POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - In '10 TJ Yates had his best ssn ever by throwing for a schl record 3,418 (67%, 19-9). Bryn Renner (PS#20) played in 3 (2 att). Yates (NC car passing leader) was the #5DC of HOU and led them to their 1st ever playoff win in his rookie year. In '11 Renner threw for 3,086 (68%, 26-13) despite bone spurs (ankle). He had surgery and played w/o pain in the ankle in '12. It was unknown how Renner would fit into Fedora's offense (likes mobile QB's) as Renner had -88 rush in '11. He showed some mobility in '12 (38 net, just 11 sk). At midseason OC Blake Anderson installed a package with bkp Marquise Williams in the shotgun and Renner at slot receiver. Williams was the #4 rusher (186, 6.4, 10-17-127). Renner threw for 3,356 (65%, 28-7). Williams was susp last spring but did a lot of work while away impressing Fedora. They added in VHT Mitch Trubisky (PS#25) who nearly beat out Williams for the #2 spot. Renner was banged up early and they started to use a 2-QB system more. Renner was then OFY after gm 7 (1765, 65.8%, 10-5). Williams became the first QB to lead NC in rushing (536, 4.8) since Gayle Bomar in 1968 and threw for 1,698 (58.1%, 15-6) finishing with a higher Eff (141.1) than Renner (139.9). Despite the loss of the school's #3 career passer, I think they could improve with QB's that better fit the system.

RUNNING BACKS - NC had 12 straight 1,000 yd rushers from 1973-'84 but had just one from '94-'10 ('97 Jonathan Linton)! In '11 they had to replace their top 3 rushers. Rfr Giovanni Bernard took charge and broke the elusive 1,000 yd barrier with 1,253 (5.2, 13 td, #3 rec, 362). AJ Blue (conv QB) was #3 (138, 4.2). In '12 Bernard was 3rd Tm AA despite missing 2 (WF, UL 2 close losses). He became (1228, 6.7, 490 rec) the first Tar Heel with B2B 1,000 seasons s/Natrone Means ('91-'92). Blue had 106 vs WF and was #2 (433, 5.3, 9 td). Rfr Romar Morris (PS#37, 100M champ HS) topped 70 three times (386, 5.6). LY Bernard left early for the NFL (#2DC) and I said it would be tough to replace his 6.7 ypc. Morris led in each of the first 3 (56 ypg). He was inj'd and Blue led vs EC with 68. True frosh TJ Logan (PS#26, tm fastest) missed the first 4 but led the RB's in 6 of the last 8 (533, 5.7). Morris was the #3 RB (296, 4.3). True frosh Khiris Francis (PS#77) added 236 (3.7). TY they lose Blue (3 st, 298, 4.0) but I expect much improved production and they also add in true frosh Elijah Hood (PS#8) who was IFS.

RECEIVERS - In '12 the Tar Heels had to replace their top rec (1196, 14.1) but ret'd 3 of their top 4. Quinshad Davis (PS#50) set an NC frosh record with 61 rec's and led with 776 (12.7). He tied an ACC record with 16 rec vs UVA. TE Eric Ebron (207, 20.7 true) was #2 with 625 (15.6). Eric Highsmith, who was #2 in '11 with 726 (14.2) dropped to #3 with just 587 (10.9). LY the top 2 ret'd. TJ Thorpe (PS#26) had 960 KR yds (26.7) as a true frosh but just 2 rec's. Ebron set the ACC record for rec yds by a TE and was #1 with 973 (15.7). Davis was #2 with 730 (15.2) and another true frosh emerged in dynamic RM Ryan Switzer (341, 10.7). Surprisingly Thorpe had just 267 (11.1) and another true frosh Johnathan "Bug" Howard (PS#71) was #4 (278, 12.6). Ebron left early for the NFL (#1DC DET). I wouldn't rule out more trues playing this year and even with the loss of their top guy, this unit could be even stronger.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '11 NC had 8 of their top 10 back (60 car sts) and put up their best rushing numbers in both ypg and ypc (139, 4.1) s/O4. In '12 they had to replace 1 st'r and I called them the ACC's top O-line. NC had a record-setting season offensively and this unit paved the way for 194 ypg rush (5.1, best s/'94) while all'g just 11 sks (fewest 15+ yrs). LY they had to replace 3 st'r's (#1, #3 & #7 DC's) but did return 1st Tm ACC LT James Hurst (PS#3). The unit with 55 car sts, saw its numbers drop to 148 ypg rush (3.9) with 21 sacks. TY they lose 1st Tm ACC Hurst (13 st, 4Y st'r, undrafted after breaking leg in bowl) and C Russell Bodine (13 st, 2Y st'r, #4DC CIN). While they lose 2 from the 2 key OL positions (C/LT) and the car sts drop to 44, LY's line had 2 frosh and a soph st'r and TY's has 3 ret st'r's as opposed to 2 LY so I'll call the unit equal to '13.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '12 NC had to replace 2x 1st Tm ACC DE Quinton Coples (#1DC), a DT (13 st, 46 tkl) and 2 bkps (48 tkl, 7 tfl). They switched to a 3-3-5 D and had 2 solid st'r's back in DT Sylvester Williams (PS#7JC) & DE Kareem Martin. Thanks mostly to a forgettable game vs GT (380 rush, 5.7), NC's rush numbers slipped a little from 124 ypg (3.6, 25 sk) to 143 ypg (3.6, 29 sk). LY they had to replace 1st Tm ACC DT Williams (#1DC) but did have 5 of their top 6 back incl 2nd Tm ACC Martin (turn down NFL). Surprisingly the rush numbers slipped to 182 ypg (4.2, 31 sk), their highest s/O4. TY they lose 3rd Tm AA Martin (13 st, #3 tkl'r, 11.5 sk, 10 tfl, #3DC ARZ) and DT Tim Jackson (13 st, 26 tkl). While they may not drop much because LY's numbers were poor, this unit is clearly less exp'd and loses by far their top guy.

LINEBACKERS - LY NC had to replace their top player in 1st Tm AA Kevin Reddick (#2 tkl'r) and 2 other st'r's (#5, #8 tkl'r). Their leading returnees were just #4, #11 & #15 tkl'r's. Travis Hughes (3 st, 38 tkl'r) st'd 11 LY (5# tkl'r, 5.5 tfl). Tommy Heffernan st'd 9 in '12 (73 tkl) but never fully recovered from offseason ankle surg LY (2 tkl). Norkeithus Otis (PS#32) finished #7 (7.5 sk, 5.5 tfl). Brandon Ellerbe st'd the first 2 but soph Malik Simmons st'd 10 at RAM (#9 tkl'r, 2 tfl). TY they only lose Terry Shankle (23 tkl) & Heffernan making this group vastly more exp'd.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - NC dropped from #17 in my PDR in '09 to #45 in '10 and #67 in '11. In '12 they had 3 back with 8+ car sts so despite losing 26 sts to graduation, they were much more exp'd and moved up to #26 (58%, 15-16) despite their 2-deep consisting of 5 frosh, 1 soph and 2 juniors. LY the unit ret'd intact and they moved up to #19 (55.9%, 16-13). This, despite SS Sam Smiley (5 st '12, 26 tkl) being OFY in Aug. TY they lose CB Jabari Price (13 st, #4 tkl'r, 9 pbu, #7DC MIN) and 2nd Tm ACC FS Tre Boston (13 st, #1 tkl'r, 5 int, 8 pbu, #4DC CAR). Getting Smiley back is like having 7 of their top 9 back and I'll call them on par with LY's solid group.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Larry Fedora had two Top 20 ST finishes in his final 3 yrs at SM. He inherited a NC team that

had finished just #111 and #74 the prior 2 years. He has made quite an impact as they moved up to #9 in '12. LY they had to replace their outstanding K and top PR (263, 16.4). NC finished #13 with the emergence of PR Ryan Switzer as a 1st Tm AA (502, 20.9) with an NCAA-tying 5 td's. Three dangerous KR's contributed to a 23.8 avg (TJ Logan 2 td). Thomas Moore (PS#49) took over on fg's and hit 14-19 but with a long of just 40 (1-5 40+). Tommy Hibbard avg 43.0 on punts and a #10 tm net of 40.3. TY everyone returns and NC should contend for the #1 spot.

COACHES - Larry Fedora took over in '12 and the 8-4 record his first season was the best here since Mack Brown's final season in '97. Fedora was previously the HC at Southern Miss (schl record 12 wins '11) and the OC at Okla St ('05-'07). Blake Anderson who was Fedora's OC the L4Y is now the HC at Ark St. The new co-OC's are Gunter Brewer (WR cch) and Chris Kapilovic (OL cch). DC Dan Disch also served in the same role at S Miss ('11) and previously at Illinois ('05-'10, co-DC 3Y). Assoc HC for the Def, Vic Koenning, is also back for his third season spending the previous 2Y at Ill (DC/interim HC), 4Y at Clemson as DC along with HC exp at Wyoming ('00-'02).

PHIL'S FORECAST

UNC did not finish above .500 for 5 straight years from '02-'06 (1 bowl). Butch Davis had a losing season in his first year but then went 8-5 in each of his last 3 yrs and could have easily had a better record. In his final season ('10), the team was hit hard by NCAA susp's. In '11 UNC opted to fire Davis a week before Aug camp. The team went 7-6 under interim HC Everett Withers despite opening 5-1. In '12 I thought Fedora stepped into a good situation despite NC being on probation and picked them to win the Coastal. Had UNC been eligible, they would have been in the ACC Title game finishing in a 3-way tie for 1st with a couple of tough losses but still improved to 8-4. That team also set more than 35 school records including total points (487), ppg (40.7) and total offense (5,827). LY NC had 13 ret st'r's, coming off a year where they were -3 in net upsets. They also had a veteran QB in Renner and what looked to be an improved defense. SCar had a 260-120 yd edge at half and won the opener, 27-10. NC beat MT as expected and then had 10 FD's and 218 yds in their first 11:00 vs GTech leading 20-7 but ended up losing 28-20. They then were embarrassed at home by ECar. VT led them 27-10 and UNC scored a td w/1:09 left to only lose by 10. They gave Miami a great game and probably should have won but UM got a td w/1:16 left to pull out a 27-23 win. At this point, UNC was 1-5 and Fedora adopted a simple weekly slogan of "Be 1-0". UNC won 6 of their last 7 (favored all 7). With bkp QB Williams starting, they walloped BC 34-10, they trailed NCST 10-0 but rallied for a 27-19 win. NC crushed UVA 45-14 and then had a couple PR td's by Switzer to get past Pitt, 34-27. Vs ODU they set all-time records for pts and td's by mid-3Q and the two teams agreed to shorten the 4Q to 10:00. NC won 80-20 (2nd most pts ACC history). NC led Duke 15-10 before giving up a 99 yd KR td and Duke got a 27 yd fg with 2:22 left to pull out a 27-25 win. NC rebounded with an impressive 39-17 win over Cincy in the bowl to actually finish with a winning record at 7-6. TY they have 15 ret st'r's incl QB Williams, top RB Logan, dangerous RM/WR Switzer and 9 of their top 12 tkl'r's. One of my 9 sets of power ratings calls for a 12-0 season so there is a very high ceiling in '14 if they continue to build off that year end momentum.

First meeting. In '10 HC Federa beat Liberty HC Gill with both at previous schools (SMISS/Kansas). NC is 6-1 in home openers. Flames went 8-4 LY, 2 losses vs FBS tms (Kent St & ODU).
Only prior meeting was the '98 LY Bowl, NC won 20-13. The Tar Heels are 16-1 hosting non-conference opp's with the loss LY vs East Carolina (that loss snapped a string of 15 str wins).

Bonus: Into 2014, North Carolina is 4-7 s/o4 in non-conf away gms (2 straight losses).

NC is 12-3-1 (never dropped 2 str). LTH ('11) NC led 28-3 at HT, EC trailed by 15+ pts all of 2H. Federa was 2-2 vs EC while at SM. NC is 2-9 s/o3 in their road/neutral opener.

NC is 2-11 s/82 in Clemson incl 3 str losses by 25 ppg. LTH ('11) NC lost 59-38. NC is 13-23 L/9 ssns on the ACC road incl 4-8 L3Y. Tar Heels are 1-10 the last 4 ssns vs ranked opp's (8 str losses).

NC is 2-8. LY North Carolina trailed 21-7 at HT. The Tar Heels managed to hold the Hokies to just 64 2H yds but they never got within SD's. NC is 7-0 s/o7 at home after 2+ road gms.
