

# TCU HORNED FROGS

## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

**QUARTERBACKS** - Andy Dalton left as TCU's career passing leader (Sammy Baugh & Davey O'Brien played here) and was the #2 DC of CIN. Casey Pachall took over in '11 and threw for 2,921 (67%, 25-7) breaking Dalton's single-ssn records. He was #1 in the NCAA in pass eff in '12 then was susp (948, 66%, 10-1). Trevone Boykin (PS#59, 4.5 spd) threw for 2,054 (57%, 15-10, 417 rush) and Boykin became the first ever Frog QB with 4 td passes in B2B gms. Pachall came into LY 15-2 as a s'r and Boykin was 3-6. In the opener vs LSU, Boykin QB'd most of the 2H after a Pachall int. Pachall was then inj'd vs SEL (miss 5) while Boykin played the 1H of SEL at WR (3-25). Boykin only topped 200 yds passing in 1 gm. Boykin started vs Texas but Pachall ret'd and took almost all of the QB snaps after that. He hit just 13-24-139 vs Texas but was 40-58-394 vs WV and Boykin had 11 rec (most for TCU ply'r) s'95 John Washington 12 vs SMU) and had 20 catches in the last 4. Pachall in 7 gms threw for 1,468 (56.4%, 6-10) while Boykin threw for 1,198 (59.7%, 7-7). TY they lose Pachall and rFr Tyler Matthews (PS#13, 0-3) but added to the mix is rFr Zach Allen (6'3" 194, PS#76) and true frosh Foster Sawyer. HC Gary Patterson hopes that one of the young QB's can take the job as he feels Boykin would be their best PR/KR, best WR and best RB. They bring in Matt Joecek (PS#53) from Texas A&M (grad). It was a subpar year for the Frogs (13-17 ratio) and even if they have a brand-new starter, they should at least match LY's numbers.

**RUNNING BACKS** - Patterson prefers to spread the carries among his top 2 or 3 backs. In '10, Ed Wesley became TCU's first 1,000 yd rusher since '03 (1078, 6.5). Waymon James (4.4 spd) had 513 (5.9) in '10 and led in '11 with 875 (7.2) but suffered a torn ACL in '12. True frosh BJ Catalan became the first true frosh to lead here s'02 (Lonta Hobbs, 582, 4.7). Not a single TCU back had a 100 yd gm in '12 and that streak continued LY (QB Boykin 101 vs TT). TCU added Neb transfer Aaron Green (PS#8) who had 105 yds (4.4) as a true with NU in '11. Green was pretty much the 3rd string RB but with both Catalan and James out, he led TCU on their comeback vs Iowa St with 72 yds on 19 carries. Green had just 25 yds and 14 carries in the final 2. Catalan, after missing 1st, had 71 and 93 in the final 2. Catalan led (569, 5.3) while James was susp the final 3 (242, 4.4). QB Boykin was #2 and Green #4 w/232 (3.2). TY they lose James but add in Trevorris Johnson (5'11" 205 rFr, PS#61). I'll call for much more Frogs RB production.

**RECEIVERS** - LY TCU had to replace their #1 and #3 rec's (comb 1346, 13.5). The top returnees were Brandon Carter (590, 16.4), LaDarius Brown (385, 14.3) and Cam White (284, 13.5). Josh Doctson came in from WY (9 st in '11, 393, 11.2) and had 2 gms mid-ssn with 0 rec but still led w/440 (12.2). David Porter

was tied for 4th in rec's w/26 but #2 in yds w/435 (16.7). Brown was #3 w/393 (10.9) while Carter was #4 (370, 11.9). QB Boykin had 21 rec's for 163 yds in the final 4. True frosh Ty Slanina (PS#64) added 184 (9.7). Florida transfer Ja Juan Story (PS#37) had a 56 yd catch vs SMU and 82 yds in the L/2 (152, 21.7). Not listed below is TE Dominic Merka (6'4" 230 Jr, PS#49). TY they lose Cam White (5 st, 172, 9.6) and LaDarius Brown (PS#12, 11 st). I thought TCU's rec underachieved LY and this is a pretty talented group that I expect a lot more out of.

**DEFENSIVE LINE** - Patterson usually does well here, even with inexp'd O-lines (see '13 mag). In '12 with 1 starter back the Frogs dropped to 152 ypg rush (3.9) with 29 sks (7.2%) as they were playing Big 12 foes. LY they had to replace a 2nd Tm B12 (2Y st'r), a HM B12 C (2Y st'r) and a RT (12 st). TCU ret'd 29 car sts. This time Patterson did not work his magic as they rushed for just 119 (3.5, 24 sk) as they had 3 diff st's at RT, 3 at RG, 2 at C, 4 at LG and 3 at LT. TY they lose RG Eric Tausch (12 st, 2Y st'r), LG/LT James Dunbar (12 st) and John Woolridge (5 st). They do improve to 57 car sts and should greatly improve upon LY's poor numbers (119 ypg lowest s'01).

**DEFENSIVE LINE** - Patterson was the DC here ('98-'00) and always fields a top-notch DL as they have yielded 2.9 ypc or less in 10 of the last 15 yrs. In '11 TCU had to replace 3 st's incl a 1st Tm AA DE and a 1st Tm MW DT. The rush numbers all'd increased for a 3rd str yr but were still at 124 ypg (3.5) but with 25 sks (fewest s'97). In '12 they had 2 st's back and they took a step up in conf but actually only all'd 105 ypg (3.2, 29 sk). True frosh Devonte Fields (PS#30) set a TCU record with 10 sks (8.5 tfl, 4 pbu). He got the first int off Collin Klein and was the B12 DPOY! LY they had to replace a #5DC but Fields was susp, inj'd and RS (2 st's back). TCU still yielded just 131 ypg (3.3, 32 sk). TY they lose DE Jon Koontz (12 st, 29 tkl, 4 sk, 5 tfl), DT Jon Lewis (5 st, 39 tkl, 4.5 sk) & DE Matt Anderson (3 st, 11 tkl). Five of the top 8 are back incl 2nd Tm B12 DT Chucky Hunter (#8 tkl'r) & Fields returns making them one of the B12's best DL.

**LINEBACKERS** - TCU runs a 4-2-5 but I include the SS in this writeup as it's the closest to a LB. LY this unit was hit hard in the offseason. They had to replace 1st Tm B12 Kenny Cain (#1 tkl'r) and 2 bkps (3 tkl). Then ret st'r Joel Hasley (#2 tkl'r) left in Aug. They did return #4 tkl'r SS Sam Carter. TCU all'd 25.3 ppg (most s'04). Paul Dawson (13 tkl '12) had 10+ tkl's in 5 of his 7 sts and finished as the #1 tkl'r (7 st, 10 tfl). Marcus Mallet (7 st) was #3 (8.5 tfl), Jonathan Anderson (10 st) was #4 and 2nd Tm B12 SS Carter (12 st) was #6 (7.5 tfl, 5 int). All 4 return TY. Patterson said that they might have won 2 or 3 more gms had they not lost Cain & Hasley. LY's group is a lot more veteran.

**DEFENSIVE BACKS** - TCU had 5 straight Top 10 finishes in my PDR from '06-'10. In '11 they had to replace a 2nd Tm MW CB, a 1st Tm AA FS and 3 bkps (7 st, 73 tkl, #7DC) and surprisingly dropped to #65 (57%, 23-10). In '12 they had to replace 3 st's (#2, #4, #10 tkl's, #7DC) and a bkp (21 tkl). While much less exp'd, they rose up to #6 (53%, 22-11) despite moving to the pass happy B12, thanks to 2nd Tm AA CB Jason Verrett. LY the entire 2-deep ret'd but Verrett tore a labrum in his shoulder vs TT and reinj'd it vs WV missing 1 gm. FS Elisha Olabode also had a nagging inj. TCU still finished (as you expect) at #3 (51.7%, 14-19). TY they lose co-B12 DPOY Verrett (11 st, #10 tkl'r, 2 int, 14 pbu, #1DC SD), FS Olabode (10 st, #5 tkl'r, 1 int, 8 pbu) and Keivon Gamble (7 tkl). While they go from 4 ret st's to 2 and lose a 2x 2nd Tm AA, TCU always has a solid secondary.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - TCU almost always produce a top-notch ST unit and had a 1st Tm MW RM for 7 str yrs ('05-'11, 4 diff ply'rs). After a #2 finish in '11, TCU had to replace their all-time K Ross Evans and slid to their "worst" ranking s'04 at #36. LY Brandon Carter had a 69 yd PR td vs TT taken off the board, then had a 59 yd PR wiped out by a clip but still

finished w/108 (10.8) while true frosh Cameron Echols-Luper had 187 (13.4). KR BJ Catalan did well (743, 26.5) and LaDarius Brown added a 45 yd outside KR td vs SMU. 6'4" 230 P Ethan Perry (PS#10) avg 44.5 (38.0 tm net) in '12 as a true frosh but slipped some as a soph (40.3, 36.6 net). He went from 19 I20 (10 tb) to 29 I20 (4 tb) as a soph (20 FC to 33) so the drop was caused by field position. Jaden Oberkrom hit 22-30 fg's (L53) in '12 and 14-18 (L56) in '13 with 3 of his 4 misses from 55, 54 and 62. TCU finished just #44. TY, especially if Boykin handles more returns, I look for the Frogs to head back up to the Top 20.

**COACHES** - Gary Patterson returns for this 14th season and for only the second time in his tenure TCU failed to make a bowl LY. There are a pair of new co-OC's TY. Doug Meacham was the co-OC at Houston LY and spent the previous 8 seasons at Okla St (TE/WR cch). Sonny Cumbie was TT's starting QB in '04 and spent the L4Y there incl LY as the co-OC. DC Dick Bumpas has worked with Patterson at 5 diff schls. Bumpas (11th yr) was a Broyles Award finalist in '08, '09 and '11 (FBS's #1 D all 3Y).

## PHIL'S FORECAST

TCU was left out when the Big 12 was formed in '96 playing in the WAC from 1996-'00, CUSA from 2001-'04 and the MW from 2005-'11. In the past, TCU did not land many VHT's but built bigger, stronger and faster athletes with a great weight training program. Almost 75% of the roster can bench 400 and TCU was annually the MW's fastest tm, especially on D. They went 48-7 in MW play with 0 conf losses the L3Y. In '09 had Texas missed a fg vs Neb in the B12 Title gm, TCU would have been in the Nat'l Title game. In '10 TCU was ranked in the pre-ssn Top 10 (#6) for just the 4th time. Eight of my 9 sets of PR's called for TCU to go 12-0 and I was the ONLY magazine which had them ranked higher than Boise St. TCU went a perfect 13-0 (+313 ypg MW) finishing #2 AP (three #1 votes). TCU was just the 3rd tm with 3 str #1 finishes in the FBS def rankings. They had a fine 11-2 ssn in '11. They ended 5 Boise's 47 gm home conf win streak. They opened and finished #14 AP. Their switch to the B12 meant a step up in competition in '12. I called for their streak of 4 str 11+ win ssns to end. Patterson called them the youngest tm he'd ever had (just 12 Sr's, 11 Jr's). They opened 4-0 but QB Pachall was then susp. TCU went 3-6 down the stretch incl a bowl loss to Mich St. LY TCU had 14 ret st's and were pre-ssn #20 AP. They were considered a clear-cut B12 contender (picked #1 by some). In the "Cowboys Classic" they lost to LSU 37-27 (outgained 448-259). Pachall was inj'd in the 1H vs a SEL tm that had scored 26 pts in the previous 5 vs BCS foes. TCU only won 38-17. There was some ? officiating (PR td called back) and they lost to TT, 20-10. After beating SMU, TCU did not get a FD until the middle of the 3Q vs Okla. Trailing 20-0 they battled back to 20-17 but lost. TCU didn't get a 2 score lead vs Kansas until a fg w/2:34 left. They trailed Okla St 17-0 and lost 24-10. With a 3 hr lightning delay, they lost to Texas at home 30-7 then to WV at home in OT. They needed a td w/4:1 left to get past 1-7 IST on the road but gave up a 41 yd fg on the last play and lost to K-St, 33-31. They caught BU the week after their first loss. TCU, down 20-17 gave up an 82 yd IR td (14 pt swing) and at the end had a tipped pass int'd in the EZ and lost by 3 for their first losing ssn s'04. TY TCU has 16 ret st's and rate a +5.0 in my Stock Market (pg 32), had 3 net close losses, 3 net upsets and a def ypg of 14.1. They have 5 Big 12 HG's. I have no doubt Patterson will get TCU back to the top of the Big 12 in a hurry. Seven of TCU's 8 losses (4 vs ranked tms) saw them with a chance to win in the 4Q or OT and they are my surprise team of the Big 12.

First meeting. TCU has won 12 str home openers. HC Patterson lost his first home game as NWSU but is 7-0 since vs FCS tms w/an avg win by 43 ppg. The Bulldogs went 8-5 LY (FCS playoffs).

**Bonus:** LY TCU was shutout at HT 3x's and in five of the other nine gms failed to top 10 pts. The Horned Frogs ssn high mark for pts at HT was 17 (FCS SEL, WV and Baylor).

Into '14, TCU is 23-2 at home vs non-conf opp's. This marks just the 2nd all-time meeting. TCU lost 9-7 in 1974. The last time TCU failed to make a bowl, the next yr they went 11-1 (ranked #11).

TCU has won 12 of L/14. LTH TCU led 14-0 and 24-10 early 4Q but only gained 58 yds on their 4 scoring drives as they forced 6 SMU TO's (156 yds was a ssn low, 118 less than 2nd lowest).

HT is 2-5. LY TCU trailed 13-0 at HT, outgained 200-111 (all 6 1H drives went 3&out). TCU only trailed 13-10 into the 4Q and after cutting the deficit to 3 again elected to KO but OU ran out L/2:26.

Former SWC rivals reunited in B12. LTH TCU only led 28-21 after 3Q but outscored BU 21-0 in the 4Q w/a 115-63 yd edge. TCU is 17-5 in conference AG's but 4 of 5 losses were LY.

HT is 7-1-1 (24 overall gms). LY TCU trailed 17-0 at HT being outgained 293-52, in fact they had 3 str 1H drives end in TO's. TCU cut it to 7 mid 4Q but was SOD near midfield their L/2 poss.

57th meeting, tms have met just 4x's since their SWC days. LY TCU trailed 10-0 at HT but w/6:28 left tied the gm. Down just 7 the Horned Frogs L/2 drives ended on a punt & SOD at TT28 w/4:0.

LTH WV ret a punt 76 yds for a td to lead 31-24 but TCU tossed a 94 yd td pass w/1:28 left to force OT. TCU all'd a 25 yd td pass & tossed a 25 yd td pass but went for 2 & the win on the road.

The home tm is 5-2 all-time. LY's gm featured 7 lead changes (3 in the 4Q). After a 36/9pl 56 yd fg drive TCU led 31-30 w/2:13 left but then all'd KSU to go 44/9pl hitting a GW 41 yd fg w/0:3.

TCU is 2-0 in B12 action (both wins by DD's). LTH TCU only led 7-6 late 2Q but got a fg before HT. In the 2H TCU shutout KU with KU having drives end at the TCU 37 & 36 while also fumbling into EZ (from TCU3).

TCU is 2-29. LTH TCU never trailed as UT scored w/3:07 left (TCU int'd UT on its final drive w/1:20).

TCU is 4-1. LY TCU scored w/38 left for the win. L/time Frogs dropped 3 str home finales was from '88-'90.
