POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - UW has always been known for game managing QB's and a great running game. That changed in '11 when NCSt transfer Russell Wilson had an incredible year (3175, 73%, 33-4, 338 rush). Hoping to capture magic twice, former HC Bret Bielema signed another ACC transfer, Danny O'Brien who started the first 3 in '12 (team avg only 16 ppg). Joel Stave took over and in his first 5 sts the team avg 34 ppg. They also used Jr Curt Phillips (PS#18). The 3 QB's comb for 2,167 (59%, 14-6). Bielema said that Stave (1104, 56.8%, 6-3) may have the best arm, has great composure and his pre-snap reads were the best among the 3. LY all 3 ret'd and Stave won a close battle in Aug and held the job for the year. They had brought in PS#23JC Tanner McEvoy but he moved to DB. Stave threw for 2,494 (61.9%, 22-13). Phillips played in just 3 (14 att). This is the first time in 4 yrs that they return a QB that was a full-time st'r here the previous year. McEvoy returns to QB and true frosh DJ Gillins (PS#33, IFS) was added. With 4 OL st's back and another year in the system, I expect stronger QB play and McEvoy's mobility makes him a factor in the Andersen offense which values a more mobile QB.

RUNNING BACKS - UW had a streak of 10 str yrs with a 1,000 yd RB end in '03 due to inj's but now are on a new streak of 9 straight. Montee Ball was invited to the Heisman ceremony in '11 after posting 1,923 (6.3, 33 td's) and won the Doak Walker Award in '12 with 1,830 (5.1). James White had 1,052 (6.7) in '10, 713 (5.1) in '11 and 806 (6.4) in '12. When I spoke to Bielema in '12, he told me that Melvin Gordon might just be their best RB and while he rushed for just 621, his 10.0 ypc was #1 FBS. LY Gordon topped 140 in 6 of the first 7 and finished with 1,609 (7.8, 12 td) but with only 1 rec. On the first play vs Ind, White tallied the longest run in UW history with a 93 ydr (Tom Brigham 91 yd '63). White topped 100 nine times (incl 205 Ind) and was #2 with 1,444 (6.5, 39 rec's). The duo set the all-time FBS single season record with 3,053 comb rush yds (Nev's Cody Fajardo & Stephon Jefferson '12). True frosh Corey Clement (PS#25) topped 100 in each of the first 2 but was then bothered by a hamstring. He ran for 83 vs Purdue and 108 vs Ind finishing with 547 (8.2). TY they lose White (12 st, #4DC NE). While they will still be highly productive, it will be tough to replace half of the record setting combo.

RECEIVERS - A TE led UW in rec in '08 & '10. With Russell Wilson at the helm the WR's were productive in '11 as Jared Abbrederis (933, 17.0) & Nick Toon (926, 14.5) were #1 & #2 while TE Jacob Pedersen was #3 (356, 11.9). In '12 they only ret'd 1 WR with more than 15 catches in a ssn. Despite inj's, Abbrederis led with 837 (17.1) which was more than double the yds of the #2. He had 3 str 100 yd gms, the 1st here s/Lee Evans in '01. Pedersen was #2 w/355 (13.1, B10 TEPOY). 6'4" rFr Jordan Fredrick was #3 (196, 11.5). LY Pedersen missed 1 but still finished #2 with 551 (14.1). Abbrederis (1081, 13.9) twice left a game in the 1H (NW, Iowa) and had 0 rec vs Indy. He did have 207 yds vs Ohio St (mostly vs #1DC Bradley Roby) becoming the first 1,000 yd rec here s/Brandon Williams in '05. Jeff Duckworth (176, 14.7) was the #2 WR. TY they lose Abbrederis (12 st, #5DC GB), TE Brian Wozniak (10 st), Pedersen (10 st) & Duckworth. Naturally with the loss of the top 3 including their #2 car leader (didn't have a #2 man), this unit looks weaker.

OFFENSIVE LINE - When I think of Wisc, I think of big O-lines and power rush attacks. In '12 they experimented with changing the schemes early but that cch was replaced with the current cch, TJ Woods (4th OL cch s/'11). That unit got stronger as the season progressed. LY they had to replace a 1st Tm B10 C (#1DC) and a 1st Tm B10 LT, but went from 2 ret st's to 3 (48 car st back). In the final 8 of '12 they rushed for 314 ypg (6.2) but that still only put them at 236 (5.2) for the season. LY they improved to 284 and their 6.6 ypc was a schl rec'd (5.5, '96) and #2 in the FBS (Ohio St 6.8). They all'd just 16 sks. TY they do lose 1st Tm B10 LG Ryan Groy (33 car st) and Zac Matthias (2 st) but have 4 st's back (74 car sts) making this one of the best OL's in the country.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '11 UW ret'd 7 of its top 8 DL's (most exp in 3Y) but that one loss was DE JJ Watt (#1DC '11, NFL DPOY '12). Watt's value was obvious as they slipped to all'g 153 rush ypg and their 4.3 avg ypc was the weakest s/'05 (25 sk). In '12 they had 8 of their top 10 back (lost 2 st's) and improved to 129 ypg (3.8, 31 sk). LY they only had to replace 1 DE (13 st, #8 tk/r) and switched to a 3-4 and basically had "all" 3 st's back and improved to all'g 103 ypg (3.2, 26 sk). TY the losses are heavy. Gone are DE Pat Muldoon (10 st, #10 tk/r, 2 sk, 2.5 tfl), NG Beau Allen (12 st, 20 tk, 2 tfl, #7DC PHI), DE Ethan Hemer (8 st, 13 tk, 2 tfl) and DE Tyler Dippel (4 st, 17 tk). They return just 5 car sts and are the least exp'd they've been in years.

LINEBACKERS - LY the Badgers had to replace a 1st Tm B10 LB (14 st, #1 tk/r) but ret'd 3rd Tm AA Chris Borland and added in rFr Vince Biegel (PS#6). They shifted to a 3-4 but DE Brendan Kelly (13 car sts) filled the open OLB spot so it was like having 3 st's back. Borland did miss 1 but was still the star. The Badgers' D all'd just 16.3 ppg. TY they lose 1st Tm AA Borland (#1 tk/r, 4 sk, 4.5 tfl, #3DC SF), OLB Ethan Armstrong (13 st, #3 tk/r, 2 sk, 3 tfl), OLB Kelly (8 st, #7 tk/r, 4.5 sk) and ILB Conor O'Neill (9 st, #4 tk/r, 2 sk, 3.5 tfl). Borland was the 5th UW player named B10 DPOY (Troy Vincent '91, Tom Burke '98, Jamar Fletcher '00 and Erasmus James '04). Borland was the heart and soul of the D and they go from 3 ret st's to none (Michael Caputo moves back to S full-time) and while I like the talent, it's pretty obvious that this unit will not be as strong.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '11 UW all'd some big plays and the unit was inconsistent. They finished #61 in my PDR (61%, 15-16) vs a light slate of opp's. In '12 they had to replace a pair of 1st Tm B10 DB's. I said they could still move up in my PDR, which they did to #30 (55%, 18-8). LY they had to replace 3 st's (#5, #6 and #7 tk/r). The lone returnee was the FS Dezmen Southward (#4). Two DB's in the 2-deep transferred after spring. True frosh Sojourn Shelton took over at 1 CB spot. The Badgers still finished a respectable #31 (53.4%, 16-9). TY they lose FS Southward (13

st, #5 tk/r, 6 pd, #3DC ATL) and McEvoy (4 st, 27 tk) moves back to QB. They are a more veteran group with 6 of their top 8 back.

SPECIAL TEAMS - The Badgers' ST have finished middle-of-the-pack the L3Y. Kyle French hit 10-16 fg's (L46) in '12. LY he missed a 32 yd fg vs Ohio St then a 38 yd r vs NW (5-8 L42). Jack Russell took over and hit 9-13 (L48). French had 6 TB on 26 KO. True frosh Andrew Endicott had 9 TB on 57 KO. Drew Meyer (PS#25) avg 41.5 (37.6 net) as a rFr but slipped to 38.6 (35.7 net) LY. Kenzel Doe was the top KR (529, 26.5 incl a 91 yd KR td in the bowl) and PR (116, 7.2). TY they return all of the top players and after a #57 finish, they should have their best ST finish in 7 yrs (#13 in '07).

COACHES - Prior to Gary Andersen arriving LY, Barry Alvarez and Bret Bielema took Wisconsin to 11 straight bowls and avg'd 8 wins per ssn. Andersen made that 12 straight bowls with a 9 win ssn. He spent the previous 4Y at Utah St, leading them to a school record 11 wins in '12. Andy Ludwig is the OC which is a role he has held s/'97 most recently at SDSU ('11-'12), Cal ('09-'10), Utah ('05-'08) and Oregon ('02-'04). Dave Aranda was the DC at Utah St in '12 and prior to that he spent 4 seasons at Hawaii (L2Y as DC).

PHIL'S FORECAST

Bret Bielema did a fine job taking over for B10 legend Barry Alvarez going 68-24 with his teams finishing #7, #24, NR, #16, #7, #10 and NR. The '11 team might have been his best led by Russell Wilson and replacing him was a big ? heading into '12. The Badgers were a B10 best +156 ypg in '11 but benefitted from +16 in TO's and an off ypg of 10.6, signs pointing down for '12. After switching schemes on the O-line and struggling the first 2 gms, they fired their OL cch and got better as the season went on. Thanks to Penn St and Ohio St being inelig, UW (finished 3rd place Leaders with a 4-4 B10 record) went to the Big Ten Title game and beat Neb giving them their 3rd str B10 Title. They became the 3rd B10 tm to play in 3 consec Rose Bowls (OSU, Mich) and the first 5 loss tm to get there (11th str bowl, #1 B10). Bielema left for Ark and Alvarez cch'd the bowl loss to Stanford (20-14). UW finished 8-6. UW had 27 juniors on that team and was +115.4 ypg in reg ssn B10 gms (2nd best) despite their 4-4 conf record. The D has all'd fewer than 20.0 ppg the L3Y, the first time that has happened s/'92-'94. LY the Badgers avoided Neb, Mich and Mich St out of the Legends and I called for them to top their 8 win total despite having a new HC. Gary Andersen inherited 14 ret st's and the Badgers were even better than their final record. In the first 2, they won by a comb 93-0 then suffered a tough 2 pt loss to Arz St where the refs did not allow them to get a snap off to the last :15. After burying Purdue, they took OSU to the wire on the road at night but lost by 7. They buried NW 35-6, then whipped Ill and, off a bye, dominated the 2H beating Iowa 28-9. They led BYU 27-10 in their 10 pt win and destroyed Indy (like they always do), 51-3. They had 18-11 FD and 324-185 yd edges beating Minn by 13 but surprisingly were upset at home by Penn St, 31-24 then dropped the bowl to SC. The Badgers got as high as #14 but finished #22. TY Wisc only draws Rutgers and MD out of the East and had 3 net close losses LY (pg 24) and were -2 net upsets. TY's B10 opp's comb for just a 22-42 conf record LY. On the negative side, this is the least exp'd team in the B10 with just 10 ret st's but it is the 2nd year for HC Andersen. They have Melvin Gordon running behind the Big Ten's best O-line and were +175.8 ypg in Big Ten play in '13 (best). The Badgers could be back in the Big Ten Title game.
