

QUARTERBACKS - In '09 a pair of true frosh battled for the job. Tate Forcier (PS#16, IFS) threw for 2,050 (59%, 13-10) while Denard Robinson (PS#35, 10.28 100m) threw for 188 (45%, 2-4, 351 rush). In '10 Robinson was the Heisman frontrunner at midseason. In '09 six FBS QB's had passed for 1,000 and ran for 900 and Robinson accomplished that in just 5 gms. He was also the first FBS QB to run for 200 and pass for 200 in the same gm twice in a yr. Due to his slight frame and heavy workload Robinson got banged up (left 10 gms w/ inj). Robinson broke the all-time NCAA ssn rush record by a QB ('96 AF's Beau Morgan 1,494) with 1,702 (6.6) while throwing for 2,570 (63%, 18-11). True frosh Devin Gardner (PS#4) played in 4. Forcier transferred LY and while new HC Brady Hoke orig planned to go with a pro-style off, they adapted to Robinson's strengths and while he ran less, he still led with 1,176 (5.3). He now has 6 of the B10's top 10 all-time rush gms by a QB. Robinson came into the Minn game completing under 50% but hit his first 11. His passing % dropped to 55.0 (2173 yds, 20-15). Gardner played in 9 (11-23, 47.8%, 176 yd, 53 rush) as part of a 2 QB pkg and he was also at WR in spg. Russell Bellomy (6'3" 189 rFr, PS#69) RS. Hoke will stick with the spread one more yr and Robinson should have even stronger numbers.

RUNNING BACKS - Mike Hart left as UM's career rush leader in '07. In Rodriguez's first 2 yrs the top RB rusher had just 533 (5.2) in '08 and 502 (5.2) in '09, the fewest yds s/'63. Vincent Smith (PS#56) led with 601 (4.4) in '10 while Michael Shaw was #2 with 402 (5.4). True frosh power back Stephen Hopkins had 151 (4.1). Fitzgerald Toussaint (PS#28) had a shoulder inj as a true (RS) and a leg inj in '10 (87, 10.9). He was not listed among the top 3 RB's into Aug '11 but rushed for 80 (7.3) in the opener. He had one 100 yd gm in the first 7 then rattled off efforts of 170, 192, 138 and 120 and led the RB's with 1,041 (5.6). Smith had 118 vs EM but did not top 50 in any other game (298, 6.0) but did have a rush, rec and pass td vs Minny. While Smith is small (5'6" 172), he is constantly noted for his toughness. Hoke was very high on both of his true frosh RB's in Thomas Rawls (RB cch Jackson compares to Mark Ingram) and Justice Hayes (5'10" 176 rFr, PS#16, quick, good rec). This year Shaw departs (1 st, 199, 6.4) as does FB John McColgan (1 st) but with the top 2 back they look stronger again.

RECEIVERS - Roy Roundtree, who emerged in Nov '09 with 26 rec to finish #1 (434, 13.6), st'd all 12 in '10 and led with 935 (13.0) including a UM record 246 vs III (Jack Clancy 197, '66). Darryl Stonum (PS#12) was #2 with 633 (12.9) and Junior Hemingway (PS#17) was #3 with 593 (18.5). LY they had 2 of

the top 3 back (lost Stonum). Roundtree's numbers dropped to 355 (18.7) while Hemingway led with 699 (20.6). Jeremy Gallon (PS#25) who is 5'8" but can dunk a basketball and is a physical blocker, made just 1 start but was #2 (453, 14.6). TY they lose Hemingway (12 st, #7DC KC), TE Kevin Koger (12 st, 244, 10.6), TE Steve Watson (4 st, 1 rec), Kelvin Grady (3 st, 5 rec) and Martavious Odoms (4 st, 131, 18.7). With 2 of their top 3 rec's back they could top LY's stats.

**OFFENSIVE LINE** - LY they had to replace 2 st'rs (#6DC) and 1 bkp. LG Ricky Barnum only st'd 3 (inj) but they did have 4 back with 7+ sts and those 4 st'd every reg ssn game. Despite the switch in offense (Robinson 500 fewer yds rush), they still managed 222 ypg (5.2) with 18 sks all'd (6.3%). TY they lose 1st Tm AA Rimington winner C David Molk (12 st, 3Y st'r, #7DC SD), RT Mark Huyge (13 st, 3Y st'r) and C Rocko Khoury (1 st) but have 7 of the top 10 back. The career sts ret are almost identical (64) but don't underestimate the loss of Molk with C being an important part of this O-line.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '06 UM all'd just 43 ypg rush (1.9) their best ypc s/71. The results the next 4 yrs were unexpectedly poor. In '09 they yielded 172 ypg rush (4.4). In '10 they had to replace a #1DC but 5 of the top 6 ret. DT Mike Martin battled ankle inj's and the D shockingly all'd 189 ypg (4.4) rush (worst s/68, 199) with 18 sks. LY they had to replace 2 DL (10 st, 54 tkl, 4 sk) and moved back to a 4-3. I said they should be much improved. This unit was one of the key factors in UM's rise to 11 wins as they all'd 132 ypg rush (best s/'06) and 4.0 ypc with 30 sks. TY they lose 2x 2nd Tm B10 DT Mike Martin (13 st, 64 tkl, 3.5 sks, 2.5 tfl, #3DC TEN), DE Ryan Van Bergen (12 st, 45 tkl, 12.5 tfl) and DT Will Heininger (12 st, 23 tkl, 4 tfl). They add in 5 VHT DL and this may finally be the yr William Campbell lives up to his PS#2 billing but overall this unit is less exp'd (3 ret sts to 1). **LINEBACKERS** - In '09 and '10 UM had a veteran LB

corps but the def #'s were poor with their 35.2 ppg in '10, being the worst in program history. LY they had to replace their #1 (#2DC) and #6 (7 st) tkl'rs but did return their #3 and #4 tkl'rs comb 20 st). Cam Gordon (13 st, 77 tkl in '10) played in just 7 (back inj). UM cut their ppg by more than half to just 17.4. TY they lose Brandon Herron (1 st, 8 tkl) and JB Fitzgerald (12 tkl). They return their top 4 LB's (#1, #5, #9 #10 tkl) plus Gordon and some solid recruits. While I don't expect the ppg to improve much, this is clearly a more exp'd and deeper LB corps

**DEFENSIVE BACKS** - UM dropped from #27 in my PDR in '07 under Carr to #68 in '08 and #62 in '09. In '10 they lost their top CB Troy Woolfolk (inj) and 2 bkp DB's prior to the ssn. They also lost CB JT Floyd after 8 sts and moved a FS to LB. The unit's most exp'd DB had just 8 sts in SS Jordan Kovacs. UM plummeted to their worst finish in my PDR (#106). LY they had to replace 1.5 st'rs but got back Woolfolk. I summed up LY by saying that UM would have one of the biggest rises in my PDR in '11 and they moved up 62 spots to #44 (59.1%, 12-9). TY they lose Woolfolk (10 st, 30 tkl, 2 pbu) and Carvin Johnson (14 tkl, 1 pbu). They have 3 full-time st'rs back plus 2 who comb for 10 sts making this unit even more experienced and they will move up again.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In Rich Rodriguez's first 2 yrs, UM was #15 and #5 in my ST rankings. Not a lot went right in '10 (#109). One of the most troubled areas was FG kicking (4-14 L37). Hoke said Brendan Gibbons (1-5 '10) was very consistent in Aug and true frosh Matt Wile would handle long FG's. Gibbons did better than expected (13-17, L43). Wile (0 FG att) had 19 TB on 79 KO (41.6, 17 punts). William Hagerup, who avg 43.6 (36.1 tm net) in 10 saw his avg drop to 36.0 (tm net 33.4, #109 FBS) The PR #'s were avg but the KR's were horrid (18.4, #117 FBS) UM finished #75 and I look for a large rise this year

COACHES - Rich Rodriguez was under scrutiny from the very beginning for not being a "Michigan Man". While not an alum Brady Hoke was an asst here for 8 yrs ('95-'02) before taking the HC job at Ball St (34-39). After getting BSU to their highest ever rank (#12), Hoke took over at SDSt which had not had a winning ssn s/98. In his 2nd yr he left after earning MW COY leading SDSt to their best record s/77. His SDSt OC Al Borges followed him here and was also the OC at Aub ('04-'07), Ind ('02-'03), Cal ('01), UCLA ('96-'00), Oreg ('95) and Boise St ('93-'94). Greg Mattison was the DC here from '95-'96 and an NFL DC for BAL ('08-'10) as well as DC for Fla ('05-'07) and ND ('97-'01). Mattison is the B10's highest paid asst and earned every penny in '11 (ppg from 35.2 to 17.4, ypg from 451 to 322)

# RECAST FU

Heading into '08 the Wolverines had 40 str winning seasons (33 consec bowls), the NCAA's longest streaks. In 12 of Lloyd Carr's 13 seasons, they finished the season in the Top 25 (5 in Top 10). They had been to 3 of the last 5 Rose Bowls and nearly played in the Nat'l Title game in '06 (#2 into final gm). Carr's final game was a Capital One Bowl win over #9 Florida but in '08 I did not have Michigan ranked in my top 50! Rodriguez did not have a mobile QB to fit his system in '08 and UM stunningly went 3-9 (-112 ypg Big Ten, 2nd worst). In '09 UM opened 4-0, climbing to #22. The bottom dropped out again and they suffered their 7th str Big Ten loss to Ohio St (-107 ypg worst). They did have just 8 Sr's on the 2 deep so the Wolves made my Most Improved List in '10 (-12 in TO's '09). On my summer radio show circuit, I set the magic number for Rich Rod to keep his job at 8 figuring 7-5 and a bowl loss would not be enough. UM looked explosive early at 5-0 and avg 41.4 ppg. Again they went just 2-6 down the stretch (lost Ohio St 37-7) and after the worst bowl loss in schl hist to Miss St (52-14), the Rich Rod era was over. UM did "improve" to just -1.9 ypg in Big Ten play (#5) and were -10 in TO's. Brady Hoke wants to run a pro-style attack but inherited Rich Rod's spread personnel, namely their #1 weapon QB Robinson. His orig plan was to run the 40% spread, 60% pro-style but that went out the window early as they took advantage of Robinson's skills. The opener vs WM was cut short due to lightning with 1:27 left in the 3Q and 2 def td's gave them the win, 34-10 (17-17 FD). They trailed ND 24-7 after 3Q's. It was the first ever night game at Michigan Stadium and D Rob got a 16 yd td pass with :02 left and they pulled out the 35-31 win (key play of ssn). After expected wins over EM and SDSt, they handed Minn their worst B10 shutout in schl hist, 58-0. They were on the ropes vs NW down 24-14 at half but rallied for a 42-24 win. "Little Brother" MSU beat them by 14 but they whipped Pur (294-119 yd edge 1H), 36-14. They had 4 shots at the EZ from the 3 but threw 4 inc passes and came up short vs Iowa 24-16. They demolished III (249-30 yd 1H), 31-14. It was 17-10 at half vs Neb and TO's turned it into a 45-17 blowout. While it wasn't easy, they ended their 7 gm losing streak to "Ohio", 40-34. In the bowl VT had 377-184 yd and 22-12 FD edges but UM prevailed 23-20 (OT) and they finished 11-2 and the highest ranked B10 team in the cch's poll at #9 (#12 AP). TY UM has 13 ret sts and their +130.8 ypg in B10 play was 2nd best. Pointing downward are the fact that they benefitted from 3 net close wins, were +7 in TO's, had beneficial off (12.2) and def (18.5) ypp's and my Stock Market Indicator (pg 27) has them -5.0. This is an improved tm that probably won't match LY's 11 win total with gms away from home vs Alabama, ND, Neb and Ohio St but unlike LY, they could find themselves in the B10 Title game.
