QB Brett Hundley



POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - The QB's were injury-plagued during the Rick Neuheisel era and the 3 QB's comb for a 9-21 ratio in '08. They used 3 QB's again in '09 (10-12 ratio) and 4 in '10 (9-14 ratio). In '11 Kevin Prince threw for 1,828 (56%, 12-8) while Richard Brehaut added 948 (55%, 6-1). Both ret'd in '12 but were beat out by rFr Brett Hundley (PS#5). The last African American to lead UCLA in passing was Jackie Robinson in 1940! Hundley became the first UCLA QB to throw for 300+ yds in 3 consec gms. In 1967 Gary Beban won the Heisman throwing for 1,359 yds. Hundley had that topped after 5 gms and also broke the QB schl rec for rush td's w/9 and reset the record again LY (11). He also set single ssn marks for comp and tfl offense with 3,740 (67%, 29-11, 355 rush). LY the other 2 departed and Hundley, despite playing behind a questionable O-line (36 sk), threw for 3,071 (66.8%, 22-9). He also became the first UCLA QB to lead the team in rushing s/64 (Larry Zeno 325 yd) finishing with 748 (4.7) and also had a td rec. True frosh Asiantii Woulard (PS#9) was the bkp QB but Hundley stayed inj free and they managed to RS him. Jerry Neuheisel (PS#83, Rick's son) ply'd in 5 (11-13-124) while Mike Fafaul (6'2" 205 So) ply'd in 3 (4 att). With Hundley turning down a shot at the NFL and a healthier OL, he is a Heisman Trophy frontrunner.

RUNNING BACKS - Jordan James (PS#11) finished #4 in '12 w/215 and a pedestrian 3.5 ypc. LY he was on his way to a big year as the feature RB. He avg'd 141 ypg the first 3 but was inj'd vs Utah. James made 2 more sts and finished with 534 (5.3). HC Jim Mora said they missed James more than they thought they would. RFr Paul Perkins (PS#110) led the RB's w/92 vs Utah and 36 vs Cal (2.6). Sr Malcolm Jones (PS#5) led with 30 vs Stanford and 58 vs Oregon. Damien Thigpen (PS#50) had 38 vs Colo. That forced Mora to use LB Myles Jack to pull double duty. He had 120 vs Ariz (also had 8 tkl) and 145 the next 2 wks finishing as the #3 RB rusher (267, 7.0) and posting 7 td's on 38 carries. He did move to RB full-time vs Ariz St but the Sun Devils exposed the weak D without Jack and the next week vs USC he had just 2 att. Perkins (zero 100 yd gm) led the RB's with 573 (4.3) plus 296 (12.3) rec. TY they lose Jones (244, 4.6), Thigpen (1 st, 7 gm inj'd, 73, 4.1) and FB Phillip Ruhl (2 st), but get the healthy return of James and add in rFr Craig Lee (PS#43) and true frosh Nathan Starks (PS#15). Not listed in the PSL is Steven Manfro (5'9" 192 Jr, PS#202, 220 tli yd LY). I think Jack (P12 Fr OPOY) will continue to contribute at RB and this group should be much more productive in '14.

RECEIVERS - LY UCLA had to replace their #2 and #3 rec's but did return Shaquell Evans (PS#9) who was #1 in '12 w/877 (14.6). The Bruins suffered the tragic loss of walk-on Nick Pasquale and the team wore #36 emblems on their jerseys the rest of the year. Evans led with 709 (15.1). Then-QB Devin Fuller (PS#3) was a terror on the scout tm in '11 and Mora convinced him to move to WR for the final 9 (145, 7.2). In his 2nd yr at WR, he was #2 w/471 (11.0). Soph Jordan Payton (PS#15) was #3 w/440 (11.6). Devin Lucien (PS#54) was #4 w/339 (17.8). TY they lose their top guy Evans (13 st, #4DC NYJ), TE Darius Bell (7 st, 159, 9.9), and Grayson Mazzone (1 st, 173, 14.4). Despite the loss of their #1 from the L2Y, TY the top 3 returnees comb for 1,250 (LY 1,366) and with plenty of VHT's, the unit looks just as strong.

OFFENSIVE LINE - UCLA had injury-plagued O-lines from '08 to '11 but in '12 they only had 3 sts lost to injury and the rushing numbers improved from a low in '08 of 83 ypg (2.6) up to 191 (4.5) but that team did allow 52 sks (10.5%). LY they had 5 of the top 10 back (68 car sts) and then injuries hit again. Torian White (14 st LT '12) was OFY after 4 sts. LG Xavier Su'a-Filo moved to LT when Simon Goines (13 st '12, 7 st '13) was inj'd and vs Oregon, they had 3 true frosh st's in LG Scott Quessenberry (PS#52, OT in HS), RG Alex Redmond (PS#33) and RT Caleb Benenoch (PS#34). The 3 trues comb'd for 28 sts. UCLA still improved to 197 (4.5) but the sk % (9.2%, 36 sk) was only slightly better (all'd 9 vs Ariz St). TY Su'a-Filo left early for the NFL (13 st, 3Y st'r, #2DC HOU) and White was dismissed. However they return 89 car st, add in Miami, Fla transfer Malcolm Bunche (12 st '12) and I will call for a 6th str year of improved rush numbers.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '11 this unit was hit hard by inj's and for the 2nd str year all'd 5.2 ypc rush (191 ypg) and the def had just 14 sks. In '12 they added in true frosh Ellis McCarthy (PS#5) and had 6 of their top 8 back. I said they should have one of the nations most improved D-lines in the country and the numbers improved by 32 sks (14 to 46), 1.1 ypc (5.2 to 4.1) and despite allowing 306 rush yds to Baylor in the bowl, by 26 ypg (191 to 165). LY they had to replace a 2nd Tm P12 DE (#1DC) and a bkp. Owamagbe Odighizuwa (PS#5, 44 tkl, 3.5 sk '12) RS. They added in 3 VHT true frosh in Eddie Vanderdoes (PS#3, 7 st, orig singed w/ND), Kylie Fitts (PS#18) & Kenny Clark (PS#47, 4 st). UCLA's rush D numbers were similar (168, 3.9, 32 sk). TY they lose DE Cassius Marsh (PS#28, 12 st, 60 tkl, 6 sk, 4.5 tfl, #4DC SEA), NT Seali'i Epenesa (6 st, 16 tkl) and backup Keenan Graham (6 sk). Even with the loss of 1.5 st's incl the unit's top 2 sack men, this unit appears stronger in '14.

LINEBACKERS - In '12 UCLA had to replace 2 st's incl their #1 tkl'r. They ret'd their #2 and #3 tkl'r's then made a great move taking little used FB Anthony Barr (PS#12, 12 rec 2Y) and switching him to LB. Barr earned 2nd Tm AA with 13.5 sks. LY Barr amazingly turned down the NFL. They did have to replace their #7 tkl'r (11 st) and a bkp (5 st, 32 tkl) but had 6 of the top 8 back incl 2nd Tm P12 Eric Kendrick (1 tkl'r P12 w/150) who Mora says is a film room junkie. True frosh Myles Jack (PS#36) also made a huge splash, on both sides of the ball and had 2 int's & 11 pbu (P12 Fr DPOY). TY the Bruins lose their 2nd Tm AA Barr (13 st, 65 tkl, 10 sk, 10 tfl, #1DC MIN) and Jordan Zumwalt (13 st, #2 tkl'r, 5.5 tfl, #6DC PIT). They do return their #1 and #5 tkl'r's but go from 3 ret st's to 2 and lose a pair of NFL DC's.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '12 UCLA had to replace 3 DB's (comb 6 st, 62 tkl) but had 7 back who st'd in '11. It was very surprising that the more veteran secondary slipped to #64 (63%, 27-15). LY they had to replace 4 st's (#6 tkl'r SS, #3 tkl'r FS, #9 & #12 tkl'r CB's). They ret'd 1 DB (5 sts) and

the secondary consisted of a Jr, 2 soph and a rFr. Surprisingly the inexp'd secondary improved to #38 (61%, 16-14). TY they only lose Brandon Sermons (6 st, 38 tkl) and with the #1's making 51 of the 52 sts, they should be one of the top secondaries in the country.

SPECIAL TEAMS - UCLA was the only tm to finish in the Top 10 of my ST rankings each yr from '04-'07 and from '04-'10 were in the top 25 each year. After a rare drop to #92 in '11, Mora only managed to get the unit up to #73 in '12. LY they had to replace their LS (Mora called best in FBS) and 1st Tm P12 P (#5DC, 39.9 net). True frosh Sean Covington (PS#15) avg 41.9 (39.4 net) and had 21 TB on 42 KO. K Ka'imi Fairbairn (PS#20) who hit 16-22 fg's (L48) as a true hit #21 (L48) and had 24 TB on 48 KO. UCLA was +6.2 on KR (#9 FBS) and with their top 2 KR's Steven Manfro (446, 24.8) and Devin Fuller (224, 28.0) both out vs Ast, 5'8" Ishmael Adams' first 2 KR avg went 63.5 (350, 35.0) and he had 1 PR for 49 yds. The Bruins were +5.0 on PR. UCLA finished #6 and only lose their top PR making them one of the premiere ST units.

COACHES - Jim Mora has made Los Angeles a two team town again taking over a program which topped 7 wins only once in 14Y and leading them to 19 wins his first 2 yrs. He was a NFL TV analyst for 2Y and the HC for both the Seahawks ('09) and Falcons ('04-'06) as well as a 7 yr NFL DC (SEA & SF). The OC is Noel Mazzone who spent 2Y as the OC at Ariz St and 9Y at Ole Miss and Auburn in that same role. The new DC is Jeff Ulbrich (asst HC/LB/ST L2Y here).

PHIL'S FORECAST

2011 was an unusual year as UCLA made it to the Pac-12 Title game despite losing to USC 50-0 and they would lose their last 3 gms by an avg of 49-19 and were 6-8. UCLA was coming off a stretch of 4 losing seasons in 5 yrs and perhaps trying to duplicate the magic that USC had bringing in an NFL HC in Pete Carroll, they brought in Jim Mora. I put UCLA on my Most Improved List in '12 and Mora did not disappoint. RFr Brett Hundley emerged and led UCLA to a schl record 482 pts (477-'97). LY there were 7 current FBS HC's that were also HC's in the NFL and each of the other 6 improved their record in year 2. Mora made it 8 for 8 as despite playing both Stanford and Oregon on the road in B2B weeks, they managed to improve their record to 10-3. UCLA blew out Nevada in the opener then trailed Neb 21-13 in the 2Q but dominated after that winning 41-21 on the road. They did have a scare at Utah and despite the Utes having 6 int, UCLA only won by 7. UCLA moved to 5-0 and #9 when they travelled to Stanford. Unfortunately the Bruins were down to 3 frosh starting on the O-line and were also without their top RB (lost 24-10). The next week in the same situation it was 14-14 late 3Q at Oregon but they lost by 28. They rebounded to win their next 3 but trailed Ariz St 35-13 at half at home and lost their shot at the Pac-12 Title game. They rebounded to get their biggest MOV vs USC s/70 in a 35-14 rout and then whipped VTech 42-12 in the bowl for their first double digit win season s/'05 (#16 AP). It was the first time s/'97 that in their final 2 gms they beat USC and won a bowl. Hundley opted to return and those 3 frosh OL thrown into the fire are now soph's plus the Bruins have their top 4 rushers, 5 of their top 6 rec's and 10 of their top 14 tkl'r's with 17 st's back overall. They do draw both Oregon & Stanford again but this year get both at home so the Bruins figure to be the preseason favorite to win the Pac-12 South.

First meeting. The Bruins are just 4-5 s/'06 in reg ssn road gms vs non-conference opp's. UCLA has won B2B road openers but the L/time they won 3 straight was from 1980-'82.

First meeting. UCLA is 14-2 in home openers. Bruins are 15-3 hosting non-conf foes. UCLA is a perfect 12-0 the last 3 ssn at home the wk following a road gm, avg score 40-18.

UCLA won the L/gm in TX (Austin '10), 34-12. The Bruins trailed 3-0 into the 2Q but had a 27-6 lead into the 4Q. Round-trip, UCLA will travel 7,920 miles in their 2 non-conference AG's TY.
