POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2012

QUARTERBACKS - As a rFr in '09 Collin Klein got in 2 sts at WR (6 rec) and also played spec tms. In '10 he was the surprise starter vs Texas and rushed for a KSU QB record 127 and reset that record with 141 vs MO. He had just 18 pass att's (138 yds) on the yr while rushing for 432 (5.7). LY they added BC/Blinn JC trans Justin Tuggle (PS#28) but there was little question that the job was Klein's in spg. Klein had a phenomenal year (1st Tm all-ppr B12) as his 27 rushing td's tied a B12 record (Heisman winner Ricky Williams, '98) and FBS rec for QB's (Ricky Dobbbs, '09). He rushed for 1,141 (3.6) and threw for 1,918 (57.3%), 13-6 despite missing 2 wks of practice prior to A&M and Texas because his body was so banged up (#3 FBS carries). Bkp Sammuell Lamur hit 6-8 for 52 yds in 3 gms and now departs. It will be tough for Klein to improve much upon LY's stats (3059 tll yds, 40 td), but he's one of my favorite QB's to watch in college football.

RUNNING BACKS - KSU's leading rusher in '08 had just 412 (3.5). In '09 Daniel Thomas (PS#25JC) became the first Wildcat to open his career with B2B 100 yd gms s/66 (Cornelius Davis). Thomas recorded the 11th 1,000 yd ssn in KSU hist with 1,265 (5.1). In '10 Thomas opened with the best 3 gm stretch in KSU history (552, 6.7) but failed to top Darren Sproles' single season record (1986 in '03) finishing with 1,585 (5.3). LY they had to replace Thomas (#2DC) and Tenn transfer Bryce Brown (PS#1) was actually the only Wildcat on the media's preseason All-Big 12 tm. Brown's work ethic proved ? opening the door for diminutive 5'7" John Hubert to have a fine ssn. Hubert is a powerful runner (lower body strength) who ran for 970 (4.8, 3rd Tm B12). Angelo Pease (PS#74JC) is a power back with breakout speed who added 144 (4.0). Robert Rose is just 5'4" 173 (35, 3.9). Brown played in just 2 (left midssn, #7DC PHI). This year all of the key players are back making this unit much more exp'd.

RECEIVERS - KSU had one of the country's least exp'd rec corps in '10. The top returnee was TE Travis Tannahill (37 yds '09!). Brodrick Smith was #1 (191, 13.6) when he broke his leg (gm 5). Aubrey Quarles, who had 407 (12.0) in '08 and RS in '09, led w/760 (14.9). Chris Harper (PS#17QB, 12 gm true Oreg '08) was #2 (330, 13.2). Traimaine Thompson missed 6 but was #4 (258, 13.6). LY they had to replace Quarles but the unit was thought to be one of the off's strengths. Harper led with 547 (13.7) and Thompson had 388 (16.1). Tyler Lockett was #3 (246, 13.7) despite missing the final 4 and was B12's Fr OPOY (315 all-ppr vs Okla St). TY they lose Sheldon Smith (5 st, 177, 8.0) but have by far their most exp'd rec corps in 3 yrs. They also add in VHT JC Marquez Clark (PS#18) and I look for much improved production.

OFFENSIVE LINE - KSU had to replace 3 st'rs in Snyder's first yr back ('09) but still improved to 180 ypg rush (4.3) with 26 sks (8.7%). In '10 they had to replace 1 st'r (63 car st ret) and improved to 199 ypg (4.7, 31 sk, 10.6%). LY they had to replace 3 st'rs who comb for 6.5 yrs of st exp incl two 2nd Tm B12 OL. They ret'd 5 w/st exp (42 car sts) but then lost LT Manase Foketi after 2 st (13 st '10). With a dynamic, mobile QB like Klein, they only dropped to 185 ypg (4.0) but did allow 43 sks (14.8%). TY they lose 2nd Tm B12 LT Zach Hanson (11 st), 1st Tm B12 RT Clyde Aufner (3Y st'r), RG Colten Freeze (12 st) and C Shaun Simon (1 st) will RS. With the return of Foketi, they have 3 who have been full-time st'rs (42 car sts) and add in PS#40 and #72 JC's.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In Ron Prince's final yr as KSU's HC this unit all'd 218 rush ypg (5.2), their highest s/90. In '09 they essentially had 2.5 st'rs back and the rush D all'd just 105 ypg (3.5). In '10 they had to replace 2 st'rs and 3 bkps (comb 5 st). Snyder signed 3 VHT JUCO's and they used a FB and an OL on the DL as they lacked depth. Still, I was surprised as they plummeted to allowing 231 ypg (5.9), their worst s/89. LY they had to replace 3 st'rs but added in PS#17 and #11 JC's (all 4 st'rs were JC's). KSU improved to 131 ypg (4.0, 23 sk). TY they lose 1st Tm B12 DT Ray Kibble (38 tkl, 2 sk), 1st Tm B12 DE Jordan Voelker (13 st, 29 tkl, 4.5 sk) and DT Raphael Guidry (2 st, 12 tkl). I expect an even bigger impact from pass rush specialist Meshak Williams (PS#17JC, 28 tkl, 7 sk, HM B12) and Snyder brings in another JUCO PS#70JC (IFS). This unit is more experienced and should continue to improve.

LINEBACKERS - In '10 KSU had to replace their #3 and #5 tkl'rs (ret #6 & #8). They played a 4-2-5 and slipped to 29.1 ppg. Alex Hrebec was their #1 tkl'r when he suffered an elbow inj (#3, 77). True ssn Tre Walker (2 st, 47 tkl) was compared to Josh Buhl (KSU ssn rec'd 184 tkl '03). LY I said the speedier LB corps should spearhead a much more formidable D. All five LB's who st'd in '10, ret'd and they got the significant addition of Miami, FI transfer Arthur Brown (PS#5, dominant on scout tm '10). KSU allowed 51 fewer ypg but surprisingly the ppg only went down to 27.9. TY they lose HM B12 WLB Emmanuel Lamur (9 st, #3 tkl'r, 6 tfl) and Hrebec (7 tkl). They return Brown (3rd tm AA, #1 tkl'r) and their #7 tkl'r and move in QB Justin Tuggle (son of former 5x Falcons Pro Bowl LB Jessie) and look even stronger.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - Snyder has always used a deep rotation in the secondary which allows them to offset large graduation losses. The Cats had 4 consec finishes in the top 10 of my PDR but then slipped to #19, #61 and #55 (lost all 4 st'rs) from '03-'05. Under Ron Prince ('06-'08) K-St finished #54, #73 and #72. In '09 they ret'd 2.5 st'rs and I called for them to have their best finish s/'03 and they were #48. In '10 they had to replace 1 st'r (#5DC) but slipped to #54. LY they had to replace 2 st'rs but had 3 back with 12 sts and added in 4 JC's. Given the record it was surprising they only finished #49 (63%, 26-18). Nigel Malone was KSU's first Thorpe semifinalist s/'02 (Terence Newman won it) and became the 3rd KSU DB to be a Walter Camp AA (Chris Canty '96, Newman '02). TY they lose 2nd Tm B12 FS Tysyn Hartman (13 st, 69 tkl, 3 int), 2x HM B12 CB David Garrett (13 st, 2 int, #2 tkl'r, 2 pbu) and S Matthew Pearson (27 tkl). This group is on par with '11 in terms of exp, but should move up in my PDR.

SPECIAL TEAMS - While not a lot went right in the Ron Prince era, KSU finished #1 in my ST rankings in '06, #3 in '07 and #7 in '08 (4 blk punt td's). In '09 they had to replace their K and PR but KR Brandon Banks had an amazing 4 td's (28.9) helping KSU finish #23. In '10 KSU moved up to #16 and LY returned their P Ryan Doerr (39.3 tm net) but lost their K, top KR (34.6) and AA LS. True frosh Tyler Lockett had 2 KR td's and his 35.2 avg was the best in B12 history (Chris Massey, Okla St, 34.8 '01). He was OFY after 9 gms but still earned 1st Tm KR AA honors. PR Traimaine Thompson improved to 12.3 in '11. Anthony Cantele hit

17-23 FG (L54). P Doerr avg 40.8 (36.7 net, 2 blk) but surprisingly they moved down to #40. With all of the key players back and a full ssn for Lockett, they will contend for the top spot in '12.

COACHES - Bill Snyder accomplished the greatest rebuilding job in college football history taking over a KSU team that had gone 0-21-1 in '87 and '88 (NCAA's worst comb rec in hist) and guided them to bowls in 11 str yrs ('93-'03). When Snyder opted to step aside after '05, his then 136 wins were the same amount of all of the previous KSU coaches comb s/351! The stadium was renamed Bill Snyder Family Stadium. "The Legend" ret'd in '09 and will turn 73 in Oct. LY he guided the Wildcats to their first ssn with DD wins s/03 earning several COY awards including mine. Dana Dimel and Del Miller are co-OC's for the 4th year. Dimel was the HC at Wyoming ('97-'99) and Houston ('00-'02). Miller (16th yr here) was the OC at SDSU ('06-'08). The new DC is Tom Hayes who coached the secondary LY and has been a DC at Kansas, Oklahoma, UCLA and Stanford.

PHIL'S FORECAST

From '97-'03 Bill Snyder had 11 wins in 6 out of 7 ssns but in his final 2 yrs ('04-'05) KSU slumped to 4-7 and 5-6 and he left to spend time with his family. Ron Prince was hired as HC in '06 and change was the buzzword. Most of Snyder's asst's either left or were booted out and many of the old players were shown the door. They even shifted from the read option to a more pass-based attack. Prince managed a 7-6 record in his first year but in the next 2 yrs after opening 5-3 and 4-2 the bottom fell out (5-7 both yrs). In '07 KSU all'd 401 ypg (30.8 ppg) and in '08, 479 ypg (35.8 ppg). That '08 squad was a Big 12 worst -151 ypg. Snyder had just 12 ret sts in '09 but made my Most Improved List as I had the only mgk to have them ahead of rival KU (media picked 5th). KSU did not disappoint me but lost the ssn final at Neb with the B12 North Title on the line to finish 5-5 and home for the holidays. KSU was -52.8 ypg in '09 (3rd worst) and -7 in TO's and in '10 had just 11 ret sts. I thought Snyder did a great job in '10 as KSU got to the Pinstripe Bowl at 7-5 but lost to Syr by 2. KSU was -97.9 ypg (#11 B12). LY they had 5 B12 HG's and I liked the influx of transfers. I picked them 6th in the B12 which was higher than any other major pressn publication and projected them to get back to a bowl. If you follow philsteele.com during the season you know that I have an upset pick each wk in my Top 25 forecast which I also feature when I am a guest on ESPN radio Sat mornings. KSU found themselves as my upset pick on a regular basis LY. In fact, KSU was 10-2 despite being a dog in 8 of their 12 reg ssn gms! Their first upset was on the road at Miami (led 14-3 half) as UM was SOD on 48gl at the 1 with -49 left. They upset RG3 & Co. 36-35. They were a HD vs Missouri but led 24-3 in the 4Q and won. They beat TT 41-34 despite being outgained 580-339 thanks to +4 TO's and a KR td. Snyder always puts a premium on beating his rival and they rolled to an easy 59-21 win at KU. Okla was off a loss and KSU led 17-14 late 2Q but OU dominated the 2H (58-17). They had a 1& gl at #3 Okla St's 5 with :05 left but 3 inc passes left them 7 pts short. They won in 4OT vs A&M at home and then were outgained by TX 310-121 but still won 17-13. They were outgained by Iowa St 368-360 but won 30-23 in their FHG. They lost the bowl to Ark, 29-16. KSU finished #2 in the B12 at 7-2 but shockingly were -106.8 ypg (2nd worst). TY they do have their most exp'd squad since Snyder's return with 14 ret sts but LY they benefitted from 7 net close wins, +12 in TO's, an off ypg of 10.6 (pg 309) and also come in with a -3.5 in my Stock Market Indicator (pg 27). TY's team is stronger than the '11 version but probably won't match their 10 win total.

KSU is 2-0 vs MSU. The L/gm was in '10, KSU won 48-24 (only +46 yds). The Bears went 2-9 LY incl losses at Ark (51-7) and Oregon (56-7). Wildcats have won 22 str home openers by 23 ppg.

LY was the first and only meeting. KSU trailed 24-21 early 4Q but went on a 80/8pl td drive with 10:00 left. UM had a 1&gl at the 2 with under 2 min left but KSU made the goal line stand.

KSU's only loss vs NT was in '85 (1st gm), since they have won 5 str by 28 ppg. In the L/gm ('10) NT led 20-7 into the 2Q but KSU scored 28 unanswered (still needed an int at midfield on L/play to preserve the win).

Wildcats have dropped 5 str vs the Sooners by 22 ppg. LTH ('09) KSU fell behind 21-0 into the 2Q (outgained 156-9 in 1Q) but got as close as 35-30 w/11:18 left. KSU is 3-7 in 'true' road openers (2-0 L2V).

KSU is 15-4 in the Sunflower Showdown. LY KSU led 21-0 mid-2Q as KU never got closer than 14 pts (KU scored a td w/0:1 left). Under Snyder, KSU is 9-1 hosting KU (only loss was his 1st yr at the helm '89).

KSU has had 4 str vs ISU but every gm has been decided by 8 pts or less. LTH ('07) KSU trailed 21-3 but only 28-20 into the 4Q. KSU's L4 drives ended in a missed fg, SOD at ISU1, int and end of 2H at ISU26.

This series is tied at 1-1 with both gms in Morgantown but the L/meeting was in 1931, KSU lost 19-0. Into '12, the Wildcats did go 3-1 in Big 12 road gms LY (best mark S/'02) but are 8-23 since 2004.

LY's win snapped a 5 gm series losing streak. KSU trailed 31-27 late 3Q before 14 str pts. TT got a fg and rec the onside kick w/2:32 left but was SOD on a 4&4 from their own 47 and KSU ran out the L/1:43.

LY's game was tied at 24 & at 45. Kansas St allowed a 65/4pl td w/1:02 left. KSU then started at their own 29 and had 1&gl at the 5 but threw 3 straight inc passes.

KSU is 2-3 vs TCU incl 3 straight losses by 16 ppg. LTH ('86) was also the last gm, KSU lost 35-22.

KSU is 7-2 vs BU. LTH was misleading as KSU never led & trailed 47-28 early 4Q scoring their final td w/0:07 left.

Texas: The Wildcats have won 4 str and are 6-2 vs the Longhorns. LY KSU led 17-3 late 3Q but had to hold off UT on their L/2 drives (SOD at T46 & midfield). Kansas St is 18-4 in Manhattan finales.
