POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

QUARTERBACKS - Denard Robinson had a storied career at UM leaving as the NCAA's all-time QB rush leader and UM's all-time tll off leader. He left with nine Top 10 single gm tll off performances. In '12 Robinson was in'd in the 2Q vs Neb (gm 8) and because Devin Gardner had only gotten reps at WR during the week, Hoke went with rFr Russell Bellomy (PS#69) in the 2H (3-16-38, 3 int). Gardner took over and in the next 4 wks threw all but one of the team's passes (DRob wildcat QB, RB & WR). Gardner (better passer) threw for 1,219 (60%, 11-5, 101 rush). After 5 gms he had been the #1 rec (finish 44, 266, 16.6). LY Brady Hoke and then OC Al Borges felt they could finally implement their preferred pro-style offense. They also wanted less QB designed runs due to limited depth as Bellomy tore his ACL and their only other schlp QB was VHT true frosh Shane Morris (PS#3). After 4 gms, Gardner had the 2nd most int's by an FBS QB w/8. He had 3 more TO's vs PSt but had a 10-1 ratio the L/6 reg ssn gms including his schl rec 503 pass yds (584 tll) vs Indy. He was just 40 yds away from being just the 2nd 3,000 yd passer here (John Navarre 3331 '03) but missed the bowl. He was also the #2 rusher (483, 2.9, 11 td). Morris (5 gm) became the first UM QB to make his starting debut in the bowl. With better OL play (36 sk LY), I expect improved numbers as the unit has better depth.

RUNNING BACKS - Mike Hart left as UM's career rush leader after '07. The Wolves have struggled since. In '11 Fitzgerald Toussaint had one 100 yd gm in the first 7 then avg'd 155 ypg the next 4 and led the RB's with 1,041 (5.6). UM's top 4 TB's in '11 comb for 1,617 (5.8) and they had the top 2 back in '12. Toussaint (miss 3) had just 514 (4.0). UM TB's comb'd for a B10 low 940 yds in the reg ssn (league avg 1635). Thomas Rawls was the #2 RB (242, 4.2). They added 2 VHT true frosh LY incl PS#2 Derrick Green who gave them the big-body downhill back they desired. Green came in a little too big (240 lbs) and was slowed by an ankle inj in Aug and Toussaint received 65 out of the 67 RB carries in gms 2-4. Toussaint suffered a conc in gm 9 and Green had 154 of his 270 (3.3) in the final 3. The #3 RB was true frosh DeVeon Smith (117, 4.5). Not listed below is Drake Johnson (6'1" 212 So, PS#87). TY they lose Toussaint (648, 3.5) but I will call for the UM RB's to have their best comb'd rush output in the Hoke era with new OC Doug Nussmeier installing more downhill running.

RECEIVERS - In '12 UM had to replace its top WR (699, 20.6) but ret'd #2 Jeremy Gallon (PS#25) and #3 Roy Roundtree. True frosh Devin Funchess (PS#10) became the first UM TE to top 100 in a game s/'97 (Jerame Tuman) but finished with just 234 (15.6). Unheralded 5'10" Drew Dileo was #3 (331, 16.5).

Roundtree was #2 (580, 18.7). Gallon at only 5'8", can dunk a basketball and is a physical blk'r. He led in '12 with 829 (16.9) and LY topped that with a schl record 1,373 (1330, Braylon Edwards '04). Gallon tallied 63% of his yds in the L/6 gms incl a B10 record 369 (26.4, #2 all-time in NCAA) vs Indy. The #2 rec was TE Devin Funchess who joined Gallon as 1st Tm B10 with 748 (15.3) and will move to WR TY. Speedy Jehu Chesson was #4 w/221 (14.7) while true frosh TE Jake Butt (PS#6) was #3 w/235 (11.8). TY Gallon (#7DC NE) and Dileo (174, 10.9) depart and Butt tore his ACL in Feb. LY Amara Darboh was expected to be a str before being OFY in Aug (foot). I'll call this unit down a notch (with the loss of their #3 all-time rec).

OFFENSIVE LINE - When Hoke arrived he had just 8 schlp OL's and they were recruited for Rich Rod's spread offense. Hoke craved a pro-style offense and LY was up to 15 schlp OL (only 2 Sr's, 10 were frosh). They had to replace 3 interior str's, but ret'd 2nd Tm AA LT Taylor Lewan (B10 OLPYO 2 str yr). C Jack Miller lost his job to LG Graham Glasgow over the last 9 and rFr Kyle Kalis lost his job for 4 sts to Erik Magnuson. They had 5 diff LG's start. Lewan said that rFr Ben Braden was the most physically gifted OL he'd ever seen and called him a freak (319 lbs, 12% body fat). Nine different OL st'd LY but not Braden. UM had 4 gms where they rushed for 65 or less and a 3 gm stretch where they all'd 19 sks. The '12 unit (all 5 st'd all 13) opened holes for 184 ypg (4.8, 18 sk). LY they avg'd just 126 ypg rush (worst s/'99), 3.3 ypc and all'd 36 sks (most in 15 yrs). This unit's career sts go from 64 in '12 to 58 in '13 to just 37 in '14. While they lose a pair of NFL DC's in Lewan (#1 TEN) and Michael Schofield (36 st 3Y, #3 DEN) they can only improve upon LY's poor numbers.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '06 UM all'd just 43 ypg rush (1.9), their best s/'71 but have not had that type of D the LY. In Rodriguez's last yr, UM all'd 189 ypg (4.4), their worst s/'68 (199) with 18 sks. UM has trimmed it to 132 (4.0), 151 (3.8) and 140 (3.8) the L3Y. In '12, 165 ply'r's had at least 5 sks and 19 of them from the B10 - none were from Michigan. LY none of the DL hit that number again. They had to replace 2 str's. Frank Clark got a lot of press with everyone projecting a monster year but he had just 4.5 sks (7.5 tll). When LB Jake Ryan ret'd they moved Brennan Beyer (PS#38, 9 st DE '12) back to DE. TY they lose NT Quinton Washington (6 st, 19 tkl) and DT Jibreel Black (13 st, 27 tkl, 2.5 sk, 5 tll). Surprisingly, of the 4 DL that return with starting exp, only 1 (Beyer) is a VHT and Keith Heitzman (7 st, 8 tkl) moves to TE. Look for soph's Chris Wormley (PS#37) and Taco Charlton (PS#24) to help out and I think Clark could live up to his hype TY.

LINEBACKERS - In '12 UM ret'd its top 4 LB's (#1, #5, #9, #10 tkl's), got back Cam Gordon (13 st 10, in'd '11) and added in PS#8, #10 and #23 true frosh. The LB's finished #1, #2 and #3 in tkl's and the D all'd just 320 ypg (best s/'06). LY they had to replace their #2 tkl'r and a bkp (19 tkl). Their top LB, Jake Ryan (88 tkl, 4.5 sk, 11.5 tll '12) tore his ACL in the spring. He made a remarkable comeback, starting 5 of the last 6 (#12 tkl'r). Brennan Beyer (27 tkl, 2 sk, 2 tll) made 12 st between LB/DE. UM had its weakest def of the Greg Mattison era at 371 ypg (26.8 ppg). TY they lose SLB Cameron Gordon (2 st, 40 tkl, 5 sk, 3.5 tll) and Beyer is back at DL but with Ryan's return this actually figures to be one of the stronger LB corps in the B10.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '12 UM had a veteran secondary but was only #81 in the PDR (60%, 16-7). LY they had to replace a 2nd Tm B10 FS (Tm MVP) and a HM B10 CB. Blake Countess (9 st '11, RS '12) made it basically like having 3 str's back and I called for them to move up in the PDR and they did to #52 (56%, 23-17). Countess had 4 int in a 4 gm stretch. It's never a good sign when a CB (Raymon Taylor 4 int, 9 pbu) leads your team in tkl's. TY they lose SS Thomas Gordon (10 st, #4 tkl'r, 3 int), Courtney

Avery (6 st, #11 tkl'r) and S Josh Furman (3 st, 11 tkl). Five of the top 8 return incl 1st Tm B10 CB Countess. They also add in PS#1 Jabrill Peppers and they figure to rise in my PDR again.

SPECIAL TEAMS - UM was just #89 in my ST rankings in '12. Brendan Gibbons hit just 1-5 on fg's in '10 but was 29-35 (L52 in bowl) in '11 & '12. LY he set a UM record w/16 consec made FG's, but missed 3 in the 4OT loss to Penn St. He also had a UM record 141 consec PAT's. P Matt Wile replaced '12's B10 Punter of the Year Will Hagerup (susp '13) and had a 3-7 net (37 TB/76 KO) while hitting 3-5 fg's (2 miss 50+). Dennis Norfleet avg'd 23.5 on KR's (tm 6.7 PR). TY I look for a similar finish (#53) provided they find a replacement for Gibbons.

COACHES - Brady Hoke is now in his 4th ssn here. He clearly is facing pressure as the win total has dipped from 11 to 8 to 7. He was an asst here ('95-'02) before taking the HC job at Ball St (had highest ranking ever there #12) and then at SDSU (9-4 in '10 best record s/'77). The new OC is NFL QB Doug Nussmeier who was in the same role at Alabama the L2Y, at Wash ('09-'11) and at Fresno ('08). Greg Mattison is the country's 4th highest paid asst. He was the DC here in '95-'96, an NFL DC for BAL ('08-'10) as well as the DC for Fla ('05-'07) and ND ('97-'01).

PHIL'S FORECAST

Heading into '08, UM had 40 str winning ssn's (33 consec bowls), the NCAA's longest streaks. Lloyd Carr finished in the Top 25 12 out of his 13 yrs. Carr's final game was a Capital One Bowl win over #9 Florida but in '08 I did not have Michigan ranked in my Top 50! UM had that rare losing year (3-9) and went 5-7 and 7-6 in '09 & '10. Hoke wanted to run a pro-style attack but inherited spread personnel, namely QB Denard Robinson. UM had a season that went beyond everyone's expectations as they finished 11-2 in '11 (+130.8 ypg B10 play). They got a fortunate win in the Sugar Bowl (outFD'd 22-12) and finished #12 (3 str yrs NR prior). They had numerous factors pointing down in '12 (3 net close wins, +7 TO's, Stock Market -5.0) and a much tougher sked (4 ranked tms on road). They dropped to 8-5 and did not have a player drafted in the first 4 Rnds of the draft (1st time s/'68). LY Mich was the preseason fav to win the Legends (I had them tied 3rd). They had an impressive night win at home vs #14 ND and many in the media said they were a better team than even Ohio St. They barely survived vs Akron (Zips throwing into EZ from a 4 yd line as time expired). They survived Conn trailing 21-7 pulling out a 24-21 win. They were 5-0 but lost in 4OT to Penn St before a big 2H got them past Ind, 63-47. At 6-1 they were #23 but dropped 5 of their last 6 with their win being a fortuitous one vs NW (last second fg forced OT). They led Iowa 21-7 at half in a 3 pt loss and gave undefeated OST a big test, coming up short on a 2pt conv at the end. True frosh Shane Morris st'd the bowl (Gardner inj) and they lost to KSt 31-14 and finished just 7-6 with 4 of their 6 losses by a comb 11 pts. TY the interior of the OL should be improved (LY 3.3 ypc rush weakest s/'99) after all'g 36 sks (QB's under constant pressure). The indicators are pointing up as they are a +2.5 in my Stock Market (pg 32), have 15 ret str's and a def ypg of 13.8 (pg 25). They have 4 tough AG (ND, MSt, NW, OST) but are 19-2 at home under Hoke. UM's D, with my #1 LB's and #1 DB's in the Big Ten, will more resemble the 2012 unit. If Nussmeier can develop the OL, they should be able to top LY's wins but by playing both Mich St and Ohio St on the road, they will have a tough time winning the East.

UM is 21-3 in home openers. UM is 16-0 L5Y at home vs non-conf foes. #5 UM was stunned 34-32 in '07's home opener. After UM's only lead of the gm (by 1) ASU hit a 24 yd fg w/26 left.

Seven of the L10 gms have been upsets. LTH Michigan trailed 10-0 after 3Q & cut the deficit to 7 twice in the 4Q but Notre Dame ran out the final 3:27. L2Y UM is 1-6 vs ranked foes (win vs #14 ND LY).

UM is 5-0 vs Miami & 33-1 vs the MAC w/their only loss in '08 hosting Toledo. In the last 10 ssns the Wolverines are 10-0 the gm after rival ND. L/gm ('08) UM only won 16-6.

Both prior gms have taken place s/'02. The L/gm ('08's home/ssn opener) UM lost 25-23. UM trailed 25-10 into the 4Q and cut the deficit to 2 w/6:26 but their L3 drives ended in 2 punts & SOD.

The Wolverines have won 6 str by 28 ppg. LY after 1Q the gm was tied 7-7 but Michigan scored 35 of the next 41 pts. Under Hoke, UM is 10-2 in B10 HG's but has dropped the L2.

First meeting. The Wolverines are 8-17 in Big Ten away gms. While the HC at Ball St, Hoke lost to Rutgers 52-30 in the '07 International Bowl (last and only time facing Rutgers).

LY UM up 34-24 allowed a fg and a gm tying td w/27 left. UM actually missed a 52 yd fg as time exp'd in regulation. In the 4OT MU hit a 40 yd fg but allowed the GW to 7 plays later.

107th meeting, played for Paul Bunyan Trophy. Tm with the most rushing yds has won 41 of the L44. LY the gm was tied 6-6 late 2Q before UM allowed 23 unanswered. UM rushed for -48 yds.

Last year Michigan never trailed after going up 14-7. UM only led 49-47 w/12:15 but from that point on Michigan outgained IU 166-82 as both of their td drives were set up by ints.

LY with no time-outs left the Wolverines rushed on the field to hit a 44 yd fg as time expired to force OT. In the 3OT UM got a td (2pt) & then int'd NW on a 4&23 to seal the comeback.

Into '14, UM is 6-3 s/'04 after a bye in the reg ssn. UM is 3-0 vs Maryland (all gms in Ann Arbor) but last played in '90 (won 45-17). UM is just 2-4 the gm prior to rival OSU (but 2-1 L/3).

LTH saw 6 lead changes. UM trailed by just 5 but threw an int near midfield as OSU ran out the last 4:50.
