POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - USC has had 6 QB's taken in the last 12 drafts. It was Carson Palmer in '03, followed by Matt Cassel, Matt Leinhardt, John David Booty, Mark Sanchez and Matt Barkley. LY for the first time in 18 yrs USC headed into the season without a clear #1 QB! In '12 Max Wittek threw for 388 (52%, 3-5) while Cody Kessler had 2 att's. Kessler played the 1H vs UH in the opener and Wittek the 2H. They split time again vs Wash St with Wittek going 8-18 (0-1 ratio) and he would attempt just 8 more passes as Lane Kiffin named Kessler the str'r. Kessler hit 15-17 vs BC (2 inc on long passes). He then suffered a bruised right hand in the 1H vs Utah St and in the 2H comp just 5-14-58. Kessler rebounded the next week vs Ariz St (20-29-295) showing his potential. He later had ssn highs in comp/att in the win vs Stanford (25-37-288) and for yards in the bowl win (22-30-345). Kessler finished with 2,968 (64.5%, 20-7) and appeared set to go play for new HC Sarkisian at Wash out of HS before a last minute call from USC. Rfr Max Browne (PS#1) and Sark recruit Jalen Greene (PS#40) will continue. This unit has much more exp and will have improved numbers.

RUNNING BACKS - USC is known for its fine TB tradition. In '11 Curtis McNeal (PS#34) became the 27th 1,000 yd rusher here with 1,005 (6.9). Depth at RB was one of their prime concerns in the spg of '12 so they moved PS#20LB Tre Madden in (1 st, 15 tkl '11) and he was impressive before a knee inj (OFY). USC got a gift over the summer in Penn St transfer Silas Redd (PS#10, 1241, 5.1 '11). Redd was on pace for 1,000 before being banged up (905, 5.4). McNeal was #2 with 701 (6.0). LY they had to replace McNeal. When I spoke to Cch Kiffin over the summer, he called Tre Madden a no-flaw TB (high praise). Madden lived up to Kiffin's billing avg 117 ypg over the first 5 but suffered a hamstring inj and had only 31 atts for 120 yds the rest of the way to finish #2 (703, 5.1). Soph Javorius "Buck" Allen (PS#44) was 6th string heading into spring and had 137 (4.7) after 8 gms. He topped 120 in 4 of the L6 and finished #1 (785, 5.8, 14 td, 252 rec). DJ Morgan (5'10" 190 Sr, PS#6) was #3 in '12 (201, 4.9) and missed '13 w/inj. True frosh Justin Davis (PS#13, MVP spring) was #2 into the ND gm but was OFY after 7 (#4, 361, 6.8). Redd (inj) played in just 6 (#3, 376, 4.6). True frosh Ty Isaac (PS#4) who was the biggest of the RB's (6'3" 225) had 87 vs Cal and finished with 236 (5.9) but he decided to trans after spg. TY they also lose Redd but Madden and Allen may be the best RB duo in the country.

RECEIVERS - In '11 Robert Woods was not 100% but led with 1,292 (11.6). True frosh Marquise Lee (PS#10) emerged with 1,143 (15.7) while rfr TE Randall Telfer (PS#7) was #3 (273, 10.5). In '12 Lee easily won the Biletniokoff (1721, 14.6, 14

td). Woods had 846 (11.1, 11 td) while soph TE Xavier Grimble (PS#1) had 316 (10.9). LY they had to replace Woods (#2DC). When George Farmer (PS#1) and true frosh Steven Mitchell (PS#10) both tore ACL's, USC had 5 schlp WR's. Rfr walk-on Robby Kolanz played vs Ariz St (1 schlp WR during practice wk). The TE position was also decimated w/inj and with the top 4 out vs Utah, walk-on Chris Willson st'd (1 rec). Nelson Agholor who was #3 in '12 (340, 17.9) led w/918 (16.4) and Grimble was #3 (271, 10.8). Lee was never 100% (miss Utah, Ariz, Col) and had 20 rec for 270 yds in his L3 gms, finishing #1 w/57 rec but #2 w/791 yds (13.9). True frosh Darreus Rogers (PS#22) missed 3 (#4, 257, 11.7). Both Lee (11 st, #2DC JAX) and Grimble (6 st, UFA, NYG) left early for the NFL. They get back off-injured Farmer and Mitchell and add in 3 VHT's. Despite the loss of 2 stars, this unit should remain healthier and could perform better with more consistency among the coaching positions.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '12 USC had to replace a 1st Tm P12 LT who became USC's 22nd OL drafted in the 1st Rnd but had the other 4 str's back (60 car sts). Max Tuerk became the first ever Trojan true frosh to start at LT. Surprisingly USC's numbers slipped to 151 ypg (5.0, 17 sk). LY they had to replace a 1st Tm P12 C (3Y str', #4DC) and 2 bkps (comb 2 st). They had 85 car sts back. Tuerk moved to LG to make room for rfr Chad Wheeler and Marcus Martin moved to C. They lost both Martin & Audrey Walker vs UCLA. USC avg just 3.5 ypc the last 2 (7 sk) but improved to 173 ypg (4.5) with 34 sks (most s/o1) for the ssn. TY they lose 1st Tm P12 C Martin (13 st, 3Y str', #3DC SF), RT Kevin Graf (13 st, 3Y str'), John Martinez (25 st '11-'12, 5 st '13) and bkp Abe Markowitz. The car sts drop from 85 to 53 and they must learn new schemes but with 3 str's back, I'll call for improved numbers.

DEFENSIVE LINE - The Trojans had been running a 3-4 with 2 OLB's that weigh in at 250+, basically a 5 man front. USC may have come into '12 ranked #1 AP but had a shocking drop in the rush D to 167 ypg (4.1) which was their worst s/'96. Leonard Williams (PS#17) earned P12 Fr DPOY and the D did have 45 sks. LY they had to replace 1 str and improved to 121 ypg rush (4.0) with 35 sks. Williams was 4th Tm AA. TY they lose DE George Uko (14 st, 32 tkl, 5 sk, 2 tfl, undrafted). Soph Greg Townsend (PS#8) was OFY in Sept and returns. They also add in Ttech transfer Delvon Simmons (13 st, PS#21), a PS#4 rfr and PS#13JC, have 9 VHT's in the 3-deep and are one of the NCAA's top D-lines.

LINEBACKERS - Morgan Breslin and Devon Kennard were two tremendous OLB/DE and MLB Hayes Pullard was 3rd Tm P12 and the #2 tkl'r in '12. The unit ret'd intact LY incl WLB Lamar Dawson (PS#10). Breslin was OFY after 5 sts and Dawson after 7. They definitely passed the eye test being perhaps the biggest LB corps. TY they lose Kennard (14 st, #5 tkl'r, 60 tkl, 9 sk, 4.5 tfl, #5DC NYG) and Breslin (5 st, 15 tkl, 4.5 sk, 3.5 tfl) as well as Marquis Simmons (6 tkl, 1 sk). While they don't have all 4 str's back, they probably won't lose 2 midseason and this still remains one of the top LB corps in the country.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In the 9 seasons under Pete Carroll, the Trojans avg PDR finish was #8 (never lower than #16). In '10 the unit lost all 4 str's (#2, #3DC). USC had its lowest finish in my PDR since I began keeping track in '94 at #61 (60%, 30-15). They only moved up to #57 & #46 in '11 & '12. LY the losses were heavy in a 2x 1st Tm P12 FS (#1 tkl'r, #3DC), 2nd Tm P12 CB (#7 tkl'r), SS (#9 tkl'r) and a bkp (19 tkl). I said while a lot less exp'd, with a super front 7 they could actually move up in the PDR and they did, up to #11 (56.8%, 20-17). True frosh Su'a Cravens (PS#2) st'd 13 at SS. TY they lose FS Demetrius Wright (11 st, 59 tkl, 3 pbu), Torin Harris (4 st, #13 tkl'r, 8 pd) and Dion Bailey (9 st, #4 tkl'r). Despite the losses they could be just as good.

SPECIAL TEAMS - From '07-'09 USC's avg finish in my ST ranking was #70 but John Baxter took over as ST cch in '10 after his '09 Fresno unit finished #20. In his first 3Y USC was #23, #29 and #18. Andre Heidari (PS#2) was 1st Tm P12 as a true in '11 but had an up and down '13 hitting 15-22 fg's (L52, longest here s/'90). He had 4 fg's vs Utah but missed 2 fg's vs Wash St (3 pt loss) and 2 vs ND (4 pt loss) Heidari had 18 TB on 76 KO. USC had to replace their top-notch P (38.6 net). Kris Albarado (PS#11) was the P12 POW pinning Utah St 120 5 times but only avg'd 37.1 (34.5 net, #112 FBS). Agholor had 2 PR td's (75 & 93) vs Cal and led w/343 (19.1) but only had 175 (17.5) on KR's with the tm avg only 14.4 because of many squib kicks. They slipped to #33. TY with better depth this looks like a Top 25 ST unit.

COACHES - The last time a USC HC didn't last 3 full seasons was 1941. Steve Sarkisian returns for a 3rd stint as he was the QB cch here from '01-'03 and '05-'08 (OC LY). Sarkisian spent the L5Y as Wash's HC taking over a program that went 0-12 the previous year and hadn't been to a bowl in 6Y and led them to a bowl each of the L4Y. Clay Helton is the OC (interim HC bowl). He has been the QB cch here for 3Y (also OC LY) and spent 10Y at Memphis (L/3 OC). Justin Wilcox also comes over from UW where he was the DC the LY as well as previously at Tenn ('10-'11) and Boise ('06-'09).

PHIL'S FORECAST

Under Pete Carroll USC was the only tm to finish in the AP Top 4 each yr from '02-'08. They won a Nat'l Title in '04 and nearly again in '05. In '10 they were hit hard by NCAA probation (post season ban '10 & '11). Low on schlp, and with limits on contact in practices, USC fell to 8-5. In '11 I picked USC to win the Pac-12 South and they finished 2 full games ahead of UCLA (beat Bruins 50-0). LY I pointed out how amazing it is when perceptions change. In '11 at midyear, USC was NR and you would have been far fetched to think of USC as a Top 10 tm for '12 but the Trojans won their final 4 incl a road upset of Oregon and finished #6 catapulting them to #1 in the AP preseason in '12. USC became the first AP #1 team to finish NR s/'64 (Miss) and the 1st ever to lose 6 gms. USC also failed to beat a ranked team for the 1st time s/'97. LY most indicators were pointing up. The Trojans did improve but it was a wild ride. USC had a lackluster win over Hawaii then despite not all g an off td, thanks to 2 missed fg's and an SOD, lost to WSt at home 10-7, their 1st loss in a home opener s/'97. They held BC RB Andre Williams, who led the nation in rushing, to just 38 yds and had a 521-184 yd edge. USC ran 45 of their 76 plays in Utah St terr but only scored 17 pts still winning by 3. At Ariz St they actually led 21-14 3Q but then were blown out by the Sun Devils and Lane Kiffin was fired. Ed Orgeron led the win over Ariz but USC, thanks to a couple of missed fg lost to ND, 14-10. As an example of how USC was effected by their schlp limits, vs ND they only used 48 schlp players and 7 suffered inj's during the gm. They won their next 3 incl an upset of Oregon St on the road, 31-14. They caught Stanford the week after their upset of Oregon and beat the Cardinal 20-17. After beating Colo, USC lost 2 OL early vs UCLA and suffered their biggest loss (35-14) in the rivalry s/'70. USC hired Sarkisian and Orgeron left prior to the bowl giving them their 2nd interim HC of the season but they still whipped Fresno 45-20 (held Carr to 216 yds). USC finished 10-4, 3 gms better than '12 and #19. TY they are better off on schlp, have 14 ret str's, avoid Oregon and Wash from the North and should be favored in 10 of their 12 games.
