

QUARTERBACKS-In '12 UCF had 2 QB's on the roster who had been full-time st'rs but neither ply'd the position in '12. Rob Calabrese (13 car st '08-'10) & Jeff Godfrey (PS#32, 24 QB st) both moved to receiver. Blake Bortles st'd all 14 (3059) 63%, 25-7, 285 rush, 3.3). Bortles was the first UCF QB to ever be named 1st or 2nd Tm CUSA. LY Bortles set a school record with 232 atts w/o an int (snapped vs Penn St, began in '12). He threw for 3,581 (67.8%, 25-9, 272 rush) including some 4Q heroics. He was the Fiesta Bowl MVP (394 ttl vd) and was the first QB picked (#1DC JAX) in TY's draft. LY true frosh Justin Holman (PS#113) was forced into the bkp role and ply'd in 3 (9-14). I list his challengers below and they also get the addition of Boise transfer Nick Patti (PS#65). This unit goes from a 1st

Rnd DC to one with 25 career passes.

NUMBER OF THE PROPERTY O with Brynn Harvey (1109, 4.2, '09), Latavius Murray (1186, '10-'11) and VHT Miami (FI) transfer Storm Johnson (PS#20). Murray missed 3 but was clearly the top RB (1106, 5.6). Johnson was #2 w/507 (4.5) and Harvey (inj '11) never regained his '09 form (249, 4.2). When Murray ret'd from injury, Johnson had just 23 att's in the final 8.LY they had to replace Murray (#6DC), Harvey and their 4Y starting FB. Johnson had 99 in the opener plus five 100 yd efforts finishing #1 (1139, 5.3, 260 rec, 17 ttl td). True frosh William Stanback added 443 (4.2) plus 186 rec (12.4). Two QB's and 2 WR's made up the #3-#6 rushers and the #3 RB was Cedric Thompson (17 yd). TY Johnson left early for the NFL (#7DC JAX) and added to the mix is a pair of soph's in Micah Reed (PS#83), Dontravious Wilson (PS#138) along with Cedric Thompson (6'0" 226 Jr) who has 79 (4.4) the last 2 yrs. Even with no VHT's, this is a decent group.

BEFEWERS-In '11 UCF lost their top 3 rec's. RFr JJ Worton led with 531 (13.0). In '12 they moved in the QB duo of Calabrese and Godfrey. Surprisingly Rannell Hall (4 rec true) was #1 (631, tm high 18.0). Worton was #2 (594, 13.5) while Godfrey was #3 (429, 11.0). The top 4 comb for 2,042 yds (14.2) in '12 and all ret'd LY to comb for 2,824 (15.2). JJ Worton had a spectacular 1-handed grab that keyed the win over Temple (10-179) and had four 100 yd gms (721, 15.3). Breshad Perriman (388, 14.9, '12) did miss 1 gm after being taken off the field on a stretcher vs UH (conc) and while only #4 in rec (39) he was #2 in yds (20.8 ypc!). Hall led again w/886 (15.5). TY they lose Godfrey (4 st, 406, 9.4) but this unit is one of the AAC's best. They do get the large addition of Jackie Williams who was UAB's #1 receiver in

12 and in 3Y had 1,733 yds (12.4, 652 ret yds).

OFFENSIVE LINE- In '12 UCF had to replace a 2nd Tm CUSA RT (4Y st'r) and a 3Y OG but added in GT transfer Phil

Smith (3Y st'r). They had 4 back who had been full-time st'rs (89 car st). Smith only st'd the last 7 at RT when LG Theo Goins was inj. UCF improved to 182 ypg rush (4.8, 23 sk, 5.6%). LY they had to replace a 1st Tm CUSA C (3Y str), a 3Y LG and their RT (7 st). They did return 2nd Tm CUSA LT Torrian Wilson (PS#35) and 3rd Tm CUSA Jordan McCray but the car sts dropped to 68. UCF's numbers slipped a little to 160 ypg (4.4, 22 sk) but they did move up to the AAC. TY they lose 1st Tm AAC LG Jordan McCray (13 st, 2Y st'r), 1st Tm AAC RG Justin McCray (13 st, 2.5Y st'r) and 2nd Tm AAC RT Chris Martin (13 st, 2Y st'r). They do return 3rd Tm AAC LT Wilson but the car sts drop again down to 45.

DEFENSIVE LINE- In both '10 & '11 UCF had to replace 3 st'rs but were solid (108 ypg, 3.4 '10, 109 ypg, 3.8 '11). İn '12 they had 3 st'rs back but surprisingly slipped to 156 (4.0, 27 sk). LY they had to replace a 1st Tm CUSA DE (8 sk), their other DE (12 st) and 2 other DL (comb 9 st, 54 tkl). I summed it up by saying that they were slightly less exp'd but it wouldn't surprise me to see them improve upon '12's underachieving numbers. That is exactly what happened as UCF all'd 122 ypg (4.0, 29 sk). TY they lose 3rd Tm AAC DT EJ Dunston (10 st, 42 tkl, 3 sk, 3.5 tfl) and Blake Keller (1 st, 3 sk) but had 4 soph in the starting rotation LY and add in a PS#43JC making them even stronger.

LINES - In '12 the Knights had to replace 2 LB's (comb 14 st) incl their #3 tkl'r. The ppg slipped for a 3rd str year (17.1, 18.3, 22.1). LY UCF had to replace 2 st'rs (#4 and #5 tkl'rs) and ret'd Terrance Plummer (#3 tkl'r) along with Troy Gray (9 st '11, 33 tkl '12). Plummer (2.5 sk, 6 tfl, 8 pd) was the defensive leader (#1 tkl'r) and earned FWAA Nat'l DPOW vs Memphis (2 int, 2 pbu, 1 sk). Despite the move to a BCS conf AND playing the NCAA's #1 offense in the bowl they all'd just 21.3 ppg. TY they do lose Sean Maag (7 st, #3 tkl'r, 4 tfl) who st'd because OLB Willie Mitchell (PS#99) was OFY after 2 sts. Mitchell, Plummer (1st Tm AAC) and Gray all return so they go from 1 ret st'r to 2 and add in a PS#96JC.

THE FAMILY BY DESS-In '07 and '08 with exp'd secondaries, UCF finished #14 and #8 in my PDR. In '09 I called the unit my biggest concern on the tm (lost 186 car sts, 50 car int). The unit plummeted to #83. In '10 they had 3 st'rs back and moved back up to #12 and in '11 (2 ret st'r) they were #13. In '12 they did have to replace 1 st'r (#3DC) but "only" finished #39 (60%, 16-11) despite Kemal Ishmael earning CUSA DPOY. LY they had to replace Ishmael (#7DC), a CB (#8 tKl'r) and a NB (5 st, #9 tkl'r). Despite going from 3 ret st'rs to 2, I pointed out that with UCF's track record of Top 15 PDR rankings, I didn't think they'd drop too much. They actually rose to #16 (56.8%, 13-14). They moved CB Brandon Alexander (3 int, 7 pbu) to FS where he was a better fit (#4 tkl'r) opening up a spot for Jordan Ozerities (#6 tkl'r, 7 pd). RFr Jacoby Glenn st'd at one CB (2 int,15 pbu, #7 tkl'r) éarning 1st Tm AAC. SS Clayton Geathers was 2nd Tm AAC (#2 tkl'r). They added 3 very athletic ply'rs in rFr Drico Johnson (PS#153) and true frosh Shaquill Griffin (PS#211) and DJ Killings (PS#224) who gained exp as bkps. TY the entire 2-deep returns and I expect

UCF to make the Top 10 in my PDR this year. ST unit (sign of a good cch) as you can see by the rankings listed including a pair of Top 10 finishes (#8 '07, #9 '10). LY they had to replace their career KR yds leader Quincy McDuffie (#1 NCAA 34.2) as well as their P (35.1 net). I noted that they had speedy KR Rannell Hall and that they could have another Top 25 finish and they finished #29. Hall had 689 on KR's (23.8) while JJ Worton had 157 (12.1) PR yds. K Shawn Moffitt, whó had problems with a low trajectory in 12 (10-14, L49) improved to a schl rec % (91.3%) hitting 21-23 (L50 miss from 50). The new P was rFr Caleb Houston who avg 42.2 (35.4 net). There's a lot to be said when your worst finish in the last 7Y is #29 and with all of the key ply'rs back, this looks like another premium UCF ST unit.

CONDITIES - George O'Leary keeps working his magic. In his 10th ssn here and UCF's first in a BCS conf, he led them to a schl record 12 wins a BCS bowl victory and 2 wins vs Top 10 teams. O'Leary won 3 CUSA COY awards and now an AAC COY. Prior to UCF he led GT to five bowls in 7 yrs ('95-'01). Charlie Taaffe is in his 6th ssn as OC and has 21 yrs as a HC in both the CFL & NCAA (Hamilton '07-'08, Montreal '99-'00, The

Citadel '87-'96 and Army '81-'86). For the 6th time in 5Y UCF has a new DC. Paul Ferraro was originally hired as the new DC for TY, but left in March (personal) and LB cch Tyson Summers was elevated to interim DC and then permanent DC in late April. He was LB cch here L2Y and at UAB from '07-'11 (LB/S)

ALSO ON ROSTER-

George O'Leary has done a fine job at UCF. His first season ('04) they went 0-11 but became the 7th team in NCAA history to go from winless to bowl-eligible (8-5) in '05. After a drop back to 4-8 in '06, they finished 10-4 in '07. It was back down to 4-8 in '08 but they made my MIT list again in '09 moving up to 8-5. O'Leary broke the trend of winning and losing season's with a dominant D in '10. UCF won the CUSA Title then upset UGA in the bowl and for the first time ever finished ranked (#21). They were the media's pick to win the CUSA East in '11 (I had SMiss) but dropped back to 5-7. In '12 they were my #1 MIT as they came off a year in which they had 6 net close losses and had 16 ret st'rs. They lived up to my MIT billing but did have a few tough losses. They dominated Missouri in the 1H (269-74 yd) lost by 5. They had 2 tough losses to Tulsa by 2 and 6 (see '12 mag) but whipped Ball St in the bowl 38-17 and went from 5 to 10 wins. LY they had 7 st'rs back on offense incl NFL caliber QB Bortles. The D did lose 7 of their top 10 tkl'rs. They opened with blowout wins over Akron and FIU then led Penn St 21-10 at half and won 34-31, their first ever win vs the B10. They led SC 10-0 at half but lost by 3. In a letdown spot vs Memphis, UCF trailed 7-3 at half. UCF scored a td w/2:05 left, Memphis fmbl'd the KO, UCF ret'd it for another td w/1:56 left and Memphis' HB option pass into the EZ was int'd w/:35 left and they escaped. They played UL for what would have been the AAC Title and trailed 28-7 in the 3Q. UCF rallied and got a td w/:23 left to pull the upset and take control of the AAC. After blowing out Conn 62-17 UCF led Houston 6-0 at half but at the end of the game with :20 left, UH had a 4&gl from the UCF7 but the pass was tipped and fell inc and UCF won 19-14. They were fortunate to get past Temple (trailed 36-29) getting a 30 yd td pass to Worton w/1:40 left with an outstanding 1-handed grab. Then with :02 left, after another big pass play, a 24 yd fg. They destroyed RU 41-17 but struggled again vs USF. They got a td w/4:50 left to pull out the 23-20 win. There was a blizzard and ice storm in Dallas and only a few hundred fans attended. SMU with a bkp QB led 10-3 at half but UCF came back to win 17-13. UCF was not given much of a chance in the bowl vs #6 Baylor but controlled matters in a 52-42 win. TY UCF goes from 12 ret st'rs to 15 but does lose Bortles. They rate a -4.5 in the Stock Market Indicator (pg 32), had 6 net close wins and +3 net upsets. UCF was the youngest school (1963) and football program (1979) to ever participate in a BCS bowl. They play Penn St, Missouri, Houston and East Carolina away from home so they probably won't match their 12 wins of '13 or Top 10 finish but are still one of the nation's stronger teams especially with 9 st'rs back from their excellent defense.
