POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - After Vince Young led Texas to a National Title in '05, Colt McCoy took over and was a 4Y st'r from '06-'09. In '10 Garrett Gilbert, who replaced an inj'd McCoy in the Title gm, struggled (2744, 59%, 10-17). Gilbert began '11 as the st'r but soph Case McCoy (PS#51, Colt's brother) and true frosh David Ash (PS#16) took over. McCoy st'd 5 (1045, 61%, 7-4). Ash st'd 6 (1068, 57%, 4-8, 103 rush) and ply'd the entire bowl. Ash (2699, 67%, 19-8) st'd every game in '12 until he suffered bruised ribs vs TCU (gm 11). McCoy st'd vs KSt and hit 26-34-314 incl 17 str comp (#2 UT hist to Colt's 18) but he also had 2 int's that resulted in td's. LY they added in PS#10 Tyrone Swoopes, who looked great in the spring but suffered a hamstring injury in Aug. They finally took the RS off Swoopes for the final 6 (5-13-26, 79 rush). Ash was the clear-cut st'r but was OFY (conc) in week 3 (760, 60.9%, 7-2, 152 rush). McCoy had an uneven year. He was nowhere near the runner Ash was and had a negative ratio (11-13, 1933, 56.8%). While they lose their starting QB, they are in much better shape as Ash and Swoopes are an upgrade. Miles Onyegbule (6'4" 235 Sr, PS#40WR) took snaps at QB in the spg and added to the mix is PS#5 Jerrod Heard.

RUNNING BACKS - Texas had a streak of 11 straight years ('96-'05) with a 1,000 yd rusher but now have not had one s/'07 (Jamaal Charles, 1619). In '11 true frosh Malcom Brown (PS#1) was on his way (#1 rusher each of first 6) but missed 3 (742, 4.3) Joe Bergeron (PS#36) had 191 vs TT finishing #2 (463, 6.4). In '12 Bergeron had 5 td's vs Baylor (all 16 of his td's in first 9 gm) and finished #2 (567, 4.5). True frosh Daje Johnson (5'10" 180, PS#29, speed) was #4 (203, 7.5, 284 rec) with an 84 yd td run vs BU. Brown missed basically 6 gms and after posting 238 over the first 3 only finished with 324 (5.3). True frosh Johnathan Gray (PS#11) became the 8th Texas frosh RB to post B2B 100 yd gms joining the likes of Earl Campbell ('74), Ricky Williams ('95) and Cedric Benson ('01). Gray led with 701 (4.7, 151 rec, 13.7). In '13 Gray took the feature role but was inj (Achilles) vs WV. He missed the L4 (780, 4.9). Brown topped 100 five times incl the L/3 and was #1 (904, 4.2, 195 rec). Powerful Bergeron added 362 (5.0) and Johnson (most explosive) had 140 (5.8, 140 rec). FB Alex De La Torre (PS#54LB) had a 19 yd run on a fake punt vs KSt. TY the unit returns intact and they add 2 VHT true's. Also adding depth is Jalen Overstreet (6'2" 210 So, PS#50QB) who had 102 (5.1) LY and was very impressive in the spring. They only had 2 healthy RB's for the bowl. TY they will be outstanding (if they can stay healthy).

RECEIVERS - In '12 Mike Davis had some drops but led for the 2nd str yr with 939 (16.5). Jaxon Shipley led in rec (59) and finished #2 (737, 12.5). LY they had to replace their #3 rec (#3DC, 340, 13.1) and 3 TE's (comb 7 sts). Davis, despite being banged up, still led w/727 (14.3). Shipley was #2 (589, 10.5). Kendall Sanders (PS#20DB) who had 2 rec as a true, was limited early (ankle, susp) but finished #3 (361, 9.8). The unit should maintain better health and also add in 2 VHT. The TE's will be a bigger part of the new offense and I will actually call for improved numbers from the Horns' rec's TY despite the loss of their top guy as he was never really 100% in '13.

OFFENSIVE LINE - Surprisingly UT has not had an OL drafted s/'08. LY they had 8 of their top 10 back (124 cars) with all 5 st'rs having 11+ sts in '12 and the 5 bkps were all PS#18 or better. UT improved slightly to 196 ypg (4.4) with just 16 sks as RT Josh Cochran was OFY vs Miss (gm 3) and replaced by soph Kennedy Estelle (PS#10). TY they lose 2nd Tm B12 LT Donald Hawkins (13 st, 2Y st'r), 2x 2nd Tm B12 LG Trey Hopkins (12 st, 3.5Y st'r), 2x 3rd Tm B12 RG Mason Walters (13 st, 4Y st'r), Cochran (23 car st) and bkp Garrett Porter (0 st). They have 2 ret st'rs (basically 4 LY), the car sts drop to 49 (39 by C Espinosa) and they also have to learn a new offense.

DEFENSIVE LINE - The Horns routinely all'd under 100 ypg rush heading into '12. That season they had to replace 2 DT's (#7DC). 1st Tm AA Alex Okafor and DE Jackson Jeffcoat ret'd but Jeffcoat was lost after 6 sts to inj. Okafor earned 1st Tm B12 (12.5 sk most s/'84 here). They still dropped to all'g 192 ypg (4.6, 35 sk, inexp'd LB's). LY they had to replace Okafor (#4DC) but had 3 st'rs back incl Jeffcoat. Chris Whaley (PS#14) was having a fine year incl 2 return td's (1 int, 1 fmb) but was OFY (9 sts still 3rd Tm B12). Jeffcoat (#1 tk/r) was 2nd Tm AA with 13 sks and 9 tfl. DE Cedric Reed was 2nd Tm B12 (79 tkl, 10 sk, 9 tfl). They all'd 183 ypg rush (4.4) but were 8th in the country w/39 sks. New HC Strong knows how to develop a solid D-line and there are plenty of VHT's. It will be tough to replace Jeffcoat and Whaley but I can see the rush D improving and I liked the way the D-line looked in the spring.

LINEBACKERS - It's very surprising that from '95-'09 UT had just 2 LB's drafted. In '12 they had to replace #4 and #6 DC's but ret'd Jordan Hicks (PS#1) and Steve Edmond (PS#5, 255 lbs, fast). Unfortunately, Texas' D went south when Hicks was OFY vs Miss (#1 tk/r at time). Edmond finished #2 in tkls w/103. LY the entire 2-deep ret'd. Unfortunately the injury Gods weren't kind. Demarco Cobbs (PS#8, 6 sts '12) missed the year (knee). Hicks had 41 tkls in 4 gms and tore his Achilles. Edmond was OFY vs TTech (still in 5 tkl'r). Tevin Jackson tore his ACL (7 gm, 5 tkl). They had 4 schlp LB's available vs Baylor. RFR Timothy Cole (PS#22, '42 pro agility drill, 41" VL) struggled in his first start (ISU) and had just 10 tkls. The great news TY is that everyone returns incl 10 VHT's and 8 w/staring exp.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - Texas was #15 and #5 in my PDR in '10 & '11 but slipped to #36 in '12 (59%, 16-15). LY they had to replace a 1st Tm B12 FS (#1 tk/r, #1DC) but had 7 of the top 8 back. Josh Turner beat out Mykkele Thompson at FS but suffered a hip injury in Aug and only st'd 3. They moved up to #15 (56.8%, 13-10). TY they lose 2nd Tm B12 CB Carrington Byndom (13 st, #9 tk/r, 7 pbu) and FS Adrian Phillips (13 st, #2 tk/r, 2 int, 3 pbu). This time 6 of the top 8 return and while they probably won't move up much pass D wise, and are slightly less exp'd than '13, I'll call this unit a little stronger.

SPECIAL TEAMS - With Brown's recruiting success, most of the bkps are VHT's and contribute on ST. Since '00 they have had 8 top 20 finishes. After a #31 finish in '12, UT had to replace their top KR (515, 24.5) and outstanding P (40.8 net). Penn St transfer Anthony Fera (PS#3) was banged up in '12 (2-4 fg) while

Nick Jordan (PS#7) hit 9-15 (L40). Fera was healthy LY and was named 1st Tm AA K (20-22, L50) and avg 40.7 on punts (37.8 net). Nick Rose had 32 TB on 75 KO. Surprisingly the KR coverage was poor (25.0) and they were -4.0 on KR but Daje Johnson and Jaxon Shipley comb to have them +2.9 on PR's. UT finished #38. TY they lose Fera but there is too much talent here to not expect a small bounce back.

COACHES - When you are one of the most storied football programs in the country and your website used to read MackBrown-Texasfootball.com it says it all. Sixteen seasons, 158 wins, 15 bowls, 3 BCS bowl wins and a Nat'l Title is the Mack Brown legacy. Charlie Strong went 37-15 at L'ville incl a BCS bowl win and was previously the DC at Florida ('02-'09) and SCar ('99-'01). Joe Wickline is the OC (OL cch OklaSt '05-'13, Fla '02-'04). DC Vance Bedford was DC at UL ('10-'13) and at Okl St ('07). Shawn Watson was UL's OC for 2Y and is the QB cch while Les Koenning is the WR cch after being an OC at Miss St ('09-'13), A&M ('03-'07) and Alabama ('01-'02).

PHIL'S FORECAST

Texas beat defending Nat'l Champ #1 USC in the Rose Bowl in '05 to win their first National Title s/'70. That was their 9th straight year of DD wins and 7th top 10 finish in 9 yrs. That rightfully raised expectations for Longhorn fans to be a Nat'l Title contender every year. In '10 they entered as the AP #5. I got beat up pretty good in the preseason by Texas fans as I did not have the Horns in my Top 10 and when the dust settled they had their first losing season s/'97 and finished last in their div for the 1st time s/'56 breaking Mack Brown's streak with 20 str yrs of having a winning team. In '11 they opened 4-0 and #11 in the polls (NR pressn) but finished just 8-5 and NR again. In '12 they were #15 in the preseason. They opened 4-0 again (#11) and were 8-2, but lost their L/2 in the reg snn before beating Oreg St in the bowl to finish 9-4 (#19). LY I thought (and so did Mack Brown) that they had the talent and sked to go unbeaten and I picked them #1 in the Big 12. Unfortunately they lost 15 contributors to injury during the year incl QB Ash, RB Gray, DT Whaley, WLB Hicks and MLB Edmond. Over the summer I put Brown at #1 on my Coaches on the Hotseat list (philsteale.com), knowing that he needed a big winning season. Texas was run over by BYU in Wk 2 w/550 rush yds all'd and DC Manny Diaz was fired. They led Miss 23-14 just before half and if not for settling for fg's, could have been up by more. They gave up a fg on the last play of the half and a PR td and lost 44-23. With new DC Greg Robinson, they righted the ship. After leading KSt 31-14 and going on to a 10 pt win, they did have a close win at Iowa St but then dominated Okla (led 36-13 4Q). They crushed TCU and Kansas but then needed OT to get past WV. With a chance to take control in the Big 12, they trailed Okla St 14-10 before an int went thru a DB's hands and into the OSU's WR's hands for a td. A few seconds later a 43 yd IR td blew it open and Texas lost 38-13 at home. Still, after beating TT 41-16, a Longhorn victory at Baylor would have given them the Big 12 crown. QB McCoy hit just 12-34-54 and a 3-3 game at half turned into a 30-10 loss. After that loss Brown stepped down but would coach the bowl. In the bowl, with UT hitting just 9-23-56 passing, they lost to Oregon in Brown's final game. Charlie Strong inherits 15 ret st'rs and they can only maintain better health. Strong says they won't win a National Title TY but they may have the Big 12's best D and if they get adequate QB play they are a contender in the Big 12.

UT is 9-0 incl a 56-7 win in the L/gm ('06). Longhorns have posted shutouts in 2 of the L/3. UT has won 14 str home openers by 39 ppg. UT is 36-7 hosting non-conf foes s/96 (B12 started).

UT is 1-3 vs BYU. LY the lead changed each of the 1st five scores. UT led 14-0 w/10:29 left 2Q but from that point was outscored 30-7 even though only 4 of their L/9 drives ended in punts. UT is 1-3 s/'97 but did win 49-20 in the L/meeting ('11). Texas led 21-0 early 2Q and UCLA never got closer than 14 pts (UT got 21 pts off 4 TO's). Only the 7th all-time meeting but 4th different venue.

Bonus: The last time that a Texas HC had a losing record in his inaugural ssn was in 1937, the seven HC's to follow were all above .500 (combined 56-22-1 mark).

UT has won all 11 as B12 foes. LTH trailing 14-7 into the 4Q. UT needed a 70/9pl GW td drive w/12 to avoid the upset. The 4 pt win was the closest MOV s/'04. UT is 14-1 in their conf opener.

The home team has won 3 str by 17 ppg. LY UT handcuffed the BU offense in the 1H as the gm was tied 3-3. UT trailed by 10 early 4Q and mustered just 16 ttl yds their final 3 drives.
