9 ypg despite a 7-1 CUSA record and benefitted from +12 in TO's with 3 net close wins (pg 309). As expected, UCF's record dropped in '06 to 4-8. In '07 they made my Most Improved List again and opened Bright House Stadium which ignited the fan base. They nearly upset #6 Texas in the first ever sellout at UCF. The Knights finished as CUSA Champs at 10-4 (+139 ypg CUSA best). In '08 O'Leary continued his up/down trend (4-8). In '09 they were back on my Most Improved List and back to the post season (8-4) before losing to Rutgers in the bowl. In '10 I called for UCF to have their first B2B winning seasons s/'01-'02. I said they would top '09's 8 win total and they were my pick to win the CUSA East. UCF had a dominant D and the last time O'Leary had 18 Sr's they won the CUSA Title ('07). UCF got to the CUSA Title game (beat SMU) and in the bowl upset Georgia and for the 1st time ever, finished ranked (#21). LY UCF was the media's pick to win the CUSA East but I was not as high on them. UCF had a beneficial off ypp (11.7, pg 309) and despite being CUSA Champs were only 4th best at +64 ypg. UCF had just 10 ret sts (#11 CUSA) and drew both SMU and Tulsa out of the West as well as SMiss on the road. While they opened up beating an FCS tm and BC by a comb 92-3. They had a 300-238 yd edge at FIU but lost with FIU getting a 51 yd FR on the last play of the 1H keying their 17-10 upset. UCF had a 399-260 yd edge at BYU but lost by 7. After beating Marshall in a heavy downpour 16-6 (387-130 yd edge) they lost by 21 at SMU. Then on a Thurs night were upset by UAB 26-24 (outgained 501-331). After whipping Mem 41-0, they lost to Tulsa at home on a Thurs by 7 and then scored a td on the final play against SMiss but went for 2 and the win and came up short. At EC they gave up a 56 yd td run with 2:10 left and once again lost by 7 before dispatching UTEP in the FHG for 15 Sr's leading 31-0 in the 4Q. TY there are a lot of signs pointing upward. UCF had SIX net close losses, have 16 ret sts and despite their 3-5 CUSA record were +39.8 ypg (5th best). While they do pull SMU and Tulsa out of the West, they get SMiss at home. UCF not only makes my Most Improved List, they are my pick to win the CUSA East.

UCF has dropped all 3 trips to Akron. LTH ('03) UCF trailed 21-3 at HT and were outFD 30-15 and outgained 504-317 in the 38-24 loss. The Knights are 2-11 in road openers (beat Buf '10 & NCS '07).

First meeting. O'Leary and Urban Meyer squared off in '06 (only time as HC's) when UCF lost 42-0 at #7 Florida. Into 2012, the Knights are 3-17 since 2002 in non-conf away gms (1-7 the L/8).

LY (1st meeting) UCF was up 7-0 and driving late 2Q but FIU got a 51 yd FR td and took the momentum into HT. The Knights are 13-3 in home openers. UCF is 1-9 L16Y vs instate opp's (only W in '03 vs FAU).

Bonus: Into 2012, UCF is 16-12 on the CUSA road but went 0-4 last year.

First Meeting. The Knights are 1-10 hosting current BCS schools but LY beat Boston College. Into '12, UCF is 24-9 at Bright House which opened in '07. Under O'Leary UCF is just 4-10 off a bye wk.

HT is 4-1. LY's loss eliminated UCF from a bowl. The score was tied for a 4th time at 31 when UCF allowed a 68/4pl drive (56 yd td run) w/2:10. UCF ret'd the KO 72 yds but were int'd in the EZ 4 plays later.

UCF is 1-6 (4 str losses by just 7 ppg). LY these tms exchanged scores 6 different times in the 4Q. Trailing by 7 UCF went 89/12pl hitting a 25 yd td pass as time exp'd. UCF down 1 elected to go for 2 but fired inc.

UCF has won 7 of 8 with the only loss in '90 (1st meeting). LTH UCF had already locked up a spot in the CUSA Title gm but showed no letdown (led 37-10 late 4Q).

UCF is 3-2 in Huntington incl 3 str wins. LTH was a Wed Night "White Out" but UCF controlled leading 28-7 early 3Q. The gm did not have a HT due to a 1 hr 8 min lighting delay w/6:12 2Q.

UCF is 3-1 vs SMU. LY the Knights trailed 17-0 and 24-3 into the 4Q. UCF gained 40% (184) of their yds in the 4Q. Into '12, the Knights are 22-9 hosting CUSA foes (11-2 L3Y) since joining in '05.

LTH ('08) UCF lost 58-13 despite a +2 FD edge. The Knights committed 6 TO's & allowed a blk'd punt that resulted in 34 UTEP pts. UCF is 9-3 since 2007 in Nov road games.

In only trip to Tulsa ('08), UCF lost 49-19 to #22 TU. UCF had a 19-14 HT lead but gained just 38 2H yds. In the 7 yrs of the CUSA Champ these 2 have appeared a comb 6 times incl against each other in '05 & '07.

UCF has never lost 2 str in this series. LY UCF led 14-7 after 1Q but were held scoreless till the 4Q.

After taking a 24-23 lead UCF allowed a 61/13pl drive & 40 yd fg w/2:1. UCF is 5-1 in home finales.
