POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - In '10 rFr Keith Price was the bkp to Jake Locker and threw for 164 (51%, 2-0). Locker was a #1DC but I speculated in spg of '11 that Price could actually improve upon Locker's '10 stats (2265, 55%, 17-9). Price had a phenomenal season throwing for 3,063 (67%) while setting the UW single ssn rec for td passes with 33 (11 int). Price did miss 1 st (Nick Montana st'd) and sprained both knees but ret'd healthy in '12. After Montana trans, the bkp spot was a battle between true frosh Cyler Miles (PS#5) & Jeff Lindquist (PS#14). I said that Price wouldn't improve much upon his '11 stats but I think most were surprised they dropped to 2,726 (61%, 19-13). LY I said I looked for Price to be much closer to '11's stats with a more stable O-line and a faster paced off. They also added in true frosh Troy Williams (PS#7). Price missed Oreg St (inj) and Cyler Miles got the start guiding them to a road win. Price threw for 2,966 (66.2%, 21-6, 108 rush). Miles (418, 60.7%, 4-2, 200 rush) is a running QB like Locker was but is more of a glider and a little more elusive. He was susp in spring (reinstated mid-May) all'g Lindquist & Williams to split the snaps. Naturally with the loss of a 3 yr st'r that departs w/10 schl records (best comp%), I'll call this unit down a few notches.

RUNNING BACKS - The Huskies had seven 1,000 yd rushing ssns (4 diff plyrs) from 1989-'97. After a 9 yr drought UW has had six 1,000 yd seasons in the LTY. In '12 they had to replace Chris Polk (PS#18) who had 3 str 1,000 yd seasons. I listed soph Bishop Sankey (PS#38) as the st'r despite the fact that Jesse Callier (260, 5.5 '11) was on the Doak Walker Watch List. Callier st'd the opener but tore his ACL while Deontae Cooper (PS#26) tore his ACL for a 3rd yr in a row. Sankey had seven 100 yd gms and after a monster bowl (record 205 rush, 74 rec) led with 1,439 (5.0, 249 rec). I said Sankey would improve upon his 5.0 ypc with exp and the fact that he had a stronger O-line. Sankey topped Corey Dillon's schl record (1695 '96) rushing for 1,870 (5.7, 304 rec). He also tied the UW record for career td's. Cooper had 166 yds and 2 td's vs Ore St (270, 6.3). RFr Dwayne Washington was #2 w/332 (7.1) and Jesse Callier had 213 (4.4). Not in the PSL are LB Shaq Thompson (PS#2) who cch's hope will do what Myles Jack did at UCLA, Lavon Coleman (6'0" 215 rFr, PS#47), Ralph Kinne (5'10" 203 rFr) and Ryan McDaniel

(6'0" 210 So, PS#80). With 2nd Tm AA Sankey (#2DC TEN) leaving early for the NFL (just 610 yds away from UW rush rec), it will be interesting to see if UW can uncover another 1,000 yd rusher. I will call the unit clearly weaker for '14.

RECEIVERS - In '12 UW had to replace their top 2 WR's (1310, 14.9) incl their #2 all-time rec. Surprisingly, UW had just one catch of 40+ yds by a WR/TE through 9 gms. TE Austin Seferian-Jenkins (PS#1) was a Mackey finalist (850, 12.3) while WR Kasen Williams (PS#8) led w/878 (11.4). LY Williams (foot) ply'd in just 8 (421, 14.5). True frosh Damore'ea Stringfellow (PS#13) finished with 259 (12.9) with 147 (8 rec) coming vs UCLA. Seferian-Jenkins (susp opener) didn't match '12's stats w/450 (12.5) but still won the Mackey Award and was a #2DC (TB). Jaydon Mickens (PS#35, 190, 9.5 '12) was #1 in catches (65) and #2 in yds (688, 10.6). Surprisingly Kevin Smith, who had 6 career sts (294 yds 3Y), led w/765 (15.3). TY they lose their #1 Smith (13 st), Stringfellow (4 st, trans) and Jenkins (12 st). If Williams comes back 100% healthy (missed spg), they'll be in pretty good shape but with the loss of their top WR and star TE, I'll call them down a few notches despite 5 VHT's in the unit.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '11 Senio Kelemete became the first UW OL to earn 1st Tm All-Conf honors s/'01. They appeared in pretty good shape in '12 only losing 2 st's incl Kelemete (#5DC) but 2 ret st's were OFY after 2 so they basically had just 1 back. UW slipped again to 142 ypc rush (4.0, 38 sk). Injuries forced 6 diff starting OL combos. LY they had to replace a 3rd Tm P12 C and not only did they have 4 s'r's back, but they also got back Eric Kohler and Colin Tanigawa ('12 st's) and ret'd 81 car sts. UW showed good improvement up to 239 ypg (5.1, 30 sk). The great news TY is they only lose Kohler (2 st) so they jump to 124 car sts (#5 FBS) with 5 fifth yr seniors in the 2 deep and this could be the P12's best O-line.

DEFENSIVE LINE - It has actually been 9 yrs ('05) since UW has all'd less than 4.0 ypc rush. Despite having a pair of 330 lb DT's in '11 they still allowed 169 ypg rush (5.1). In '12 they had to replace a DE and DT (160 ypg, 4.4, 27 sk). LY they had to replace a DT and DE (comb 16 st). DE Hau'oli Kikaha was a co-Tm MVP (70 tkl, 13 sk) and true frosh Joe Mathis (PS#34) and Marcus Farria (PS#53, 1.5 sk vs Cal in 4Q) both gained more time late. At the start of Aug, they moved TE Evan Hudson (PS#99) to DE (13 st, 4 sk). Surprisingly Josh Shirley (PS#16), who had 15 sks in '11-'12, lost his spot to Cory Littleton (#6 tkl'r, 5 sk, 5 tfl). Not in the PSL is Psalm Woohcing (6'3" 230 So, PS#99) who moves over from FB. With all 4 st's back plus 2 others with 13+ car sts, this will be the year UW finally breaks through that 4.0 ypc barrier.

LINEBACKERS - In '12 the Huskies had to replace a 1st Tm P12 MLB (#1 tkl'r) and a bkp (23 tkl) but ret'd 4 of the top 6. John Timu (OLB pass rusher in '11) moved inside and was the #1 tkl'r w/91. RFr Travis Feeney moved in from S in August (#3 tkl'r, 4 sk). True frosh Shaq Thompson (PS#2) was the #5 tkl'r in the NB/WLB role, Thomas Tutogi (PS#87JC) added 42 tkl and Princeton Fuimaono had 31. The unit trimmed the ppg all'd to 24.2. LY they ret'd intact and the D improved for a 2nd straight ssn (22.8 ppg). Fuimaono beat out Feeney for the SLB spot and was the #1 tkl'r. TY they do lose Fuimaono (11 st) and Tutogi (28 tkl) but they do return their #2, #3 and #8 tkl'r's and while not quite as exp'd, they should be just as strong.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '12 UW finished #17 in my PDR (55%, 17-17). LY they had to replace 1st Tm P12 Desmond Trufant (47 car st, #1DC), a S (11 st, 3 tkl'r) and a bkp (11 tkl). Sean Parker lived up to his PS#14 billing (#2 tkl'r '11 & '12). They added in Travell Dixon (PS#4JC). UW moved up to #4 all'g just 55% (15-16 ratio). TY the losses are heavy in Parker (13 st, #5

tkl'r, 4 int, 4 pbu), S Will Shamburger (9 st, inj, #11 tkl'r), CB Gregory Ducre (13 st, #12 tkl'r, 2 int, 7 pbu) and Tre Watson (#10 tkl'r, 9 pd) whose 84 yd IR td vs Colorado was the longest here s/97. They do return CB Marcus Peters (5 int, 9 pbu) who had a 53 yd fr td in that same game vs the Buffs. True frosh Kevin King got in 3 sts in place of an inj'd Shamburger. They go from 2 ret st's down to 1 and had a very high finish LY so I look for them to take a couple of steps back.

SPECIAL TEAMS - From 2004-'10 UW's highest finish in my ST rankings was #84. In '11 they moved up to #49 but in '12 had to replace their K, both P's and their top 2 KR's (24.7 in '11) were banged up (1 OFY, 1 just 5 KR) and they were #116. Travis Coons hit 9-14 fg's (L45) in '12 and 15-16 (L48) LY. He improved his net P from 34.8 to 38.1. True frosh Cameron Van Winkle (PS#8) had 11 TB on 33 KO before being OFY and Coons later had 8 TB on 57 KO. True frosh John Ross had a game changing 100 KR td in the bowl (720, 23.2). TY they lose Coons but I like the promise of Van Winkle and P Korey Durkee. UW finished #61 LY but new HC Chris Petersen had FIVE top 11 finishes in his 9Y at Boise.

COACHES - Two-time Paul "Bear" Bryant award winner Chris Petersen was at Boise St since 2001 spending the first 5Y as OC before taking over as HC in 2006 and leading the Broncos to a 13-0 season and an overall record of 92-12! The OC is Jonathan Smith who was Boise's QB cch the L2Y, the Montana OC for 2Y ('10-'11) and the Idaho QB cch the 6Y prior ('04-'09). DC Pete Kwiatkowski was at Boise for 8Y first as the DL cch ('06-'09) before getting promoted to DC the L4Y ('10-'13).

PHIL'S FORECAST

The Huskies have a proud winning tradition. They had a streak of TWENTY-SEVEN non-losing seasons snapped in '04, thanks in part to NCAA probation (low schlp). They then had 6 straight losing yrs incl Steve Sarkisian's 1st ssn ('09). I mentioned in my '09 magazine that coming off an 0-12 '08 season, UW was probably the most improved team in the NCAA but faced my #16 sked. They did not make my Most Improved List as I thought getting up to 6 wins would be tough but they came close at 5-7 incl upsets of #3 USC and #19 Cal. They were 4-5 in P12 play and in Sarkisian's final 4 yrs ('10-'13), they were pretty consistent going 5-4 in the P12 each year and winning 7, 7 and 7 overall but bumped it up to 9 in '13. UW improved all 4Y in P12 play going from -30.1 to -22.9 to +2.6 to +60 ypg LY. It was Sarkisian's most exp'd team with 18 ret st's. Ironically, LY UW opened up dealing Chris Petersen his worst ever loss 38-6 in the opener. The Huskies blasted their first 4 foes setting up a showdown vs #5 Stanford. They did trail 31-21 but had the ball, down 31-28 at the end coming up just short on the road. The next wk vs Oregon, they gave great effort. It was 31-24 after 3Q's and they were the first team to force the Ducks to play the starters in the 4Q but UW went 66/5, 75/8, 60/11 and were taking a knee at the UW 9 at the end winning 45-24. After those two huge games, UW had nothing left in the tank vs Ariz St where they were pounded 53-24. UW rebounded to blast Cal and Colo but TO's did them in vs UCLA and QB Price was inj'd in the 1H (lost 41-31). With bkp QB Miles and benefitting from +4 in TO's, they whipped Oregon St on the road 69-27 in the Beavers' home finale. For the first time s/'02, both teams entered the Apple Cup with a winning record and UW came out on top, 27-17. With interim HC Marques Tuiasosopo leading them in the Fight Hunger Bowl, they beat BYU 31-16. This year Sark moves on to USC and Petersen inherits 14 ret st's but they lose QB Price, AA RB Sankey (1870, 5.7) and their top WR who led UW to the most yds it's had in 124 yrs of football (6491). UW is a contender in the Pac-12 and 3 of my 9 sets of PR's call for a double digit win season (play 13 gms).

LTH ('07's ssn finale) UW lost vs undefeated #11 UW. UW led 21-0 after 1Q but were outgained 468-268 (outscored 35-7) the L3Q's. Huskies are 1-11 in 'true' road openers (lost 6 str by 19 ppg).

UW won 30-27 in '11 (only prior gm). UW up 3 punted w/1:17 left but int'd EW in the EZ from their 25 w/29 left. UW is 19-2-1 vs FCS, both losses in 1920. Huskies are 23-5 in home openers.
