4th meeting w/last gm in Provo ('90). BYU won 50-36. The Cougars are 10-4 in LaVell Edwards openers (11 vs BCS tms, 7-4). The BCS started in '98 and since BYU is 9-7 when hosting a BCS school. BYU is 2-0 but this is the first gm S/79. Utah, USU, Weber St & BYU play for the Beehive Boot. WSU went 5-6 LY in losses at WY (35-32) and Utah St (54-17). These instate programs are 80 miles apart. Since 1922 this series is called the Desert First Duel. 88th "Holy War". BYU is 3-7 incl 2 str losses. LTH BYU led 13-0 into the 4Q but down 1, had a 42 yd fg blk'd as time expired. BYU is 0-2 vs Boise St incl a 28-27 loss in the L/meeting ('04) on the blue turf. BYU battled back from down 16-0 to take the lead 27-22 into the 4Q. The Cougars then allowed a 57/3pl 44 yd td pass w/3:42 left. BYU has won 8 of 9 and have never lost to Hawai'i in Provo (8-0). LY BYU trailed 13-10 at HT but limited UH to 11 2H yds until a garbage td w/5:55 left as the Cougars opened the 2H with 31 unanswered. BYU is 21-2 S/83 vs USU. LY in a revenge gm the Cougars trailed 24-13 w/12:43 left but went on a 60 yd td drive and 2 poss later a 96/9pl GW drive hitting a 13 yd td pass w/11 left to complete the comeback. HC Mendenhall is an OSU alumni (2Y str at S/LB & Capt). He was on staff in '89-'90 & again in '95-'96. LY's gm was tied 14-14 at HT but BYU scored 24 of the gms next 31 pts into the 4Q (OSU td w/23 left). First of a 6 game agreement with Notre Dame. The Cougars are 2-4 all-time vs the Fighting Irish (1st gm in '92) including just 1-3 in South Bend (only win here was in 1994). BYU is 1-1 vs GT with the visitor dropping both. LTH ('02) was the schools first meeting. BYU led 19-14 into the 4Q but allowed a 73/12pl td drive and a 54/9pl td drive (2 yd run) w/5:03 left.

LY was the 1st gm S/55. BYU rolled as they led 42-0 mid-3Q. BYU has won 6 str home finales by 22 ppg. In the L3Y the Cougars are 7-0 off a bye w/an avg score of 46-14. BYU is 6-1 in the LY7 gms vs SJSU. BYU is 1-5 in San Jose but the last visit was in 1968 (lost 25-21). In LY's meeting (Gm 6) QB Nelson made his first start replacing an inj'd Heaps.

LY was the schools 1st and only meeting. BYU will conclude their two yr agreement with the WAC ('11-'12) that was designed to meet short-term scheduling needs after going Independent.
