POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2016

QUARTERBACKS - In '13 Baker Mayfield started 7 gms as a true frosh walk-on at Texas Tech (2315, 64%, 12-9, 190 rush, B12 FPOY). While Mayfield sat out his trans in '14, Trevor Knight & Cody Thomas combined for 54.4% which was Oklahoma's lowest comp % s/05 (53.3%). With OC Lincoln Riley bringing in the TT offense LY, I called for Mayfield to win the job & for much improved numbers. Mayfield was just 8-25-84 with 2 int's trailing Tenn by 14 in the 4Q but HC Bob Stoops stuck with him and was rewarded. He led the comeback win & had a great ssn. He had an OU rec 572 total yds in the win vs Tulsa (Landry Jones 554 '12 vs WV). OU led 23-7 with 320 yds vs TCU when he was inj'd. Knight QB'd the 2H (5-16-76-0-1) and OU barely held on. Mayfield threw for 3,700 (68.1%, 36-7, 405 rush). Knight transferred and Thomas left for baseball (could return) so the only schlp bkp is true frosh Austin Kendall (PS#13 IFS). Mayfield will probably run less and while he just missed out on a trip to New York in '15 (Heisman), he should earn a trip TY.

RUNNING BACKS - In '14 Oklahoma had to replace its top 3 rushers (comb 1857, 5.3). The leading returnee had just 134 (5.8) but I still ranked the Sooners in my top RB units. While OU had PS#3 true frosh Joe Mixon, the talk amongst the players and coaches was of Samaje Perine (PS#22, 275 bench 20x, 35' LY). Perine broke the FBS record with 427 and 5 td's vs Kansas and led with 1,713 (6.5). Soph Alex Ross (PS#15) was #2 w/595 (6.8) while Mixon was susp. The top 3 RB's comb for 2,700 (6.4). Their 5.2 ypc in '13 was the best of Stoops' 16 seasons and they topped that in '14 with 6.1. LY they changed to the "Air Raid" offense and after Perine, Mixon and Ross avg just 114 ypg rush over the first 6. Riley used them more and in the final 6 they avg 255 ypg. Both Perine & Mixon were inj'd in the bowl while true frosh Rodney Anderson (PS#18) RS (inj WK 2). Ross departs (trans to Missouri) but the Perine/Mixon combo (2,102 comb yds '15) could be the best in the country.

RECEIVERS - In '14 the Sooners had to replace 3 of their top 4 (comb 1337, 13.1). Sterling Shepard had 15 rec's vs Kansas St (tie single gm rec) but was limited in the last 6 (inj). He still led w/970 (19.0)! Durrone Neal (PS#9) was #2 (513, 12.2). LY they had to replace a #4DC TE, but added 1st Tm AA JUCO DeDe Westbrook (PS#21, 185.9 ypg at JC, speed, IFS). Shepard was one of the nation's best WR's (1288, 15.0) while Westbrook was #2 (743, 16.2). RFr TE Mark Andrews (PS#2) had an OU frosh record 7 rec TD's. TY they lose 3rd Tm AA WR Shepard (13 st, #2DC NYG) and Durrone Neal (11 st, 559, 12.7). I do expect a dropoff but there are a lot of VHT's in the wings (see below) including Penn St transfer Geno Lewis (PS#18).

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '14 the Sooners had to replace a 1st Tm AA 4Y starting C and a 2Y starting RG but did have

107 car sts returning and OL cch Bill Bedenbaugh felt it was his deepest unit since he'd arrived. The Sooners improved to 261 rush ypg with their 6.1 ypc being the best s/1971 (6.6 under Barry Switzer). They also all'd just 9 sks (2.3%). LY they lost a 1st Tm B12 RT (#4DC, 3Y str), 1st Tm B12 LT (#6DC, 2.5Y str), 2nd Tm B12 LG (3Y str) and 2 bkps. The unit lost 144 car sts and only ret'd just 28. RFr Orlando Brown emerged in August. After the Texas game they were avg just 144 ypg rush (3.6) but shuffled the unit putting true frosh Dru Samia (PS#58) at RT and RFr Jonathan Alvarez at LG. In the final 8 they avg 271 (5.8). TY they lose 1st Tm B12 C Ty Darlington (12/26), 1st Tm B12 RG Nila Kasitati (13/26), LG Derek Farniok (4/5) and Josiah St John (4/4). They go from 1.5 ret str's to 3 and only lose 61 car sts (ret 32). With 3 frosh starters in '15, they are much more exp'd in '16 and add in PS#38 & 40 JC's (both IFS).

DEFENSIVE LINE - The Sooners had everyone back on the D-line in '14 and I said it would resemble the strong OU rush D's of old and they led the B12 in rush D (106, 3.0, 32 sk). LY they lost their top 2 tkl'r's in a #2DC DT and 2nd Tm B12 DE. Charles Tapper was the focus of NFL scouts all year (50 tkl, 7 sk) but OU slipped to 162 ypg rush (3.8) despite having 40 sacks. This year 5 of the top 6 are back with the lone loss being 2x 1st Tm B12 DE Tapper (#4DC DAL, 13 st). His bkp, Charles Walker, earned 2nd Tm B12 despite not starting a single game. Calvin Thibodeaux is their 3rd DL cch in 3Y. This could be an improved group even after losing their top guy.

LINEBACKERS - LY the Sooners lost their #8 tkl'r (#3DC) but they ret'd their #1, #2 and #4 tkl'r's including 1st Tm B12 Eric Striker and got Frank Shannon back (95 tkl '13 susp '14) so the unit looked pretty formidable in '15. My computer (pg 43) called for OU to allow 364 ypg and that's exactly what they allowed! This year they lose 5 of their top 6. Gone are 2X AA Striker (13 st, #4 tkl'r, 7.5 sk, 11.5 tfl), 2X All-B12 Dominique Alexander (13 st, #1 tkl'r, 7 tfl, UFA CLE), DeVante Bond (5 st, miss 4 inj, #10 tkl'r, #6DC TB), Frank Shannon (3 st, #7 tkl'r) and PL Lindley (3 st, 14 tkl). Still a solid group incl 2nd Tm B12 ILB Jordan Evans returns, but they are still less exp'd.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - OU always finishes high in my PDR, even with an inexp'd secondary. LY they lost a SS (#5 tkl'r) and CB (#10 tkl'r). They were a little more exp'd and ret'd 1st Tm B12 Zack Sanchez and had a new DB coach in Kerry Cooks. Their #23 finish in '14 was their "worst" s/04 and not only did they improve, but they went all the way up to #1 in my PDR (52.6%, 19-20). TY they lose 3rd Tm AA CB Sanchez (11 st, #9 tkl'r, 7 int, 7 pbu, #5DC CAR) and FS Hatari Byrd (2 st, 29 tkl). They return 9 of the top 11 including 2nd Tm B12 CB Jordan Thomas (#8 tkl'r, 5 int) and 2nd Tm B12 S Ahmad Thomas (#3 tkl'r) and remain one of the nation's best.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Stoops has eleven Top 16 ST finishes in his 18Y and has only finished worse than #37 twice. Last year they lost their K (#4 FBS all-time scoring) and P but it was business as usual. Nick Hodgson (#2 FBS '10 w/58 TB's) had 52 TB on 102 KO's in '15. True frosh Austin Seibert (PS#4) avg 42.0 on punts with a 41.1 net (opp 12 PR yds) and hit 18-23 FG's (long 46) earning Frosh AA. Alex Ross had 718 (31.2) on KR's in '14 but slipped to 645 (21.5) in '15. OU was a strong #3 overall. They lose PR Shepard (7.8) and Ross transferred but Oklahoma will contend for Top 10 honors again.

COACHES - Bob Stoops arrived in '99, won a Nat'l Title in his 2nd ssn, played in 3 more National Title games and is OU's all-time winningest coach. He is the ONLY HC to win the quartet of Rose, Sugar, Fiesta & Orange Bowls. Stoops is one of 2 HC's (LSU Les Miles) to have won 8 or more gms at one school the L11Y. Lincoln Riley brought the "Air Raid" to Norman LY after being the EC OC the previous 5Y & a TT asst for 7Y

(alma mater). Bob's brother Mike is now in his 5th ssn of his second stint ('99-'03) as DC (Ariz's HC prev 8 yrs). Jay Boulware has run the ST's the L3Y & held the same post at Auburn ('09-'12), Iowa St ('07-'08), Utah (co '05-'06) and Arizona ('03).

THIS DECADE 62-17 (78.5%) #8 - In Stoops' 2nd year ('00) Oklahoma did not have a starter miss a single gm due to inj. They stunned the nation, winning the Nat'l Title despite not being in the preseason Top 20. In the L15Y, Stoops has had ten Top 10 finishes with 9 of those at #6 or higher. They played in the National Title game in '03, '04 and '08 but came up short in all 3. The key for Oklahoma is not to be ranked high in the preseason. 2013 was the first time s/'00 that they were not in the preseason Top 10 (#16). An under the radar Okla exceeded expectations and upset Alabama in the Sugar Bowl to finish #6. 2014 was the 9th time in 14Y that they were preseason #4 or higher. Interestingly had they lost to Bama, they wouldn't have been in the Top 10. Once again when ranked high they disappointed (8-5 NR 1st time s/'09). LY they opened at #19, and they made the playoffs. They are #8 in win % this decade and the previous decade were 110-24 (82.1%).

2015 ANALYSIS 11-2 - A lot of indicators were pointing up in '15. OU ranked a +2.5 in my Stock Market Indicator, had -5 net upsets in '14, and were +31 in ret all-conf pts. The previous 2 times Stoops was not in the preseason Top 10 they finished #1 and #6. In between 2 DD wins, OU was outplayed by Tenn for 3Q and trailed 17-3 but rallied for a 2OT win to get their season rolling. They beat #23 WV 44-24 but then looked like a pretender as they lost to Texas 24-17 (national media pounded them). It was unleash the hounds time and in the final 7 reg ssn games the offense avg'd 299.9 ypg rush and 293 ypg pass (almost 300/300!). They were fortunate in their games vs #4 Baylor, #11 TCU & #9 Oklahoma St (B2B2B weeks) as they faced 3 bkp QB's. They were favored over Clemson in the Orange Bowl and led 17-16 at half but imploded and lost by 20 to finish 11-2 and #5 in the AP.

PHIL'S FORECAST

OFFENSE - In the spring of 2014 Gil Brandt told me that OC Lincoln Riley (then at EC) was one of his favorite OC's and on the rise. Sure enough, Riley got the OC job at Oklahoma and the Sooners improved to 530 ypg and 43.5 ppg while making the playoffs. This year they have QB Mayfield, RB's Perine and Mixon and a veteran O-line back. While they won't top LY's totals, they still have one of the top offenses in the country.

DEFENSE - The Sooners D has been steadily allowing between 22.0-25.9 ppg and 350-398 ypg the last 5 yrs. They return 6 starters just like LY but this time lose most of their marquee defenders. This should still be the typical strong Oklahoma defense that we're accustomed to. They have my #2 rated DL, #3 LB's and #1 DB's in the conf so despite playing in the Big 12, they could still have a Top 10 defense.

2016 - Bob Stoops is 96-8 at home and they get key games vs Baylor, Ohio St and Oklahoma St in Norman. Oklahoma usually fares better when expectations are low but this year they will be Preseason Top 5 although they have not finished above #15 (unranked twice!) the last 4 times in that role. They have one of the toughest schedules in the country (#19) but are near the top talent wise and have an experienced QB. As long as they do not run into Clemson again in the post season (lost 77-23 L2Y), they have a shot at getting back to the playoffs and making the National Title game. Both the offense and the defense rank in my Top 10 and they are a complete team at every position.

OU is 2-0 vs UH (won L/gm 63-13 in '04) and this marks the series 2nd neutral venue (Sun Bowl in '81). NRG Stadium is home to the NFL Houston Texans. The Sooners are 15-3 s/'98 in their road opener.

Sooners shutout Warhawks 34-0 in '13 (only prior mtg). It was 0-0 into the 2Q but OU finished with 429-166 yd & 25-9 FD edges. OU is 28-2 in Norman openers (both losses vs TCU in '96 & '05 while ranked #7).

One of the most anticipated gms in '16. HT is 0-2 but L/mtg was in '83, OU lost 24-14. Sooners under Stoops are 20-15 vs Top 10 ranked foes. Stoops is 2-5 vs OSU as a plyr/coch (Iowa DB/staff from '79-'87).

Bonus: OU is 96-8 (92%) under Stoops at Memorial Stadium but 5 losses have come in the L4Y. **Bonus:** Oklahoma is 16-1 in games immediately following the RRS under Stoops.

LTH Oklahoma led 31-24 3Q. Turning pt was a TCU 41 yd IR 4Q (OU ret blk'd XP). Down 4, OU was int'd at the TCU9 & SOD at TCU22. Sooners are 23-8 s/'08 in B12 AG's incl 14-2 L4Y (avg win by 20 ppg).

Only 6 of the L/18 RRS's haven't been decided by DD's (L/2 by 7 pts or less). This series is deadlocked at 6-6 L12Y alternating wins/losses the L4Y. Stoops 10 wins over UT is the most by an OU HC.

OU is 64-10-1 S/35 (prior to '12 & '14, OU's last reg ssn loss had been in '97). LY, off the RRS loss OU dominated KSU from start to finish (+458 yds/+23 FD). KSU had 9 of 13 drives go 3pl or less (2 comb yds).

LTH's gm was tied 21-21 into the 4Q after OU trailed 21-7 early 3Q. After a TT fg w/14:11 left, OU put the gm away w/21 unanswered outgaining TT 162-2 during that span. TT gbg td came on the final play.

LY Oklahoma led 21-0 & 55-7 into the 4Q. KU's only td (29/6pl drive) was set up by a fmbld Sooner PR late 1Q. Into '16, OU is 46-5 hosting B12 foes s/'02 (the 3 losses at home in '14 were most s/'97).

LTH OU led 21-0 in the 1Q, nevering looking back. Sooners had a trio of plyr's each rush for 100+ yds (incl Perine & Ross). This marks just the 2nd non-Sat reg ssn gm for OU L9Y, lost in '13 at BU 41-12.

The Sooners had won 20 straight over the Bears but are just 2-3 s/'11. LY Oklahoma broke a 20-20 3Q tie by scoring 14 str. Baylor cut the lead to 3 w/10:29 left but OU got a td & then an int.

LTH Oklahoma returned a KO 100 yds for a td 1:08 before HT, 24-24. OU opened the 2H going 75/7pl with a 9 yd td run & never relinquished the lead.

The Mountaineers cut the deficit to just 4 but the Sooners answered w/2 td's before West Virginia scored a td w/2:12.

OU leads Bedlam 85-18-7 (13-4 under Stoops). LY after trailing 10-7 1Q, OU scored 37 of the next 44 & gms L/14 pts.
