## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2012

**QUARTERBACKS** - Jason White became the first OU QB to win the Heisman in '03. In his final 2 yrs he threw for 7,051 (63%, 75-19). In '07 I projected rFr Sam Bradford (PS#20) to start (3-way battle) and he led the FBS in pass eff. In '08 he won the Heisman setting a then FBS pass eff record (180.8, 50-8 ratio). In '09 Bradford turned down the NFL but was OFY vs Texas. RFr Landry Jones (PS#3), who barely won the #2 job threw for 3,198 (58%, 26-14). Jones had his ups and downs (5 int vs Neb) but threw for 418 in the bowl and eclipsed Bradford's OU Fr passing mark. In '10 Jones threw for 4,718 (66%, 38-12, schl rec 405 comp). He tied Bradford's schl record for pass yds with 468 vs Okla St. RFr Drew Allen (pocket passer) hit 9-14-89 (5 gm). Jones was a clear Heisman frontrunner going into LY but his numbers dropped off in the last 4 games when he lost his security blanket, WR Ryan Broyles. Jones threw for 4,463 (63.2%) but his ratio dropped to 29-15 with Blake Bell stealing some tds's running the ball in the GL offense. Jones set an OU rec with 505 vs K-St despite 30 mph wind gusts. When targeting Broyles, Jones did not throw an int but had a 1-6 ratio without him. OU installed the Belldozer package in the final 6 with the 6'6" 245 lb Bell (PS#3) running like Tim Tebow. Bell hit 1-4 passes but rushed for 171 (3.9) and 13 td's. Bell had 3 td's in the bowl but was a ? choice as Bowl MVP (only 10 plays). Added to the mix is Kendal Thompson (6'2" 183 rFr, PS#24). Jones should have his best year as a senior.

**RUNNING BACKS** - DeMarco Murray topped Joe Washington (5881, '72-'75) for car all-purp yds (6718, '07-'10). He led with 1,214 rush (4.3) in '10 but also led all FBS RB's with 71 rec (594, 8.4). Electric true frosh Roy Finch (PS#16) missed 6 (inj) but still had 398 (4.7). Fellow true frosh Brennan Clay (PS#7) added 127 (3.5) and HC Bob Stoops said that Trey Millard (209 tti yds '10) could be his best ever FB. LY they had to replace Murray (#3DC) and added Brandon Williams (PS#5, IFS). The ? was who would start - Williams, Finch or Clay? Surprisingly the answer turned out to be walk-on Dominique Whaley. Whaley broke Adrian Peterson's OU position records for the standing broad jump (11'1"), VL (40.5") and squat lift (525) and runs a 4.39 (Peterson 4.37). Williams had just 219 (4.8) in 8 gms. Whaley led with 627 (5.5) in just 7 gms but was then OFY (inj). Finch, who is too small (5'7" 166) to be a feature back, was #2 with 605 (5.5). Clay was #3 with 274 (3.7) and Millard was #6 with 169 (7.0). TY

they only lose Williams (transfer). There are 2 VHT newcomers and I look for improved production from the OU RB's.

**RECEIVERS** - In '10 the top 3 WR's were back. Biletniokoff finalist Broyles (FBS best 131 rec) had an amazing ssn (1622, 12.4). True frosh Kenny Stills (PS#13) was #2 with 786 (12.9). True frosh Trey Franks had 263 (9.1) and TE James Hanna 292 (16.2). LY Broyles became the NCAA's all-time career leader in total rec and had a schl rec 217 yds vs KU to take that spot in style. Unfortunately he was lost to an ACL and the offense was much less effective in the final 4 games. Stills (miss 2) was #2 with 849 (13.9) and Jaz Reynolds (miss 3) #3 with 715 (17.4). TY they lose Hanna (13 st, 381, 14.1, #6DC DAL), Broyles (9 st, #2DC DET), WR Dejuan Miller (4 st, 245, 11.1), WR Kamel Jackson (2 st, 165, 13.8) and TE Trent Ratterree (10 rec). I like the talent and unlike LY, they probably will not go into shock without Broyles. They do add in PS#4 Trey Metoyer (star of spg) as well as PS#9, #19 and #21 true frosh and a PS#8JC.

**OFFENSIVE LINE** - In '08 OU's OL had 130 car sts ret (#1 FBS) with all 5 st's listed as NFL prospects. They opened holes for 199 ypg rush (4.7) with 13 sks (2.5%). In '09 this unit was largely to blame for their 8-5 ssn as they had to replace 4 multi-year st's (#2, #5 DC's) and plummeted to 135 ypg (3.6) but with just 15 sks (2.9%). OU st'd 10 diff OL lineups. In '10 they had to replace 2.5 st's (#1DC) but had 8 w/st exp. Surprisingly, their numbers dropped to 3.3 ypg (21 sks, 3.3%). LY OU had to replace a 1st Tm B12 RT and 2 bkps but had 4 st's back. I said the unit, after being a weakness for 2 yrs, should become a strength and even though they lost C Ben Habern for 6 gms, they moved up to 163 (4.5, 11 sks, 1.9%). TY they lose LT Donald Stephenson (13 st, 2Y st'r, #3DC KC) and LG Stephen Good (2 st). Conv DL Lane Johnson (12 st) is now in his 2nd yr and moves from RT to LT and they add a PS#14JC. With 102 car sts returning, this should be OU's best O-line s/'08.

**DEFENSIVE LINE** - The Sooners always have an excellent D-line. In '09 DT Gerald McCoy turned down the NFL and they had all 4 st's back. The rush D improved to 93 ypg (2.8) while Jeremy Beal led with 11 sks. In '10 they had to replace 2 st's (McCoy #1DC). DT Adrian Taylor (13 st '09) was never 100% then was OFY midseason. Beal was named the B12 DPOY but it was an inexp'd group. They slipped to 149 ypg rush (4.1), their weakest s/'97. LY they had to replace Beal (#7DC), Taylor and 2 bkp. Ronnell Lewis (PS#6) st'd the final 4 in '10 but his eligibility saga dragged on thru Aug. Only one DL st'd more than 9 (Frank Alexander, Hendricks finalist). OU did improve to 135 ypg (3.7) with 40 sks. TY they lose Big 12 co-Def POY Alexander (13 st, 54 tkl, 8.5 sk, 10.5 tfl, #4DC CAR) and Lewis (9 st, 59 tkl, 5.5 sk, 7.5 tfl, #4DC DET) but should continue to improve their rush D.

**LINEBACKERS** - In '09 OU ret'd 5 of their top 6 LB's and got back Ryan Reynolds (PS#3, inj '08). Travis Lewis, who also broke Brian Bosworth's OU frosh rec for tkl (144, B12 FrYr), earned 1st Tm B12 and OU all'd just 14.5 ppg (best s/'01). In '10 they had to replace 2 st's (#3, #4 tkl'r). Of OU's top 7 LB's, 5 were soph or frosh and the unit was hit hard by inj's as they slipped to 21.8 ppg. LY Lewis (#1 tkl'r) turned down the NFL but was only about 80% (foot inj). They also suffered the tragic death of MLB Austin Box in May. OU had similar numbers (22.1 ppg). TY they lose Lewis (12 st, #2 tkl'r, 4 tfl, #7DC DET) but return 4 of their top 6 (#4, #7 tkl'rs). Despite being a little less exp'd and losing their top guy, this unit looks stronger and is loaded with 9 VHT's.

**DEFENSIVE BACKS** - OU always fares well in my PDR and despite losing 3 st's were #11 in '08 (see more in Hardcore Fans). LY they had to replace a 1st Tm AA FS (#4DC) and their SS (#7DC). Tony Jefferson split time between FS, SLB and NB and had 3 int in 1Q vs Ball St (#3 tkl'r). TY they lose CB Jamell Fleming (11 st, 60 tkl, 2 int, 10 pbu, #3DC ARZ) and FS Sam

Proctor (3 st, 28 tkl). The DB's nicknamed themselves "The Sharks" LY but despite allowing several big plays vs TT, BU and OSU, the unit finished #8 in my PDR (54.2%, 18-15) and TY have their most exp in yrs and Mike Stoops back as a mentor.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - In Stoops' first 9 yrs his ST units were a strength with 6 top 13 finishes. Surprisingly in '08 they plummeted to #101 (all'd 4 KR td's). In '09 I expected a move back up to their usual spot and they finished #12 despite not settling on a K. P Tress Way was #5 in the FBS with a 40.3 net. In '10 (everyone back), they surprisingly dropped to #37 (4 more ret TD). Stoops bypassed FG's at times in '10 so he bought insurance with 4 schlp K's LY. Jimmy Stevens (38-48 career FG) hit 4-4 FG but was inj after 2 and OFY. RFr Michael Hunnicutt hit 21-24 (L53) incl his final 10. Trey Franks was the top KR (23.9) and Way had 34 punts 120. OU finished #16 and have almost everyone back.

**COACHES** - Bob Stoops arrived in '99 and won a Nat'l Title in his 2nd season. OU then played in the Nat'l Title gm in '03, '04 and '08. OU's 132 wins the L12Y are more than any other BCS team. The OC position has gone from Mike Leach to Mark Mangino to Chuck Long to Kevin Wilson and Stoops has never looked beyond his existing staff to fill it. Jay Norvell is in his 3rd season as co-OC while 7Y QB cch Josh Heupel is in his 2nd. Mike Stoops returns as DC ('99-'03) after being Arizona's HC the last 8 yrs. The D was run by the same co-DC's for the LBY in Brent Venables (to Clemson) and Bobby Jack Wright (still DE cch).

## PHIL'S FORECAST

In '00 Okla did not have a starter miss a single gm due to inj. They stunned the nation winning the Nat'l Title despite not being in the preseason Top 20. In '02 OU won the Big 12 Title and the Rose Bowl. In '03 OU lost the conf title gm and the Nat'l Title gm vs LSU. In '04 they were 12-0 but lost the Nat'l Title game vs USC, 55-19. In '05 OU slumped to 8-4 before winning the Big 12 Title the next 3 yrs but lost 3 straight BCS bowls (2 large upsets in Fiesta) while finishing #11, #8 and #5. In '09 OU lost QB Bradford and TE Jermaine Gresham to inj's early on and finished 8-5. Despite their 5-3 B12 record, they were +133 ypg (#1). In '10 I picked the Sooners as my #1 Surprise Team. OU moved to 6-0 but at #1 went down with ESPN Gameday on hand at Missouri. OU had 3 trips inside the MU15 result in zero pts (2 TO, miss FG). At half, Okla had a 301-99 yd edge but trailed 17-14. The redzone problems crept up again vs A&M as they were SOD on 1&g1 3 times, had a fake FG incomp pass and missed a FG. OU still won the Big 12 Title and blew out #25 Conn 48-20 in the Fiesta Bowl to finish #6 (+161.3 ypg in B12 #1). They were +14 in TO's, had 5 net close wins and only 4 sts lost in '10, all key indicators pointing downward but entered '11 #1 AP. There was a huge build up to their road trip to Fla St but OU prevailed, 23-13 (FSU lost QB 3Q). They trailed Missouri 14-3 in the 1Q in a letdown spot but won, 38-28. OU rolled over Ball St by 56, won the RRR by 38 (+44 TO's) then beat Kansas by 30. There was a 1.5 hr weather delay prior to their TT gm and they were stunningly upset at home, ending a 39 gm Owen Field streak. OU took on #10 K-St on the road and trailed 17-14 but won 58-17. They knocked off A&M by 16 but were stunned vs Baylor. Top RB Whaley was already OFY when they lost top WR Broyles and QB Jones did not throw a td pass in the final 3 reg ssn gms w/o Broyles. After knocking off Iowa St, OU was a no show vs Okla St on the road (lost 44-10). They only led 24-14 when Iowa was SOD in its own terr and OU tacked on a td in the final seconds of the bowl. OU finished #16 AP. LY OU had 2 net close losses, were -2 in TO's and their +113.3 ypg was #1 in the B12. With Jones turning down a shot at the NFL, they have 15 ret sts and 8 of my 9 sets of power ratings call for a 12-0 season!

OU is 62-8 S/'35 vs KSU (OU's last reg ssn loss was in '97). LY QB Jones passed for a OU rec 505 yds. Sooners trailed 17-14 w/12:44 2Q but from that point on ran off 44 unanswered and outgained KSU 472-108.

LY marked OU's 1st loss ever to BU (20-1). Tied 38-38 w/51:40 QB went 80/5pl hitting a 34 yd td pass w/08 left!		
OU is 2-2 vs WV but this marks the 1st trip to Morgan-town. L'gm was the '07 Fiesta Bowl, OU lost 48-28.		
OU last lost 2 str gms in '01 & '02. LY OU suffered its worst Bedlam loss S/'45 (shutout 47-0, next yr won 73-12).		
Visitor is 8-2 S/'45. LTH ('98) OU had a 260-198 yd edge. OU trailed 9-0 at HT but hit a fg w/10 left for the 1 pt win.
