POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - Boise has had some fine QB's excel in their system. In '08 I projected VHT rFr Kellen Moore (PS#24) to win the job (not the starter out of spring). Moore became the first frosh QB to start the opener here and had a storied career. In '11 Moore set the NCAA career record for most wins by a starting QB with 50 (3 losses by 5 tlt pts). Moore threw for 3,800 (74%, 43-9) and left holding almost every Boise passing record and is the 2nd least int'd QB in FBS history. Joe Southwick (2 yr bkp) played in 8 (198, 77%, 1-1) and rFr Grant Hedrick played in 8 (3 att) as the Wildcat QB (70 rush, 8.8). In '12 Southwick had a 10-7 ratio in the first 9 but over the final 4 threw for 888 (70%, 9-0) finishing with 2,730 (67%, 19-7, 121 rush). Hedrick played in 8 (12-17-116). LY Southwick had his 3rd OC in 3 yrs yet still hit a school record 93.1% (27-29-287) vs Air Force (Jared Zebransky's 91.3% '06). He st'd the first 7 but broke his ankle vs Nev (only 2 att after) finishing with 1,654 (72.7%, 12-5). The Broncos had not lost a QB to an extended injury s/'02. Hedrick became the first Bronco QB to rush for 100 yds in a game s/'04 (115 vs Nev, 277 yr) and threw for 1,825 in his 5 sts (69%, 16-5). RFr Nick Patti (PS#65) hit 8-11-63 in 6 gms. TY they add in rFr Ryan Finley (PS#50) and JC Tommy Stuart while Patti trans. While they lose a 2 year starter, Hedrick is not trying to replace a legend like Southwick was.

RUNNING BACKS - For 7 str yrs, Boise did not have a 1,000 yd rusher who weighed 200 lbs. Doug Martin (The Muscle Hamster) broke that streak in '10 and became the 5th Boise rusher with B2B 1,000 yd seasons then had a fine year with the TB Bucs in '12 (#1DC). In '12 DJ Harper (206 lb) had 1,137 (5.0) and Jay Ajayi (PS#97, 548, 6.7) was #2. LY I said the 225 lb back (Ajayi) with speed and elusiveness (physical runner), would top Harper's '12 numbers. Ajayi rushed for 1,425 (5.7) with 18 td's. QB Hedrick was #2 and true frosh Aaron Baltazar (PS#49) was #3 (234, 4.7, 5 gm til ACL). Jack Fields (5'9" 197 Jr, PS#162) added 139 (3.0). Surprisingly Derrick Thomas (PS#159JC) had just 95 (3.0). RFr Devan Demas (PS#125) led with 73 vs WY (125, 6.0). Charles Bertoli (5'11" 190 So) had 115 (6.4). TY the only loss is Baltazar (trans) and this unit has now produced a 1,000 yd rusher for 5 str seasons with 4 diff backs.

RECEIVERS - The WR's were the tms biggest concern into '11 (lost #1 & #2 car rec's). Matt Miller set the Boise frosh record for rec's w/62 (679, 11.0). In '12 they had 3 of the top 4 back. Miller led with 769 (11.7, 1st Tm MW), 6'3" Kirby Moore (PS#104) was #2 (368, 10.2). Geraldo Boldewijn was 6'4" and a deep threat but was susp'd the first 4 of '12 (197, 10.9). True frosh Shane Williams-Rhodes (PS#133) who is 5'6" 160, had 21 rush att's (97, 4.6) and added 142 (5.7) rec. 6'3" Aaron Burks had

Boise's first 100 yd gm (Wk 10 UH) in '12 (319, 18.8). LY they had their most exp'd rec corps in 3 yrs. A key TE had been inj'd each of the previous 5 yrs including Gabe Linehan (1 st OFY '12). Kirby Moore had 25 rec in the first 4 but missed 6 then had 7 in the bowl (#5, 280, 7.8). Williams-Rhodes had the most rec in a 2 gm span S/'03 (Tim Gilligan) with 22 vs SM/UST, but missed the L/2 and finished #2 (702, 9.1). Miller was the first here to top 200 yds rec s/'03 (11-206 bowl) and led with 1,140 (13.0). TY they lose Boldewijn (13 st, 528, 13.5) Moore, (5 st), Burks (3 st, 309, 17.2) and TE Linehan (3 st, 2 rec). Despite the losses, the top 2 are back so they could be just as strong.

OFFENSIVE LINE - From '10-'12 Boise had 88, 98 and 56 car sts back. In '12 they did have a streak of having a 1st Tm conf LT snapped after 8 yrs (Charles Leno "only" 2nd Tm). That '12 Boise OL had to replace a 1st Tm MW LT (4Y st'r, #7DC), 3Y C and RG (10 st). They lost their C (8 st) in Aug and used 3 diff OL combos the first 3 but still opened holes for 168 ypg (4.6). LY they had to replace a 2Y st'r RG, 3Y LG, 3Y RT and a bkp. They did return a pair of all-conf players (52 car sts). They ran the ball more (478 to 563 rush att) so the ypg improved to 198 (4.6) but they all'd 26 sks (5.6%). TY they lose 1st Tm MW LT Charles Leno (13 st, 3Y st'r, #7DC CHI), 2nd Tm MWC Matt Paradis (13 st, 2Y st'r, #6DC DEN), LH Spencer Gerke (13 st, 21 car st) and bkp Chris Tozer. They do not have any seniors on TY's O-line and their car sts drop again to 26.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '10 the entire 2 deep ret'd and I said Boise could top '06's dominant rush D totals (89 ypg, 3.2). They allowed just 2.9 ypc (104 ypg) and had 49 sks (best s/'97). Boise's rush numbers have gotten weaker in each of the last 3 yrs (now face option tms like AF & NM). In '12 they had to replace a 1st Tm MW DE (#3DC), 1st Tm MW DE (#1DC), 2nd Tm MW DT (#6DC), a NT (10 st) and a DE (6 st). They had 5 car sts back but did add in PS#23JC Demarcus Lawrence. Boise did well all'g just 146 ypg (3.7, 38 sk). LY they had to replace a 1st Tm MW NT, a Fr AA DE and 2 bkp DL (6 st). They expected a PS#152JC to start but he DNQ. With 2 ret st's incl Lawrence (did lose all 3 LB) they slipped again (164 ypg, 3.8, 30 sk). TY 1st Tm MW Lawrence left early for the NFL (12 st, 72 tkl, 10.5 sk, 10 tfl, #2DC DAL). Also gone are 1st Tm MW NT Ricky Tjong-A-Tjoe (52 tkl, 4 tfl) and STUD Kharye Marshall (13 st, 32 tkl, 6.5 tfl). True frosh Gabe Perez (29 tkl, 2.5 sk, 4.5 tfl) and Kamalei Correa (PS#121, 12 tkl) got their feet wet so this will still be a decent DL despite the 3 big losses.

LINEBACKERS - For years I included the nickle pos in the LB write up and LY they officially changed the pos name from nickle to SLB and this yr are moving back to a 4-2-5 and I include the NB here. Boise had not had a LB make 1st Tm All-Conf s/'06 but JC Percy (64, 65, 48 tkl as 3Y bkp) missed the sch'l rec for tkl's in a season by 1 and was 1st Tm MW in '12. LY they had to replace all 3 LB st's. The leading returnees were Blake Renaud (PS#48, #6 tkl'r) and Corey Bell (#7 tkl'r, 4 st). In '12 their top 3 returnees had comb'd for 83 tkl's in '11 and LY the top 3 comb'd for 118 tkl's in '12. Renaud st'd the first 6 but then was inj'd (#18 tkl'r). True frosh Tanner Vallejo (PS#86) st'd 6 (#8 tkl'r, 5.5 tfl). Soph Tyler Gray began as the st'r but '12's Scout Tm DPOV Ben Weaver emerged at 240 lbs and finished as the #1 tkl'r (89). The SLB spot had 4 diff st's. The only loss TY is Jonathan Brown (1 st tjl inj, 10 tkl). This is by far the most exp'd Boise LB corps in years and they should greatly improve upon the 24.8 ppg all'd LY (highest s/'04).

DEFENSIVE BACKS - Heading into LY, Boise had been #8, #6, #15, #52, #15, #20, #4, #11, #2, #40 and #14 in my PDR. They all'd a FBS low 4 pass td's in '12. LY they had to replace a 1st Tm MW CB (#2DC), a 2nd Tm MW CB and a SS (31 tkl). They were on par with '12 exp-wise but the results were not. Shockingly

Boise fell all the way down to #72 (64.6%, 17-16). TY they lose bkp Ebo Makinde (6 tkl) who missed 8 gms so basically the entire 2 deep returns (CB Maston moved to NB) and Boise will have one of the most improved PDR's in '14.

SPECIAL TEAMS - From '99-'08 Boise had 9 Top 32 finishes (4 Top 10). In my '09 magazine, I proj'd them the #1 ST unit and they finished #1. I was very surprised that in '12 they plummeted down to their lowest ever finish (#106). LY they had to replace their K and top PR. P Trevor Harman (42.6) was pushed by rFr Sean Hale and the tm's net was 39.6! Dan Goodale hit 17-19 lg (F47) with 37 TB on 90 KO. Three players had 200+ KR yds (Boise +3.6 KR). Shane Williams-Rhodes was the top PR and Boise was +12.5 on PR allowing only 41 yds all year. The Broncos moved all the way up to #12 and TY they lose Harman but even with the coaching change, should easily land in my Top 25 once again.

COACHES - Bryan Harsin was a backup QB here from '95-'99 and after taking a GA post he worked his way up to QB cch/OC ('06-'10). Harsin left to become the Texas co-OC for 2Y before becoming the HC at Ark St LY. New OC Mike Sanford was also a bkp QB here ('00-'04) and started coaching under his father at UNLV. He spent the L3Y at Stanford (RB/QB). DC Marcel Yates finishes off the alumni trio as he was a DB here ('96-'99). Yates returns after the alumni trio as the co-DC at TX A&M.

PHIL'S FORECAST

Boise St joined the WAC in '01 and despite coming from the lower level Big West Conf, they thoroughly dominated the league for their 10 yr stay. While the Broncos didn't win EVERY championship, they went a remarkable 75-5 (94%) in WAC play (+161 ypg). They have had 4 Top 10 finishes in the final AP poll (#5 '06, #4 '09, #9 '10 and #8 '11). In '12 they lost 2 gms in the same season for the first time s/'07. I had mentioned after they avg'd just 391 ypg in '12, that they would get back to the 481 ypg level of '11 and that they did (476 ypg). I did not have Boise included in my Preseason Top 25 in '13 due to their tough schedule which upset a few Bronco fans. They entered the year 19 AP. Ironically Petersen suffered his worst loss in his HC career to Wash in the opener, 38-6, the team he now coaches. They had the fewest DD losses over the previous 10 years (5) but would actually suffer 3 LY. In Wk 3 they only led AF 21-17 at half but went on to a 42-20 win. Fresno got a td w/2:14 left to pull out a 41-40 barn burner. Boise whipped SMiss then in a Mountain div showdown, beat USU on the road with the Aggies QB Keeton OFY the previous wk (Boise led 34-10). That gave them the clear run at the MW Title game. After dispatching Nev, they lost at BYU, which ended Boise's 50 game Oct win streak (s/'01)! They trailed Colo St 10-0 but led 42-17 in the road win. WY jumped out to a 7-0 lead but Boise scored the game's final 48 pts. SdSt became the first team to beat Boise in consec years s/Wash St ('00 & '01) in a game the Aztecs led 28-10 after 3Q's and held on. That loss cost them a berth in the MW Title gm. Boise beat NMex 45-17 to go bowling for the 12th consec year but lost to Oregon St, 38-23 for their 5th loss of the season (most s/'98). They only won 8 after having DD wins in 12 of the previous 14 yrs. TY Petersen moves on. Boise rates a +3.5 in my Stock Market Indicator and had 2 net close losses. They are also a much more exp'd team with 15 ret st's as opposed to 9 LY. Their 4 MW road games are all vs teams that had losing records LY. Harsin steps into a great situation and with the most talented team in the MW, Boise gets back to DD wins.
