

## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2012

OUARTERBACKS - Vince Young became the first player in NCAA history to have 2,500 pass and 1,000 rush yds in a season ('05) and left with a record of 30-2 as a starter. AFr Colt McCoy then took over as a 4 yr st'r from '06-'09. Unfortunately McCoy was inj'd in his final game (Nat'l Champ) and true frosh Garrett Gilbert replaced him (15-40 w/4 int vs Bama). McCoy threw for 3,521 (71%, 27-12) as a senior. He set the record for wins by a college QB (45) which was broken by Kellen Moore (Boise St) LY. Expectations were high in '10 for Gilbert and he finished as the #2 rusher (380, 3.8) while throwing for 2,744 but hit just 59% with a poor 10-17 ratio. LY was a 4-way battle in the new Boise St offense between Gilbert, soph Case McCov (PS#51, Colt's brother), rFr Connor Wood (PS#6) and true frosh David Ash (PS#16), Gilbert started the first 2 gms (48%, 1-2) but was benched (BYÚ) and had shoulder surgery. Ash and McCoy split the duties the rest of the ssn. Ash, who is known as more of a dual threat, surprisingly rushed for just 103 (1.4) while throwing for 1,068 (56.6%, 4-8). McCoy started the final 2 gms in the reg ssn (1045, 61.4%, 7-4) but had 5 TO's vs Baylor and Ash took every snap in the bowl. Both Wood and Gilbert transferred but

Texas will still have their best QB play s/09. **RUNNING BACKS** - Texas has had a terrific RB tradition incl Heisman Trophy winners Earl Campbell and Ricky Williams. Cedric Benson became just the 5th ply'r in NCAA hist to top 1,000 rush yds for 4 str yrs (incl 1834, 5.6, '04). Jamaal Charles led the RB's for 3 consec yrs (1619, 6.3, '07). The Horns top rusher in '08 had just 376 (4.3) and just 552 (4.8) in '09. One of the reasons I had UT rated lower than most in '10 was that I failed to see a feature RB on the roster. After 10 wks their leading rusher in gross yds was QB Gilbert. 250 lb Cody Johnson led with 592 (4.4). LY I projected true frosh Malcolm Brown (PS#1) to top 1,000. Brown was on his way (#1 rusher each of 1st 6) but missed 3 (742, 4.3). Brown and Joe Bergeron (PS#36) became the first pair of UT frosh RB's to top 100 in a gm (vs KU) and Bergeron then had 191 vs TT finishing #2 (463, 6.4). Vs Missouri both Brown and Bergeron were out then Fozzy Whittaker (QB in Wild Fozzy formation) was OFY in the 1Q ending with 386 (5.8). DJ Monroe (PS#27) led with 77 vs Baylor (326, 6.8). TY LB Chet Moss (6'2" 242 So, PS#30LB) moves to FB and Monroe moves to WR. They only lose Whittaker (6 st) and FB Johnson

(10 st. 200, 4.2), Brown and Bergeron should remain healthier and they add in PS#1 Johnathan Gray (home run threat) to the backfield. This is one of the nation's best RB corps

RECEIVERS - In '10 Texas had to replace Biletnikoff finalist Jordan Shipley (#3DC, 1485, 12.8) and James Kirkendoll led with 707 (13.6) while Mike Davis' 47 rec's set a school frosh record (BJ Johnson, 41 in '00). LY they had to replace their #1, #3 and #4 rec's. Marquise Goodwin (324, 10.5 in '10) was going to RS to train for the Olympics but ret'd in Wk2. True frosh Jaxon Shipley (Jordan's bro) was having a fine year but missed 3 (inj) and finished #2 (607, 13.8). Davis had issues with drops yet still led with 609 (13.5) and Goodwin was #3 with 421 (12.8). TY they lose WR Darius White (5 rec, PS#3), TE Blaine Irby (3 st, 11 rec), TE Darius Terrell (1 rec, PS#13) and TE Dominique Jones (5 st, 2 rec) but are much more exp'd in the 2nd yr of OC Bryan Harsin's offense.

OFFENSIVE LINE - Surprisingly UT has not had an OL drafted s/'08. In '10 they had to replace a 2nd Tm B12 C, a 2nd Tm AA LT and an HM B12 LG (2 st'rs ret). They still improved to 151 ypg rush (4.2, 18 sk, 4.0%). With just 2 strs back again LY (36 car sts), I said they could improve and they did (203, 4.5). The OL spent the summer preparing for Gilbert's vertical passing game, had a new OL coach and lacked depth with just 7 schlp OL. Soon after allowing a comb 13 sk in B2B losses to OU and OkSt, true frosh Josh Cochran beat out Tray Allen (PS#3) leaving 2 frosh and 2 soph st'rs. TY they lose LG David Snow (13 st, 2Y st'r) and LT Allen (6 st) but have 4 st'rs ret (63 car st). They add in a PS#9JC LT Donald Hawkins, making this their most veteran OL in 3 yrs and Mack Brown said that the improvement up front

was "night and day" this spring compared to a yr ago.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '10 UT had to replace 2.5 st'rs (2 DC's). Surprisingly, the Horns rush D all'd their highest ypg s/'03 139, 3.5). LY they lost a 1st Tm B12 DE (#4DC) and 2 others (comb 10 st). They had 10 DL ranking PS#25 or higher. The Horns allowed just 96 ypg rush (3.1, 29 sks). TY they lose DT Kheeston Randall (13 st, 34 tkl, 5 tfl, #7DC MIA) and DT Calvin Howell (7 st, 16 tkl, 1 sk). 1st Tm AA Alex Okafor (58 tkl, 7 sk) turned down the NFL and teams with Jackson Jeffcoat for one of the nation's best DE combos. Some have compared Desmond Jackson (PS#9) to former UT star and NFL'r Roy Miller in terms of toughness and work ethic (shares NT with hyped JC transfer Brandon Moore). The Horns are equal to LY in exp, have their top 2 DL back and

figure to be one of the top DL's in the country. NEBACKERS - In '10 UT had to replace a 2nd Tm B12 LB (#1 tkl'r) who was only the 2nd Horns LB to be drafted in the previous 15 yrs (#4DC). They did have 3 VHT signees (2 RS). They played 5 DB's a lot in '09 so while just 1 st'r ret'd in Keénan Řobinson (#3 tkľr), they also ret'd #9 Émmanuel Acho. UT allowed 23.7 ppg (7 ppg more than in '09). LY they had to replace 1 st'r (#9 tkl'r) but had their top 2 tkl'rs back ('10 VHT's). Acho earned 1st Tm B12 (13 st, 131 tkl, 19 tfl, #6DC CLE) and Robinson was 2nd Tm (13 st, 106 tkl, 10 tfl, #4DC WAS). Depth was an issue with Acho and Robinson playing virtually every snap. TY they lose their #1 and #2 tkl'rs and the top returnees are Jordan Hicks (PS#1, #6 tkl'r) and Steve Edmond (PS#5, 16 tkl true) who is 255 lbs but fast and physical. While this unit

is loaded with VHT's, they are less experienced. **DEFENSIVE BACKS** - In '10 the Horns had to replace 1 st'r (#1DC SS) but finished #15 in my PDR (162 ypg, 56.7%, 13-8). LY they had to replace 3 NFL DC's. Soph Quandre Diggs is nicknamed 'Quandre the Giant' (5'10" but plays like he's 10'5"). Ret st'r SS Christian Scott (sùsp, inj) lost hiś job but UT improved to #5 (56.6%, 13-12, 210 ypg). TY they lose NB Scott (4 st, 21 tkl, 4 pbu), FS Blake Gideon (13 st, #3 tkl'r, 4 pbu) and AJ White (6 tkl), With 3 st'rs back incl star S Kenny Vaccaro and 10 VHT's, UT will contend for my #1 pass D this year.

SPECIAL TEAMS - With Brown's past recruiting success, most of the bkps have been VHT's and contribute on ST. Since '00 they have finished #18, #10, #16, #15, #36, #1 (in '05), #12, #26, #10, #3 ('09), #48 and #23 in my ST rankings. LY K/P Justin Tucker hit a super 17-21 FG (L52), had 12 TB on 70 KO and avg 39.2 on punts (35.5 net). Quàndre Diggs was the top PR (20.1) and thanks to Fozzy Whittaker (10-42.4) the tm avg'd 24.1 on KR's. UT also blk'd 2 punts (both by frosh). This year they lose both Tucker and Whittaker and Brown claimed both K and P jobs are wide open out of the spring. They will drop some.

COACHES - Mack Brown took over a 4-7 team in '98 and took them to a bowl in 13 of 14 ssn. He has led UT to at least a share of six B12 South Titles and in '08 won the Bobby Dodd Nat'l COY. He is among the highest paid HC's in college FB with his contract extended in Jan through '20. Former UT QB great Major Applewhite ('98-'01) came here in '08 as an asst HC and LY was named co-OC along with Bryan Harsin who calls the plays and was Boise's OC from '06-'10. DC Manny Diaz is in his 2nd season and was the DC at Miss St ('10) and Middle Tenn ('06-'09).

# PHIL'S FORECAST

Mack Brown came into '05 with just a 1-12 record vs Top 5 tms but things changed in a big way. UT won at #4 Ohio St and after having lost 5 str to Okla, won 45-12. They beat defending Nat'l Champ #1 USC in the Rose Bowl to win their first National Title s/'70. In '06 they were #4 when QB McCoy was inj'd and finished just 10-3. In '07 they fell as low as #23 but finished #10. In '08 they had just 11 ret sts and a tough schedule. The young team came together quickly and they knocked off #1 Okla (45-35) and moved to #1 appearing to have arrived a year early. They gave up a td with :01 left and lost to #6 TT on the road and with a 3-way tie were excluded from the B12 Title game. Denied a shot at the Nat'l Title a disappointed UT still beat #10 Ohio St (Fiesta). In '09 I projected the Horns to play in the Nat'l Title gm and in the B12 Title game needed a 46 yd FG with :01 left to get there. Unfortunately leading 6-0 they lost QB McCoy and despite a 276-263 yd edge, were done in by 5 TO's and lost to Alabama 37-21. In '10 I mentioned that they had just 8 sts lost in '09, were +9 in TO's, had an incredible off ypp of 10.7 (pg 309) and had been only #3 B12 at +94.3 ypg. UT moved from the spread to more of a pro-style downhill run attack despite not having a feature back on the roster. With Garrett Gilbert's solid 2H in the Title game, many treated the Horns as if they had a ret st'r at QB in '10. I got beaten up pretty good in the preseason by Texas fans as I did not have the Horns in my Preseason Top 10. They entered the season at #5 AP but when the dust settled they had their first losing ssn s/97 and finished last in their div for the first time s/56. Gilbert's play reflected his inexp (10-17 ratio) and the leading rusher had less than 600 yds. Mack Brown had led UNC and UT to winning records for 20 straight yrs (longest FBS streak). LY he brought in new coor's and UT had been -12 in TO's so naturally they made my Most Improved List. UT jumped out to a 4-0 start (#11) but vs #3 Okla gave up 3 def td's and lost, 55-17. They lost to #6 Okla St at home, 38-26. After blasting KU and TT, UT was without their top 3 RB's vs Missouri on a windy day and lost 17-5. Despite having a 310-121 yd edge vs K-St, they lost at home 17-13. They rallied to beat Á&M Ďehind McCoy but vs Baylor were -5 in TÓ's and lost, 48-24. They finished with a 21-10 win over Cal in the Holiday Bowl but wound up the ssn #30 (NR). TY UT goes from 11 to 15 ret sts and despite their 4-5 B12 record were +61.9 ypg (4th best). Texas is my #1 Surprise Team (a non Top 10 team that can win a National Title) thanks to the B12's best D.
