POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2016

QUARTERBACKS - In '13 Jameis Winston was replacing a #1 DC QB yet became the youngest player to ever win the Heisman. He threw for 4,057 (67%, 40-10, 219 rush). In '14 Sean Maguire (PS#42) was the bkp (8 gm, 13-21-116-2-2 '13). Winston threw for 3,907 (65%) with 25 td's (but 18 int's). Maguire hit 21-39-305-1-2 in a start vs Clemson. Winston (overall #1DC) left and Maguire was #1 out of spring in '15 before ND QB Everett Golson transferred in. Golson (25 sts ND, 5850, 59.5%, 41-20) won the job and did not throw his first int until a pass into the EZ bounced out of his WR's hands vs GT. Maguire st'd 2 (Golson in) then Golson st'd vs NCSt and had 3 TO's that led to a 17-7 deficit. Maguire stepped in, guided the comeback and the job was his (1520, 59.3%, 11-6, -71 rush). JJ Cosentino (PS#19) hit 5-10 for 27 yds on the season. Golson moves on (8 st, 1778, 67.1%, 11-3) and they bring in rFr Deondre Francois (PS#9) along with true frosh Malik Henry (PS#3). Whoever wins the job should at least match '15's numbers.

RUNNING BACKS - In '14, the top 2 RB's left early for the NFL. The top returnee was Karlos Williams (PS#2DB), who had 730 (8.0!) after moving from S to RB in Wk 2 in '13. They added true frosh Dalvin Cook (PS#2). Williams was the main guy in the F/5 (351 yd) while Mario Pender (PS#6) only played in 9 (206, 5.0). Cook had just 128 in the F/3 but then took over (1008, 5.9, 203 rec). LY they lost Williams (689, 4.6, #5DC) but added in 233 lb true frosh Jacques Patrick (PS#3, IFS) & Johnathan Vickers (PS#46). Cook was susp in July but dominated early. He had the first 200+ yd gm here s'r88 (Sammie Smith, 212) with 266 vs USF. Cook may have set a ton of records but he hurt his hamstring after a 94 yd TD run vs WF (2 att for the gm). He then had 222 vs Miami (1st FSU RB two 200+ gms same yr s'r81 Greg Allen), 163 vs L'ville but missed Syr (ankle). He still had 194 vs Clemson, 138 vs NCSt and 183 vs Florida. He set the FSU record (Warrick Dunn 1,231 '95) w/ 1,691 (7.4, 244 rec). Patrick had 162 vs Syr & was #2 (314, 5.0). Not in the PSL below is FB Freddie Stevenson (6'1" 243 Sr, PS#32) who had 10 st LY. Ryan Green (5'11" 205 Sr, PS#9) moved from DB to RB in spg (16-84 in SG). Pender, who battled int LY (3 gm, 140, 4.7), is the only loss TY. Cook is clearly a Heisman frontrunner.

RECEIVERS - In '14, Rashad Greene led for a second straight season (1365, 13.8, #5 DC) while TE Nick O'Leary (618, 12.9 #6 DC) won the Mackey Award. True frosh Travis Rudolph (PS#6) had just 1 rec over the F/4 but had a ssn-high in the Rose Bowl (6-96) and was #3 (555, 14.6). LY I expected big things from PS#1 George Campbell (IFS) but he had just 3 rec. Kermit Whitfield had been a star RM but came into his own as a WR with 798 (14.0) including 172 vs L'ville. Rudolph was #1

with 916 (15.5) including 191 vs Syracuse while Jesus "Bobo" Wilson was #3 (622, 10.7). TY the unit returns intact making it much more experienced (12 VHT's among WR/TE unit).

DEFENSIVE LINE - FSU had an inexperienced O-line back in '11 (4 true frosh starting at end) and they had a poor 112 ypg rush (3.3, 41 sk). LY those OL finally moved on after 4 yrs. They lost a 2X ACC 3Y RG (#4DC), 4Y LT/C (#1DC), 2nd Tm ACC 3Y LG, C (5 st) and 3Y RT (#7DC). That was 174 car sts lost but they had underachieved in '14 plus added in PS#5 & PS#29 JC's who signed in '14 and RS (10 VHT's in unit). While the unit struggled with 9 diff st's and many different combo's, they still improved to 168 ypg rush (5.1, 26 sk). TY the unit returns intact (74 car sts ret) with 15 VHT's and they made huge strides in 2012 in a similar situation.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In '13 the Seminoles had to replace 4 NFL DC's (#1, #2, #5 & #7 tk'l's) along with a starting DT and a bkp. FSU slipped a little (125 ypg, 3.3, 35 sk). In '14 they had to replace a 2nd Tm AA DT (#2DC) as well as 2 bkp's (51 tk'l) and slipped again (170 ypg, 4.2, 17 sk). New DL coach Brad Lawing was brought in from Florida (also at SC w/Jadeveon Clowney). They had to replace a pair of #2DC's (DE & DT) but still had 13 VHT's in unit. FSU had been using a JLB (250-260 lb DE/LB) but switched to a BUCK LY (230 lb) so I will call it a 3-4. They allowed just 145 ypg (3.8) with 32 sacks. This year they lose 1st Tm ACC DT Nile Lawrence-Stample (12 st, 36 tk'l, 2.5 sk, UFA CLE) and Giorgio Newberry (21 tk'l, 2 sk, UFA PIT). Four of the top 6 are back and they add in PS#6, #19, #24 and #39 true frosh. This is their most exp'd and best D-line s'/12.

LINEBACKERS - After having to replace 2 st's including a 3rd Tm AA LB (#1 tk'l'r, #5DC) in '14, the unit was banged up and all'd 25.6 ppg (worst s'/09). LY 2nd Tm ACC WLB Terrance Smith (#3 tk'l'r) turned down the NFL and they also ret'd their #1 tk'l'r Reggie Northrup. Four of the top 7 LB's ret'd (I include the STAR position at LB). STAR Trey Marshall was OFY after 6 sts and they struggled to replace him. Northrup was questionable coming into the year but was the #1 tk'l'r again. Smith missed 4 but was #4 tk'l'r. My computer projected (pg 43) them to allow 17.9 ppg and they yielded 17.5. TY they lose 2nd Tm ACC Northrup (11 st) and Smith (9 st, UFA KC). Despite losing their top 2, they figure to stay healthier and the unit has 14 VHT's.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - From '10-'13, FSU had consecutive finishes in my PDR of #32, #18, #3 & #6 (52%, 14-26). In '14 they had to replace a 1st Tm AA DB along with a 1st Tm ACC FS (#3DC). They had 7 of the top 9 back so it was stunning that they fell to #65 (57%, 22-14). LY both starting CB's left early for the NFL (#2 & #3 DC). They lost 62 car sts & only had 2 st's back (#2, #6 tk'l's) and finished #48 (56.9%, 14-8). TY they lose 1st Tm AA CB Jalen Ramsey (13 st, #7 tk'l'r, 10 pbu, #1DC JAX), SS Tyler Hunter (1 st, #13 tk'l'r) & FS Lamarcus Brutus (13 st, #3 tk'l'r, UFA TEN). Despite the loss of their top guy, this unit has 9 VHT's and should get back to their more customary finish in my PDR.

SPECIAL TEAMS - FSU always has a top ST unit (#1, #1, #3 '11-'13). Everyone was back in '15 and they moved up from #21 to #14. Kermit Whitfield avg 26.7 (#1 in FBS) on KR's (team just 3.7 on PR) while P Cason Beatty improved to 45.2 (40.6 tm net). Roberto Aguayo (1st Tm AA, '14 Groza winner) proved he was human hitting "just" 21-26 FG (long 51) and drilling 47 TB on 84 KO. He hit all 198 of his career xp's. TY they lose their super P & K and will find it tough to stay in the Top 10.

COACHES - Jimbo Fisher is in his 7th year. In the L4Y FSU has amassed a 49-6 record, and the '13 Nat'l Champ. Prior to FSU Fisher spent 7Y as LSU's OC (5 with Nick Saban). The 3rd year co-OC's are QB cch Randy Sanders and WR cch/pass gm coor, former Noles WR and '91 NFL ROY, Lawrence Dawsey. The Seminoles had just 2 DC's in 29Y and Charles

Kelly returns for his 3rd ssn. He was the LB/ST's cch here in '13. Previously he was at GT for 7Y (DB's cch). He was DC at Nicholls St, Henderson St & Jax St. Former All-SEC/NFL RB Jay Graham (4th ssn) took over as ST coor LY.

THIS DECADE 68-14 (82.9%) #4 - FSU had an amazing run of 14 straight Top 5 finishes. Not only did that end in '00 but the Seminoles went through 12 str yrs of zero Top 5 finishes (just 1 Top 10). In '12 they were a 2 td fav in every game but 1 (7 pt HF vs Florida). Against NCSt, they blew a 16-0 halftime lead giving up a td on 4th down with :16 left and lost. In '13 they had to replace 11 NFL DC's and had just 11 ret st's. They were almost a consensus pick for 2nd place in their own division and were not even in the preseason AP Top 10 (#11). I had FSU as my #1 Surprise Team (my top non-Top 10 tm that I thought could win the National Title (pg 35). Despite losing a QB that started in the NFL and all of those DC's, FSU beat 4 ranked foes by a comb score of 200-35 and won the National Title game over Auburn. In 2014, FSU was a consensus #1 (13 ret st's). This time the ssn was far from dominant. It was a season of narrow escapes but they went 13-0. Oregon had a large crowd edge in the Rose Bowl. FSU had a 272-261 yd edge in the 1H but lost 59-20. It was their first loss in 2Y. LY they did not win the ACC Title and they were upset in the bowl for a 3 loss season.

2015 ANALYSIS 10-3 - LY FSU had just 11 ret st's, were -71 all-conf pts (pg 33), had benefitted from 7 net close wins (pg 24) & were only +68.6 ypg in conf play (5th best). They were #10 AP preseason and had just 1 close call (Miami) getting to 6-0. They lined up for the GW FG vs GT but it was blk'd & ret'd for a TD & they lost. After beating Syracuse, they dominated early at #3 Clemson but were SOD twice & lost on the road. They clubbed their final 3 foes incl a 27-2 win over SEC East Champ Florida. They were a large favorite vs a Group of Five team in the bowl but were upset by Houston to finish 10-3.

PHIL'S FORECAST

OFFENSE - In '13 FSU averaged an amazing 51.6 ppg. The solid 33.7 and 31.7 of the L2Y pales in comparison. LY they not only had to replace QB Winston but also 174 car sts from the O-line and had just 4 starters back. TY they have all 11 starters back including Heisman candidate Dalvin Cook and this offensive line should be one of the nation's best. This team should score about a TD per game more than they did last year.

DEFENSE - The Seminoles D allowed an avg of 270 ypg and 14.0 ppg from '11-'13 but took a big step back in 14 (397, 25.6) before improving LY (337, 17.5). TY they have 6 st's back and the unit is loaded with VHT's. They do lose some key players but should still have one of the nation's top defenses.

2016 - There were a lot of key indicators pointing down LY (see 2015 Analysis above) but they were still very close to an unbeaten regular season LY. That '15 squad was #128 on my Experience Chart and this year they have 17 ret st's and climb up to #49. They have a tough schedule drawing Ole Miss, Miami and Louisville all away from home but get perhaps the key game of their season (Clemson) in Tallahassee. I rate Florida St #1 in the ACC on the O-line and on the D-line. They have 57 lettermen back with just 15 lost. In 2013 I had Florida St as my #1 Surprise team (non Top 10 team that could win the National Title) and they won it all. They had the #1 recruiting class this year. They can't make my surprise team list TY because they are in the Top 10 but they are a National Title contender once again.

FSU was shutout in their only prior mtg but that was in 1961. The Seminoles just played their spring gm at the Citrus Bowl in Orlando on 4-9-16. Florida St is 7-0 since '91 opening a ssn at a neutral site.

FSU won the only prior mtg 62-10 in '11 w/a 647-84 yd edge (+26 FD). Noles are 25-1 in home openers (loss to Miami in '09, 38-34). Buccaneers went 10-3 LY (ranked #6 FCS/playoff tm) incl losses at Troy & Bama.

FSU owns a 14-2 overall mark in the series. LTH they trailed 21-0 2Q before mounting a furious comeback. FSU's 374 tll yds in the 2H, was more than UL had all'd in any prior reg ssn full gm in '14.

In-state schools have met just 3x's (FSU is 2-1). LTH ('12) the Seminoles made their 1st appearance in Tampa s'79 & won 30-17 taking advantage of 2 USF TO's, while also holding a 424-268 yd edge.

Just 7-0 into 4Q, FSU held BC to 7 punts, 2 TO's, SOD & EOH.

LTH former FSU QB Winston went 30-36-317 yds & 3 td, in a 38-20 win, giving FSU a school record 22nd str victory.

LY FSU handcuffed UF as the 2 pts were fewest all'd in the series 60 gms. FSU led 13-0 into 4Q & after a UF SAF tacked on 15 & 29 yd td runs. Since '06 if FSU has the ACC Title on deck they are 3-1 but 2-4 when ending reg ssn w/their rivals.
