POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - In '11 ret st'r Stephen Garcia would start just 4 gms. Connor Shaw got his first st vs Kentucky (311, 67%) and never let go of the job (L9 sts) throwing for 1,448 (65%, 14-6) and finishing as the #2 rusher (525, 3.9). In '12 Shaw dealt with a few inj's and Dylan Thompson started 2 (1027, 52%, 10-2) and had the GW td pass in the bowl. Shaw threw for 1,956 (68%, 17-7, 435 rush). LY Shaw threw for 2,447 (63.4%) with an amazing 24-1 ratio finishing as the #2 rusher (558, 3.6) once again. Thompson threw for 783 (58.4%, 4-3). Shaw left as SC's winningest QB. Backing up Thompson TY will be soph Brendan Nosovitch (PS#39, 3 gm, 2 att) and rFR Connor Mitch (PS#27). Nosovitch is more like Shaw (dual-threat) while Mitch is more like Thompson (pocket passer). I thought Thompson did a great job filling in the last 2 yrs but I cannot see him matching Shaw's ratio, running ability or intangibles.

RUNNING BACKS - SC had its top 3 RB's returning in '10 but I listed true frosh Marcus Lattimore (PS#1) on my Preseason All-SEC Tm. Lattimore became the first 1,000 yd rusher here s/'00 (1197, 4.8) despite missing most of 3 gms with inj's. Kenny Miles (626, 5.4 '09) had 152 (3.8). In '11 Lattimore was on his way to a great season (818, 5.0) but was OFY after 7 gms. True frosh Brandon Wilds (PS#53) rushed for 486 (4.5) while Miles added 204 (3.8). QB's were the #2 & #5 rushers. True frosh Shon Carson (PS#23) had an ACL inj in Wk 2 and RS. In '12 Lattimore (662, 4.4) suffered a gruesome leg inj in Wk 9 yet still broke the SC record for career rushing td's w/38 (31, George Rogers '77-'80 and Harold Green '86-'89). Wilds RS while true frosh Mike Davis (PS#11) had 275 (5.3). Only 3 non-Lattimore RB efforts topped 50 yds. Miles finished #3 (359, 3.5). LY Davis was the MIP RB in spring and I pointed out that Lattimore (4DC), missed half the year and called for the unit to match '12's production. Davis surpassed my expectations. In '12 the top 3 RB's comb'd for 1,296 (4.3) while LY the top 3 had 1,660 (5.4). Davis topped 100 in 7 of the first 9 but was inj'd vs Florida (13-54). He DNP vs CU then had just 22 yds on 15 att's vs CU. Carson rushed for 256 (4.2) incl 102 vs Fla. Davis had 1,183 (5.8 and 352 rec). Wilds (221, 5.1) played in just 7 (inj). Not in the PSL are David Williams (61") 210 rFR, PS#18) and FB Gerald Turner (62") 251 rFR, PS#99DL). With everyone back, they are much more exp'd and Davis is one of the country's top RB's.

RECEIVERS - With the loss of 6'4" Alshon Jeffrey (#2DC), the WR's had a much different look in '12 with the top 3 at 5'8", 5'9" and 5'9". Their 2 TE's and 2 RB's were among the top 6 in rec's. 6'1" true frosh Shaq Roland (PS#6) surprisingly had just 5 rec while Bruce Ellington led w/600 (15.0). Damiere Byrd (PS#29, 1 rec true) had 366 (26.1). LY they had to replace their TE (#7DC) and their deep threat, Ace Sanders (#2, 531, 11.8, #4 DC). Ellington had an uneven season with 43 yds in 5 gms but 732 yds and 45 rec in the other 8. Byrd (4.26 spd) had Lasik eye surg which really improved his gm (#2, 575, 17.4). He is also a sprinter on SC's track tm (10.42 100M). RB Davis was #4. Roland was the #1 rec when he was susp for 3. He had just 1 rec for 4 yds in his first 2 bac (455, 18.2). TE Rory Anderson (PS#32) had 235 (13.8) but was inj this spg and is ? for '14. Adding depth are Kane Whitehurst (5'11" 180 Jr) who trans in '12 from Ark (66, 16.5 LY) and TE Kelvin Rainey (6'3" 232 So, PS#21). TY they lose Ellington (#4DC SF) but do bring in PS#14 Shaq Davidson and will be stronger.

OFFENSIVE LINE - SC has had only 3 OL earn 1st Tm SEC. In each of Spurrier's first 5Y ('05-'09) this was an injury-plagued group. Only once did they top 3.6 ypc rush ('06, 4.5). With 72 and 70 sts back in '10 and '11, they made strides and in '11 rushed for 192 ypg (4.5, 30 sks, 9.5%). In '12 they had to replace a rare 1st Tm SEC OL (#5DC), a 2Y starting LT and their RG. They had 61 car sts back but dropped to 138 ypg (3.7, 38 sks, 10.4%). LY they had to replace a 2nd Tm SEC C (4Y st'r, #7DC) but had 72 car sts back. I said it could be Spurrier's best OL here and that is exactly what it was as SC had their best ypg rush (198), best ypc (4.8) and fewest sks all'd (23) in the Spurrier era. TY 9 of the top 10 are back (113 car st) with the only loss being RG Ronald Patrick (12 st, 2Y st'r). Despite the loss of QB Shaw and his 558 rush yds, they should be able to set a new high-water mark.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '12 SC had to replace a #7DC DT and #1DC DE but thanks to the presence of PS#1 Jadeveon Clowney, they all'd 121 ypg (3.1) w/43 sks. LY they had to replace a #4DC DE, a st'g DT and a bkp. As a true soph, Clowney was forced to ret despite being judged as the potential #1 pick for the draft. He had numerous ailments, drew triple teams and only had 3 sks (8.5 tfl). SC actually all'd 154 ypg rush (4.3), their highest s/'07 and had just 25 sks their lowest s/'07. TY they lose not only a #1DC but the 1st overall pick (HOU). DE Clowney (1st Tm SEC, 11 st), 3rd Tm AA DT PS#18 Kelcy Quarles (11 st, 39 tkl, 9.5 sk, 4 tfl) and DE Chaz Sutton (13 st, 32 tkl, 3 sk, 5.5 tfl). Adding depth is rFR Devin Washington (6'3" 226, PS#61). Five of the top 8 are back and LY's unit underachieved. They add in 2 VHT JUCO's, but they lose arguably their top 3 DL and look less talented in '14.

LINEBACKERS - SC has a senior-laden group of LB's in '12. They had to replace their top 5 LB tkl'r's (#1, #3, #4, #7 and #14) LY and their leading returnee, Jordan Diggs (PS#30) had just 5 tkl's. The unit was my biggest ? on the team. Surprisingly 5'10" 205 Sharrod Golightly beat out Diggs at the Spur position, starting 12 (2nd Tm SEC, #6 tkl'r). Their DC thought all 4 true frosh LB's would play and while Skai Moore (PS#48) only st'd 4, he finished as the #1 tkl'r as a true. By the end of LY, the 3-deep was made up of 1 Jr, 3 soph and the rest Fr so naturally this unit is vastly more exp'd.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - SC has had just one blip on their pass D rankings s/'07. They finished between #4 and #35 in 6 of 7 yrs but only #92 in '10. LY they had to replace a 2nd Tm SEC FS (#2 tkl'r, #2DC) and a bkp. They did lose their top guy but had 6 of the top 8 back but slipped to #40 (59.9%, 15-18). TY they lose CB Jimmy Legree (13 st, #2 tkl'r, 3 int, 4 pbu), 2nd Tm SEC CB Victor Hampton (10 st, #4 tkl'r, 3 int, 9 pbu) and Ahmad Christian (1 st, 18 tkl, 2 pbu). Despite going from 3 ret st'r's to 2, they don't lose a #2DC like LY so I'll call them equal.

SPECIAL TEAMS - SC has never finished very high in my ST rankings. After a #53 finish in '12, they had to replace Ace Sanders (SC rec PR yds ssn 429, 15.3, 2nd Tm AA) and their K. RFR Elliott Fry who was not in the 2-deep in spg ended up as an All-SEC Frosh (15-18, L45). Landon Ard had 36 TB on 83 KO. True frosh Pharoh Cooper was the top KR (359, 22.4) & PR (40, 4.4). P Tyler Hull slipped to a 37.8 avg (34.1 net). SC dropped to #88. With all of the specialists back, I look for solid improvement.

COACHES - How many coaches can you name that have 200+ college wins, while also having HC exp in both the NFL and USFL? Steve Spurrier continues to work his magic as prior to his arrival SC, reached the 10 win mark just once but they've now had 3 straight 11 win seasons. Spurrier calls his own plays but promoted his son, Steve Jr (10Y) and OL cch Shawn Elliott (5Y) to co-OC's in '12. Lorenzo Ward was the DB coach at VT ('99-'05), Ark ('07) and here since '08. He is in his 3rd season as DC.

PHIL'S FORECAST

When the preseason poll debuts, the Gamecocks will have been ranked for 65 consec wks, the longest streak in SC history. SC's last conf title, however, came in the ACC in 1969. Steve Spurrier has now had 0 losing seasons in 9 yrs (8 bowls). Spurrier's high water mark in his first 5 yrs was at #6 in '07 when the team was 6-1 but they finished 6-6 (NR). After winning 7 in '08 and '09 SC stepped it up to 9-5 (#22) in '10. They were 11-2 and finished #9 in '11. It was the 2nd year in a row they swept their biggest 4 rivals, UF, UGA, Tenn & Clem. In '12 SC opened #9 and finished #8. They got as high as #3 (highest s/'84) after knocking off #5 UGA. Their only 2 losses came in the 2nd and 3rd gms of a brutal 3 game stretch (3 top 10 tms). LY SC had just 12 ret st'r's and were #96 in my exp chart but were the only one of the top 3 in the East not to face Bama, LSU or A&M. I said they figured to be an underdog in only 1 game and that was Wk 2 at GA. They were actually a dog in 2. SC dominated NC in the opener. Trailing 34-30 they gave up a 3&13, 85 yd td pass to UGA and lost by 11. SC came out angry and led 28-0 5:00 into the 2Q and beat Vandy 35-25. They trailed UCF 10-0 at half but went up 28-10. UCF got within 28-25 but SC rec'd the onside. SC led 21-0 at half vs Kentucky (292-116 yd) but UK got three 4Q td's incl one with 4:02 left to pull them within 7 before SC ran out the clock. SC blasted Ark 52-7 but Tenn got a 19 yd fg on the last play to upset SC, 23-21 which cost them a berth in the SEC Title game. Mizzou was up 17-0 late in the 3Q when QB Shaw came off the bench to force OT and MU's 24 yd chipshot fg bounced off the upright. SC was outgained by Miss ST 385-307 (23-12 FD) but won 34-16 (+5 TO's). UF was down to 3rd string QB Mornhinweg but led 14-6 at half. SC battled back for a 19-14 win. After a breather vs CC, they got their 5th str win vs #6 Clem with a 6-0 TO edge. They were an underdog to Wisconsin in the bowl and trailed 14-13 at the half but won 34-24 and had their highest finish ever in the final AP Poll at #4. SC recorded its 3rd str 11 win season and their 3rd bowl win in 3 years was a 1st in school history. They are 1 of 3 tms in the country to finish in the top 10 each of the last 3 yrs (Oregon, Bama). TY they do lose the bulk of their D-line and QB Shaw but have 14 ret st'r's. Despite being 6-2 in SEC play, SC was +101.9 ypg (#2). TY SC draws both Aub and A&M out of the West. They have an excellent shot at getting to the SEC Title game.
