



POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - While he never led the Bulldogs to an SEC Title, Aaron Murray broke nearly every career SEC passing record. LY Murray was a Heisman frontrunner. He was 1-5 career vs Top 10 tms but beat two LY (SC & LSU, both AP #6). However, injuries to his skill players led to B2B losses at midssn He still broke the SEC record for career pass yds (UGA David Greene '01-'04) and td's (UF Danny Wuerffel '93-'96). Murray threw for 3.075 (64.8%, 26-9, 186 rush) becoming just the 4th QB in NCAA history (1st SEC) to notch 4 ssns w/at least 3,000 pass yds (Timmy Chang-Hawaii, Kellen Moore-Boise & Landry Jones-Okla). Unfortunately, in his schl-record breaking 52nd career start (Greene), he tore his ACL. As a true, 6'3" Hutson Mason (PS#43) became the 2nd QB in NCAA history to throw a td on his first career snap (9-17-102-1-0) and in '11 threw for 254 (60%, 2-0). In '12 he RS. LY Mason, who prefers a more uptempo offense threw for 968 (60.9%, 5-3) and led UGA to a 20 pt come-from-behind win over GT. He will be backed by VHT's rFr Brice Ramsey (PS#5) and true Jacob Park (PS#8 IFS) as well as Faton Bauta (PS#35). OC Mike Bobo, who also played QB here, called Murray (#5DC KC) the best QB ever to play here. Despite his loss I look for solid stats from the Bulldog QB's.

RUNNING BACKS - Isaiah Crowell led in '11 with 850 (4.6) and many said that UGA was in trouble when he was lost prior to '12. I, however, pointed out that they were actually in BETTER shape as while the starting job would be held for a 2nd straight yr by a true frosh, they now had 2 VHT's in Keith Marshall (PS#2) & Todd Gurley (PS#19). They were so impressive that the term "Gurshall" was formed (last names and reminder of Herschel Walker). They were the most productive frosh duo in schl history and comb'd for 25 td's. Marshall had 759 (6.5) while Gurley became just the 2nd UGA true frosh RB (Walker 80) to top 1,000 (1385, 6.2). LY the RB's were ravaged by injury, like the rest of the tm. Gurley had 450 (6.3) in the 1st 4 before missing the next 3. Marshall (246, 4.4) ran for 96 (4.8) vs LSU but then was OFY vs Tenn. True frosh JJ Green had 129 (7.6) vs Tenn gm 5) and finished #2 w/384 (5.6) while Brendan Douglas (5'11 202 So, PS#143) was #3 w/345 (4.1). Gurley came back vs UF (gm #8) and ran for at least 75+ in each of the last 6 also picking up the slack for the inj'd rec corps (441, 11.9, 6 tkl). He finished #1 (989, 6.0, #4 rec). TY they add in PS#4 Sony Michel & PS#9 Nick Chubb! Not listed is AJ Turman (6'0" 198 rFr, PS#24) and Dominic Bryan (6'0" 236 So, PS#118). With a healthy Gurley and Marshall this could be the deepest and most talented RB corps in the country (pg 18).

RECEIVERS - In each of the L/2 yrs the UGA rec corps has been ravaged by injury. In '12 soph Malcolm Mitchell (PS#18,

665, 14.8 in '11) began at DB but moved back to WR in wk 5 and finished #2 w/572 (14.3). Tavarres King (PS#6) led with 950 (22.6!) while TE Arthur Lynch had 431 (18.0). Michael Bennett was #1 in rec after 5 but was OFY. Marlon Brown (PS#3) had 469 (17.4) when he was OFY after 8. LY they lost King and Brown. Mitchell was OFY in Wk 1. Vs Tenn (gm 5) they lost both Bennett (miss 2) and Justin Scott-Wesley (OFY 311, 19.4). Bennett finished #2 (538, 13.1) while Chris Conley led (651, 14.5, miss 2). True frosh speedster Reggie Davis (98 yd td vs NT longest schl hist) had 257 (23.4). Bkp TE Jay Rome (PS#3) was OFY after 8 (99 11.0). TY they lose Lynch (11 st, 459, 15.3, #5DC MIA), Rantavious Wooten (6 st, 424, 14.1) and Rhett McGowan (4 st, 233, 11.6). The top 2 return as well as LY's inj'd players, so expect UGA to have one of the SEC's best rec corps.

OFFENSIVE LINE - UGA's OL's underachieved in '10 (155 car sts) and '11 (86 car sts) as they avg just 4.1 and 3.9 ypc. In '12 they had to replace a comb 125 sts incl a 4th Tm AA C (#4DC), a 3rd Tm AA LT (#2DC) and a #7DC RT. They ret'd just 31 car sts. John Theus (PS#3) became just the 3rd true frosh to start an opener here at OT s/73. Once again the Bulldogs surprised, this time in a good way (183 ypg) and their 4.9 ypc was best s/92. LY the line ret'd intact (101 car sts). Despite RB's Gurley & Marshall having 118 less carries than '12, the Bulldogs still avg'd 170 rush ypg (4.5) and only all'd 13 sks (3.4%) the F/11 before Murray's inj (9 sks L/2). TY they lose LT Kenarious Gates (13 st, 3Y st'r), LG Dallas Lee (12 st, 3Y st'r) & RG Chris Burnette (13 st, 3Y st'r). Their car sts drop to 54 but the OL stats won't drop as much as you would think with the unit loaded with VHT's and healthier RB's.

DEFENSIVE LINE - Former DC Todd Grantham's system required a large NT and in '11 they had 351 and 350 lb NT's rotating. That helped them allow just 101 ypg rush (3.2, 35 sk). They had 5 of the top 6 back in '12. It was surprising they allowed 299 ypg (5.3) in their final 4 (did face 2 option tms) and yielded 182 ypg (4.1) rush, worst s/94. LY they had to replace a #6DC DE, a #3DC NT and 2 bkps (5 st). They did return Garrison Smith (PS#13), their top DL tkl'r (57). With an inexp'd D overall and replacing 2 strs, the DL did well at 148 ypg (3.7, 33 sk). TY they lose DT Smith (13 st, #4 tkl'r, 6 sk, 4 tfl, 12 gbh) but have 5 of the top 6 back incl Ray Drew who finally lived up to his PS#3 billing w/6 sks. This group is more exp'd and stronger.

INEBACKERS - In '12 UGA's LB corps ret'd intact and they all'd just 19.6 ppg (best s/'06). LY the losses were heavy as they had to replace a 3rd Tm AA (#1DC), a 2x 1st Tm AA (#1DC) and their #7 and #11 tkl'rs. They did return Amarlo Herrera (PS#27, #5 tkl'r) and Jordan Jenkins (PS#9, #13 tkl'r). UGA's entire D was young LY, then banged up and all'd 29.0 ppg. TY the unit returns intact (#1, #2, #7 and #8 tkl'rs) and LY's extremely young LB corps now becomes a veteran group incl 3rd Tm AA Ramik Wilson and 2nd Tm SEC Jenkins.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - LY UGA had to replace both CB's (#9 tkl'r, #5DC & #14 tkl'r, 9 st, 25 tkl), their SS (#2 tkl'r, #3DC) and 2nd Tm SEC FS Bacarri Rambo (#4 tkl'r, #6DC) whose 16 career int's tied Jake Scott's schl record. With inexp throughout the D, UGA dropped to #90 (57.9%, 18-7) in my PDR. Inj's cost FSTray Matthews (PS#14) & CB Brendan Langley (PS#27) each 5 sts. This unit is pretty easy to call. Nine DB's st'd LY incl'4 true frosh. Six return along with LY's #2 rusher JJ Green who moved in during the spg. They lose Josh Harvey-Clemons (11 st, #3 tkl'r, 6 pd), CB Shaq Wiggins (8 st, 19 tkl, 2 int, 4 pbu as true, trans), Connor Norman (2 st, 24 tkl) and 2 bkps (3 tkl). After having their lowest finish in my PDR ever, the Bulldogs could have the most improved secondary in the country.

SPECIAL TEAMS - After a shocking #31 finish in '11 (ret'd AA P & 1st Tm SEC K), UGA climbed to #30 in '12 despite having

to start a pair of true frosh at K/P. LY everyone ret'd ST but for the 3rd consec ssn, expectations were not met (#58). K Marshall Morgan was susp F/2 gms and they had snapping issues incl a costly one vs Clem in the opener. Morgan still finished as one of the best in the country hitting 22-24 (L56!). Collin Barber avg 44.1 & while he was inj'd Adam Erickson 13 Tm Net Avg filled in admirably avg 40.5 (tm net 39.2, #17 FBS). UGA only avg d 2.9 on PR and 18.6 on KR and were K/O (38.8) -3 in td/blk.TY everyone returns and they should be back to their usual Top 30 finish (10 of L14Y).

COACHES - Mark Richt is in his 14th ssn here K/O (40.8) #108 (Fla St OC 7Y prior) and has taken the Bulldogs to 13 bowls reaching DD wins 8x's. Mike Bobo was a QB here and has been the QB cch s/'01. He became the youngest coor (32) in the SEC when he was promoted in '07. The new DC is Jeremy Pruitt who spent 3Y as Bama's DB coach before taking over as Fla St's DC LY

In Richt's 2nd ssn ('02) he led UGA to its first SEC Title in 20 yrs and set a schl record with 13 wins (#3 AP). Only UGA and USC finished in the Top 10 each year from '02-'05. UGA's D finished in the Top 20 for 7 str yrs ('01-'07). Richt became the then-5th SEC HC to win 10+ in 4 straight yrs (Bryant, Dooley, Fulmer, Spurrier and now also Saban). Richt started 7-4 vs top 10 teams but starting in '08 went 1-9 before splitting the last 6. In '07 UGA was the consensus pick for 3rd in the East and I picked them tied for the East Title and they were, finishing #2 AP. In '08 they were tagged #1 Preseason AP but I had UGA 2nd in the East due to a tough schedule and they slipped to 10-3 (#13). After surprising 8-5 and 6-7 seasons, in '11 UGA only had 12 ret st'rs but I called them one of my Most Improved Teams and they were my upset pick to win the East (no LSU, Bama, Ark on sked). UGA got to the SEC Title game. In '12 UGA was #6 to start and got to the SEC Title gm again, losing to Bama 32-28 running out of time inside the UA10 at the end. LY UGA had just 11 ret st rs and my Stock Market Indicator had them at -4 and they were +11 in TO's in '12. They drew LSU from the West but got SC at home. They faced 3 top 10 tms in the first 4 wks. Clem had a great sked edge with only SCSt on deck while UGA had SC. UGA had a 545-467 yd edge but lost 38-35 thanks in part to a bobbled fg snap. They beat SC 41-30 at home. Two wks later they got a td w/1:47 left to get past #6 LSU 44-41. RB's Gurley & Marshall were both inj'd vs Tenn and while UGA led 17-3 at half they needed a td w/:05 left to force OT & escaped 34-31. UGA was missing its top 2 RB's and 3 of their top 4 WR's and their 15 gm home win streak was snapped by Mizz, 41-26. A still banged up UGA led 24-14 vs VU but a couple of key 4th down convinct a? targeting call all'd VU to pull the upset. They led Fla 23-3 at half and held on 23-20. They trailed Auburn 37-17 in the 4Q but took their only lead w/1:49 left. They then gave up the "Immaculate Deflection" for a tough 43-38 loss. In an Aub/GT sandwich they still crushed UK 59-17. In Mason's first start they trailed GT 20-7 at the half (279-152 yd deficit) but forced OT and won it in the 2nd OT and Richt moved to 12-1 vs the instate rival. Mason hit 21-39-320 in the bowl (UGA 416-307 yd edge). Trailing 24-19 they were SOD at the Neb 14 & 16. While UGA finished with 5 or more losses for the only the 3rd time in 17 yrs, they all came within the L5. While Murray departs their RB's & WR's are now healthy and 8 st'rs ret from a D that was very young LY that all'd 29 ppg which was 2nd highest in UGA history (1905, 31.3). UGA does have to play SC on the road and draws Aub and has just 3 SEC HG's. They are a +3.0 on the Stock Market, were -7 in TO's and had -4 net upsets LY all indicators pointing upward. UGA is a legitimate contender in the SEC East.
